Aztecs Begin 2020 Season at Jacksonville's River City Leadoff Tourney

The San Diego State softball team kicks off its 2020 slate with five games over the weekend at Jacksonville University's River City Leadoff Tournament in Jacksonville, Fla.

The Aztecs open with Jacksonville at 5 p.m. ET (2 p.m. PT) Thursday. SDSU also plays Villanova (noon ET) and Nicholls (2:30 p.m. ET) on Friday, and again on Saturday (10 a.m. ET vs. Villanova and 12:30 p.m. ET vs. Nicholls).

San Diego State returns three all-Mountain West players from a year ago in shortstop Shelby Thompson (.336, 17 R, 19 RBI), first baseman Taylor Adams (.327, 4 HR, 18 R, 24 RBI) and pitcher Marissa Moreno (12-12, 3.01 ERA, 4 SV). Thompson made the all-MW first team for a third consecutive season (2017-19), while Adams and Moreno landed on the all-MW second team.

The Aztecs also welcome the fourth-best transfer recruiting class in the country, according to *Softball America*, in Maggie Balint (Oregon), Summer Hargett (Northwestern), Hannah Johnson (Cal State Fullerton), Sara Lillie (Oregon State), Alexa Schultz (Oklahoma) and Riley Thies (Towson).

SDSU has historically played well in season-opening games under 24th-year head coach Kathy Van Wyk. San Diego State has won six of its last seven season-opening games, 17 of 19 and 20 of the 23 lid-lifters in head coach Kathy Van Wyk's 23-year tenure. Since records were first kept in 1980, the Aztecs are 29-11 (.725) in their opening games.

SDSU has the most first-place votes (3) in the MW preseason poll and is picked to finish second. San Diego State, which has won a league-record seven MW regular-season titles, also received a vote in the preseason ESPN.com/USA Softball Collegiate Top 25 Poll.

Aztecs Excel in Lid-Lifters

San Diego State has excelled in season-opening games since Kathy Van Wyk took over the reigns of the program in 1997.

After a dramatic 9-8 win over Syracuse last year to kick off the season, the Aztecs have now won six of seven season-opening games, 17 of their last 19 and 20 of 23 lid-lifters in Van Wyk's 23-year tenure.

SDSU's only blemishes in the past 23 season-openers under Van Wyk came in 2018 (lost to No. 25/25 Georgia, 23-2), 2012 (lost to Texas Tech, 5-4) and in 2000 (lost to UIC, 5-3).

Over the 23 years under Van Wyk, SDSU has outscored its opponent, 133-78, or 5.8-3.4 per game in lid-lifters.

Since records were first kept in 1980, San Diego State is 29-11 (.725) in their opening games.

Aztecs Receiving Votes in Preseason Top 25 Poll

San Diego State is receiving votes in the preseason ESPN.com/USA Softball Collegiate Top 25 Poll, which was released Jan. 28. The poll is voted on by coaching representatives of 10 Division I conferences as well as members of the media who consistently cover Division I softball across the country.

The Aztecs picked up one vote, tied with Drake for the 40th most in the preseason poll. SDSU and Boise State (two votes) were the only Mountain West teams to receive preseason recognition in the poll. San Diego State is 55 points away from No. 25 Ole Miss. Auburn leads the receiving votes group with 53 points, followed by Virginia Tech (35), Louisville (25), North Carolina (25), Baylor (19), Houston (15), Missouri (15), Indiana (8), Stanford (8), South Florida (6), Mississippi State (5), Notre Dame (4), Ohio State (3), Boise State (2), the Aztecs (1) and Drake (1).

Alabama is ranked first with 487 points and 12 of the 20 first-place votes, while Washington (460, two first-place votes), Oklahoma (458, three first-place votes), defending champion UCLA (445, three first-place votes) and Arizona (405) round out the top 5.

SDSU is scheduled to play No. 4 UCLA (Saturday, Feb. 29 at home), No. 5 Arizona (Friday, Feb. 21 in Cathedral City, Calif.) and No. 23 Wisconsin (Feb. 21 in Cathedral City, Calif.) this season. Other San Diego State opponents on the docket who are receiving votes are Mississippi State, Notre Dame and Boise State.

Aztecs Picked Second in the Mountain West

The San Diego State softball team received the most first-place votes and is picked to finish second in the Mountain West in a preseason poll voted on by the league's nine head coaches, the conference announced Jan. 29. The Aztecs have won a MW-record seven regular-season titles.

SDSU totaled 50 points in the preseason poll, trailing San José State's 53 points and two first-place votes. Colorado State and UNLV both tied for third with 45 points and a first-place vote apiece, while Fresno State (44) and Boise State (41) were picked fifth and sixth, respectively, each with the other first-place votes. In all, 12 points separated the top six spots in the poll. Nevada (23), Utah State (15) and New Mexico (8) rounded out the poll.

Softball America Names SDSU Fourth-Best Transfer Class

San Diego State's 2020 transfer class has been deemed the fourth-best in the country, Softball America announced in October.

In an article written by Maren Angus on Tuesday, Oct. 1, the Aztec transfer class of juniors Maggie Balint (Oregon), Riley Thies (Towson Univ.), Alexa Schultz (Oklahoma) and Sara Lillie (Oregon State), and sophomores Summer Hargett (Northwestern) and Hannah Johnson (Cal State Fullerton) only trails No. 1 Oklahoma State, No. 2 Louisiana and No. 3 Oregon. SDSU is also ahead of such national powers Missouri (10), Oklahoma (11), Washington (12) and Arizona State (15), among others.

Balint spent two seasons at Oregon from 2017-18, going a remarkable 28-4 in the circle with a 1.51 ERA. In 185 2/3 innings, the right-hander finished with 13 complete games, five shutouts and three saves, striking out 214 with just 53 walks, while limiting the opposition to a .189 average.

Thies, meanwhile, batted .302 (74-for-245) with 23 RBIs, 61 runs, seven doubles, a triple and a walk over two seasons at Towson from 2018-19, while Schultz (60 GP, 7 R, 1 HR, 3 RBI) and Lillie (11 starts, 6 RBI, 1.000 fielding pct.) each spent the last two years at NCAA tournament teams Oklahoma and Oregon State, respectively.

Hargett comes to The Mesa after playing the 2018 season at Northwestern, appearing in 17 games with three starts, while Johnson redshirted last year with the Aztecs after pitching for Cal State Fullerton in 2018.

Aztecs to Play USA Softball National Team

San Diego State will play the 2020 USA Softball Women's National Team in an exhibition game on March 10, 2020, Team USA announced in December.

The March 10 game will start at approximately 7 p.m. PT in the nearby Sportsplex USA Santee in Santee, Calif., following an earlier game between Team USA and Cal State Northridge at 5 p.m. PT.

The exhibition game is part of Team USA's "Stand Beside Her" tour in preparation for the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games where softball returns for the first time since 2008.

"We are thrilled with the opportunity to play the U.S. Olympic Team," Aztec head coach Kathy Van Wyk said. "These are not only the elite softball players in the United States, but in the world. It will be an amazing experience for our team and the San Diego community."

"It's an honor, pleasure and true privilege to again host a USA Women's Olympic Softball team in Southern California, where softball is played at every level all year," USA Softball of Southern California Commissioner Phil Gutierrez said. "We look forward to witnessing the unequalled athleticism and sportsmanship of the greatest women's softball players in the world as the team prepares to compete at the 2020 Summer Olympic Games in Tokyo, Japan."

With the return of softball to the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games program, the "Stand Beside Her" tour provides much-needed training and competition for the 2020 WNT in their preparation for the Olympic Games while also giving fans a chance to watch the Red, White and Blue in person. Olympic competition will start July 22, 2020 with the Gold Medal Game being played on July 28.

The "Stand Beside Her" tour evokes a powerful message of unity aimed to inspire communities to stand beside HER -- the members of the WNT, America and the future generation of female athletes.

San Diego State Releases 2020 Schedule

San Diego State softball head coach Kathy Van Wyk has announced a 54-game schedule for the 2020 season, highlighted by two home tournaments, a neutral matchup with the US National Team on March 10 and a home exhibition contest against the Mexican Olympic Team on March 24.

The Aztecs, who have won a league-best seven Mountain West titles in the 20-year history of the league, are scheduled to play 17 contests against teams that made last year's NCAA tournament, including a Feb. 29 home game against defending national champion UCLA. Additionally, SDSU will play nine games against conference champions.

San Diego State begins its season on the road for the 13th straight year, playing at Jacksonville's River City Leadoff Tournament from Feb. 6-8 in Jacksonville, Fla. The Aztecs open with host Jacksonville on Thursday, and play doubleheaders against Villanova and Nicholls on both Friday and Saturday.

Following a road game at UC Riverside on Wednesday, Feb. 12, SDSU opens its home portion of the 2020 slate with the 30th annual Campbell/Cartier Classic from Feb. 13-15. San Diego State will play NCAA tournament teams and conference champions Brigham Young twice (Thursday and Saturday) and Cal State Fullerton on Friday. The Aztecs also will meet Southern Utah on Friday and Saturday.

Before heading to the always competitive Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic from Feb. 20-22, SDSU welcomes Loyola Marymount on Tuesday, Feb. 18. At the MNCC, San Diego State is slated to play four teams that made the NCAA tournament, including Notre Dame on Thursday, Women's College World Series qualifier Arizona and Wisconsin on Friday, and Mississippi State on Saturday. The Aztecs also play Idaho State on Thursday.

After a visit to California Baptist on Wednesday, Feb. 26, SDSU co-hosts the San Diego Classic. On the docket for San Diego State in the classic is NCAA tournament qualifier Weber State on Friday, St. John's and defending NCAA champion UCLA on Saturday, and CSUN on Sunday.

The Aztecs wrap up their five-game homestand on Wednesday, March 4 against Villanova before heading to the Louisville Slugger Classic, co-hosted by Long Beach State and UCLA. SDSU will play Cal State Fullerton for a second time on the season on Friday, Cal Poly and NCAA tournament qualifier Boston Univ. on Saturday, and UCF and host Long Beach State on Sunday.

San Diego State kicks off Mountain West play at home from March 13-15 against defending MW champion Colorado State before traveling to Fresno State for a weekend series from March 20-22.

Breaking up the beginning of league play is an exhibition game against the Mexican Olympic Team on Tuesday, March 24 at 7 p.m. at SDSU Softball Stadium. Mexico, which features former Aztec Stefania Aradillas, is one of six teams to qualify for the 2020 Tokyo Olympics along with USA, host Japan, Italy, Canada and Australia.

SDSU returns to official action from March 27-29 with a home series against Nevada, followed by a road trip to UNLV from April 3-5.

Next up for San Diego State is a weekend home series with Boise State from April 9-11 and its final non-conference game of the season on Wednesday, April 22 against San Diego at home.

The Aztecs finish the MW regular season with a road series at San Jose State from April 24-26, a home series with Utah State from May 1-3 and a road series at New Mexico from May 7-9.

The NCAA Regional kicks off postseason play from May 14-17 at 16 campus sites.

SDSU is coming off a 25-26 season, but welcomes the fourth-best transfer recruiting class in the country, according to Softball America.

Three Aztecs Named NFCA All-America Scholar-Athletes

San Diego State softball players Paige Barth, Katie Byrd and Marissa Moreno each earned NFCA All-America Scholar-Athlete honors for the 2018-19 academic year, the National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA) announced in October. To be considered for the award, the student-athletes must have earned a 3.5 grade-point average or higher for the academic year.

In her first season last year, Barth appeared in 12 games, starting seven times, posting a .056 average (1-for-18) with an RBI and two runs scored.

Byrd, who graduated last May, ended her final season with a .290 average (42-for-145), 11 RBIs, 22 runs, eight doubles, a triple, 11 walks and a .352 on-base percentage, while starting all 46 appearances at second base.

Moreno, meanwhile, was named a second-team all-Mountain West selection as a junior last year after posting a 6-8 record in league play with a 2.80 ERA, three saves and two solo shutouts in 80 innings, striking out 62 and holding the opposition to a .217 average. Overall, she was 12-12 with a 3.01 ERA, four saves, four shutouts and 120 strikeouts in 151 1/3 innings.

Lorena Bauer Named Volunteer Assistant Coach

Former San Diego State softball standout Lorena Bauer has been named a volunteer assistant coach for the 2020 season, Aztec head coach Kathy Van Wyk announced in September.

Bauer, a 2013 Easton All-American and the 2015 Mountain West Player of the Year, finished her career with a .351 average, 60 home runs, 200 RBIs, 101 runs, 51 doubles, three triples and 62 walks, while recording a .411 on-base percentage and a .737 slugging percentage.

Bauer owns five career records at SDSU, including home runs (60), RBIs (200), doubles (51), total bases (452) and extra-base hits (114). Additionally, she ranks second all-time at San Diego State in slugging percentage (.737), third in batting average (.351), fifth in hits (215), seventh in on-base percentage (.411), ninth in runs (101), 10th in at-bats (613) and tied for 10th in walks (62).

Bauer also appears 29 times in the Aztec single-season record books, including a school-record 67 RBIs as a senior in 2015. Bauer put together one of the best seasons in program history in 2015, when she batted .415 (73-for-176) with 19 home runs, 67 RBIs, 40 runs, 15 doubles, 23 walks, a .488 on-base percentage and a .835 slugging percentage as SDSU finished runner-up at the the NCAA Los Angeles Regional.

Bauer was also a two-time NFCA All-West Region selection (2013 first team and 2015 third team), a two-time all-MW selection (2013 and 2015), five-time MW Player of the Week and a 2015 MW Spring All-Academic Team member.
