

San Diego State Postgame Notes vs. [9] Creighton NCAA Tournament First Round, Midwest Region Dickies Arena | Fort Worth, Texas Thursday, March 17, 2022

Team Notes

- San Diego State finishes its season with a 23-9 record.
- San Diego State sees its 37-game winning streak snapped when leading with five minutes to go, and is now 21-1 on the season and 110-8 in the Brian Dutcher era when leading with five minutes to go.
- San Diego State sees its 12-game winning streak snapped when leading at the half, and is now 21-2 on the season and 104-13 in the Brian Dutcher era when leading at the half.
- San Diego State sees its six-game overtime winning streak snapped and is now 23-3 in its last 26 overtime games.
- The Aztecs fell to 15-2 in their last 17 games immediately following a loss.
- Since the start of the 2005-06 season, San Diego State has a 424-152 (.736) record. Among those 152 defeats, San Diego State has suffered backto-back losses on only 27 occasions.
- San Diego State has won 124-of-151 games (.822) immediately following a loss, since the start of the 2005-06 season.
- San Diego State drops to 4-1 this season, 17-3 in the Brian Dutcher era and 8-1 in its last nine games played on a Thursday.
- San Diego State sees its six-game winning streak snapped against the current members of the Big East Conference.

- San Diego State falls to 2-1 against Creighton in neutral site games.

- San Diego State outscored Creighton, 19-14, off turnovers.
- San Diego State outscored Creighton, 17-12, in second-chance opportunities.
- San Diego State outscored Creighton, 30-1, off the bench.
- San Diego State held Creighton without a three-point field goal in the first half. It was just the second time in the last 318 games for the Bluejays.
- San Diego State hit its first two shots and then missed on its next five.
- San Diego State used an 9-0 run over 2:39 to turn a 12-10 lead into a 21-10 advantage in the first half.
- Chad Baker-Mazara scored 11 consecutive points from 12:24 to 6:54 and 15-of-17 from 12:48-to-6:54.
- Due to two fouls each Matt Bradley, Lamont Butler and Nathan Mensah were limited to a combined 25 minutes in the first half.

Player Notes

Chad Baker-Mazara - 17 points, 5-8 FG, 3 rebounds, 1 assist

Reached double figure scoring for the sixth time this season and 11th time of his career... Scored his 17 points in just 17 minutes, 1 second (17:01) with 15 coming in the first half... Led the team in scoring for the fourth time this season and 12th time of his caeer...

Matt Bradley - 16 points, 8 rebounds, 3 assists, 1 blocked shot

Reached double figures for the 26th time this season and 97th of his career... Recorded his 18th 15-point game of the season and 66th of his career... Did not make a 3-pointer for the first time since Feb. 19 at Fresno State.

Trey Pulliam - 14 points, 3 rebounds, 3 assists, 2 steals

Reached double figures for the 14th time this season and 22nd time of his career... SDSU fell to 19-3 for his career when he scored in double figures.
