Big Notes

- San Diego State's 23-point win is its largest in an NCAA Tournament game (previous was a 19-point win over North Dakota State on March 22, 2014 (SDSU 63, NDSU 44).
- The 23-point victory was also the largest NCAA Tournament win by any Mountain West team.
- San Diego State improves to 8-14 all-time in NCAA Tournament games.
- San Diego State improves to 8-5 in the NCAA Tournament as a higher seed.
- San Diego State advances to the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament for the third time and first time since 2014.
- San Diego State wins its fourth straight NCAA Tournament second round game and improves to 5-1 all-time in second round games.
- San Diego State improves to 2-0 as a No. 5 seed in the NCAA Tournament.
- San Diego State improves to 4-2 in the South Region of the NCAA Tournament.
- A game after snapping College of Charleston's 10-game winning streak, San Diego State snaps Furman seven-game winning streak. The seven-game winning streak was the sixth-longest active streak in the country heading into today.
- San Diego State has won 12 of its last 13 games (12-1).
- San Diego State improves to 5-0 in postseason play with five straight neutral wins.
- San Diego State improves to 16-1 this season in games decided by 10 more points.
- San Diego State improves to 148-46 (.763) under Brian Dutcher.
- For the second straight NCAA Tournament game, San Diego State held a team to its fewest points of the season. Furman's fewest points in a game prior to today was 65 (twice).
- The Aztecs also held Furman to a season low .320 field goal percentage (previous lowest was .381).

Series Notes

- San Diego State wins the first meeting between the two schools.
- San Diego State improves to 3-0 all-time against teams from the Southern Conference.

Team Notes

- San Diego State held a 14-point lead at the half, its largest halftime lead in an NCAA Tournament game in program history. SDSU's previous largest lead was a 12-point advantage over New Mexico State on March 20, 2014 (SDSU won, 73-69, in overtime).
- San Diego State improves to 23-3 on the season when leading at the half and 127-16 under Brian Dutcher. SDSU has now won 58 of its last 63 games when leading at the half (58-5), 96 of its last 104 (96-8) and 190 of its last 214 (190-24).
- The Aztecs move to 25-2 this season and 135-10 in the Brian Dutcher era when leading with five minutes to play.
- San Diego State wins its 19th straight game when shooting better than its opponent, and improves to 22-1 on the season and 123-8 under Brian Dutcher.
- The Aztecs won their 10th straight game (9-0 this season) and improved to 45-2 under Brian Dutcher when holding their opponent to under 35 percent shooting from the floor.
- SDSU won its 11th straight game when outrebounding its opponent and is now 24-2 on the season (109-12 under Brian Dutcher).
- San Diego State improves to 10-2 on the season and 43-20 under Brian Dutcher in games played on Saturday.

Game Flow

- Furman won the tip.
- Furman scored first on a Garrett Hien layup 27 seconds into the game.
- San Diego State scored on its third possession on a Lamont Butler layup 1:37 into the game.
- SDSU's substituted four players - F Aguek Arop, F Jaedon LeDee, G Micah Parrish and G Adam Seiko - at the first media timeout (15:52). The only started to stay in the game was G Lamont Butler.
- San Diego State went on a 15-0 run over a 5 minute, 40 second stretch (5:40) in the first half from 9:27 remaining until 3:47 remaining. It was SDSU's second-largest scoring run this season, only trailing an 18-0 run against Utah State on Jan. 25.

Player Notes

Micah Parrish – 16 points, 6 rebounds, 1 blocked shot

Scored in double figures for the ninth time this season (SDSU is 7-2) and 42nd time of his career... Parrish entered the game averaging 6.8 points in SDSU's previous four postseason games (three Mountain West games, one NCAA Tournament game)... Led the team in scoring for the second time this season (SDSU is 2-0)... The 16 points were his second most in a game this season... Had 14 of his 16 points in the first half... His six rebounds were one off a season high.

Darrion Trammell – 13 points, 2 rebounds, 2 assists, 1 steal

Reached double figures in scoring for the 15th time this season (SDSU is 12-3) and 64th time of his career... Entered with a seven or fewer points in six of his previous seven games.

Lamont Butler – 12 points, 6 rebounds, 6 assists, 2 steals

Scored in double figures for the 12th time this season (SDSU is 11-1) and 24th time of his career (20-4)... Was one rebound and one assist shy of tying a career high... Became the second Aztec to record at least 12 points, 6 rebounds and 6 assists in an NCAA Tournament game, joining Richie Williams vs. Indiana on March 16, 2006... For the two games in the NCAA Tournament, is averaging 9.5 points, 4.0 rebounds and 5.5 assists.

Matt Bradley – 10 points, 3 rebounds, 2 assists, 1 blocked shot, 1 steal, +27 plus/minus ratio

Scored in double figures for the 11th time in the last 12 games, 25th time of the season (SDSU is 20-5) and 122nd time of his career... Had a game-high +27 plus/minus ratio.
