SERIES RECORDS

- > San Diego State and Marist will be meeting for the first time ever on the volleyball court.
- > The Aztecs have a record of 1-2 against Michigan State with the last meeting coming during the 1995 season. The Aztecs defeated the Spartans in 1978 then lost twice to them in 1995, once at the MSU Tournament and a second time at the NCAA Regional in Hawai'i.
- > San Diego State's record against Denver stands at 1-1 with the Aztecs winning a match at the University of Arizona tournament in 2001 and the Pioneers winning at last season's San Francisco Invitational.

HEAD COACH DEITRE COLLINS-PARKER

- > San Diego State Head Coach Deitre Collins-Parker enters her eighth season with the Aztecs after being named the fourth head coach in program history prior to the 2009 campaign. Her seven-year record at San Diego State is 113-97 (.538).
- > She previously served as head coach at UNLV for eight seasons (1996-2003) and at Cornell for five years (2004-2008). Her 19-year career record stands at 263-269 (.494).
- > A three-time All-American as a player at the University of Hawai'i, she led the Rainbow Wahine to consecutive national titles (1983-84) and was named the national player of the year twice.
- > She was a member of the U.S. Olympic Team and competed at the Goodwill Games and Pan Am Games prior to playing professionally in Europe for four years
- > She is one of six players named to the NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball 25th Anniversary Team in October 2005 and was inducted into the AVCA Hall of Fame in the fall of 2008.

SCOUTING THE OPPOSITION

- > Marist returns 11 letterwinners including four starters and the libero from last season's squad that finished 21-10 overall and 13-5 in the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference. Top returnees include junior outside hitter Kelsey Ediger (3.03 kps, 3.35 dps) and junior middle blocker Ashton Corona (1.46 kps, 0.91 bps). Ediger and libero Lexi Millington were named to the all-tourney team at the 2016 MAAC Championship
- > Michigan State has six starters back from a team that was 19-14 overall last season and finished seventh in the Big Ten with a mark of 10-10. Leading the returnees are outside hitter Chloe Reinig (3.03 kps, 0.62 bps) and setter Rachel Minarick (9.18 ast/s, 2.28 bps). Reinig was an honorable mention AVCA All-American in 2015 while Minarick earned AVCA all-Region honors in 2014.
- > Denver is coming off a season that saw it finish 27-8 (13-3 Summit League) and advance to the NCAA Tournament. Five starters return from that squad led by right side hitter Kayla Principato (3.50 kps, 2.63 dps) and Moni Corrujedo (2.12 kps, 1.75 dps, 0.47 bps). Principato was an all-Summit League selection and a member of the all-tourney team at the Summit League Championship in 2015.

FOR OPENERS

- > San Diego State's record in season openers stands at 21-19 since the sport began at SDSU in 1976.
- > This will mark just the Aztecs' first opener at home since 2012.
- > SDSU has a record of 16-13 when it begins the season on Aztec Court in Peterson Gym.

AZTEC VETERANS

- > SDSU returns six starters and the libero from a team that compiled a mark of 12-19 overall and 9-9 in Mountain West play (tie-5th).
- > Those starters include setter Hailey Jones (70.5 ast/s), outside hitter Alexis Cage 1.82 kps, 2.07 dps) and middle blockers Emma Fuzie (1.88 kps, 0.82 bps), Deja Harris 2.30 kps, 1.04 bps) and Baylee Little 2.27 kps, 0.54 bps) plus libero Devyn Pritchard (3.27 dps).
- > Other returnees who saw significant playing time include outside hitter Alexandra Psoma (2.27 kps) along with defensive specialists Danielle Bolden (1.36 kps, 1.84 dps) and Alexa Saba (2.45 dps).
- > Harris and Little were both named to the 2015 Mountain West all-conference team at the conclusion of last season.
- > Also back are redshirt freshmen outside hitters Alexis Harris, Alyssa Mathis and Bailey Osborn. None of the three played during the 2015 campaign.

SIX FRESHMEN

- > Among the seven new players on the roster this season are six true freshmen.
- > Outside hitter Ashlynn Dunbar was a two-time all-state selection in Texas (Clear Falls HS in League City) and was the 2015-16 Galveston County Athlete of the Year.
- > Defensive specialist Sam McGrath was a first-team all-Alameda County-Foothill League honoree after helping her team (Bishop O'Dowd HS in Oakland) win the 2015 North Coast Section (NCS) Division III championship.
- > Middle blocker Tamia Reeves was a 2015 all-district player at Hebron HS in Carrollton, Texas, where her team won the 2015 Texas 6A State Championship and was ranked No. 1 in Texas and No. 2 in the nation.
- > Defensive specialist Loren Teter was a 2015 all-Sunshine League first team honoree as a senior and was also selected team MVP after helping lead her prep team (Notre Dame Academy in Los Angeles) to the CIF semifinals.
- > Middle blocker Charlee Thomas played three seasons at Mater Dei HS in Santa Ana, Calif. as her team won the 2015 CIF Championship.
- > Outside hitter Hannah Turnlund was named to the West Catholic Athletic League second team after leading her squad at Presentation HS in San Jose, Calif., in kills as a junior and senior.

TRANSFER ADDED

- > The Aztecs have also added one four-year transfer to their 2016 roster.
- > Setter Indigo Thompson comes to SDSU after two years at Virginia Commonwealth where she redshirted in 2014 and was the starting setter in 2015.
- > Last season Thompson was a member of the Atlantic 10 All-Rookie Team and was also named to the all-tournament squad at the Wake Forest Classic.

STAFF ADDITION

- > The Aztecs have added a new assistant coach, volunteer assistant and student manger to their 2016 staff.
- > Michele Chatman-Smith, a former All-America player at Florida, joins the SDSU program after eight seasons as an assistant coach at Central Florida.
- > Her duties include overseeing team defensive training as well as assisting with recruiting.
- > Rodrigo Suelotto, who has experience both as a player and as an assistant coach, scout, and strength and conditioning coach for professional and amateur teams in his native country of Brazil, is SDSU's new volunteer assistant.
- > The 31-year-old Suelotto will work primarily with the setters during the 2016 season.
- > Former SDSU team member Jordan Conole has taken on the role of student manger this season after redshirting during her first year at San Diego state.

RETURNEES AMONG LEAGUE LEADERS

- > Four returning players ranked among the top 10 in the Mountain West in various statistical categories last year.
- > Sophomore middle blocker Deja Harris finished ninth in the conference overall stats in blocking at 1.04 per set. She was also seventh in hitting percentage in league matches at .315.
- > Setter Hailey Jones' averages of 7.05 assists per set and 6.11 assists per set in all matches and conference matches only both ranked eighth in the Mountain West.
- > Danielle Bolden finished eighth overall in service aces at 0.28 per set and was fifth in league contests with an average of 0.29 per set.
- > Devyn Pritchard was ninth in digs in all matches at 3.27 per set and she ranked eighth in conference-match stats at 3.92 per set.

PRESEASON PROGNOSTICATIONS

- > The Mountain West coaches' poll has predicted the Aztecs to finish fifth in the 11-team league.
- > In the 17 years of the MW's existence, SDSU has finished first (2012), second (2002, 2011), fourth (2000, 2001, 2003, 2013), fifth (2005, 2015), sixth (1999, 2004, 2006, 2009, 2010, 2014), seventh (2008) and eighth (2007) in the final league standings.
- > Colorado State, the 2015 MW champion, has been chosen to successfully defend its title. The results of the preseason coaches' poll are as follows:
