### @AztecWBB to Host SDSU Thanksgiving Classic This Weekend

After a one-year absence, San Diego State will play host to an in-season tournament when it welcomes North Dakota State, Wisconsin and Delaware this weekend for the SDSU Thanksgiving Classic, Nov. 27 and 29, at Steve Fisher Court at Viejas Arena. The Aztecs will tip off the inaugural event on Friday when they battle Summit League member North Dakota State starting at 6:30 p.m. PT, followed by a Sunday afternoon clash with Big Ten foe Wisconsin beginning at 2:30 p.m. (**Complete tournament schedule on page 2**) SDSU alumnus Chris Ello will call the action for both games live on GoAztecs.com, with streaming video available for the Aztecs-Badgers showdown via the Mountain West Network on Sunday.

SDSU is still looking for its first win of the season after suffering an 80-51 setback at Washington on Monday. The Aztecs trimmed a 17-point deficit down to three at 43-40 with 3:37 left in the third quarter before the Huskies drained back-to-back three-pointers to spark a 13-0 run and quash SDSU's comeback hopes. The Aztecs were led by sophomore McKynzie Fort (Fontana, Calif.), who tallied 16 points on a career-high eight field goals, while junior Aleiah Brandon (Corona, Calif.) tossed in a collegiate-best 11 points, highlighted by a trio of three-pointers.

Both of this weekend's matchups for SDSU will mark the first-ever meetings between the respective schools. The Aztecs are 1-1 against current members of the Summit League and own a 4-7 all-time record against Big Ten teams. SDSU will tangle with a Big Ten team for the second year in a row after falling to Michigan at the San Juan Shootout in Puerto Rico last season.

Following Sunday's action, SDSU concludes its homestand on Thursday, Dec. 3, when it locks horns with San Diego in the annual city showdown starting at 6:30 p.m. PT.

### SDSU in Regular-Season Home Tournaments

- The Aztecs will hold a preseason home tournament for the 10th time in the last 11 seasons after playing host to the San Diego Surf 'N Slam for nine consecutive years from 2005-13.
- Prior to that stretch, the last time SDSU conducted a home tourney was in November of 2000, when it split a pair of games to Illinois State and Chattanooga, respectively, in the Pacific Bell Classic.
- The Aztecs have played host to 24 in-season tournaments and are 81-55 all-time in such events.
- Overall, SDSU is 22-2 in the opening game of a home tournament. In addition, the Aztecs have split games in nine of their last 12 home series. The Scarlet and Black won the opening contest and dropped the second in 1998, 1999, 2000, 2006, 2010, 2012 and 2013, but completed the opposite in 2005 and 2007.

### Scouting the Bison

North Dakota State (2-2) will embark on its first road trip of the year after splitting four games at home to start the season. The Bison recorded back-to-back victories over a pair of NAIA squads in the College of Saint Mary (Neb.) and Valley City State, bookended by losses to New Mexico State and Maine.

NDSU is paced by senior Marena Whittle, a native Australian who is averaging 22.0 points per game, highlighted a double-double (32 pts, 10 rebounds) against VCSU. In addition, sophomore Taylor Thunstedt (15.8 ppg) leads the Bison with 16 assists (4.0/g) on the year and is NDSU's main three-point threat, draining 14 of 28 attempts from beyond the arc, while junior Brianna Jones (11.0 ppg) tops the squad with 10.5 rebounds per contest. Not to be outdone, fellow classmate Emily Spier is averaging double figures as well with 10.8 points per game and has posted a team-high four blocks.

Collectively the Bison are shooting 44.7 percent from the field, including a 41.3 percent clip from three-point territory (26-63), and 69.6 percent from the free-throw line. For the season, NDSU has committed six more turnovers than its opponents (65-59) for an average of 1.5 per game.

Head coach Maren Walseth is her in second year at the helm of the Bison program after piloting the team to an 11-18 overall record and a sixth-place mark of 7-9 in the Summit League last season. Prior to her arrival on the Fargo campus, Walseth spent seven seasons as an assistant at her alma mater Penn State, where she helped the Lady Lions to three Big Ten championships and four NCAA tournament appearances, including a pair of trips to the Sweet 16.

A native of Bloomington, Minn., Walseth was a two-time all-Big Ten honoree as a forward at Penn State from 1997-2002. Selected by the Sacramento Monarchs in the WNBA Draft, Walseth played professionally for the Washington Mystics in 2002 before spending two years overseas with a French team.

### Scouting the Badgers

Prior to its clash with SDSU on Sunday, Wisconsin (1-2) will square off against Colonial Athletic Association member Delaware on Friday. The Badgers are coming off an 87-64 defeat at Dayton in their first road test of the season on Nov. 22. Wisconsin opened the year with a split at home, defeating Louisiana Tech by a 79-65 count before suffering an 89-70 setback at the hands of Drake.

All five Badger starters boast double-digit scoring averages, led by redshirt senior Michala Johnson (12.3 ppg), who is shooting a team-best 65.4 percent from the floor (17-26), which ranks 24th in the nation entering the weekend. Wisconsin has also received a substantial contribution from senior Dakota Whyte (12.0 ppg), who leads the team with 10 assists on the year and has converted 14 of 15 foul shots. Fellow classmate Nicole Bauman (11.7 ppg, 4.0 rpg) will likely see significant minutes as well, along with redshirt junior Avyanna Young (11.3 ppg, 5.7 rpg) and senior Tessa Cichy (10.7 ppg, 8.3 rpg).

As a team, Wisconsin has connected on 44.6 percent of its field-goal attempts but has found limited success from three-point territory, draining just 9 of 46 shots from long range (19.6 percent). In addition, the Badgers have sank 60 percent of their free throws (40-66) and are minus-4 in the turnover department (58-62).

Head coach Bobbie Kelsey is in her fifth season on the UW campus and has compiled a 41-78 overall record. Prior to her arrival in Madison, Kelsey enjoyed a four-year stint as an assistant at her alma mater Stanford, where she helped coach the Cardinal to four straight NCAA Final Fours. As a player, Kelsey was a four-year letterwinner on The Farm from 1992-96 and was a member of Stanford's 1992 national championship team. A two-time co-captain, Kelsey also received her squad's Most Inspirational Player award on two occasions (1992, 1996) and was named Most Improved Player in 1993.

### Notes With a 'W'

An SDSU victory over North Dakota State on Friday will mean:

- The Aztecs win their first game of the year and avoid their first 0-5 start since the 2005-06 campaign.
- SDSU moves to 1-3 on the season in games following a loss.
- The Aztecs raise their record to 76-30 at home since the 2008-09 campaign.

### Rewind: Aztecs-Huskies Recap

San Diego State played well in stretches on Monday against hot-shooting Washington, but was unable to turn in a complete game, dropping an 80-51 decision to the Huskies at Alaska Airlines Arena in Seattle, Wash. The Aztecs (0-4) cut a 17-point deficit late down to three in the third quarter before Washington scored 13 points in a row to essentially put the contest out of reach.

The Huskies shot 55.4 percent from the field (31-56) and sank 14 of 18 free throws to help keep their unblemished record intact at 4-0 on the season. In addition, UW used its tremendous size advantage to maintain a 48-22 spread on points in the paint and a 32-22 edge in rebounding.

On the flip side, SDSU connected on just 39.6 percent of its attempts from the floor (19-48) and was outscored on the fast break 18-2 in the loss. The Aztecs were also plagued by the turnover bug for the fourth straight game, as the Huskies converted 18 miscues into 24 points, while the visitors scored just nine points off 10 Washington turnovers.

Individually, SDSU was led by sophomore McKynzie Fort, who logged the 22nd double-digit scoring performance of her career with 16 points on 8-of-13 shooting to go with a team-high three assists. The Aztecs also received a personal-best 11 points from junior Aleiah Brandon, who drained a trio of three-pointers, while sophomore Lexy Thorderson broke out of an offensive slump with nine points on three triples of her own.

However, San Diego State was unable to contain the exploits of Husky guard Kelsey Plum, an All-America candidate who finished with a game-high 32 points on 12 of 19 field-goal attempts to go with an 8-for-8 effort at the free-throw line. In addition, the host school benefited from Talia Walton's 19-point performance, while Brianna Ruiz surpassed the double-digit scoring plateau with 12 points.

The Aztecs nursed a slim 5-4 advantage following a Fort layup with three minutes elapsed in the first quarter before the Huskies reeled off six straight points to take the lead for good. Still, SDSU managed to keep things close after an Ahjalee Harvey layup narrowed the gap to 12-11 by the 3:16 mark of the opening frame.

The Scarlet and Black quickly went into a funk, misfiring on seven of its next eight shots over the ensuing eight minutes while committing six turnovers. UW capitalized on the Aztecs' offensive woes, uncorking an 18-2 run punctuated by a Ruiz three-pointer to give the hosts a commanding 30-13 with nearly six minutes gone by in the second period.

SDSU began its long climb back into contention at this juncture, closing the half with a 10-2 spurt, highlighted by a pair of Brandon treys and another by Thorderson. An old fashioned three-point play by senior Deidra Smith trimmed the margin to six coming out of the locker room, but a layup by Chantel Osahor restored the Huskies' double-digit lead at 40-30 by the 5:47 mark of the third period.

The Aztecs countered with another 10-3 outburst, fueled by a pair of Thorderson triples and two additional baskets by Fort, which narrowed the gap to 43-40 with 3:37 left in the quarter. However, Washington quickly dashed SDSU's comeback hopes after Walton nailed two back-breaking three-pointers on consecutive possessions to spark a 13-0 blitz. Plum also converted an and-one opportunity during that stretch while the Aztecs committed two costly turnovers. With the clock winding down in the period, a Smith layup finally put an end to the run, but SDSU found itself on the wrong side of a 56-42 score and would never threaten again.

Washington extended its lead in the fourth quarter as Plum recorded 13 points in an eight-minute span, capped by another

- The SDSU bench outscored the Washington reserves by a 14-5 tally. For the season, the SDSU bench has amassed 69 points (17.3/g).
- The Aztecs suffered their fifth straight defeat to a Pac-12 opponent. SDSU's last victory against a Pac-12 squad occurred at home vs. USC on Nov. 30, 2012.
- Sophomore Lexy Thorderson ended a season-long three-point field goal drought with three treys on a career-high tying six attempts.
- Junior Aleiah Brandon's personal-best 11 points were fueled by a career-high three triples as well.
- Sophomore Ariell Bostick appeared in her 50th game as a collegian and 27th in a row after her return last year from a devastating knee injury in 2014.
- Senior Deidra Smith played in her 65th consecutive game at SDSU.

### Fort-i-Tude

Sophomore McKynzie Fort set a career high with 25 points against UC Riverside in the Aztecs' home opener on Nov. 16. In addition, the Fontana, Calif., native established collegiate bests in three-pointers made (2), field-goal attempts (17), free throws (11) and free throw attempts (12).

Fort followed that performance with a team-high 16 points on a collegiate-best eight field goals for the 22nd double-digit scoring effort in her career. In the process she also extended her streak to 35 games with scoring at least one point.

### @AztecWBB Picked Sixth in MW Preseason Poll

San Diego State has been predicted to finish sixth the Mountain West preseason poll released on Oct. 28 by the league office. The voting panel consisted of the MW's 11 head coaches and select women's basketball media from around the conference.

The Aztecs, who placed seventh in the MW standings during the 2014-15 campaign, earned 135 points from the panel, trailing fifth-place UNLV (132) by just three points while topping seventh-place Wyoming (125) by 10 points.

Two-time defending regular-season champion Colorado State was picked to repeat once again after receiving 21 of 28 first-place votes and 237 points, just ahead of New Mexico, which garnered seven first-place votes and 221 points, while 2015 MW tournament champion Boise State followed closely in the third spot with six first-place votes and 215 points.

With the league's forecast, SDSU has not been selected to finish among the top three places in the MW preseason rankings in back-to-back years for the first time since the 2006-07 and 2007-08 campaigns. The Aztecs completed conference play where they were projected last season, landing in the seventh spot with an 8-10 record.

Ahjalee Harvey and Deidra Smith. A 5-9 guard, Fort earned Mountain West all-freshman honors last spring after finishing third among conference rookies with 10.9 points per game in league play while averaging 3.2 rebounds and 1.7 assists. In addition, Harvey made a successful recovery from a knee injury that sidelined her for the final 22 games of the 2013-14 campaign with 25 starts in 29 appearances last season. The 5-6 point guard was SDSU's top ball-handler and main three-point threat in 2014-15, dishing out 2.3 assists per contest to go with 21 triples. Meanwhile, Smith has played in all 62 games for the Aztecs the past two years following her transfer from Boston College. The tallest member on the squad as a 6-2 forward, Smith is the team's top returning rebounder after averaging 3.5 caroms last season.

Third-year head coach Stacie Terry and staff welcome back four additional letterwinners, including juniors Ariell Bostick and Aleiah Brandon and sophomores Cheyenne Greenhouse and Lexy Thorderson. Fellow classmate Allison Brown, who made seven spot appearances last season, also finds herself in the mix once again.

## Noting the Newcomers

Of the 12 student-athletes on the current roster, four players will be wearing a Scarlet and Black uniform for the first time during the 2015-16 campaign. Guard Kymberly Ellison (Columbus, Ga.) practiced with the squad last year, but did not compete after transferring from Georgia Tech, while fellow backcourt mate Geena Gomez (Huntington Beach, Calif.) utilized her redshirt season as well following her transfer from St. Joseph's (Pa.).

With the departure of forwards Erimma Amarikwa, Khristina Hunter and Desi Culberson, who accounted for 43 percent of SDSU's rebounding total and 38 percent of the team's scoring offense from a year ago, a pair of newcomers look to gain significant experience on the frontline this season. Junior Kylie Herd (Phoenix, Ariz.) received second-team All-America recognition and was named the Arizona JC player of the year as a sophomore last year at Mesa Community College, following a solid freshman campaign when she helped the Thunderbirds to the NJCAA Division II national championship. Not to be outdone, freshman Arantxa Gómez (Valencia, Spain) brings strong credentials with her to The Mesa after sharpening her skills as a six-year member on the Spanish club circuit, including an MVP performance in U18 regional competition last April.

SDSU alumnus Chris Ello begins his ninth season of calling the action and is a familiar voice in the San Diego area. In addition to his responsibilities with the Aztec women's basketball squad, Ello is a member of the football broadcast team as a sideline reporter for the school's flagship station, The Mighty 1090 AM.

Ello started his career in sports talk radio in San Diego on XTRA Sports 690 in the summer of 1994. He has accumulated a wealth of experience doing play-by-play for a variety of sports at every level, including stints with the SDSU football (1985), baseball (1998-99) and men's basketball (2006-07) squads.

From 1996-2006, Ello was the voice of the San Diego Gulls hockey team and has called the action for the San Diego Sockers (indoor soccer), San Diego Spirit (outdoor soccer), San Diego Wildcards (CBA) and San Diego Riptide (arena football). He also has experience broadcasting high school CIF football and basketball games since 2000.

For the third straight year, nearly all regular-season Aztec home contests in 2015-16 will feature a live video stream via the Mountain West Network to supplement the audio call from Viejas Arena.

## 2015-16 By the Numbers

With excitement brewing for head coach Stacie Terry's third season on Montezuma Mesa, below are a few trends to watch for in 2015-16:

- SDSU enters the year having claimed 43 of its last 59 home games and has gone 75-28 on the Viejas Arena floor since the start of the 2008-09 campaign.
- The Aztecs have recorded 81 Mountain West victories in the last eight seasons after posting 31 wins in the league's first nine years.
- SDSU has won 44 straight games and is 74-1 over the last three seasons when leading with five minutes to go in the game, including an 12-0 mark in 2014-15. The Aztecs' lone blemish during that stretch was a heart-breaking 59-58 defeat at Washington in December 2012.

- SDSU is 35-17 in December games dating back to the 2006-07 campaign, with seven of those losses coming against teams either ranked or receiving votes in the national polls.
- The Aztecs have advanced to finals of the MW Championship in five of the last eight years after not winning a single game in the tournament's first eight years of existence.
- For the third straight season, SDSU will play 18 conference games. The Aztecs will complete a home-and-away slate with eight squads, while facing Nevada (home) and Air Force (away) just once.

## NCAA Rule Changes at a Glance

### Game Format

- Beginning with the 2015-16 campaign, NCAA women's basketball games will be played in four 10-minute quarters.
- Teams will now reach the bonus and shoot two free throws on the fifth team foul in each quarter. Previously, teams reached a one-and-one bonus on the seventh team foul of each half and reached the double bonus (two shots) on the 10th team foul.
- In the four-quarter format, team fouls reset to zero at the start of each quarter. However, if a team reaches the bonus in the fourth quarter, that team would remain in the bonus during any additional overtime periods.

### Advancing the Ball

- Teams will be allowed to advance the ball to the frontcourt following a timeout immediately after a made basket in the last 59.9 seconds of the fourth quarter and any overtime periods.
- Teams will also be allowed to advance the ball to the frontcourt following a rebound or a change of possession. In these scenarios, the ball would be inbounded at the 28-foot mark on the side of the court where the scorer's table is located.

### 10-Second Backcourt Exceptions

- For the upcoming season, a team will not receive a new 10-second backcourt count when a throw-in results from the following situations:
  - The ball is deflected out of bounds by the defense.
  - There is a held ball and the possession arrow favors the offensive team.
  - A technical foul is called on the offensive team while the ball is in its backcourt.

### Post Defense

- Defenders will be allowed to place a forearm or an open hand with a bend in the elbow on an offensive post player with the ball whose back is to the basket.

### Bands and Amplified Music

- In an effort to improve the overall fan experience, bands or amplified music may be played during any dead-ball situation during a women's basketball game. Previously, rules allowed music to be played only during timeouts and intermission.

## SDSU Holds Grand-Opening Ceremony for Jeff Jacobs JAM Center

San Diego State held a grand-opening ceremony for the 23,500-square foot Jeff Jacobs JAM Center on Sunday, Aug. 23. The event marked the official opening of the Aztecs' on-campus basketball performance center, which broke ground almost a year to the date on Aug. 27, 2014.

Speaking before the ceremonial ribbon cutting was SDSU president Elliot Hirshman, men's basketball head coach Steve Fisher and women's hoops senior guard Ahjalee Harvey.

Preliminary site work started in July 2014, just south of the Fowler Athletics Center and east of the football practice fields. The facility, which will support the continued growth and development of the SDSU men's and women's basketball teams, includes two full-length courts, eight baskets, locker rooms, film room, team lounges, athletic training room and coaches locker rooms.

Hundreds of supporters contributed to the effort to make the Jeff Jacobs JAM Center a reality. In addition to the naming gift from Jeff Jacobs, Hal and Debby Jacobs, Steve and Lisa Altman and Jim Morris, creating the name "JAM" Center, sizeable donations were made from the Manna Charitable Foundation and the Walter and Betty Zable Foundation. The total cost of the project was \$15 million.

The project was designed by JCJ Architecture and was built by The Hunt Construction Group.

San Diego native Stacie Terry enters her third year at the helm of the Aztec women's basketball team after she was named the eighth head coach in program history on May 15, 2013.

Despite a 12-19 record and an 8-10 mark in the Mountain West, Terry's squad still showed dramatic improvement on defense last season, finishing second in the conference and 34th nationally in opponent three-point field goal percentage, compared to 2014 when SDSU ranked last in the league and near the bottom of Division I in that statistic.

In addition, the Aztecs were fourth in scoring defense during MW play a year ago, allowing nearly 10 points per game fewer than the previous campaign and topped the conference in rebounding defense for the second straight season.

Under Terry's watch, forward Erimma Amarikwa capped off her collegiate career with honorable mention all-MW accolades, while guard McKynzie Fort gave SDSU's its second consecutive all-conference freshman honoree.

Terry's charges also made tremendous strides in the classroom, with the squad posting the highest collective GPA in program history during the fall of 2014, while five Aztecs landed a spot on the MW all-academic team, the most since 2001-02.

During her first season on Montezuma Mesa, Terry was saddled with the unenviable task of replacing four senior starters who accounted for nearly 64 percent of the team's scoring offense from the previous year, as well as overcoming the loss of two key players to injuries prior to conference play, Amarikwa, who was a preseason all-MW selection, and starting point guard Ahjalee Harvey.

Despite those obstacles and a demanding schedule featuring nine games against teams that eventually advanced to postseason competition, Terry's squad flashed its resiliency during the 2013-14 campaign, finishing with a 13-17 overall record and a 9-9 ledger in the MW.

With Terry at the controls, the Aztecs led the league in rebounding margin and rebounding defense while ranking second in field-goal percentage.

Individually, Terry also oversaw the progress of senior center Cierra Warren, who became the fifth SDSU player in a six-year span to receive first-team all-MW recognition.

Prior to her arrival on The Mesa, Terry gained a wealth of experience as an assistant coach at the Division I level for 14 years, including five under head coach Nikki Caldwell, who transformed UCLA into a powerhouse before restoring LSU to national prominence.

During Terry's two seasons at LSU, the Lady Tigers compiled a 45-23 overall record and earned two NCAA tournament bids, including a Sweet 16 appearance during the 2012-13 campaign. During that season, the Lady Tigers also posted six victories against ranked opponents and finished with their second-highest scoring average (69.0) in the last seven years. Under Terry's guidance, forward LaShondra Barrett garnered first-team all-Southeastern Conference accolades and received honorable mention All-America distinction in 2012 before becoming a first-round draft choice of the WNBA's Washington Mystics.

Prior to her appointment at LSU, Terry served as an assistant under Caldwell at UCLA from 2008-11, helping the Bruins gain national acclaim with a pair of NCAA

tournament appearances. During Terry's tenure, UCLA posted 72 overall victories, as the 2010-11 squad finished with a 28-5 record, setting a school record for fewest losses in a single season to go with a No. 7 national ranking. In addition, the Bruins signed the fourth-ranked recruiting class that season, according to ESPN Hoop-Gurlz, while Terry helped mentor first-team all-Pac-10 performers in Doreena Campbell, Darxia Morris and Jasmine Dixon, a 2012 honorable mention AP All-America selection, as well as all-conference freshman honorees Atonye Nyingifa and Markel Walker.

Terry spent the 2007-08 campaign at Southern Mississippi, as the Golden Eagles posted a 21-14 record and earned a postseason berth in the Women's National Invitation Tournament (WNIT). While at Southern Miss, Terry spearheaded the development and coordination of the Lady Eagle recruiting campaign. Her responsibilities also included working with the perimeter players, scouting opponents and film breakdown, as well as coordinating all of the team's community service events.

Terry also coached for three seasons from 2004-07 as an assistant under Hall of Fame head coach Theresa Greutz at Illinois, where the Fighting Illini had three straight recruiting classes ranked among the top 25 in the nation, according to Blue Star Basketball, and made three consecutive trips to the WNIT. Her primary duties included defensive instruction and working with the perimeter players.

In addition, Terry coached at Dayton during the 2003-04 season following a three-year stint at Louisville from 2000-03. With the Cardinals, Terry's responsibilities encompassed recruiting, scouting, player development, summer camps and serving as a liaison for the program's community service outreach. Louisville captured the Conference USA regular-season title and earned a trip to the NCAA tournament in 2001 before making a WNIT appearance in 2002. She also assisted in signing the nation's 21st-ranked recruiting class in 2002-03, according to All-Star Girls Report. Terry recruited and coached all-Conference USA honoree Lori Nero, a draft choice of the WNBA's Houston Comets, as well as Sara Nord, who finished her collegiate career as the Cardinals' all-time assist leader and ranks among the top 15 scorers in school history.

Terry enjoyed a successful collegiate playing career at the University of Texas at Arlington, winning four varsity letters from 1994-98 under head coach Mike Dean. She earned first-team all-Southland Conference honors after leading the Mavericks in scoring with 17.4 points per game as a senior in 1997-98. Terry scored 1,169 points during her career at UTA and still ranks among the school's top 10 in three-point field goals made (third), assists (sixth), steals (seventh) and free-throw percentage (10th). She is just one of 17 players in Maverick history to surpass the 1,000-point plateau, while her .335 career three-point field-goal percentage is also a school and Southland Conference career record.

Terry played one season of professional basketball in Warsaw, Poland, averaging 12.0 points and 6.0 assists with the Polonia Phoenix, before returning to UT Arlington to begin her coaching career as a graduate assistant in 1999.

Terry prepped at El Capitan High and held the Vaqueros' career scoring record for three years following her graduation. She was inducted into the school's athletic hall of fame in 2008.
