 Coached Lobo place-kicker John Sullivan to consensus All-America honors in 2007.

Earned three letterwinners as a punter and safety at UNM, where he won the Chuck Cummings Memorial Award for morale and spirit.

▶ In his third stint at SDSU, having coached the wide receivers (2002 and 2006), running backs (2005) and secondary/special teams ('94-96).

▶ Has also coached at Oregon State (STs/TEs), Cal (STs), Washington Redskins (STs), Phoenix Cardinals (WRs), Cal Poly (Sec/STs), San Diego Chargers (Asst. STs) and Hartnell

College (Sec).

▶ Honorable mention All-American as a senior cornerback in 1980.

Brian Sipe

Ouarterbacks, 3rd Year (San Diego State)

▶ Played for legendary SDSU coach Don Coryell and was the Aztecs' leading passer in '70 and '71. In '70, he directed SDSU to a 9-2 record as the Aztecs spent eight weeks ranked among the nation's top 20.

▶ As a junior, he was an honorable mention All-American by the AP after throwing for 2,618 yards and 23 TDs. ▶ In 1980, he earned league MVP honors and was named first-team all-pro, leading the Browns to an 11-5 record.



Andy Ludwig

Off. Coor./TE's, 1st Year (Portland St. '88)

Andy Ludwig has 16 years of service as an offensive coordinator at the NCAA level and has 24 years of coaching experience overall.

Notable quarterback pupils include Heisman Trophy Finalist David Carr (Fresno State), Kellen Clemens (Oregon), Brian Johnson (Utah) and Billy Volek (Fresno State). While at Fresno State in 2001, Ludwig was a finalist for the Frank

Boyles Assistant Coach of the Year award.

Comes to SDSU from Idaho, where he coached the Vandals' offensive line for the past four years.

▶ Played professional football for two years as a member of the Denver Broncos' practice squad in 1998 and a starter at guard for the World Bowl champion Frankfort Galaxy of NFL Europe in 1999.

▶ Worked along side SDSU head coach Rocky Long at UNM from 2003-07 as the defensive coordinator.
