

 San Diego State's wide receivers have combined for just nine starts with Brionne Penny and true freshman Baylin Brooks making their first start last week.





#### **Defensive Tidbits**

• Kurt Mattix is serving as the defensive coor-dinator in his fourth season at San Diego State and is the first person to call the Aztec defense not named Rocky Long since 2008. Has 11 years of experience as a defensive coordinator.

• The Aztecs have had eight of the best defen-sive seasons nationally and are looking to con-tinue that success this year. Below are total ranks of the last nine seasons and this year so far:

 SDSU defensive ranks under defensive coordinator Kurt Mattix (since 2020): 4th in rushing (99.5), 9th in total (323.1), and 15th in both scoring (20.1) and pass efficiency (119.1).

• San Diego State has held its opponent to sin-gle digits 20 times time since 2015 (105 games) and to 10 or less points 31 times over that span.

• SDSU has allowed just 923 points over the last 51 games (18.1 ppg).

• Last year opponents had 163 drives where they tried to score on SDSU and the Aztecs forced three-and-outs (or less) in 67 of those drives (41.1 pct.). San Diego State averaged 5.15 three-and-outs per game. This year SDSU is averaging 3.33 three-and-outs per game.

 San Diego State has forced eight turnovers (six interceptions, two fumble recoveries) on the season, tied with the Liberty for most in the country.

• Over the past five-plus seasons (2018-23), San Diego State allowed only 35 rushes (out of 1,944 attempts, 1.80 pct.) for 20 or longer (3 in 70 attempts this year (4.28 pct.).

• SDSU's 149 interceptions since the 2014 sea-son are the most in the country over that while its 15 interceptions returned for a touchdown ranks in a tie for 17th.

• Since the start of the 2020 season, San Diego State has 14 non-offensive touchdowns, tied with Houstonand Pittsburgh for sixth most in the country over that span, trailing only Iowa (16), Middle Tennessee State (16), Alabama (15), TCU (15), and Western Kentucky (15).
