Big Notes

- Streaks broken:
 - 20-game home winning streak (was the second-longest streak in program history and was tied for third-longest active streak in the country)
 - 34-game home winning streak when following any loss
 - 27-game winning streak when leading with five minutes remaining
- San Diego State lost its first home game since Jan. 14, 2023 vs. New Mexico. The Aztecs had gone 417 days in between home losses until tonight's setback.
- The Aztecs have still won 35 of their last 37 home games dating back to Jan. 24, 2022.
- SDSU falls to 88-12 (.880) in Mountain West home games since the start of the 2013-14 season (since the current configuration of the league started), the best winning percentage in the league (No. 2 is Boise State at .790).

Team Notes

- San Diego State falls to 160-45 (.781) all-time in Mountain West home games, which is the best record and win percentage among any member in the league.
- The Aztecs are now 4-3 this season, 23-8 under Brian Dutcher, and 45-13 in their last 58 games which have been contested on a Friday.
- As a ranked team, San Diego State falls to 11-3 against Boise State, including a 6-2 mark at Viejas Arena.

- Head coach Brian Dutcher's career record falls to 173-56 (.755).
- The Aztecs fall to 20-1 this year and 156-11 under Brian Dutcher when leading with five minutes to play. SDSU has still won 409 of its last 424 games when leading with five minutes to play.
- Under Brian Dutcher, the Aztecs are 25-10 (.714) in games in March and as a program has still won 70 of its last 95 (70-25) games in the third month of the year.
- As a program, SDSU is now 260-146 (.640) all-time in Mountain West games.
- The Aztecs are 16-5 this season, 126-17 (.881) under Brian Dutcher and 267-43 (.861) in their last 310 games in which they outrebound their opponent.
- SDSU outscores Boise State in the following situations:
 - 44-34 in the paint
 - 7-5 in fast-break chances
 - 61-60 from the starting 5
 - 13-12 off turnovers

Series Notes

- San Diego State stands at 18-13 in the all-time series against Boise State.
- In games contested in San Diego, the Aztecs fall to 10-4, including 9-4 at Steve Fisher Court at Viejas Arena.
- Head coach Brian Dutcher's record at Steve Fisher Court falls to 6-2 against Boise State and 8-8 overall
 against the Broncos.

Game Flow

- Boise State won the tip.
- Boise State's O'Mar Stanley scored the first point of the game, a free throw at 17:39.
- Jeadon LeDee scored the Aztecs first points on a bucket with 15:33 to play in the first half.
- Trailing 5-0 at the first media timeout, Jaedon LeDee went on a personal 6-0 run to give SDSU is first lead
 of the game.
- The biggest lead of the half, 25-18, came at 5:02 left and belonged to Boise State.
- San Diego State outscored Boise State 17-9 in the first four minutes of the second-half to take a. 48-42
- San Diego State used an 11-0 run in the second half to turn a 42-41 deficit into a 52-42 lead with 13:45 to play.
- Boise State tied the game at 65-65 with 3:05 left, and each team scored seven points in regulation the rest
 of the way.

Player Notes

Jaedon LeDee — 21 points, 9-15 FG, 6 rebounds, 1 block, 1 assist

Scored in double figures for the 30th time this season in 30 appearances... Now has 49 career double-figure scoring games, 41 of which have come in the 69 games he has played as an Aztec... Logged his 18th 20-point game of the season and 21st of his career... After shooting 2-for-12 from the floor in his last game at UNLV, he was 9-for-15 tonight.

Lamont Butler — 13 points, 6 rebounds, 2 assists, 1 steal

Scored in double figures for the 14th time this season and 40th of his career... His six rebounds were his second most of the season, trailing his career-high 10 boards vs. Colorado State on Feb. 13, 2024.

Micah Parrish - 12 points, 1 rebound, 2 assists

Scored in double figures for the 16th time this season and 58th time of his career.

Darrion Trammell – 11 points, 3 rebounds, 5 assists, 2 steals

Scored in double figures for the 11th time this season and 78th time of his career... Now has 26 assists over the last four games (6.5 apg)... Led the team in assists for the 14th time this season and 81st time of his career.

Elijah Saunders – 9 points, 3-4 3PFG, 2 rebounds

Extended his career long streak of making at least one three-pointer to seven games and multiple three-pointers to three games... Is now 7-for-13 over the last two games from three-point range and 9-for-17 over the last three.

Jay Pal tied a season high with three blocks.
