SDSU Softball Plays Host to Five-Day Campbell/Cartier Classic This Weekend

The San Diego State softball team plays host to the prestigious 21st annual Campbell/Cartier Classic this weekend at SDSU Softball Stadium.

This year's classic features eight teams, including the defending national champion (No. 6/9 UCLA), two other nationally ranked schools (No. 23/rv Fresno State and No. 25/23 Houston), two programs that are receiving votes in either poll (the Aztecs and Baylor), a 2010 NCAA Super Regional squad (Brigham Young) and two perennial Big West powers (Long Beach State and Cal Poly). The eight teams will play a combined 20 games over the five-day tournament.

SDSU (6-7) plays six games over the five days, beginning with Long Beach State (4:30 p.m. PT) and Houston (7 p.m. PT) on Thursday. San Diego State is also scheduled to play Fresno State (6 p.m. PT) on Friday, UCLA on Saturday (6 p.m. PT), Cal Poly on Sunday (2 p.m. PT) and Baylor on Monday (6 p.m. PT). The classic kicks off at 11:30 a.m. Thursday with Houston and Brigham Young.

The tournament is named after Susanne Campbell and Karin Cartier, who lost their lives during the 1991 softball season in a single-car accident that took place in Rosarito, Mexico. It left a lasting mark on teammates, coaches and the program. To pay tribute to Campbell and Cartier, the Aztec softball team renamed the SDSU Spring Classic in 1994 to the Campbell/Cartier Classic in memory of their friendship and fine athletic ability.

Six of SDSU's seven losses this season have come against top-10 teams and 2010 Women's College World Series foes, including the Bruins back on Feb. 13. For the season, nine of San Diego State's opponents made last year's NCAA tournament. The Aztecs' opponents this year have combined to go 116-59 (.663).

Sophomore Kameran May (.394), redshirt senior Lindsey Marquez (.333) and junior Justeen Maeva (.323) are each hitting above .300 for SDSU. Junior Bailey Micetich (4-5, 3.26 ERA, 38.2 IP) and senior All-American Samantha Beasley (1-2, 4.59 ERA, 29.0 IP) have spent the bulk of the time in the circle.

HEAD COACH | 15TH SEASON | CS FULLERTON, 1983

- As a player, Van Wyk earned All-America honors and won the Broderick Award, given to the best player in the nation, in 1981 after going 35-1 with a 0.18 ERA. The victories remain a school single-season record and .972 winning percentage was an NCAA Division I record until 2001. Her phenomenal season included four no-hitters, six one-hitters, back-to-back perfect games, 26 shutouts and 270 strikeouts.
- Is the school's all-time winningest coach with 481 career victories, including a program-best 44 wins in 2008
- Earned her third Mountain West Conference Coach of the Year award in 2008 after leading the Aztecs to a 15-5 mark in league play. She also won the award in 2002 and 2006.
- Has led SDSU to six NCAA tournament appearances (2001, 2003, 2006, 2008, 2009 and 2010)
- Guided San Diego State to its fourth MWC regular season title in 2008 with a 15-5 record. The team's other championships came in 2002, 2003 and 2006.
- Coached her third All-American in 2010 in Samantha Beasley. Beasley was named to the Louisville Slugger/NFCA Third Team.
- Has coached 46 all-conference selections, seven MWC Pitchers of the Year, four MWC Freshmen of the Year and 87 conference player/pitcher of the week winners

21st Annual Campbell/Cartier Classic Info

The San Diego State University Campbell/Cartier Classic is an annual event held in the memory of former Aztec softball players Susanne Campbell and Karin Cartier. Campbell and Cartier lost their lives during the 1991 softball season in a single-car accident that took place in Rosarito, Mexico. It left a lasting mark on teammates, coaches and the program.

Campbell, a three-year starting catcher, was in her senior year. She had a .344 batting average, was an all-Western Athletic Conference selection and led the Aztecs in many offensive and defensive categories. She also set several single-season and career records and is among the top softball athletes to wear an SDSU uniform.

Cartier, a transfer pitcher from Hawai'i, had an excellent 1991 season at SDSU. She was emerging as a top pitcher and great hitter. Along with Campbell, Cartier was one of the strongest Aztecs in the weight room and possessed good leadership abilities and Division I playing experience.

To pay tribute to Susanne Campbell and Karin Cartier, the San Diego State softball team renamed the SDSU Spring Classic in 1994 to the Campbell/Cartier Classic in memory of their friendship and fine athletic ability. The 2011 tournament will be the 21st annual classic.

The 2011 version of the Campbell/Cartier Classic will once again be one of the strongest tournaments in the nation. This year's classic features eight teams, including the defending national champion (No. 6/9 UCLA), two other nationally ranked schools (No. 23/rv Fresno State and No. 25/23 Houston), two programs that are receiving votes in either poll (the Aztecs and Baylor), a 2010 NCAA Super Regional squad (Brigham Young) and two perennial Big West powers (Long Beach State and Cal Poly). All eight teams were below 104 (out of 290 schools) in last year's final RPI, including top-50 teams UCLA (No. 3), San Diego State (No. 28), Brigham Young (No. 31), Fresno State (No. 41) and Houston (No. 50).

The eight teams will play a combined 20 games over the five-day tournament. SDSU plays six games, beginning with Long Beach State (4:30 p.m. PT) and Houston (7 p.m. PT) on Thursday. San Diego State is also scheduled to play Fresno State (6 p.m. PT) on Friday, UCLA on Saturday (6 p.m. PT), Cal Poly on Sunday (2 p.m. PT) and Baylor on Monday (6 p.m. PT). (.353) and junior Ashley Rose (.333) each cleared .300. Senior All-American Samantha Beasley (San Diego/Steele Canyon HS) (0-1, 4.08 ERA, 12.0 IP) and junior Bailey Micetich (1-3, 4.47 ERA, 15.2 IP) combined for 35 strikeouts in 27 2/3 innings (8.85 per seven innings).

Long Beach State is off to a 9-5 start heading into this weekend. The 49ers went 2-3 last week at the Cathedral City Classic, including an impressive 2-1 win over No. 6/6 Oklahoma.

Megan Denio leads the .289-hitting team with a .438 average and five stolen bases. Caitrin DeBaun (.364) and Liz Javier (.350) are also hitting above .350 for Long Beach State. Erin Jones-Wesley leads the pitching staff with a 5-1 record and 1.59 ERA over 44 innings pitched.

Long Beach State leads the all-time series between the two schools, 47-23.

Scouting No. 25/23 Houston

Houston is 13-3 and ranked 25th in the latest USA Today/NFCA poll and 23rd by ESPN.com/USA Softball. Last weekend at the Getteman/STI Classic in Waco, Texas, the Cougars went 3-0 with wins of 8-0 and 1-0 over Louisiana-Monroe, and 1-0 over previously unbeaten Baylor.

Katy Beth Sherman leads Houston with a .357 batting average, while Brooke Lathan (.286, 6 HR, 12 RBI), Baillie Lott (.270, 4 HR, 10 RBI) and Jennifer Klunkert (.250, 4 HR, 10 RBI) have combined for 14 home runs and 32 RBIs. The pitching staff has been phenomenal for the Cougars this season, going 13-3 with a 0.79 ERA. Amanda Crabtree is 8-0 with a 0.40 ERA and 86 strikeouts over 52 innings, while Donna Bourgeois is 4-3 with a 1.29 ERA and 35 strikeouts over 49 innings.

Thursday will be the first meeting ever between the two schools.

A Glance at No. 23/rv Fresno State

Fresno State brings a 6-1 record into the Cambell/Cartier Classic with its only loss coming last weekend to Syracuse at the Cathedral City Classic. The Bulldogs, who are ranked 23rd by USA Today/NFCA, have beaten top-25 teams Missouri and Oklahoma State.

CSUF is hitting .301 as a team and is led by Brooke Ortiz's .400 average. Haley Gilleland (.375), Michelle Moses (.348), Demi Walker (.318) and Courtney Moore (.316) are also above the .300 mark for Fresno State. Mackenzie Oakes (4-0, 2.36 ERA, 26.2 IP) and Moses (2-1, 2.92 ERA, 26.1 IP) have combined for a 2.64 team ERA.

The Bulldogs lead the all-time series, 51-9, but SDSU did take two of three between the teams last year.

Discussing No. 6/9 UCLA

The defending national champion, UCLA comes into the the tournament with a 13-3 record, and is ranked No. 6 by USA Today/NFCA and ninth by ESPN.com/USA Softball. Two of the Bruins' three losses - Florida and Tennessee - have been against teams who SDSU also lost to.

Alyssa Tiimalu, who was named the Pac-10 Player of the Week on Monday, leads the team with a .457 batting average. UCLA, which is hitting .338 as a team with 25 home runs in 16 games, also has had offensive production from Kellie Fox (.426, 17 R, 3 HR, 16 RBI), B.B. Bates (.396, 14 R, 4 HR, 16 RBI) and GiOnna DiSalvatore (.392, 13 R, 2 HR, 14 RBI). Donna Kerr (5-0, 0.83 ERA, 42.0 IP) and Jessica Hall (7-3, 2.41 ERA, 58.0 IP) have pitched 100 of the team's 104 innings this season.

Previewing Cal Poly

Cal Poly is off to a bit of a slow start this season with a 2-13 record. The Mustangs, however, have played a brutal schedule with 10 of their 13 setbacks coming against top-25 teams.

Kim Westlund is hitting a team-high .327 with three stolen bases to lead the offense, which has a .229 average. Anna Cahn (.286) has five homers and 12 RBIs. Cahn (1-4, 5.83 ERA, 36.0 IP) and Rebecca Patton (1-8, 6.20 ERA, 55.1 IP) have logged the most innings for Cal Poly.

SDSU is 16-7 all-time against the Mustangs. The two teams split their last meetings in 2009.

Browsing rv/rv Baylor

Baylor is 16-1 this season with its only loss coming to Houston on Feb. 27. The Bears, who are receiving votes in both polls, have played 14 of their first 17 games at home.

Baylor is hitting .319 as a team with 13 home runs. Holly Holl leads the squad with a .438 average and four doubles. Dani Leal (.395, 12 R, 5 HR), Kayce Walker (.370, 10 SB) and KJ Freeland (.364) are also hitting better than .350 for the Bears. Whitney Canion (6-1, 0.46 ERA, 45.2 IP), Courtney Repka (6-0, 0.84 ERA, 41.2 IP) and Liz Paul (4-0, 1.14 ERA, 24.2 IP) have combined for a 0.74 ERA in 114 innings this year.

Baylor leads the all-time series, 3-2.

Aztecs Just Outside of the ESPN.com/USA Softball Poll

Despite losing seven of its last nine games, SDSU is still receiving votes in the ESPN.com/USA Softball poll, mainly because six of those losses were against top-10 teams.

San Diego State has five points, 28 behind No. 25 Auburn (33 points) and the 30th most in the nation. Last week, the Aztecs had 30 points, while they had 60 the week before. Baylor, SDSU's opponent on Sunday, has 32 points and is the first team in the receiving votes crew. The Bears are followed by Fresno State (25), Notre Dame (19), Syracuse (17), San Diego State (5), DePaul (3), SC-Upstate (3), Georgia Tech (2) and Florida State (1).

The Aztecs were left out of the USA Today/NFCA national poll for the second consecutive week after having 17 votes the week before.

To Be the Best, You Have to Beat the Best

Once again head coach Kathy Van Wyk hasn't made it easy for this year's Aztecs.

This year, SDSU has already played six top-10 teams and six schools who made the 2010 Women's College World Series, including the defending national champion UCLA. In addition, nine of San Diego State's 13 contests have come against teams who made last year's NCAA tournament. The Aztecs' opponents this year have combined to go 116-59 (.663).

Coming into the season, San Diego State was scheduled to play seven games against six of the eight 2010 Women's College World Series teams, including seven against seeded teams from the 2010 NCAA tournament. Of San Diego State's 35 opponents, 14 (40 percent) will be against 2010 tournament teams. In addition, the Aztecs will play six games against top-10 RPI teams from a year ago and 11 versus top-25 RPI programs.

Offensive Notes

The Aztecs are 5-1 when outhitting their opponents this season (1-6 when being outhit) and 3-0 when leading after five innings ... With two outs, SDSU is hitting .287 (33-for-115) with 22 RBIs ... San Diego State is also hitting .284 (29-for-102) with runners in scoring position ... The Aztecs are outscoring the opposition, 12-1, in the second inning ... SDSU has three players over the .300 barrier, including P Kameron May (.394), 2B Lindsey Marquez (.333) and 1B Justeen Maeva (.323) ... May is sixth in the MWC in batting average, tied for seventh in on-base percentage (.429) and tied for 10th in hits (13) ... May is hitting a team-high .375 (9-for-24) with four RBIs against 2010 NCAA tournament teams ... Marquez has a team-high four multi-hit games, while her five-game hitting streak from Feb. 13-24 is the longest on the team this season ... Marquez leads the team with a .421 average (8-for-19) against 2010 Women's College World Series teams and .455 mark (10-for-22) against ranked teams or schools receiving votes ... Maeva reached base safely in each of her first 11 games ... CF Hayley Miles is hitting .333 (6-for-18) against ranked teams or teams receiving votes ... LF Lorena Klopp has four home runs and 10 RBIs in 13 games ... Her four home runs are already tied for ninth in the single-season record books ... Klopp also has a team-best four multi-RBI games (rest of the team has four combined) ... Klopp also leads the squad with three game-winning RBIs ... C Kristin May has just four hits, but all are for extra bases (two doubles and two triples).

Pitching Notes

SDSU is 5-0 when keeping the opposition to two or less runs ... Right-handers are hitting just .229 (47-for-205) heading into this weekend ... RHP Bailey Micetich ranks among the MWC leaders in wins (T-3rd, 4), games started (T-3rd, 7), ERA (4th, 3.26), strikeouts (T-4th, 38), innings pitched (5th, 38.2) and appearances (T-5th, 10) ... Micetich is second in school history in strikeouts per seven innings (6.71) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (5.22) ... RHP Samantha Beasley leads the MWC in opponents average (.234), and is tied or first in saves (1) and tied for fourth in strikeouts (38) ... Beasley owns three career school records - strikeouts (689), strikeouts per seven innings (9.05) and total shutouts (31) - and four season marks ... Beasley has 23 career double-digit strikeout games, including one this year ... RHP Kameron May had her career-long 14 2/3 scoreless inning streak (dating back to last year) snapped in the sixth inning against No. 8/10 Tennessee on Feb. 24 ... Micetich has the best strike-to-ball ratio of 67.6 percent.

Defensive Notes

SDSU committed just two errors in 138 chances (.986 fielding percentage) over its first five games ... Over the last eight, the Aztecs have made 13 errors in 215 chances (.940 fielding percentage) ... Six of those errors came in a 6-3 loss to No. 10/11 Washington, where San Diego State outhit the visitors, 9-5 ... The six miscues were SDSU's most since the 2007 season ... C Eva Sahatdjian has a perfect fielding percentage in 55 chances ... Over her career, Sahatdjian has just four errors in 329 chances (.988 fielding percentage) ... The .988 mark is the sixth-best mark in SDSU history ... Sahatdjian has thrown out three attempted base stealers this season ... Other Aztec players with a perfect fielding percentage include CF Hayley Miles (16 chances), RF Jessica Camello (11), LF Felicia Reifschneider (10), RHP Bailey Micetich (9), LF Lorena Klopp (7) and UT Katie Mathis (4).

SDSU Softball Picked Second in 2010 MWC Preseason Poll

The San Diego State softball team has been picked to finish second in the 2011 Mountain West Conference regular season, the league announced Feb. 3. The preseason poll was voted on by the league's six head coaches.

The Aztecs, who went 34-16 last season and finished second in the MWC at 11-4, picked up 22 points, including two first-place votes. Brigham Young, which has won the league championship the past two years, is predicted to win the title again with 24 points, including the other four first-place votes. The last time a team other than SDSU or BYU won the regular season championship was 2004 (Colorado State). UNLV was picked third with 15 points, followed by Colorado State (13), Utah (11) and New Mexico (5).

San Diego State, which was also receiving votes in both the ESPN.com/USA Softball and USA Today/NFCA preseason polls, lost only two senior starters from last year's squad that advanced to the NCAA tournament for the third consecutive season, a first in program history. The Aztecs boast four former all-conference selections on the roster, including redshirt senior Lindsey Marquez (Tustin, Calif.), senior Samantha Beasley (San Diego/Steele Canyon HS), and juniors Justeen Maeva (San Diego/Mira Mesa HS) and Bailey Micetich (Woodland, Calif.).

SDSU returns a stellar pitching staff, led by Beasley, a 2010 third-team NFCA All-American, who finished last year ranked seventh in the nation with a 1.20 ERA, while recording a school-record 354 strikeouts. Despite her numbers, the right-hander was left off the 2011 USA Softball Player of the Year Watch List, which included 20 other pitchers.
