San Diego State *Aztecs* (2-5, 0-0 MWC) vs. Pittsburgh *Panthers* (8-2, 1-0 Big East)

▶When & Where: Thurs., Dec. 22 (2 p.m. PST) at Cox Arena (12,414), San Diego, Calif.

► Webcast/Live Stats: Dan Lawton (play-by-play) and Tammy Blackburn (analysis) will have the audio broadcast, while live stats will be available on the Aztecs' official website - www.goaztecs.com.

▶ The Records: The San Diego State women's basketball team (2-5) looks to continue its winning ways, as the Aztecs face Pittsburgh (8-2) on Thursday afternoon for the first time since 1995. SDSU will be less than two days removed from its second victory of the season against Boise State (54-51) on Tuesday evening. A win against the Panthers would give the Aztecs their first three-game winning streak since the 2003-04 campaign.

►SDSU Head Coach Beth Burns: Burns (Ohio Wesleyan, 1979) is in the first year of her second stint as head coach at San Diego State. She coached the Aztecs from 1989 to 1997 and has a school record of 153-88 in nine seasons. Her 14-year head coaching record stands at 234-153.

▶ Pittsburgh Head Coach Agnus Berenato: Berenato has a three-year record of 26-37 at Pittsburgh and an overall 22-year coaching record of 302-299.

▶ Pittsburgh Series History: San Diego State leads, 1-0 (Last: SDSU def. Pitt, 83-69, in San Diego on Dec. 30, 1995.)

Notes With A 'W'

An SDSU victory over the Pittsburgh will mean:

▶SDSU will have a three-game win streak for the first time since 2003. That year, the Aztecs opened with a loss to St. Mary's before defeating Nevada and grabbing road wins at Cal State Fullerton and UC Irvine.

▶SDSU improves to 8-4 against members of the Big East Conference. Each of the Aztecs' last two games against schools in the Big East have both been against the Panthers.

►SDSU head coach Beth Burns is 5-0 all-time versus Pittsburgh. Burns was 2-0 against the Panthers as the head coach at Ohio State, winning 66-54 in Pittsburgh in 1997, and cruising to a 75-40 victory in Columbus in 1998.

Notes From SDSU's Victory Over Boise State

The Aztecs limited BSU to just 16, first-half points. The 16 points are the fewest by an SDSU opponent in the first half since Utah Valley State also scored 16 on Feb. 10, 2005... SDSU owned an advantage at the half for the first time this season... the Aztecs' 54 points are the fewest in a win since beating Southern Utah 51-37 back on Dec. 30, 2004... SDSU has outrebounded its opponent five times this season, including a season-high plus-12 margin versus the Broncos. The Aztecs outrebounded an opponent only twice last season after doing so 10 times in 2003-04... SDSU's 21 offensive boards are its most in a game since Jan. 31, 2004, at Air Force... three SDSU players have reached double-figures in points in the same game in four contests this year.
