

WHAT'S ON TAP THIS WEEKEND IN AZTEC BASEBALL

- ◆ San Diego State continues a four-game home stand with a three-game Mountain West series against Nevada this weekend.
- ◆ SDSU will face the Wolf Pack in single games on Friday (Mar. 7) at 6:00 p.m., Saturday (Mar. 8) at 2:00 p.m. and Sunday (Mar. 9) at 12:00 p.m.
- All three of those contests can be viewed live on the Mountain Digital Network with links available at www.GoAztecs.com.

SERIES RECORD

- San Diego State leads the series with Nevada by a 9-8 margin since the teams first met during the 1986 season.
- ◆ Last season the Aztecs swept a three-game series vs. the Wolf Pack at Tony Gwynn Stadium and lost two of three in Reno.
- ♦ The Aztecs are 4-3 at home, 2-4 away and 3-1 at neutral sites vs. Nevada.

SCOUTING THE WOLF PACK

- ◆ Nevada enters the week with a record of 5-7 and 2-4 in the Mountain West. Most recently it defeated Pacific, 8-4, Tuesday night in Stockton after winning two of three from San Jose State at home last weekend.
- ◆ The Wolf Pack offense is led by shortstop Kyle Hunt (.343, 4 doubles, 5 RBI), left fielder Kewby Meyer (.340, 6 doubles, 6 RBI) and designated hitter Trenton Brooks (.333, double, 4 RBI).
- ◆ Michael Fain (1-1, 1.76) will get the start on Friday with the other two starters TBD. Adam Whitt has recorded a pair of saves out of the bullpen.
- ◆ Nevada is hitting .258 as a team with a 4.36 earned run average.

HEAD COACH TONY GWYNN

- ◆ Tony Gwynn is in his 12th season as San Diego State's head coach after being named to the position in Sept. 2001. He became just the fourth head coach in SDSU history since baseball was elevated to major sport status in 1936.
- ◆ In 2002, he served as a volunteer coach for the Aztecs under Jim Dietz, who retired at the end of that season.
- ◆ In 2004, Gwynn led his squad to the Mountain West Conference regular-season championship and was named the MWC coach of the year.
- ◆ A former Aztec who played baseball at San Diego State from 1979 to 1981, Gwynn concluded a 20year major league career with the San Diego Padres in 2001. With a career batting average of .338, he won eight National League batting titles, five Gold Gloves, and made 15 appearances in the annual All-Star Game.
- ◆ Tony Gwynn was inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame on July 29, 2007.
- His overall record entering the week stands at 330-345 (.489). His mark in conference contests is 164-123 (.571).

FRANCE HAS BIG WEEK

- Over SDSU's last six contests, third baseman Ty France has hit .560 (14-for-25) with seven extra-base hits (five doubles, two home runs), nine RBI and six runs scored.
- In those six games he has compiled a 1.000 slugging percentage and a .607 on-base percentage.
- ◆ Most recently he went 3-for-5 with two RBI and a run scored in the win over the University of San Diego on Tuesday (Mar. 4).
- He leads the team in batting average, runs scored, doubles, home runs and runs batted in.
- His three doubles in the contest vs. West Virginia on Sunday (Feb. 23) tied the SDSU record for two-baggers in a game.

CEDEROTH SAVES

- Since moving to the SDSU bullpen as the closer, junior Michael Cederoth has made six appearances and recorded a win and four saves.
- In those six relief stints he has allowed no runs on one hit while striking out 10 over eight innings.
- Last week he made two appearances out of the pen as SDSU's closer and registered two saves.
- ◆ At UC Riverside (Feb. 25) he came on in the bottom of the ninth after SDSU had come back to take an 8-7 lead. He gave up a leadoff single, then retired the next three batters including striking out the final two to preserve the victory.
- ◆ On Saturday (Mar. 1) at St. Mary's, he entered the contest in the bottom of the eighth and got the final two outs of the inning. He then struck out the side in the ninth (two looking) for his third save of the season as he faced the minimum of five hitters over his 1.2 innings of work.

BROWN EMERGES

- ◆ Freshman Andrew Brown made the start at first base on Tuesday vs. USD due to the illness of regular starter Ryan Muno.
- ◆ Brown responded by registering the first three hits of his collegiate career including

- a solo home run that provided SDSU's final run of the contest in the eighth inning.
- ◆ On the night he recorded three RBI and scored once as he lifted is batting average to the .333 mark.

ZIER LEADS THE HIT PARADE

- ◆ Tim Zier had a five-game hitting streak end in the series finale at St. Mary's last Sunday (Mar. 2).
- During that steak he hit .571 (12-for-21) with four doubles, eight runs scored and four RBI.
- ◆ He ended a streak of recording a double in four straight contests on Sunday as well.
- ◆ In the Tuesday (Mr. 4) game against USD, he had an RBI single in the first inning
- ◆ Zier has a pair of four-hit games this season, the only Aztec to accomplish that feat thus far in 2014.

SEYLER IS GOLDEN

- Despite taking the loss, sophomore Mark Seyler had another excellent outing in the series finale at St. Mary's last Sunday (Mar. 2).
- ◆ In that contest he tossed six innings allowing two runs (one earned) on four hits with a career-high nine strikeouts in the 2-0 loss.
- ◆ In the process he lowered his season earned run average to 3.20.
- ◆ The contest went only seven innings due to SDSU's travel commitments.

MUNO HITS AWAY

- Prior to missing Tuesday's game against USD due to illness, junior first baseman Ryan Muno hit safely in each of the previous five contests.
- Over that span he had gone 8-for-20 (.400) with three doubles, four RBI and five runs scored.
- ◆ He has made 10 starts at first base and one as the DH this season.

ALLEN STREAK ENDS

- After going 1-for-9 in the opening two games of the season, center fielder Greg Allen proceeded to hit safely in each of the next eight games.
- ◆ During that eight-game hitting streak, which ended on Sunday at St. Mary's, he batted .472 with six doubles, a triple, six RBI and eight runs scored.
- His eight multiple-hit games lead the team while his three multiple-RBI efforts ties for second on the squad.
- ♦ He had a pair of hits and scored twice in the win over USD on Tuesday (Mar. 4)

DERBY STARTS WELL

- ◆ Bubba Derby picked up his first win of the season in SDSU's 7-4 victory at St. Mary's last Sunday (Mar. 2).
- In that contest, his second start of the year, he went six innings allowing two runs on five hits with five strikeouts.
- Derby served as SDSU's closer as a freshman, making his only start last season vs. UNLV at the 2013 Mountain West Tournament.
- ◆ In his first start of the year vs. West Virginia on Feb. 22, he went eight innings allowing one run on four hits with a walk and seven strikeouts. He was not involved in the decision in the contest which SDSU won in 10 innings.

ZAVALA STREAKING

- Seby Zavala's eight-game hitting streak to open the season ended with the contest at St. Mary's last Saturday (Mar. 1).
- During his streak he hit .314 with three doubles, three RBI and six runs scored.
- Zavala has recorded four assists from left field including directly throwing out three runners at home plate.

POTTER STARTS STRONG

- Senior shortstop Evan Potter had a fourgame hitting streak ended in the series finale at St. Mary's on Sunday (Mar. 2).
- ◆ During that streak he hit .313 (5-for-16) with two doubles and two runs scored.
- ◆ He has been hit by pitch three times to bring his career total to 23 to rank sixth on the SDSU all-time list. The Aztec record is 36 by Pat Colwell (2007-09, 11).
- ◆ Potter also ranks third in career sac bunts with 27, just four off the school record of 31 held by Steve Dietz (1990-93).

HITTING STREAKS

- ◆ Ty France has the team's current longest hitting streak at eight games.
- ◆ That matches longest for an Aztec this season by both Seby Zavala and Tim Zier.
- ◆ Ryan Muno has a five-game hitting streak in progress entering the weekend as well.
- France and Zavala have reached safely in all 12 games (via hit, walk or hit by pitch) while Muno has done so in the 11 games in which he has appeared.

MOVING UP THE CHARTS

- Senior second baseman Tim Zier is within striking distance of several San Diego State career marks.
- ◆ He has played in 186 games during his SDSU career and could catch the record of 225 contests by Jake McLintock (2002-05).
- He is currently tied for fourth in career at bats with 737. The record is 843 by McLintock.
- ◆ Zier is also fourth in career hits with 241. The top Aztec mark is 281 by McLintock.
- His 28 times hit by pitch ranks fourth, eight behind record holder Pat Colwell (2007-09, 11).

Michael Cederoth is leads the conference with four saves.

◆ As a team, San Diego State is second in team batting average (.309), third in earned run average (3.60) and fourth in fielding percentage (.966).

COACHING ADDITIONS

- The Aztec baseball program has added a pair of new coaches and a new Director of Baseball Operations for the 2014 season.
- ◆ Taking over as the pitching coach is Veteran John Pawlowski, most recently the head coach at Auburn. A former Major League pitcher with the Chicago White Sox, he was also head coach at College of Charleston as well as an assistant at both Clemson and Arizona State.
- ◆ Joe Oliveira takes over as the team's volunteer assistant coach. A three-time all-conference selection as a catcher at University of the Pacific, he played in the Baltimore Orioles organization for three seasons before beginning his coaching career during the summer of 2013 at Battle creek in the Northwoods League.
- ◆ Former Aztec outfielder Landon Burt steps into the role of Director of Baseball Operations for the 2014 season. Burt was an all-Mountain West Conference honoree in 2004 when he batted .321 with six home runs and 30 stolen bases and was drafted by the Minnesota Twins that year.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- ◆ Junior catcher Brad Haynal (San Diego, Calif./Rancho Bernardo HS) earned the Mountain West Conference's Player of the Week award on Feb. 17 for his performance in the season-opening series at San Jose State.
- ◆ He hit for an average of .364 with four hits including a double and home run, three runs scored and six RBI.
- ◆ In the series opener, a 6-4 loss to the Spartans, he was 1-for-3 with one run scored and one RBI. In Saturday's 5-3 win, Haynal went 1-for-3 with one run scored, two RBIs and a double.
- ◆ Haynal then went 2-for-5 with one run scored, three RBI and a home run in the 13-8 weekend finale victory. His three-run homer in the fifth inning gave San Diego State a 9-7 lead after trailing the Spartans 7-2
- Over the three-game series he caught all 26 innings for the Aztecs and did not commit an error in 17 chances.

- In a vote of the seven MWC head coaches, the Aztecs received three first-place votes and 43 as did the Lobos. The remaining first-place vote went to UNLV, which was picked third.

PRESEASON ALL-AMERICA HONORS

- Juniors Greg Allen (OF) and Michael Cederoth (RHP) have been named preseason All-Americans by Baseball America.
- ◆ Allen, a second-team selection, hit .299 last season and was named to the alltournament team at the NCAA Regional at UCLA and at the Mountain West Tournament in Fresno.
- ◆ Cederoth was a second-team all-Mountain West performer a year ago, leading the league in strikeouts with 109 over 95.2 innings.
- In addition, Cederoth was listed as the No. 11 junior for the 2014 Major League draft while Allen was No. 38.

PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE

- Second baseman Tim Zier and center fielder Greg Allen have been tabbed to the Preseason all-Mountain West team in a vote of the league's coaches.
- ◆ Zier is the team's leading returning hitter (.341, 14 2B, 41 RBI, 18 SB).
- ◆ Allen led the Aztecs in runs scored (51), walks (36) and stolen bases (25) while hitting .299 as a sophomore last season.

DRAFTED AZTECS

- ◆ Two current member of the SDSU squad have been drafted by Major League clubs.
- ◆ That duo includes pitcher Michael Cederoth of Steele Canyon HS in San Diego (42nd rd. in 2011, Arizona Diamondbacks) and catcher CJ Saylor (33rd rd. in 2012, Los Angeles Dodgers).

AZTEC NOTES

- With a record of 9-3, San Diego State is off to its best start under Head Coach Tony Gwynn and the best for an SDSU squad since the 1997 team opened with a record of 14-2.
- ◆ The Aztecs have used only one player as a pinch hitter through the first seven games of the season, that being freshman Tyler Adkison who is 1-for-2 in that role.
- Five players have started every game thus
- ◆ Ty France is 8-for-13 (.615) with runners in scoring position while Greg Allen is also 8-for-13 (.615).
- ◆ Freshman Ryan Alvarez made his first appearance as an Aztec in the win at St. Mary's last Sunday (Mar. 2). He did not record a hit in two at bats, but did have an RBI on a fielder's choice.
- ◆ Tanner Reibenspies has made two plate appearances as the DH and has singled in both at bats. He had the game-winning RBI in the ninth inning of the game at UC Riverside on Feb. 25.

UP NEXT

- San Diego State will be back on the road for a mid-week contest next week when it travels to Cal State Northridge on Tuesday Mar. 11, to take on the Matadors at 2:00 p.m.
- ◆ The Aztecs will then return home to host a four-game series against Purdue that gets underway on Friday, Mar. 14, at 6:00 p.m.
- ◆ SDSU and Purdue will also meet on Saturday (Mar. 15) at 6:00 p.m., Sunday (Mar. 16) at 1:00 p.m. and Monday (Mar. 17) at 6:00 p.m. at Tony Gwynn Stadium.
- The series will mark the first-ever meetings betweent he Aztecs and Boilermakers on the baseball field.
