GAME STORYLINES

- ▶ This week's match-up is the 38th meeting between the teams with San Diego State holding a 24-11-2 advantage.
- ▶ The Aztecs have won 9 of the last 11 in the series and 18-of-22. SDSU has won three straight after UH won back-to-back games in 2018 and '19.
- ▶ SDSU has a 12-7-2 advantage in games played in Honolulu including a 17-10 victory in 2021. The Aztecs have won four of the last five games in Honolulu.
- ▶ Four of the last five meetings have been decided by seven points or less.
- ▶ The teams have met every year since 2012 as members of the Mountain West, which the Aztecs have won nine of the 11 match-ups. In those 11 meetings, UH has been limited to 14 points or less nine times.
- ▶ Both teams are coming off bye weeks.
- ▶ The teams met last season in San Diego also following a UH bye week and the Aztecs pulled out a come-from-behind 16-14 victory with a field goal with 0:07 remaining.
- ▶ Hawai'i (2-4, 0-1 MW) dropped its Mountain West opener two weeks ago to UNLV in Las Vegas, 44-20. The Warriors trailed 20-3 at halftime.
- ▶ Hawai'i has scored 20 points or less in each of its last three games, averaging 16.7 points per game during that span. In contrast, the Warriors averaged 27.7 points per game in their first three games of the season.
- ▶ SDSU (2-4, 0-2) suffered its fourth consecutive loss two weeks ago following 49-10 setback to Air Force in Colorado Springs, Colo.
- ▶ During its four-game losing streak, the Aztecs have scored 10 points or fewer three times and are averaging 19.3 points per game on the year.
- ▶ UH is 2-1 at home while SDSU is 0-2 on the road.
- ▶ UH has been out-scored 130-50 in the first half this season, including 66-17 in the first quarter. The Warriors have trailed at the half in five of six games this season.
- ▶ Hawai'i has dropped its last nine games on national television and 12 of its last 13 dating back to the start of the 2021 season. UH is 0-3 on national TV this season.
- ▶ QB **Brayden Schager** has thrown at least one touchdown pass in each of his last 15 games, which is currently the sixth-longest streak nationally. His seven fourth quarter TD passes this season is tied for the national lead with Colorado's Shedeur Sanders.
- ▶ UH ranks No. 130 of 130 FBS teams in rushing offense, averaging 58.5 yards per game.
- ▶ The Aztecs rank 112th nationally in total offense (326.3) and No. 116 in total defense (439.7).
- ▶ UH's **Matthew Shipley** and SDSU's **Jack Browning** are the only two players in the MW who double as their team's primary punter and placekicker.

NEW HOME STADIUM

UH began playing its home games on-campus at the retrofitted Clarence T.C. Ching Athletics Complex in 2021. The stadium increased capacity to approximately 15,000 this season. Previously, Hawai'i played its home games at Aloha Stadium, which was shuttered at the conclusion of the 2020 season. UH had an all-time record of 211-145-4 in 46 seasons at Aloha Stadium.

WE ARE THE "RAINBOW WARRIORS"

Hawai'i's men's team nickname is the "Rainbow Warriors" while the women's teams are referred to as "Rainbow Wahine." The word "Wahine" (pronounced wah-HEE-nay) means woman in the Hawaiian language. The rainbow has been part of the nickname since 1923 and Warriors were first adopted in 1974.

WHAT'S AN 'OKINA?

What's that punctuation mark in the word Hawai'i? In the Hawaiian language, it's called an 'okina, which translated literally in English means separator. Phonetically it is referred to as a glottal stop, similar to the sound that would be made in the English oh-oh. The 'okina is actually a letter in the Hawaiian language and typed out looks like a backwards, inverted apostrophe. The practice of the UH Sports Media Relations office is to use the 'okina in all Hawaiian words in which they occur.

LAST TIME OUT

LAST GAME vs. UNLV
UNLV 44, UH 20 — Sept. 30, 2023
Allegiant Stadium; Las Vegas, Nev.

▶ UNLV regained possession of the Island Showdown Trophy.

▶ UNLV has won seven of the last eight games in the series in Las Vegas.

▶ UH dropped its Mountain West opener for the third straight season.

▶ UNLV rushed for 307 yards on 47 carries, the most by a UH opponent this year. The previous high for yards was 227 in UH's last road game at Oregon.

▶ The 27 first downs by the Rebels were also an opponent season high.

▶ UH surrendered six sacks, tied for the most in a game this season (also vs. Stanford).

▶ UH went just 1-of-11 on third down conversions.

▶ QB **Brayden Schager** posted his third 300-yard game this season finishing with 313 yards on 22-of-35 passing and two touchdowns.

▶ WR **Steven McBride** had a team-high six catches for a career-high 180 yards and a touchdown for his first career 100-yard receiving game. The 180 yards were the most by a Warrior since JoJo Ward had 189 yards against Oregon State in 2019.

▶ McBride hauled in a pair of 50+ yard receptions. He scored his team-leading sixth TD on a 51-yard catch and hauled in a 55-yard catch for UH's longest play from scrimmage this year.

▶ LB **Isalah Tufaga** finished the game with a career-high 10 tackles, all of them assisted while fellow LB **Jalen Smith** also had 10 tackles in his first career start.

UH-SDSU SERIES INFORMATION

▶ SDSU leads the overall series 24-11-2 and has won the last three meetings.

▶ The Aztecs have won 9 of the last 11 in the series and 18-of-22.

▶ Four of the last five meetings have been decided by seven points or less.

▶ The teams have met every year since 2012 as members of the Mountain West, which the Aztecs have won nine of the 11 match-ups.

TEAM NOTES

▶ UH has been out-scored 130-50 in the first half, including 66-17 in the first quarter. However, UH has out-scored its opponents in the second half, 83-78, including 59-41 in the fourth quarter.

▶ UH has lost the turnover battle in four of six games and had equal turnovers in the other two.

▶ UH suffered its third consecutive season-opening loss after a 35-28 decision to Vanderbilt, while also dropping to 3-4 all-time in Week 0.

▶ UH's win over UAlbany was its 20th straight over an FCS opponent.

HAWAI'I IN THE MOUNTAIN WEST

▶ This year is Hawai'i's 12th season competing in the Mountain West.

▶ UH is 28-61 (.315) all-time in the MW—16-29 at home and 12-32 on the road—and have appeared in one Mountain West Championship game during the 2019 season.

TROPHY GAMES

▶ UH will play all four of its rivalry trophy games in 2023—Island Showdown (at UNLV), Dick Tomey Legacy (vs. San José State, Oct. 28), Kuter (vs. Air Force, Nov. 11), and Paniolo (at Wyoming, Nov. 18) — marking the first time in program history the team will play all four in the same season.

▶ The Warriors lost control of the only trophy they had possession of—the Island Showdown Trophy—after a 44-20 loss two weeks ago in Las Vegas.

▶ UH and Air Force will meet for the first time since the Falcons retained possession of the Kuter Trophy in 2019.

ROAD WARRIORS

▶ Over the last decade (not including 2020 COVID season), UH played no less than six road games each year, including a program-high seven in 2021.

▶ UH will make six road trips this season, which included a 8,680-mile trek to Nashville, Tenn, for its season-opener at Vanderbilt.

▶ The six trips will total 37,720 air miles.

▶ The most miles UH travelled in a season was 46,568 in 2016, that included trips to Sydney, Australia (vs. California) and Ann Arbor, Mich., in back-to-back weeks.

A BIGGER HOME

▶ The 2023 season marks UH's third home season for the Rainbow Warriors at the Clarence T.C. Ching Complex, which opened in 2021.

▶ During the off-season, Phase 2 of renovations increased the seating capacity by roughly 6,000 to an official capacity of 15,194.

▶ The latest renovation project also includes the installation of Aloha Stadium's 75-foot scoreboard.

▶ UH has a 9-7 all-time record in Ching Complex. Hawai'i went 4-2 in its inaugural season; finished with a 3-4 mark last year; and are 2-1 this season.

SCHEDULE NOTES

▶ Six of UH's opponents this season played in bowl games in 2022—**Air Force** (Armed Forces Bowl), **New Mexico State** (Quick Lane Bowl), **Oregon** (Holiday Bowl), **Wyoming** (Arizona Bowl), **San Diego State** (Hawai'i Bowl), and **San Jose State** (Potato Bowl).

▶ UH will not play Fresno State this season, which will snap a streak of 31 consecutive years played.

▶ UH will play in Laramie, Wyo. against the Cowboys for the third time in the last four seasons.

THE RUN-AND-SHOOT

- ▶ The most productive offensive scheme in program history is the **Run-and-Shoot**, which Hawai'i used for 15 seasons since 1999.
- ▶ UH ran the offense for 13 consecutive seasons under coaches June Jones (1999-2007) and Greg McMackin (2008-11) until Nick Rolovich brought it back for the 2018 & '19 seasons.
- ▶ UH finished in the Top 10 nationally in passing in 13 of 15 seasons and led the country in 2002, '06 & '10. UH also led the nation in scoring in 2006 and '07.
- ▶ UH is the only school to feature three 1,000-yard receivers in the same season twice – 2018 (JoJo Ward, Jared Smart, Cedric Byrd II) and 2007 (Ryan Grice-Mullen, Davone Bess, Jason Rivers).

- ▶ The Run-and-Shoot era featured the program's top two statistical quarterbacks, **Timmy Chang** and **Colt Brennan**, who combined went on to break a number of NCAA records.
- ▶ Chang and Brennan also broke dozens of conference and school records and are No. 1 and 2 in many of the program's career marks.

OFFENSE NOTES

- ▶ The Warriors are 10-of-17 (58.8%) on fourth-down plays this season. Last season, UH converted 18-of-34 (52.9%). In two seasons under head coach Timmy Chang, UH is 28-of-51 (54.9%).
- ▶ UH has only two rushing TDs on the season—which ranks last in FBS—both by quarterbacks and none by its running backs.
- ▶ UH ranks No. 130 of 130 FBS teams in rushing offense (58.5 yards/gm).
- ▶ After not having a lost fumble through the first four games of the season, UH has lost one in each of the last two, both by QB **Brayden Schager**.
- ▶ RB **Solo Vaipulu** made his team-high 44th career start and first at running back two weeks ago at UNLV. He did not register any stats.
- ▶ WR **Alex Perry** scored a touchdown on the road for the second straight time with a 38-yard reception in the fourth quarter against UNLV. The redshirt freshman scored UH's lone touchdown in UH's last road game at No. 13 Oregon.

AIR ATTACK

- ▶ UH switched back to the **Run-and-Shoot** offense this season, and its passing attack is averaging 278.7 yards per game up from 205 yards per game from a year ago.
- ▶ Head coach Timmy Chang has brought back the offense that made him the NCAA's all-time leading passer. Chang is the team's play-caller this season.
- ▶ UH ran the four-wide offense with notable success and national recognition from 1999-2011 and again from 2018-19.
- ▶ UH went 94-60 (.610) during those seasons with 10 bowl appearances including a trip to the Allstate Sugar Bowl during its memorable 2007 season.
- ▶ In 15 previous seasons of the Run-and-Shoot offense, UH ranked No. 1 nationally in passing TDs (564) and 300-yard passing games (143) and was No. 2 in passing yards per game (354.6) and No. 6 in scoring offense (33.6).

TEXAS GUNSLINGER

- ▶ In his first season running the Run-and-Shoot offense, QB **Brayden Schager** has surpassed his career-high in passing yards twice and eclipsed his career high in touchdowns.
- ▶ Schager has thrown for 1,661 yards on 155-of-243 passing (63.8%) with 14 touchdowns and seven interceptions.
- ▶ Schager ranks No. 11 nationally in passing TDs, No. 16 in passing yards, and No. 23 in points responsible for (90).
- ▶ Schager has thrown for at least one touchdown pass in 15 consecutive games dating back to last year. The last time Schager did not throw a touchdown pass was Sept. 17, 2022 versus Duquesne.

- ▶ In the first two games of the season, Schager threw for 351 yards and three TDs against Vanderbilt and 355 yards and three TDs vs. Stanford.
- ▶ Last season, the Dallas, Texas native threw for 2,348 yards on 221-of-400 passing (55.3%) with 13 touchdowns and 10 interceptions.
- ▶ Named to the preseason watch list for the Earl Campbell Tyler Rose Award, given to the best offensive player with ties to Texas.
- ▶ Has a 6-12 career record (.333) as a starting QB which includes a win in his starting debut over nationally ranked Fresno State in 2021.

WELCOME TO THE SHOW

- ▶ Through six games this season, WR **Pofele Ashlock** leads all FBS freshmen in receptions (38), receiving yards (465), and receiving yards per game (77.5) and is tied for fifth in receiving TDs (3).
- ▶ The Euless, Texas native became the first UH freshman in the school's Division I era to start a career with back-to-back 100-yard receiving games.
- ▶ Ashlock earned Mountain West Freshman of the Week honors in each of those weeks.
- ▶ After redshirting last season, has a team-leading eight catches of 20+ yards, including four of 30+.

NOT IN KANSAS ANYMORE

- ▶ Transfer WR **Steven McBride** has already tallied more receptions and receiving yards than his three prior seasons at Kansas combined.
- ▶ The Napoleonville, La., native has 30 catches for 469 yards and six TDs in his first season as a Rainbow Warrior compared to 21 receptions for 128 yards in 24 career games with the Jayhawks.
- ▶ Team-high six catches for a career-high 180 yards and a touchdown against UNLV. Two of his catches went for 50+ yards.
- ▶ Scored in four of six games this season while his six receiving TDs ranks 10th nationally.

SPREADING THE WEALTH

- ▶ UH is tied for fourth nationally with 18 different players catching a pass this season. Toledo, Georgia, and Georgia Southern are tied for the nation's lead with 19.
- ▶ WR **Pofele Ashlock** (38) and WR **Steven McBride** (30) have combined for 68 of the team's 156 receptions (43.6%) this season and nine of the team's 14 receiving touchdowns (64.3%).
- ▶ At least eight different players caught a pass in five of UH's six games this season, including 10 against Stanford and Oregon.

SOLO ACT

- ▶ Offensive lineman turned running back **Solo Vaipulu** has done it all for the Rainbow Warriors in his six-year career.
- ▶ Vaipulu started his first career game at running back this season and has totaled four catches for 40 yards and four rushes for 15 yards.
- ▶ His first career touch was a 23-yard catch-and-run in the season-opener against Vanderbilt.
- ▶ In his first five seasons (redshirted in 2022 but played in four games), he had a team-best 43 career starts between left guard and right guard positions and was a back-up center.

DEFENSE NOTES

- ▶ UH posted a second half shutout in a win over New Mexico State. The last time UH shutout an opponent in the second half was in a 21-7 road win at UNLV on Nov. 16, 2019. UH's last shutout of an opponent in a half was in the 2020 New Mexico Bowl when it out-scored Houston 21-0 by halftime.
- ▶ UH registered six pass breakups two weeks ago at UNLV, tied for a season-high. **Caleb Brown** led the way with three of them and was the FBS's highest-graded cornerback in coverage (90.6) in Week 5 according to Pro Football Focus.

PASS THE SAUCE

▶ With perhaps the biggest defensive play of the season, **Daniel "Sauce" Williams** stripped and returned a New Mexico State fumble 41 yards in the second quarter that set up a UH field goal.

▶ Top-graded defensive player nationally in Week 4 with a 97.4 rating according to Pro Football Focus.

▶ Ranked the No. 2 interior defensive lineman in the Mountain West this season with a 76.2 rating, (min. 100 snaps).

STOUT DEFENSE

▶ Despite allowing an average of 34.7 points per game, UH's defense has played big at times this season.

▶ Holding a slim four-point lead in the fourth quarter against UAlbany, UH's defense came up with 4th-down stand and forced a turnover on ensuing possessions after the Great Danes took over both times in UH territory. UH had nine tackles-for-loss, four sacks, and two turnovers in the win.

▶ With 29 pass breakups this season, UH is tied for No. 4 nationally. CB **JoJo Forest** is tied for No. 4 nationally with seven PBUs while CB **Caleb Brown** is tied for No. 13 with six.

COMEBACK SEASON

▶ LB **Isaiah Tufaga** is off to a solid start in 2023 in his return to the line-up after missing the final six games of last season.

▶ The Laie, O'ahu native leads the team with 40 total tackles, including 4.5 for loss and two sacks.

▶ Both of his sacks occurred in the season-opener against Vanderbilt in which he also led the team with eight tackles.

▶ Career-high 10 tackles against UNLV.

▶ Has 16 starts in 35 career games for the Rainbow Warriors after transferring from Oregon State in 2020.

SET IN STONE

▶ Perhaps the biggest acquisition during the off-season for the Hawai'i was Wyoming transfer cornerback **Cam Stone**.

▶ After missing the UAlbany and Oregon games, Stone returned to the lineup the past two weeks.

▶ The Angleton, Texas native appeared in 28 games over three seasons for Wyoming and was an honorable mention all-Mountain West pick in 2022 after recording 10 PBUs and two interceptions.

▶ Stone was a preseason all-MW selection and was named to the Jim Thorpe Award preseason watch list.

ROTATING LINEBACKERS

▶ The other linebacker position has rotated among several players after the season-ending injury to starter **Logan Taylor**.

▶ Taylor started the first three games before suffering the injury against UAlbany. The Harbor City, Calif., native totaled 21 tackles, including four for loss prior to the injury.

▶ **Nalu Emerson** started two games before suffering an injury in the New Mexico State game. The Kahuku, O'ahu native recorded 10 tackles and forced a fumble in his two starts against Oregon and NMSU.

▶ **Jalen Smith** started the UNLV game and posted a career-high 10 tackles, including 1.5 for loss in his first career start.

MANUMA MAGIC

▶ Safety **Peter Manuma** has made 14 consecutive starts at safety since entering the lineup in the fifth game of last season.

▶ The 'Ewa Beach, O'ahu native has 37 tackles including 1.5 for loss this season and had a season-high eight tackles against UAlbany.

▶ Last season, finished third on the team with 70 tackles, including three for loss, one sack, two INTs, four PBUs, and two forced fumbles.

▶ The Campbell High School product also played with a heavy heart last season as his mother succumbed to breast cancer on Oct. 11. He wore pink gloves, wristbands, and socks in her honor.

SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

▶ UH recovered an onside kick in the third quarter against New Mexico State, marking its first successful recovery since 2019 (Nov. 2 vs. Fresno State). UH is 1-of-3 on onside kicks this season.

▶ **Matthew Shipley** kicked a 24-yard field goal as time expired in UH's win over New Mexico State for its first walk-off win at the end of regulation since Marcus Kemp's TD against UNLV on Nov. 22, 2014.

ROCKET SHIP

▶ In his fourth season as the team's starting place-kicker, **Matthew Shipley** is moving up the school's all-time lists.

▶ With two field goals and two extra points against UNLV, Shipley moved into fourth all-time on the UH scoring list (256), surpassing Davone Bess (250).

▶ The Liberty Hill, Texas native is 7-of-8 in field goal attempts this season with his only miss from 51 yards out.

▶ Shipley has made 49-of-63 (77.8%) field goal attempts and 109-of-110 PAT attempts over his career. His 77.8% career clip ranks No. 2 behind Jason Elam (79.0%) all-time.

▶ Since the start of the 2021 season, has made 41-of-49 (83.7%) field goal attempts.

▶ Dating back to last season, has made 30 of his last 32 field goal attempts from 40 yards and in.

▶ Named to the preseason watch list of the Lou Groza Award for the second straight year and was a semifinalist in 2021.

▶ Team's starting punter for the third straight season and is averaging 41.2 yards in 2023.

► UH's captains this season are DB **Virdel Edwards II**, RB **Tylan Hines**, DL **Jonah Kahahawai-Welch**, OL **Eliki Tanuvasa**, and LB **Logan Taylor**. Taylor suffered a season-ending injury against UAlbany.

WALK-ON U.

► UH has a reputation of turning walk-ons into stars most notably Colt Brennan, who finished his career as a Heisman Trophy finalist.

► Former walk-ons who have made starts include DL **Andrew Choi**, OL **Eliki Tanuvasa**, DL **John Tuitupou**, WR **Koali Nishigaya**, and DB **Meki Pei**.

ALL IN THE FAMILY

► The 2023 squad features seven second-generation Warriors—Wynden Ho'ohuli (Watson, 2000-05), **Kila & Kalani Kamakawiwo'ole** (Kila, 2002-05); **Landon Sims** (Travis, 1989-92), **Ethan Spencer** (Sean), **Matagi Thompson** (Afatia, 1998-2000), and **Chad Owens, Jr.** (Chad, 2001-04).

► Two sets of brothers are on the 2023 squad—**Kila & Kalani Kamakawiwo'ole** and **Anthony & Josh Sagapolutele**.

► Two others have older brothers who once suited up for UH—**Andrew Choi** (Zeno), **Sergio Muasau** (Darius), and **Maurice Ta'ala** (Blessman).

SPANNING THE GLOBE

► UH's roster features players from eight countries—United States (103), American Samoa (7), Australia (1), Canada (1), England (1), Japan (1), New Zealand (1), and Samoa (1).

► UH ranks second nationally for most countries represented to Temple's 10.

► Fifty of the 115-man roster hails from the state of Hawai'i while California (18) and Texas (11) combine to make up more than a quarter of the roster. In addition, Arizona and Florida each have four.

► UH also has players from 15 states, encompassing five time zones.

► Fifteen Warriors are former Crusaders including **Kamalu DeBlake**, **Ka'ena Decambra**, **Nick Delgadillo**, **Kila Kamakawiwo'ole**, **Kona Moore**, **Arasi Mose**, **Koali Nishigaya**, **Jonah Panoke**, **Anthony Sagapolutele**, **Josh Sagapolutele**, **Ethan Spencer**, **Tasi Tadio**, **Eliki Tanuvasa**, **Devon Tauaefa**, and **Isaiah Tufaga**.

► Head coach **Timmy Chang** and defensive coordinator **Jacob Yoro** also prepped at Saint Louis.

NINTH ISLAND PIPELINE

► UH has started a pipeline with Las Vegas power Bishop Gorman High School with three players from the 2023 signing class: **Aiden McComber**, **Jamih Otis**, and **Elijah Palmer**.

► LB coach **Chris Brown** was Bishop Gorman's assistant head coach and defensive coordinator from 2015-21.

► Four former Warriors made NFL 53-man rosters, seven-year veteran P **Rigoberto Sanchez** of the Indianapolis Colts, fifth-year LB **Jahlani Tavai** of the New England Patriots and first-year free agent OL **Iim Manning** of the Arizona Cardinals. In addition, sixth-year WR **Keith Kirkwood** (New Orleans Saints) spent one season at UH before transferring to Temple.

► Four others are currently in the Canadian Football League—OL **Dejon Allen** (Toronto Argonauts), LB **Penel Pavihi** (Hamilton Tiger Cats), DL **Blessman Ta'ala** (Ottawa Redblacks), and PK **Ryan Meskell** (Saskatchewan Roughriders).

Former record setting quarterback Timmy Chang is the sixth former Rainbow Warrior to head the program, joining Tom Kaulukukui (1946-50),

Jim Asato (1962-64), Larry Price (1974-76), June Jones (1999-2007), and Nick Rolovich (2016-19).

Chang was hired as UH's 25th head coach in program history on Jan. 22, 2022. He completed his first season with a 3-10 record which included career win No. 1 against Duquesne.

Chang spent the previous five seasons as the wide receivers and tight ends coach at Nevada, under coach Jay Norvell. He helped direct one of the most potent offensive attacks on the West Coast while the Wolf Pack earned a bowl bid in each of the last four seasons.

Prior to his time at Nevada, Chang had two stints as an offensive coordinator. In 2016, he served as the offensive coordinator at Emory & Henry College in Virginia and also spent two seasons at Jackson State in Mississippi from 2014-15.

Chang first got his coaching start as an offensive assistant at SMU under his collegiate head coach, June Jones, for two seasons assisting with the quarterbacks.

A four-year starter for Hawai'i from 2000-04, Chang set the NCAA's all-time passing (17,072) and total offense (16,910) records. The Honolulu native finished his career with 117 total touchdowns, which ranked third at the time. A two-time Hawai'i Bowl Most Outstanding Player, Chang led UH to three bowl appearances and a program-record 29 wins at quarterback. In his final season as a Warrior, he was a finalist for the Johnny Unitas Award, given to the nation's top senior quarterback.

Following his collegiate career, Chang played professionally in the NFL, CFL, and NFL Europe for four seasons. He retired from pro football in 2009 and returned to Hawai'i to complete his bachelor's degree.

- ▶ **Timmy Chang** is one of two Polynesian head coaches (Kalani Sitake-BYU) in FBS.
- ▶ **Chang** is also one of 18 head coaches who is coaching at his alma mater, including one of four in the Mountain West (Andy Avalos-Boise State, Troy Calhoun-Air Force, and Danny Gonzales-New Mexico).
- ▶ In addition to **Chang** (2000-04), three other former Warriors are on the full-time coaching staff: LB coach **Chris Brown** (1998-2002), RB coach **Keiki Misipeka** (2001), and DT coach **Jordan Pu'u-Robinson** (2012-14).
- ▶ Among the full-time staff, Chang has previous coaching ties with only **Thomas Sheffield** at Nevada. In addition, **Silas Clapham** (Dir. of Player Personnel) and **Cade Socha** (Analyst) also were on the same staff at Nevada.
- ▶ Defensive coordinator **Jacob Yoro**, who joined the program in 2017, spent one season as co-coordinator in 2020. Yoro, who prepped at powerhouse Saint Louis School under legendary coach and former UH assistant Cal Lee, previously served as DC at Pacific University (Ore.) from 2010-14.
- ▶ WR coach **Jared Ursua** is the older brother of former UH receiver John Ursua.
- ▶ Co-OC/TE coach **Ian Shoemaker** and co-DC/DL coach **Eti Ena** both coached at Eastern Washigton in 2021. Prior to EWU, Shoemaker was head coach at Central Washington from 2014-19 while accumulating a win percentage of .704. In addition to Shoemaker, Ena coached alongside Yoro at Cal Poly.
- ▶ Co-OC/OL coach **Roman Sapolu's** father is former UH All-American Jesse Sapolu, who earned four Super Bowl rings with the San Francisco 49ers. Brother Landon also suited up for the Rainbow Warriors.
- ▶ LB coach **Chris Brown** still owns two UH weightlifting records—bench press (500lbs) and squat (605lbs).

GAME NOTES

- ▶ The game was delayed 101 minutes due to inclement weather. Originally scheduled to kickoff at 6:30 p.m. CT, the game started at 8:11 p.m. CT.
- ▶ Hawai'i dropped to 3-11-1 all-time against current members of the Southeastern Conference including 0-5 on the road.
- ▶ UH dropped its seventh consecutive road game dating back to last season. It has lost 16 straight road games (including neutral sites) against Power 5 teams.
- ▶ After surrendering 404 yards rushing to Vanderbilt in the 2022 meeting, UH allowed a measly 39 yards in this year's match-up.
- ▶ The two teams failed to rush for 100 yards marking the first UH game since 2013 that neither the Warriors or their opponent broke the century mark. (UH-40, Vandy-39). The last time that occurred was UH's game at Oregon State, Sept. 7, 2013.
- ▶ Brayden Schager completed his first eight passes of the game and finished 27-of-35 for a career-high 351 yards, three touchdowns and two interceptions.
- ▶ Pofele Ashlock caught seven passes in his collegiate debut for a team-high 127 yards and scored his first career touchdown with a 3-yard reception in the 4Q.
- ▶ Isaiah Tufaga led the UH defense and tied his career-high with eight tackles, including three for loss and two sacks.
- ▶ Andrew Choi set a new career-high with seven tackles, including a sack.

- ▶ Ashlock is the first Warrior player to surpass 100 yards receiving in the first two games of a season since 2018 (John Ursua at Colorado State, vs. Navy).
- ▶ Koali Nishigaya set new career highs in receptions (6) and receiving yards (52).
- ▶ Logan Taylor had a team high nine tackles for UH. He has led the team in tackling in six of the last seven games dating back to last year.
- ▶ True freshman defensive back Elijah Palmer made his first career start ad a strong showing, finishing with seven tackles, all of them solo.
- ▶ Matthew Shipley attempted his first field goal the season, connecting on a 32-yard attempt as the first half expired.

- ▶ UH won the first-ever meeting between the teams and has now won its last 20 games against FCS teams dating back to the 2001 season.
- ▶ Hawai'i snapped a three-game losing streak dating back to last season and started the season 1-2 for the second time in the last three years (also 2021).
- ▶ Brayden Schager tossed for 266 yards and a career high four touchdowns. He has thrown for three or more touchdowns in each of the first three games.
- ▶ Steven McBride has scored in each of his first three games as a Rainbow Warrior after scoring a pair of touchdowns on catches of 30 and 12 yards. He now has a team-high five touchdowns on the season.
- ▶ UH produced its first turnover of the season when Elijah Palmer picked off a pass in the first quarter. It was also the first turnover this year committed by UAlbany.
- ▶ The Rainbow Warriors limited the Great Danes to 239 yards of total offense. UH had nine tackles-for-loss and four sacks on the evening.
- ▶ Running backs Jordan Johnson and Naszjze Bryant-Lelei each saw their first action of the season and combined for 19 carries for 111 yards. Johnson led the way with 11 carries for 76 yards.
- ▶ Noah Kema made his first start of the season and made a key fourth-quarter fumble recovery that he returned 41 yards to set up UH's game-sealing touchdown.

- ▶ Oregon scored 24 first-quarter points and all six of its first-half drives to take a commanding 34-3 lead at halftime.
- ▶ Bo Nix led to the Ducks to a score in all seven drives he directed as the Ducks ended a three-game series skid against UH in the first meeting in nearly 30 years.
- ▶ Oregon had seven explosive plays of 20 or more yards, four of which went longer than 40 yards. UH did not have any offensive snaps go longer than 20 yards.

- ▶ UH's enjoyed its first walk-off win at the end of regulation since Marcus Kemp's touchdown against UNLV on Nov. 22, 2014.
- ▶ UH scored 17 unanswered points while holding NMSU to 78 yards after the break and pulled off the program's biggest comeback since overcoming a 14-point deficit in a 27-24 win over Fresno State on Oct. 2, 2021.
