THIS WEEK

The San Diego State swimming and diving team will be in San Antonio, Texas, to compete at the Mountain West championships to be conducted from Wednesday, Feb. 20 through Saturday, Feb. 23. This marks the first year that the meet will be held at the Palo Alto College Aquatic Center in San Antonio. The meet was held in Oklahoma City each of the previous 13 years.

San Diego State will be looking to regain the league championship that it won in 2011 and lost by just five points to Boise State in 2012.

HEAD COACH MIKE SHRADER

San Diego State head coach Mike Shrader is in his sixth season with the Aztecs and has compiled a dual meet record of 70-13 (.844) during his tenure. Shrader has been named the Mountain West Coach of the Year on three occasions (2011, 2010, co-coach in 2009). Including eight seasons as the head coach at Nevada, his career record stands at 165-26-1 (.862).

AZTECS CONCLUDE SEASON WITH WIN AT USD

San Diego State Wrapped up its regular season with a 176-118 dual meet victory at the University of San Diego on Jan. 26. The Aztecs captured 12 of 14 swimming events and both diving events en route to the win.

Junior Mikaela Macklin led the way for San Diego State in the individual races as she recorded three first-place finishes. Macklin won the 100 and 200 backstroke events with times of 57.29 and 2:03.25 respectively. She came back later in the meet to emerge victorious in the 200 individual medley with a mark of 2:05.60.

SWIMMERS OF THE WEEK

Three Aztecs earned Mountain West Swimmer of the Week honors during the 2012-13 season.

Mikaela Macklin earned the award on Oct. 10 after finishing first overall in the pentathlon against the University of San Diego.

Melanie Garibaldi received the honor on Oct. 24 for her effort at the Pacific Invitational where she won three individual races and one relay.

Katelyn Weddle was named the MW Swimmer of the Week on Nov. 21 for her performance in the breast-stroke races during the Arena Invitational. Her times in both of those events were the best in the conference his season and were NCAA "B" Cut marks.

DIVER OF THE WEEK

Junior Anna Steiner captured conference Diver of the Week honors on Jan. 9 after she won both the 1-meter and 3-meter boards in the dual meet against Tulane. While doing so she set a career best on the 1-meter and a season best on the 3 meter.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

San Diego State completed its third consecutive undefeated home season during its 2011-12 campaign with a 4-0. The Aztecs have now won their last 31 consecutive meets at home. SDSU's record at the Aztec Aquaplex stands at 42-3 since the facility opened for the 2007-08 season.

THE STREAK ENDS

San Diego State saw its lengthy dual meet win streak come to an end with the loss at UCLA on January 12. SDSU had won its last 45 straight meets dating back to the 2009-10 season prior to the loss to the Bruins. The Aztecs' last loss came against Wyoming on Jan. 29, 2010, in Laramie. San Diego State also had its streak of 55 straight wins against non-conference opponents ended as well. The last loss to a non-Mountain West team had been a defeat at North Texas on Nov. 17, 2006. In current Head Coach Mike Shrader's four seasons at SDSU, the Aztecs have now lost only one dual meet to a non-conference foe.

SCHOOL RECORDS SET

Aztec individual swimmer set a pair of San Diego State senior swimmers set school records this season, both during the Arena Invitational (Nov. 15-17). Melanie Garibaldi swam a 4:15.24 in the 400 IM to record the best time in school history. Gemma Johnson added a new Aztec all-time best in the 100 butterfly with a mark of 53.36. Garibaldi improved her school record time by 1.51 second while Johnson bettered her previous school record mark by .15 second.

In addition, diver Anna Steiner established a school record on the 1-meter springboard when she recorded a mark of 317.30 during the diving against the University of San Diego.

TOP 10 AZTEC TIMES

In addition to the school records set during the 2012-13 season, SDSU swimmers turned in a total of 21 individual times that enter the school record book among the top 10 all-time fastest marks in school history. There were also 14 relay times that rank among the top 10 ever at San Diego State as well as seven diving scores.

TOP 2012-13 CONFERENCE TIMES

Of the 14 individual swimming events contested in the Mountain West, San Diego State swimmers currently have the top conference times in seven of those races. That group includes the following:
