Big Notes

- San Diego State lost for just the ninth time in the last 134 games (125-9) in which it outshoots its opponent for the field.
- SDSU lost for just the 18th time in 83 November games (65-18) in the Brian Dutcher era.
- Jaedon LeDee led the Aztecs in scoring and rebounds for the second time in as many games.

<u>Team Notes</u>

- San Diego State scored first but is left at 104-23 under Brian Dutcher and had a 12-game winning streak snapped when scoring first in a game.
- Darion Trammell made his season debut at the 14:39 mark of the first half and finished the game with seven points, one rebound and one assist.
- The Aztecs fell to 41-11 in games played on Friday and had their seven-game win streak on game played on the day.
- Head coach Brian Dutcher's record is 3-3 against Brigham Young as a head coach.
- The Aztecs moved to 21-29 in its last 50 games when trailing at the half in the Brian Dutcher era.
- SDSU outscored Brigham Young, 8-9, in second chance points.
- San Diego State outshot Brigham Young, 44.8 percent to 42.6 percent.
- SDSU's starters outscored the Cougars starters, 56-32.

Series Notes

• SDSU falls to 4-31 all-time in Provo, Utah and 27-51 to Brigham Young overall.

Game Flow

- Brigham Young won the tip.
- Jaedon LeDee scored the first bucket of the game at 19:10.
- Brigham Young missed its first four shot attempts and didn't score until 17:39.
- The Aztecs scored the first seven points of the game and had its biggest lead of the game at the 17:41 mark
- Using a 12-4 run late in the first half, Brigham Young turned a one-point deficit into a seven-point advantage with 2:52 to play.
- Brigham Young's first bucket, a 3-pointer, came at the 17:34 mark.
- San Diego State trailed 33-28 at the half.
- Brigham Young's largest lead, 11 points, came with 50 seconds left in the game.
- Brigham Young took its final lead at the 8:07 mark.

Player Notes

Jaedon LeDee – 21 points, 9-16 FG, 7 rebounds, 1 block, 1 assist, 1 steal

Achieved his 21st career double-digit scoring game and 14th as an Aztec... Leads the team in scoring for the 10th time of his career and in rebounding for the 21st time... Sets his career high with nine field goals.

Reese Waters - 15 points, 4 rebounds, 2 assists, 2 steals, 2 blocks

Scores in double figures in his second game as an Aztec and 18th time of his career... Reached 15 points for the second time in as many games this season.
