SDSU Swimming and Diving Team Travels North to San Luis Obispo for Triangular Meet Vs. Host Cal Poly, Pepperdine

• The San Diego State swimming and diving team will compete in its final away meet on Friday before the Mountain West Conference Championships when it travels to San Luis Obispo, Calif., for a tri-meet versus host Cal Poly and Pepperdine. The meet is set to begin a noon.

Last Week With The Aztecs

• SDSU split in its two meets last week, with a convincing 175-116 victory over Northern Colorado on Thursday and a 136-107 loss to MWC foe Wyoming on Saturday.

◆ On Thursday, the Aztecs won 11 individual events and the 200-yard medley relay en route to a 175-116 triumph over Northern Colorado. Junior Emily Parker, sophomore Katie Smith and freshman Kendal Twilling led the way for the Aztecs with two wins apiece. Parker was victorious in the 500 (5:12.08) and 1,000 free (10:33.18), Smith took first in the 100 (1:01.21) and 200 back (2:12.33), and Twilling earned first-place finishes in the 100 (1:08.59) and 200 breast (2:27.59).

Senior Samantha Peters won the 100 free in a season-best time of 53.92 and junior Kimberlee Frith took first in the 200 free with a 1:55.56 clocking, while junior Stella Karoly raced to a first-place showing in the 200 fly (2:11.68).

The 200 medley relay team of Smith, freshman Lizette Patterson, Karoly and Peters earned a first-place finish with a time of 1:51.81.

SDSU swept the diving events as sophomore Joelle Felton won the 3-meter diving competition with 225.67 points and freshman Megan Flanagan took first in the 1-meter event (225.67).

◆ In the 136-107 loss to Wyoming on Saturday afternoon, Frith won two events to lead the Aztecs. Frith, the school-record holder in the 200 free, won the event with a time of 1:53.68. She later took first in the 100 free (53.27), and anchored the 400 free relay to a first-place finish and season-best time of 3:37.87.

Peters raced to a first-place showing in the 50 free (24.98) and was runner-up to Frith in the 100 free (54.49), while Smith won the 100 back in 1:00.46.

Senior Emily Schmied had a pair of second places in the 200 free (1:54.68) and 100 fly (1:00.05), and joined Frith, Karoly and Rachel Rife on the victorious 400 free relay.

Flanagan was the top diver for SDSU with fourth-place showings in the 1-meter (221.46 points) and the 3-meter (229.05) events.

Scouting Cal Poly

• The Mustangs (0-6) fell to Cal Baptist (190-106), Loyola Marymount (185-77) and Northern Colorado (207-91) over the weekend. The Aztecs have defeated both Loyola Marymount (180-107, Jan. 6) and Northern Colorado (175-116, Jan. 19) in the new year.

Against Cal Baptist, Stacey Sorensen placed first in the 50 free (25.32) and second in the 100 Back (1:03.37), and Erin Moody was second in the 500 free (5:28.84).

In the double-dual meet against Loyola Marymount and Northern Colorado, Kira Linsmeier led Cal Poly with a second-place finish in the 200 free (1:59.45). Other second-place showings for the Mustangs went to Sorensen in the 50 free (25.10), in the 200 back (2:14.83) and Leanne Singleton in the 200 breast (2:29.98).

A Look at Pepperdine

• The Waves are 0-1 after falling to Loyola Marymount, 155-139, on Thursday, Jan. 19 in Pepperdine. Leading Pepperdine was Ali McLeod who took first in the 100 back (58.08) and the 200 IM (2:23.59). McLeod also swam to a second-place finish in the 100 free (52.73), while Nicole Okuna placed first in the 100 fly with a time of 59.03.

The 400 free relay team of Ketrina Lemmen, Heather Brehmer, McLeod, and Haley Wilson took first (3:42.72), while the 200 medley relay of Lemmen, Lauren Velarde, Okuna and Brehmer placed second (1:50.32).

Aztecs Among the Mountain West Leaders

• SDSU is making waves in the Mountain West Conference as several athletes are ranked among the top-10 in the league.

Junior transfer Kimberlee Frith leads the way with the MWC's fastest time in the 200 free (1:51.48). She is also fifth in the 500 free (5:02.17) and sixth in the 100 free (52.22).

Freshman Diana MacManus is seventh in the 100 back (58.20) and 10th in the 200 back (2:06.74).

Other top-10 MWC times by Aztecs include junior Emily Parker in the 1,000 free (10:30.66) and classmate Stella Karoly in the 200 fly (2:09.12).
