GAMEDAY TIDBITS

■ Tonight's game is sold out, with a listed attendance of 12,414. This is the 48th consecutive regular-season home sellout for the Aztecs.

■ Tip today is scheduled for 8:05 p.m. PT with a possible 5-minute slide. The game will air nationally on CBS Sports Network.

■ San Diego State has won 23 consecutive home games, the longest streak in school history and the sixth-longest active streak nationally entering today.

■ The Aztecs are expected to start Winston Shepard (F), JJ O'Brien (F), Skylar Spencer (C), Matt Shrigley (G) and Aqeel Quinn (G) tonight for the first time. This would be the third different lineup utilized by Steve Fisher this season.

■ If he starts, Shrigley would be making his first start of the season, fourth of his career and first start since Dec. 27, 2013, when he was in the opening lineup against St. Katherine College. The Aztecs are 3-0 in his three previous starts.

■ San Diego State postgame interviews will take place on the mezzanine level of Viejas Arena (second level). Contact the SDSU media relations staff if you have questions. There will be no formal postgame news conference for New Mexico, but typically, interviews take place near the South Corridor outside of UNM's locker room. 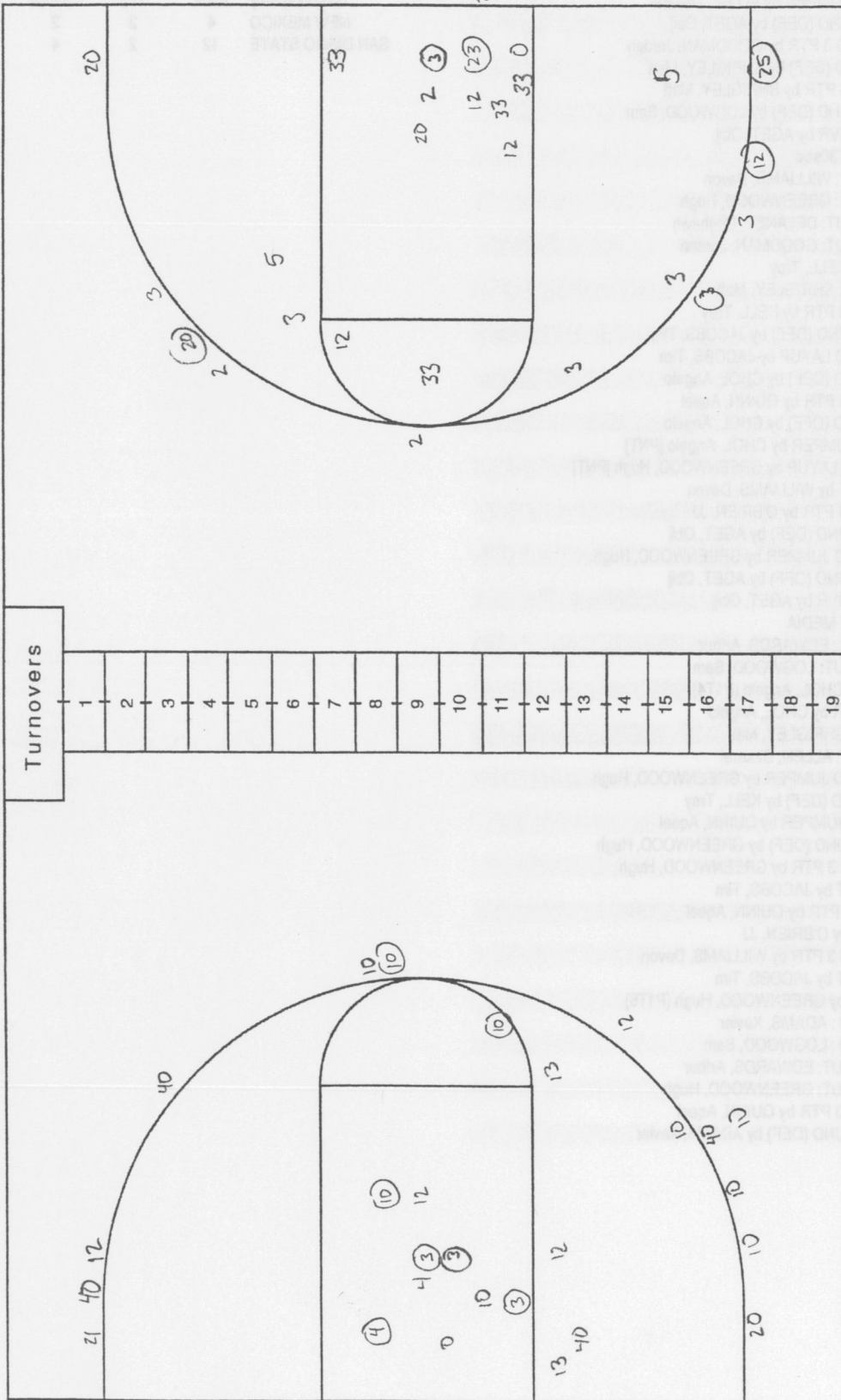

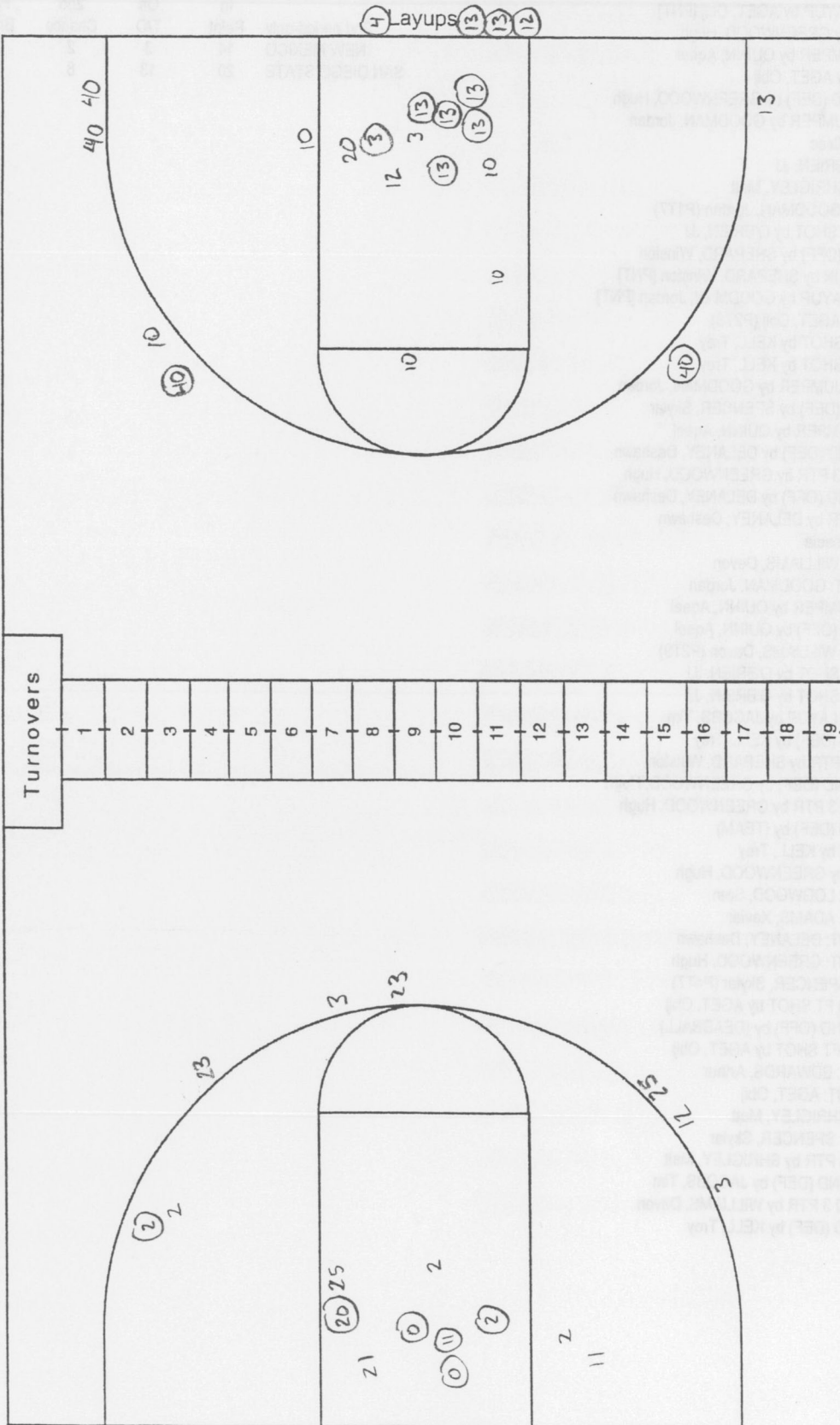

Recorded his second double-figure scoring game of the season and third of his career... Tied a career high with 10 points.

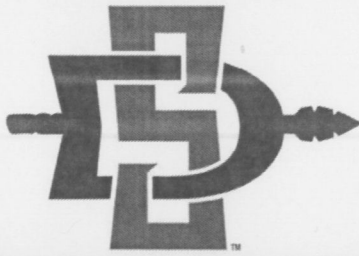
Matt Shrigley – 8 points, 2 rebounds, 1 block, 1 assist, 2 steals

San Diego State-New Mexico Postgame Quotes

SDSU head coach Steve Fisher

Opening Statement:

"Obviously when you win, you feel good about yourself. I'm especially appreciative of our crowd and the energy they helped provide. They were sensational from the opening tip and we owe them a debt of gratitude. They are very instrumental in our success at Viejas Arena. I knew that we would come out and compete. I'm proud of the energy that they brought from the opening tip. (In the first half), we struggled to make shots but we controlled the tempo and how the game was played and we competed. That's what you have to do. In the second half, we made shots. It was a good and important win for us. You must win at home and we won at home. This was New Mexico and San Diego State who compete hard against one another and we got this one tonight. We feel really good about it. I thought Matt Shrigley came out in his first start of the year and played with confidence. He did more than shoot the ball. He made a couple of defensive plays and dove on the floor in front of our bench to save a ball that got us a basket. He was valuable to us. Trey (Kell) who didn't start came off the bench and was aggressive. Winston (Shepard) probably had his best game of the year in terms of staying with it. In the second half, he was invaluable to us at both ends of the court. It was what we expected and what we got."

On Winston Shepard's performance:

"It was nice to see. Winston is a good player. When he doesn't get anxious to try to do things too fast or make things happen, he makes plays and does what he did tonight. He was aggressive going to the glass. He got some really big offensive rebounds and he played well for us. That's what we expect. He's had other good games for us. This was a night where he scored some important points for us. He also did some things at the defensive end, moving from guarding (Deshawn) Delaney on the perimeter to guarding a four-man on the inside. He was efficient on both sides."

On responding with a win after their loss against Fresno State:

"I think anytime you lose a game, there should be a renewed focus on having to win the next game. If you do it by putting the right kind of pressure on yourself, you have a chance. I was a little concerned that we would put pressure and paralyze us but it didn't. I have done it long enough to know. When we came back, I gave the team all of the venom in a negative way that I could give them halftime and after Fresno. When we met on Sunday, I was nothing but positive about what I expected us to do. We had a positive meeting. We watched the three minutes and 45 seconds where we scored 17 straight points on Fresno State and some of the earlier shots where even though we didn't make them, but look at the good things we did. We rolled it right into the next game when at times, you have to do. To the team's credit, they responded and knew the urgency they needed to bring to tonight's game."

On playing defensively and stopping New Mexico:

"We're a good defensive team. I don't know if I would say we are exceptional but when we focus on the job, we're very good. Tonight we made a point to rebound the ball and not letting this team (UNM) get an inordinate amount of offensive rebounds. They are a team, in the games that I've watched, that run and score a lot of points in transition. We didn't give them very many quick conversion baskets which was significant."

SDSU forward Winston Shepard

On taking over in the second half:

"I had to pick my energy up. Coach talked about playing with supreme confidence and giving a championship effort, two things that I maybe haven't been so good at all season. I just wanted to pick my energy and my effort up."

On if having a great performance takes a weight off his shoulders:

"Absolutely. I've been waiting for it, so it finally came."

On where this great game came from:

"First and foremost, I keep my faith in God. I trust myself, I work hard and I trust my teammates. I play hard and I try my best to put myself in good situations and I believe that it will always come. I'll be alright."

On Coach Fisher's great record following a loss:

"We didn't get down on ourselves like everyone else. A lot of people made it seem like it was the end of the world. It was a tough loss, we watched the film, we met as a group and we moved on. Coach Fisher always preaches next play, next man up, next game and so Fresno State is in the past and we just wanted to move forward."

On if the quick turnaround between games was beneficial to the team:

"I love it, it's not like football where you have to wait a whole week. You get a day to rest, a day to prepare, then you're right back on the court. You get to redeem yourself pretty quickly."

On how SDSU was so dominant in the paint:

"Angelo Chol. He played like a beast tonight."

Sophomore forward Matt Shrigley:

On starting in tonight's game:

"Yesterday, right before practice, coach let everyone know (who would be starting). He didn't go into details. We all have great respect for everybody, so it's just one of those things where you accept it, and you have to go out there and keep playing hard"

On preparing to start tonight's game:

"It was the same routine, same everything, I just started the game this time."

On junior forward Winston Shepard's performance in tonight's game:

"That's big time for someone to step up like that and dominate, and take control of the game. It's great for us, and that's why we won tonight. He had a great game and had a man's game tonight, same with Angelo. This was a big pick up for us."

Junior forward Angelo Chol:

On his success during tonight's game:

"I just told myself I had to go out there and make something happen to help the team because I feel like I haven't been doing anything lately, so I just was telling myself, 'Go out there and do something.' If you're going to be out on the floor you have to make something happen."

On playing against New Mexico sophomore center Obij Agat:

"He's just a basketball player, you can't be scared of anybody, you just have to go out there and play."

New Mexico head coach Craig Neal

On the game:

"Well I bet it wasn't a very enjoyable game. Neither of us played well offensively in the first half. I thought our guys were ready for this – ready for the pressure and ready for the intensity – and our guys weren't. One thing (SDSU) does real well is they pressure you, and when they pressure you, they take you out of your offense. Therefore, you have to make plays out of your offense, and we had a lot of those early in the game and we just couldn't make baskets. We had a lot of opportunities in the first half to make some plays, and we didn't make them. We have to get some more out of some guys, and if we don't, we have to start playing some other guys and giving them a look. (SDSU) has a really good team. They guard you. But we were right there. We cut (the deficit) to six in the second half, and then we let them go on an 8-0 run. We just can't make those kind of mistakes when you're playing a good team on the road in a tough environment."

On his message to the team:

"Well, I think some of our guys have to grow up. I think some of our guy we're expecting to play big roles, it's new for them. It's the first time we've had a team with five new players. I thought Jacobs played extremely well. But one thing (SDSU) did to us that we have to figure out is they tried to take Hugh (Greenwood) out of the game. Hugh has to find other ways to get involved, and it's not his fault. When teams do that to him, other guys have to step up, and we didn't do that tonight. We just couldn't make any baskets. We had some really good looks in the first half, and we came back and cut it to four at halftime. But then we came out in the second half and got off to a bad start again and just weren't able to make shots."

On facing SDSU's length defensively:

"I think we're just as long as they are. (SDSU) just played on top of us and we weren't able to do anything. We couldn't drive (to the basket). Guys were tentative, and when you get tentative and you can't make baskets, then their intensity is going to pick up."

On Matt Shrigley's impact on the game:

"I think you have to try to limit his shots. He made two big threes for them. We kind of kept him under wraps. (SDSU) was 3-for-18 (from 3-point range), which we wanted, but (Shrigley) hit two big threes that hurt us. We just didn't locate him. For us to be really good, we have to get better at that."

On if he still has bad feelings about SDSU's comeback victory to conclude the 2013-14 season:

"No not really. Yeah, we didn't finish and do some things we wanted to do, but I was proud how our guys bounced back and we were able to beat them eight days later. But we let a great opportunity go. You have to give coach (Steve) Fisher credit. They battled back into it and we just couldn't stop them. We got tentative then, and we got tentative tonight. We have to solve that."
