Aztecs Head to Colorado State

The San Diego State softball team hits the road for the first time during Mountain West play with a weekend series at Colorado State.

The Aztecs (17-11, 1-2 MW), who have won a league-record seven regular-season MW titles, will play the Rams (13-9, 1-2 MW) at 4 p.m. MT Friday, 1 p.m. MT Saturday and noon MT Sunday.

SDSU has advanced to eight NCAA tournaments in the last nine years, nine of the past 11 and 11 of the past 16.

Of San Diego State's 11 losses this year, four have come against the top 25 (1-4) and nine vs. teams that made the 2016 NCAA tournament (8-9).

The Aztecs are currently on pace to break school single-season records in average (.348), on-base percentage (.405) and slugging percentage (.499), and are ranked ninth in the country in average and 25th in runs per game (6.18).

SDSU has six players batting over .350, led by Molly Sturdivant (Santa Ana, Calif.). The sophomore third baseman leads San Diego State in batting average (.427), doubles (9, tied), home runs (7, tied), slugging percentage (.827), walks (13) and on-base percentage (.500). Junior Taylor Stewart (Bellflower, Calif.) is hitting .385 with 10 RBIs and 12 walks for a .468 on-base mark, while junior Jenavee Peres (Garden Grove, Calif.) (.372, 7 HR, 29 RBI, 27 R) and sophomore Katie Byrd (Santee, Calif./West Hills HS) (.372, 2 HR, 15 RBI, 24 R, 9 2B) are each batting .372. Senior Sydnee Cable (Huntington Beach, Calif.) his hitting .369 with 28 RBIs (second on the team) and junior Zaria Meshack (Vallejo, Calif.) is at .359.

The Aztec pitching staff has combined for a 3.58 ERA this year, led by freshman Marissa Moreno (Torrance, Calif.), who is 6-4 with a 3.32 ERA in 52 2/3 innings. Senior Erica Romero (Corona, Calif.) (5-3, 3.41 ERA, 53.1 IP), sophomore Julie McDonald (Carlsbad, Calif./Carlsbad HS) (2-2, 3.53 ERA, 37.2 IP) and junior Alex Formby (Orange, Calif.) (4-2, 4.13 ERA, 42.1 IP) have also added to the staff.

KATHY VAN WYK

HEAD COACH | 21ST SEASON | CAL ST. FULLERTON, 1983

- As a player, Van Wyk earned All-America honors and won the Broderick Award, given to the best player in the nation, in 1982 after going 35-1 with a 0.18 ERA. The victories remain a school single-season record and .972 winning percentage was an NCAA Division I record until 2001. Her phenomenal season included four no-hitters, six one-hitters, back-to-back perfect games, 26 shutouts and 270 strikeouts.
- Is the school's all-time winningest coach with 702 career victories, including a program-best 44 wins in 2008
- Earned her fifth Mountain West Coach of the Year award in 2014 after leading the Aztecs to a 16-8 mark in league play. She also won the award in 2002, 2006, 2008 and 2013.
- Has led SDSU to 11 NCAA tournament appearances (2001, 2003, 2006, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2015)
- Guided San Diego State to its seventh MW regular season title in 2014 with a 16-8 record. The team's other championships came in 2002, 2003, 2006, 2008, 2012 and 2013.
- Coached her sixth and seventh All-Americans in 2013 in Lorena Bauer and Patrice Jackson. Bauer was a first-team Easton All-American, while Jackson garnered second-team honors.
- Has coached 68 all-conference selections, 33 NFCA all-West Region selections, nine MW Pitchers of the Year, eight MW Freshmen of the Year, three MW Players of the Year and 128 conference player/pitcher of the week winners

The Aztec softball games that are scheduled for the Mountain West Network this season are Washington on Feb. 16 (6 p.m. PT), Siena on Feb. 21 (6 p.m. PT), McNeese State (3:30 p.m. PT) and Brigham Young (6 p.m. PT) on March 2, Miami (OH) on March 4 (6 p.m. PT), Fresno State on March 17 (6 p.m. PT) and March 19 (noon PT), San Jose State on April 1 (6 p.m. PT), New Mexico on April 13 (6 p.m. PT), April 14 (6 p.m. PT) and April 15 (noon PT), Boise State on April 21 (4 p.m. MT/3 p.m. PT), April 22 (4 p.m. MT/3 p.m. PT) and April 23 (noon MT/11 a.m. PT), Utah State on April 28 (4 p.m. MT/3 p.m. PT), April 29 (4 p.m. MT/3 p.m. PT) and April 30 (noon MT/11 a.m. PT), UNLV on May 5 (6 p.m. PT), May 6 (6 p.m. PT) and May 7 (noon PT), and at Nevada on May 12 (4 p.m. PT) and May 13 (noon PT).

Scouting Colorado State

Colorado State enters this weekend with a 13-9 overall record, including a 1-2 mark in Mountain West play after losing two of three at Boise State last weekend.

The Rams are hitting .273 on the season with 19 home runs and 101 runs in 22 games (4.56 runs per game). Amber Nelson leads CSU in most offensive categories, including batting average (.491), home runs (8), RBIs (14), total bases (53), slugging percentage (.964), walks (19) and on-base percentage (.633). Haley Hutton (.397), meanwhile, tops Colorado State in runs (24) and stolen bases (5).

The Rams' pitching staff has posted a 5.04 ERA with Larissa Petakoff leading the way with a 5-2 record and 2.95 ERA over 39 2/3 innings.

Against common opponents this year, both SDSU and CSU are 1-0.

SDSU and the RPI

The San Diego State softball team is ranked 58th out of 295 teams in the first edition of the Ratings Percentage Index (RPI), released March 20 by the NCAA.

Below are the final RPI marks from the past nine years, where SDSU made the NCAA tournament every season except 2016.

The RPI is a mathematical calculation used to help determine each team's success, using a calculated strength of schedule and won-loss percentage. When determining the RPI for each team, 25 percent is based on winning percentage, 50 percent on opponents winning percentage and 25 percent on opponents' opponents' winning percentage. Although the NCAA publishes this basic formula, it does not release its bonus and penalty calculations that may sway the rankings a few spots either way.

According to the RPI, San Diego State is 1-3 against teams from the top 25, 3-8 vs. the top 50, 5-10 vs. the top 100 and 12-1 against teams 101 and higher.

Fresno State leads the Mountain West with a 30 RPI. The Aztecs come in second in the league at 58, followed by Colorado State (82), San José State (92), Boise State (98), Utah State (104), UNLV (107), Nevada (135) and New Mexico (164).

Aztecs No Longer Receiving Votes in Both National Polls

For the third straight week, San Diego State is not receiving votes in either national poll.

Three weeks ago, the Aztecs had two votes in the USA Today/NFCA poll and one vote in the ESPN.com/USA Softball poll. SDSU's two points in the USA Today/NFCA poll were tied with Arkansas and Oregon State for the 33rd most in the poll. The one vote in the ESPN.com/USA Softball poll, meanwhile, were the 37th most.

San Diego State's opponent last weekend - Fresno State - has one vote in each poll this week after taking two of three against the Aztecs last week.

Kathy Van Wyk Picks Up Win No. 700

San Diego State scored the final five runs of the game in a 5-1 win over Longwood on March 11 at the Cal State Fullerton Invitational. The win completed a sweep (also a 10-0 win over Eastern Michigan) to give 21st-year Aztec head coach Kathy Van Wyk her 700th career win.

Van Wyk is now 702-466-1 (.601) as SDSU's head coach. The school's all-time winningest coach, Van Wyk has guided San Diego State to 11 NCAA tournament appearances, including eight of the past nine years and nine of the past 11 seasons. She has won the MW Coach of the Year five times and led the Aztecs to seven league titles.

Entering this season, Van Wyk's 685 wins were the 41st most among active NCAA Division I coaches.

Van Wyk's teams are also 203-114 (.640) all-time in Mountain West games and 247-157 (.611) in all conference games.

SDSU on the Offensive

San Diego State has come out swinging through the first six weeks of the season.

The Aztecs have 10 or more hits in 15 of the team's 28 games, including 20 apiece vs. Weber State on Feb. 12 and vs. Oklahoma State on Feb. 24.

San Diego State is batting .353 with a .405 on-base percentage and a .499 slugging mark, and 173 runs in 28 games (6.2 avg.). All percentages (average, on-base and slugging) would be school single-season records if the year ended today.

Out of 291 teams that have played games so far, the Aztecs offensively rank ninth in batting average (.353), 24th in slugging percentage (.499), 25th in runs per game (6.18), 30th in on-base percentage (.405), 38th in doubles per game (1.54) and 63rd in home runs per game (0.79).

Sophomore Molly Sturdivant (Santa Ana, Calif.) is ranked among the top 100 in the country in seven categories, while junior Jenavee Peres (Garden Grove, Calif.) appears five times in the top 100. Sturdivant is 34th in slugging percentage (.827), tied for 40th in doubles (9), tied for 43rd in home runs (7), tied for 66th in sacrifice flies (2), tied for 75th in RBI's (26), 86th in batting average (.427) and 96th in on-base percentage. Peres, meanwhile, is tied for 12th in sacrifice flies (3), tied for 29th in total bases (64), tied for 33rd in RBI's (29), tied for 42nd in runs (27) and tied for 43rd in home runs (7).

Senior Sydnee Cable (Huntington Beach, Calif.) (tied for 12th with three sacrifice flies and tied for 43rd with 28 RBI's) and sophomore Katie Byrd (Santee, Calif./West Hills HS) (tied for 40th with nine doubles and tied for 75th with 24 runs) each are ranked among the top 100 in two categories apiece, while junior Taylor Stewart (Bellflower, Calif.) is tied for 66th with two sacrifice flies.

Out of nine teams in the Mountain West, SDSU leads the league in hits (274), doubles (43), total bases (393), at-bats (788), sacrifice hits (20) and tied for first in sacrifice flies (12), and is ranked among the top 3 in 14 of the 17 major offensive categories, including second in batting average (.348), on-base percentage (.405), runs (173), RBI's (157), home runs (22, tied) and total plate appearances (904, tied).

Jenavee Peres Named to 2017 USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year Watch List

San Diego State junior catcher Jenavee Peres (Garden Grove, Calif.) was named to the 2017 USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year Watch List, USA Softball announced Feb. 1. Peres is one of 50 players on the preseason list.

Last year, Peres batted .451 (32-for-71) with nine home runs, 23 RBI's, 26 runs in just 27 games, missing 25 of the Aztecs' 52 games with various injuries (concussion, sprained ankle and fractured fibula) throughout the season. Peres' batting average (.451), slugging percentage (.915) and on-base percentage (.535) all would have been school records had she enough at-bats (100) to qualify.

Despite missing the 25 games, Peres led the team in batting average (.451), slugging percentage (.915), on-base percentage (.535) and home runs (9), and was third in stolen bases (6). Additionally, Peres was a member of the 2016 USA Softball Women's National Team Selection Camp and also played on the 2015 USA Softball Junior Women's National Team.

Peres is one of just four catchers on the preseason list.

In 27 starts this year, Peres is batting .372 (35-for-94) with team highs of runs (27), hits (35), home runs (7, tied), RBI's (29), total bases (64) and sacrifice flies (3, tied).

With enough at-bats to qualify (250 needed), Peres now ranks first all-time at SDSU in batting average (.377), second in on-base percentage (.435), slugging percentage (.678) and OPS percentage (1.113), tied for third in sacrifice flies (7), fourth in home runs (25), eighth in RBI's (100) and tied for ninth in extra-base hits (47).

Aztecs Excel in Lid-Lifters

San Diego State has excelled in season-opening games since Kathy Van Wyk took over the reigns of the program in 1997.

With a 7-1 win over South Dakota last Friday, the Aztecs have won five straight season-opening games, 16 of their last 17 season-openers and 19 of the 21 lid-lifters in head coach Kathy Van Wyk's 21-year tenure.

SDSU's only blemishes in the past 21 season-openers under Van Wyk came in 2012 (lost to Texas Tech, 5-4) and in 2000 (lost to Illinois-Chicago, 5-3).

Over the 21 years under Van Wyk, San Diego State has outscored its opponent, 122-47, or 5.81-2.24 per game in lid-lifters.

Since records were first kept in 1980, the Aztecs are 28-10 (.737) in their opening games.

San Diego State Softball Picked Second in MW Preseason Poll

The San Diego State softball team was picked to finish second in the Mountain West in a preseason poll voted on by the league's nine head coaches, the conference announced Jan. 31. The Aztecs have won a league-record seven MW titles.

Just four points separated the preseason top-three teams in the conference, led by Fresno State (59 points) and its four first-place votes. SDSU garnered 57 points and three first-place votes, while San José State is predicted to finish third with 55 points and the other two first-place votes.

Utah State (33) and Nevada (32) rounded out the top five, while Colorado State and UNLV tied for sixth with 27 points. New Mexico (26) and Boise State (8) also received recognition.

San Diego State finished 2016 with a 30-22 record, tying for third in league play with a 12-12 mark, but missing the NCAA tournament for the first time since 2007. It marked the 11th consecutive season that the Aztecs posted 30 wins.

The San Diego State softball team concluded its 2016 fall season in style with its annual alumni game on Nov. 19. Over 40 Aztec softball alumni were in attendance and competed against the current SDSU softball team in a spirited game. The game lasted five innings and each of the former players later took batting practice (BP) against San Diego State head coach Kathy Van Wyk. Prior to the game, the alumni and current team met in the clubhouse to tell stories and talk about playing for Van Wyk and the other coaches in program history. It was important for the current Aztecs to learn what it was like for the alumni playing back in the day and paving the way for the success of the program. Included in the group of alumni was a large group who played in the 1990s, who also brought along their families for a planned weekend in San Diego built around the game.

San Diego State Announces 2017 Signing Class

San Diego State softball head coach Kathy Van Wyk announced the signing of six student-athletes to National Letters of Intent in November. The six signees - Taylor Adams (Kirkland, Wash./Henry M. Jackson HS), Konnor Dahlberg (San Diego, Calif./Rancho Bernardo HS), Janina Jusay (San Diego, Calif./Rancho Bernardo HS), Katie Kempton (Pomona, Calif./Claremont HS), Kelsey Munoz (Chula Vista, Calif./Mater Dei Catholic HS) and Alizae Umi (Torrance, Calif./West HS) - join a program that has won a league-high seven championships in the 17-year history of the Mountain West.

"This is the strongest class we've ever signed," Van Wyk said, now entering her 21st season as head coach. "Several are capable of breaking into our lineup immediately and all will contribute. It's a well-balanced class as well. To have four of the six as local kids is even more exciting."

Taylor Adams, who played both first and third base at Henry M. Jackson High School, was a four-year letterwinner as a prep and also played three years for the Washington Ladyhawks club team. Adams was a three-time first-team All-Wesco District selection (2014-16) and a member of the 2015 All-USA Western Washington High School softball team. Adams helped lead HMJHS to a Wesco District Championship in both 2015 and 2016 and Wesco South Championship in 2014. She was a two-time captain in high school and the offensive player of the year in 2014 and 2016. Adams, who also played basketball at HMJHS, plans to major in journalism media studies at SDSU.

Konnor Dahlberg, a pitcher and first baseman out of local Rancho Bernardo HS with fellow signee Janina Jusay, was a first-team all-Palomar League pick and earned four letters in prep ball. She also played one season of club ball with the Explosion. Dahlberg intends to major in kinesiology at San Diego State with a plan to become a physical therapist.

Jusay, meanwhile, was an outfielder and catcher at Rancho Bernardo HS, earning second-team all-league accolades in 2016. Jusay was named the team's most valuable defensive player as a junior and earned the Silver Star Award with a 4.0 GPA. Jusay, who played her club ball with the SoCal Breakers, is undecided on a major at SDSU.

Katie Kempton, a Pomona, Calif., native, comes to The Mesa after playing shortstop, third base and catcher and earning four letters at Claremont High School. She was a first-team all-league selection last year as a junior, and an honorable-mention pick as a freshman and a sophomore. Kempton, a two-time captain, was also chosen as the league defensive player of the year in 2016 while leading the league in home runs as well. She plays her club ball with Firecrackers - Lucero and is undecided on a major.

Kelsey Munoz, a pitcher, shortstop and third baseman at local Mater Dei Catholic in Chula Vista, was a four-year letterwinner in high school. According to MaxPreps, Munoz batted .406 last year across 22 games with a home run, three doubles, 12 RBIs and 18 runs last year en route to being named a second-team all-CIF selection and first-team all-league for a second straight year. A two-time participant in the OnDeck National Elite Future Camp and current member of the Mexican Junior National team, Munoz played her club ball with the Firecrackers - Brashear. She also played two years of basketball at Mater Dei Catholic.

Alizae Umi, a catcher and second baseman, earned four letters at West High School in Riverside, Calif. Umi earned first-team all-league accolades last year, as well as honorable mention all-area. She was also the league's defensive player of the year as a junior, second-team all-league pick as a sophomore and the rookie of the year as a freshman. Umi also played volleyball at West HS and starred as a libero. She played her club ball with the Firecrackers. Umi may major in criminal justice.
