WHAT'S ON TAP THIS WEEKEND IN AZTEC BASEBALL

- ◆ San Diego State resumes Mountain West Conference play this weekend as it hosts the University of Utah for a three-game series.
- ◆ The first contest between the Aztecs and Utes is scheduled for Friday, April 8, at 6:00 p.m. at Tony Gwynn Stadium. The teams will also meet in games on Saturday (April 9) and Sunday (April 10) with both starting at 1:00 p.m.

SERIES RECORD

- ◆ SDSU has a record of 99-30 against Utah in a series that began in 1964.
- ◆ Over the past two seasons the Aztecs and Utes have split 10 contests. Last year San Diego State won two of three games in San Diego during the regular season, but lost to Utah while hosting the MWC Tournament.
- ◆ The Aztecs are 63-15 vs. Utah in San Diego, 26-11 in Salt Lake City and 10-4 at neutral sites.

SEEKING NO. 100

- ◆ San Diego State will be looking for its 100th win against Utah which it will achieve with its next victory over the Utes.
- ◆ The current 99 wins against the Utes are the most for the Aztec baseball program against any team.
- ◆ Its next highest win total is vs. New Mexico against whom SDSU has an all-time record of 97-55.
- ◆ The Aztecs have played the most games vs. Fresno State, a total of 163 contests with a 79-84 record.
- ◆ In addition to those three teams, SDSU has played over 100 contests against seven other schools including Brigham Young (71-55-1), Cal State Los Angeles (75-46), Hawaii (67-78), Long Beach State (77-47-1), San Diego (65-48-3), UC Santa Barbara (80-29-1) and UNLV (58-44).

SCOUTING THE UTES

- ◆ Utah enters the week with a record of 12-10 overall and 5-2 in the Mountain West Conference.
- ◆ The Utes are led by first baseman C.J. Cron (.476, 10 doubles, 5 HR, 25 RBI), shortstop James Brooks (.341, 3 triples) and outfielder Shaun Cooper (.329, 6 doubles, 16 RBI).
- ◆ Top pitchers include Rick Anton (3-1, 2.20) and Zach Adams (2-0, 2.40). Closer Tyler Wagner (0.57) has recorded seven saves.
- ◆ Utes are hitting .282 with a 3.81 earned run average.

POTTER SHOWS VERSATILITY

- ◆ Prior to last Saturday's (April 2) game vs. Oral Roberts, Evan Potter had started the previous seven contests at second base.
- ◆ He was the starting shortstop on Saturday, then returned to second base for the series finale.
- ◆ He has not committed an error thus far at second base (55 chances in 12 games).
- ◆ He recorded a pair of hits and two RBI in the win over Northridge on March 29.
- ◆ His only other RBI prior to that contest was a bases-loaded walk at UC Riverside.
- ◆ He streak of 11 consecutive games in which he reached base safely (either via hit, walk or hit by pitch) ended on Sunday (April 3) vs. Oral Roberts.
- ◆ He has now appeared at second, third and short this season, starting a total of 15 games (11 at 2B, four at 3B and one at SS).

COLWELL COMING ON

- ◆ Fifth-year senior center fielder Pat Colwell had a five-game hitting streak end in Sunday's (April 3) contest vs. Oral Roberts.
- ◆ During that streak he batted 7-for-23 (.304) four runs scored and six RBI.
- ◆ Usually a fixture in center field, Colwell has started the last seven games at third base.
- ◆ Prior to this season, he had appeared at third on only four occasions, starting there in four contests during the 2009 campaign.
- ◆ He has also made two starts at shortstop during his SDSU career – one in 2007 and one in 2009.
- ◆ Colwell had the game-winning hit, a bases-loaded single in the bottom of the 14th, to give SDSU the win over ORU last Saturday (April 2).

- ◆ Colwell turned in his second four-hit game of the season on March 20 against New Mexico. He is the lone Aztecs to have as many as four hits in a game this season.
- ◆ He went 6-for-11 with a double, two runs scored and two RBI in the series against UNM.
- ◆ His other four-hit effort came vs. third-ranked Oklahoma on March 6.

TORRES AT THE PLATE

- ◆ Over the last seven games Jomel Torres has gone 8-for-24 (.333) with four doubles, two home runs, six runs scored and three runs batted in.
- ◆ He also walked nine times and was hit by pitch twice for an on-base percentage of .543 in those five contests.
- ◆ He had a single, double and home run with three runs batted in and two runs scored in the win over CSU Northridge last Tuesday (March 29).
- ◆ He went 4-for-8 with three runs scored during the BYU series the weekend of March 24-26.
- ◆ Two of his hits against the Cougars were doubles and he is now tied for the team lead in that category with nine.
- ◆ Torres is second on the team in multiple-hit games (eight) and multiple-RBI contests (four).
- ◆ Usually a first baseman, he made his first starts of the season in the outfield (left) in games vs. Arkansas on March 11 and 12. Since then he has either been at first base or DH.

WILSON HITTING STREAK ENDS

- ◆ Chris Wilson had a 15-game hitting streak come to an end when he went 0-for-4 with a walk in the win over CSU Northridge March 29.

- ◆ The streak was the longest by an Aztec this season.
- ◆ During his streak he hit .363 with seven doubles, a triple, two home runs and 14 runs batted in.
- ◆ He had a streak of reaching base safely (via hit, walk of hit by pitch) in 16 straight games come to an end in the opener vs. Oral Roberts on Friday (April 1).
- ◆ He has scored in seven of SDSU's last nine contests.
- ◆ Four of his five hits the three-game series at Brigham Young (March 24-26) were doubles.

CRABB REGAINING FORM

- ◆ Although he has struggled as a starter this season, sophomore pitcher Bryan Crabb has been stellar out of the bullpen.
- ◆ In five relief appearances covering 13.0 innings, he has allowed just two earned runs on two hits with two walks and five strikeouts.
- ◆ On March 29 at CSU Northridge, he took the mound in the bottom of the third with two out and the bases loaded, retiring the first batter he faced to end the threat.
- ◆ He then tossed four more perfect innings, as he would retire all 13 batters he faced to record his first win of the 2011 season.
- ◆ His other best effort came in the win at UC Riverside on March 22.
- ◆ The right-hander from nearby Coronado High School entered the contest to start the bottom of the fourth with SDSU leading 2-1.
- ◆ He tossed the final five frames allowing no runs on a hit, two BB and a hit batter.
- ◆ With that effort he recorded his first save as an Aztec.

MORANDA ON THE MOUND

- ◆ In his last six appearances (one start, five relief), senior Steven Moranda has allowed one run on two hits with six strikeouts over 10.0 innings.
- ◆ He got the start on the mound in Tuesday's game vs. Cal State Northridge, but was not involved in the decision.
- ◆ After moving into the starting rotation and making three starts since Feb. 22, his previous three appearances had come out of the bullpen.
- ◆ In his last three relief appearances covering 4.1 innings, he had allowed one unearned run one hit with no walks and five strikeouts.
- ◆ Moranda recorded his first save in his one-plus seasons at SDSU after tossing the final three innings in the 7-4 win over New Mexico on Friday (March 18).
- ◆ Despite taking the loss, he turned in a fine pitching performance as the starter against No. 3 Oklahoma on March 3.
- ◆ In that contest, he went 7.1 innings, allowing three runs on eight hits with one walk and seven strikeouts.
- ◆ His strikeout total was a new career high.

ZIER LEADING IT OFF

- ◆ Freshman second baseman Tim Zier (Escondido, HS) tied his season high with three hits (including a double) in the series finale vs. Oral Roberts on Sunday (April 3)
- ◆ He saw a personal-best eight-game hitting streak in the contest against New Mexico on March 20.
- ◆ During his eight-game streak he hit .452 (14-for-31) with six runs batted in and compiled a .514 on-base percentage.
- ◆ Zier has been the Aztecs' leadoff hitter in 18 contests and is batting .278 when hitting in that spot in the lineup.

AZTECS ON RADIO

- ◆ He has started at second base in 17 of 25 contests and made his first start at third base on March 20 vs. New Mexico.
- ◆ He is the team leader in multiple-hit games with eight.

MEREDITH COMES BACK

- ◆ Brandon Meredith had an RBI single to drive in SDSU's only run in the 3-1 loss at long beach State on Tuesday (April 5).
- ◆ He missed most SDSU's four-game series against Arkansas (March 10-13) with walking pneumonia making plate appearances as a pinch hitter in two of those contests.
- ◆ He before returned as the starting DH at Loyola Marymount on March 15, but did not make an appearance in the field until March 22 at UC Riverside when he had a pair of hits with a double and two runs.
- ◆ He had a pair of hits and an RBI in the series finale at BYU on Saturday (March 26) including an RBI double in the 10th inning in the 5-3 win.
- ◆ Meredith had a triple in the contest at Loyola Marymount on March 15, his fourth of the season.
- ◆ Entering the 2011 campaign, Meredith had recorded no triples in his first two seasons as an Aztec.
- ◆ He has reached base (via hit, walk or hit by pitch) in each of his last seven contests and 20 of his last 21.
- ◆ His 20 walks leads the squad as does his .439 on-base percentage.
- ◆ He is hitting .444 (12-for-27) with runners in scoring position and leads the Aztecs with five multiple-RBI games.

HAYNAL HITS

- ◆ Freshman catcher Brad Haynal has reached base (via a hit, walk or HBP) in each of the last seven games.
- ◆ He had reached base safely in 14 straight games before failing to do so in the game against New Mexico on March 20.
- ◆ He has scored in each of SDSU's last four games and five of the last seven.
- ◆ He had a personal-best six-game hitting streak ended on March 15 in the game at Loyola Marymount. During that streak he went 10-for-24 (.417) with three doubles, a home run and eight RBI.
- ◆ He hit his team-leading third home run of the year in the first game of the doubleheader at Brigham Young on March 26.
- ◆ Haynal hit his second home run of the season to cap SDSU's four-run eighth inning rally last Saturday (March 19) that ended in a 13-10 win over New Mexico.
- ◆ He had hit his first home run as an Aztec in the contest at CSU Northridge on March 8.
- ◆ He had his best day at the plate with a three-hit performance vs. No. 3 Oklahoma on March 6.
- ◆ He also drove in a pair of runs in the first inning of that game and threw out a two runners attempting to steal.

WYNVEEN SAVES

- ◆ Senior left-hander Ryan Wynveen picked up his first save of the season in the series finale at Brigham Young on March 26.
- ◆ In that contest, he pitched the bottom of the 10th inning, allowing an unearned run on two hits with a pair of strikeouts.
- ◆ Wynveen has not made an appearance since that contest at BYU.
- ◆ In his last four relief appearances covering seven innings, he has given up one earned run on five hits with two walks and six strikeouts.

SLADER GAME WINNER

- ◆ Cody Slader, a freshman from Castro Valley, Calif. (Bishop O'Dowd HS), had a short four-game hitting streak ended in the series finale at BYU on March 26.
- ◆ He has hit in three of the last four games since then including going 3-for-7 with a run scored and two RBI over the final two games of last weekend's series vs. Oral Roberts.
- ◆ He had a personal-best six-game hitting streak end on March 20 vs. New Mexico.
- ◆ That streak saw him hit .391 (9-for-23) with three runs scored and three RBI.
- ◆ At UCR on March 22, he had a pair of hits including a double along with a season-high three runs batted in.
- ◆ He drove home the tying run in the third inning as well as the go-ahead (game-winning) run in the fifth.

GETTING PLUNKED

- ◆ Two of SDSU's players adept at getting hit by pitch during their college careers will be on the field this season.
- ◆ Senior Pat Colwell is the Aztec career leader with 33 plunkings while junior Brandon Meredith ranks second with 30.
- ◆ Meredith was hit 14 times during the 2010 season, a total that ranks second all-time for an SDSU batter.

HAYNAL TIMES TWO

- ◆ Brothers Austin and Brad Haynal are both first-year Aztecs who arrived at San Diego State via different routes.
- ◆ Austin, a junior pitcher, came to SDSU from College of the Desert after also having played at Palomar JC.
- ◆ Brad, a freshman catcher, is a product of Rancho Bernardo High School.
- ◆ In the game against Connecticut on March 5, Austin came on in relief with Brad behind the plate.
- ◆ It was the first time that the Aztecs had a brother duo as a battery in a game since the 2001 season when Jon and Jacob Minter were the pitcher and catcher in the same contest (vs. Houston, Feb. 10, 2001).

AZTEC NOTES

- ◆ After starting the season with a 2-12 record, the Aztecs are 6-6 in their last 12 games.
- ◆ After six conference contests, SDSU is hitting .296 with a 4.42 ERA in league play.
- ◆ San Diego State has a record of 3-1 in one-run games this season and is 2-1 in extra-inning contests.
- ◆ San Diego State has three players ranked among the top 10 in batting average in conference games: Chris Wilson (7th - .417), Jomel Torres (9th - .381) and Cody Smith (10th - .375)
- ◆ The Aztec pitching staff recorded its first shutout of the season as Steven Moranda, Bryan Crabb, TJ Kendzora and Mike Hachadorian combined to pitch the 10-0 win over CSU Northridge on Tuesday, March 29.
- ◆ Freshman Kyle Hayes got his first hit, an RBI double in the first inning of Sunday's (April 3) contest against Oral Roberts.
- ◆ Mitch Bluman recorded his first hit (a single to center field) as an Aztec in the win over CSU Northridge on Tuesday (March 29).
- ◆ SDSU's most productive innings on offense has been the first when it has scored 24 runs. Conversely, the Aztecs have put only five runs in the ninth.
- ◆ Freshman catcher Denny Vigo made his Aztec debut a memorable one as he homered in his first collegiate at bat in the opener against Winthrop on Feb. 18.
- ◆ SDSU pinch hitters are 5-for-35 (.143) with one of those hits being the home run by Denny Vigo in the season opener. Opposing pinch hitters are 3-for-21 (.143).

- ◆ Two of SDSU's five pinch hits this season have been solo home runs (Denny Vigo and Brad Haynal).
- ◆ Senior Craig Rasmussen has picked off five runners, bettering his previous season best of four set in 2009.

THE SCHEDULE

- ◆ San Diego State's strength of schedule has been ranked 16th in the nation by Boyd's World and its non-conference schedule is the No. 3 of 300 Division I teams.
- ◆ Among the teams on the 2011 slate are seven that were ranked among the top 25 in the preseason polls.
- ◆ That group includes #2 Vanderbilt, #3 Oklahoma, #5 UCLA, #8 TCU, #14 Cal, #16 Arkansas, #22 Connecticut and #25 UC Irvine.
- ◆ Also on the schedule are three other teams that advanced to NCAA regional tournaments last season: San Diego, Oral Roberts, and New Mexico.

YOUTH WILL BE SERVED

- ◆ Of the 32 players on San Diego State's roster, 16 are true freshmen.
- ◆ Three others are in their first year at SDSU after arriving from the JC ranks.
- ◆ Over half (20) of the athletes on the 2011 roster are from San Diego county.

- ◆ Colwell was hit 13 times during both the 2008 and 2009 campaigns.

ON DECK

- ◆ Following the Utah series this weekend, San Diego State will hit the road to face UC Irvine on Tuesday, April 12, at 6:30 p.m. at Anteater Ballpark in Irvine, Calif.
- ◆ The Aztecs will then return home for a three-game league series against TCU next weekend.
- ◆ That series against the TCU gets underway on Friday, April 15, with a game at 6:00 p.m. (PT) at Tony Gwynn Stadium that will be televised nationally by CBS College Sports TV.
- ◆ Action between the Aztecs and Horned Frogs continues on Saturday (April 16) with a contest scheduled for 7:00 p.m. and concludes on Sunday (April 17) with a game slated for a 11:00 a.m. start.
