

One of the team's three returning starters and most proven player ... has 82 career games as an Aztec under her belt, most on the squad ... a 2001 second-team all-conference selection as well as a 2000 all-newcomer team choice ... came to SDSU primarily as a play-making point guard but has emerged as one of the league's top scorers ... led San Diego State in scoring twice, while finishing second on the season a year ago ... has scored in double figures in 49 of 82 games during her Aztec career and enters her senior campaign with 931 career points ... can become the 16th player in school history to reach the 1,000 career points mark, and the first since Jodi Nowlin-Tres (1994-97) ... also led the Aztecs in 3-point field goals made over the past three years ... second all-time in career three-point field goals (172) and ninth in assists (291) ... led the Aztecs in assists as a sophomore and junior.

### ■ As A Junior (2001-2002)

A starter in 25 games, third-most on the team ... second in scoring with 9.8 ppg ... third in the Mountain West in assists (4.0 apg), fifth in three-point field goals (1.89/g) ... also ranked in the top 20 in scoring (9.8 ppg), steals (1.75/g) and three-point field goal percentage (.358) ... had at least six assists in 11 games and paced the Aztecs 12 times in that category ... hit at least one 3-point basket in 25 games ... scored in double figures 14 times, including 5-of-6 to close out the season ... led the Aztecs in scoring nine times ... scored in double figures in four of the first six games of the year, including a season-high 20 points in SDSU's win over Navy ... knocked down a season-high six 3-pointers versus the Midshipmen ... snapped a three-game slide without reaching double digits in points with 13 against Radford ... also had a season-best eight assists versus the Highlanders ... finished with 14 points against Detroit and poured in a game-high 16 points versus Portland State ... three games with at least three steals, including a season-best four versus both Sacramento State and Radford ... finished with 10 points and equaled a season-high with eight assists at UNLV ... drilled three, 3-pointers en route to 15 points against Air Force ... recorded best conference game at home versus UNLV, scoring 17 points, grabbing three boards and dishing out three assists, while committing no turnovers ... had a solid outing against Colorado State at home, finishing with 14 points on 3-for-3 shooting from beyond the arc ... scored 15 points and hit on 5-of-8 from 3-point distance at Air Force ... was good on 4-of-7 from beyond the arc at New Mexico, finishing with 12 points ... finished with a team-high 14 points versus BYU, including a perfect 7-for-7 from the free throw line ... led the team in scoring with 12 points in the season-ending loss to New Mexico at the MWC tournament, which included a 4-for-7 mark from three-point land.

### ■ As A Sophomore (2000-2001)

Saw action in 27 games, all as a starter ... finished fourth in the Mountain West Conference in assists (3.93 apg), ninth in free-throw percentage (.784), fourth in 3-point field goals made (1.85 pg), eighth in 3-point field goal percentage (.373), and 10th in assist-to-turnover ratio (+1.15), in addition to finishing 12th in scoring ... scoring total of 12.4 ppg in league games ranked seventh ... in the Aztecs' starting lineup for all but the Air Force game on the road ... scored in double figures 14 times, including 11 of the final 19 games of the year ... recorded at least five assists in 11 games ... led SDSU in scoring 10 times and in assists 15 times ... had seven games with at least four 3-point baskets ... closed the regular season on a roll, averaging nearly 18 points per game in the final three regular-season contests ... shot 8-for-13 from the floor, including 5-for-8 from beyond the arc, for a season-high 24 points at UNLV ... finished with four treys en route to a game-high 21 points at Wyoming for her seventh 20+-point career game ... also eclipsed the 20-point plateau with 21 versus Chattanooga in the Pacific Bell Classic final and was named to the Pacific Bell Classic all-tournament team ... poured in 18 points versus New Mexico at home, including a season-high five treys ... posted a career-high eight rebounds and dished out eight assists at San Jose State ... had 13 points and a career-best 10 assists versus Cal State Fullerton for her first career double-double ... also tied a career-high with five steals against the Titans ... had 12 points and five assists against California ... led SDSU with 14 points, including 7-of-9 shooting from the free-throw line and six assists, at Cal Poly ... led the Aztecs in scoring at Texas A&M-Corpus Christi (14 points) ... scored a team-high 17 points with seven assists and tied a career high with five steals at New Mexico ... drilled four treys en route to a game-high 16 points at Utah.



■ As A Freshman (1999-2000)

Appeared in 27 games, making 26 starts ... set an SDSU freshman record for playing time, averaging 37.5 mpg ... missed only the Loyola Marymount game with a concussion suffered at UCLA ... injury also kept her out of the starting lineup versus Montana ... scored in double figures in 21-of-27 games, including a team-high four games with over 20 points ... led SDSU in scoring 14 times, highlighted by a career-high 30 points at Cal State Fullerton ... ranked first in the MWC in free-throw percentage (.819), fourth in three-point field goals per game (2.52) and ninth in three-point field-goal percentage (.397) ... sank 69 treys, an SDSU single-season record... her .397 three-point field-goal percentage ranks fifth on the Aztecs' single-season chart ... connected on at least one three-pointer in 25 of her 27 games ... selected as the conference's player of the week, Jan. 3, after scoring a combined 47 points (23.5 ppg) against Cal State Fullerton and Northern Arizona ... finished the regular season on a strong note, scoring 27 points and collecting a season-best five rebounds at Colorado State ... dished out a season-high five assists at Wyoming ... tied a career-high with seven threes, one shy of a school record, against Wyoming en route to 23 points ... knocked down 5-of-7 threes and finished with 18 points against Air Force at home ... tallied 25 points against the Falcons, including five treys, in Colorado Springs ... selected to the all-tournament team at the 1999 Pacific Bell Classic ... was SDSU's leading scorer in both games with 16 points versus Indiana State and 14 against Missouri ... finished 4-of-6 from the field against MU, including 4-of-5 from beyond the arc ... scored 16 points and dished out four assists in her first collegiate start at Idaho State ... snared a then career-high five steals in game No. 2 of the season versus Portland.

■ High School

Prepped at West High School in Waterloo, Iowa, where she earned four letters in basketball and two in track and field ... averaged 15 points, 6.7 assists and 2.5 steals per game as a senior ... named first team all-state in 1999 after earning second-team honors in '98 ... a two-time first team all-district selection, as well as a unanimous first team all-conference choice (1998 and '99) and all-metro pick (1998 and '99) ... named to the West High Hall of Fame ... the Warhawks were four-time Metro champions, conference champions three consecutive years and state runners-up in '99 ... West High was ranked in the top 10 in Iowa every week all four years and was nationally ranked by *USA Today* for three years ... set school record for most consecutive free throws in a game, going 10-for-10.

Jamey Lynn Cox was born Nov. 2, 1980, in Waterloo, Iowa ... Daughter of Greg and Sally Cox ... major is criminal justice.



Appeared in 27 games, including seven as a starter ... ranked fourth on the team with 3.9 rpg ... led the Aztecs on the boards in six games... averaged 3.8 ppg in her first season on the Mesa ... got off to a slow start offensively and did not score in double digits until game No. 8 versus Sacramento State ... finished with a season-high 12 points versus the Hornets ... also scored in

double figures against Radford with 10 points ... pulled down double-digit rebounds in two games ... opened her Division I career with 10 boards against Cal Poly ... closed out SDSU's pre-conference schedule with 11 rebounds versus Portland State ... equaled a season-high with 12 points at Wyoming ... also scored in double digits against Air Force, finishing with 11 points ... had eight points off the bench at New Mexico ... played 14 minutes in the MWC tournament game with the Lobos, going 3-for-3 with eight points ... one of five Aztecs named to the Mountain West All-Academic team.

### ■ Contra Costa CC (2000-2001)

A 2001 first-team all-Bay Valley Conference selection ... also earned all-academic team honors ... averaged a double-double during the 2001 season with 13.6 points and 11.0 rebounds ... in all had 20 double-doubles ... shot 42.1 percent from the floor ... named to the all-tournament teams at the Team Sports Classic, Comet Classic and De Anza Classic ... helped Contra Costa reach the 2001 state community college championship game ... averaged 14.0 rpg during the 2001 state tournament ... scored a season- and career-high 27 points versus Gavilan College ... hauled down a career-best 14 boards versus Butte College ... was teammates with classmate Ashonda Williams at Contra Costa.

### ■ High School

A 1999 graduate of De Anza High School in Richmond, Calif ... named first-team all-league as a junior after averaging 14.0 points ... did not play basketball as a senior ... also played volleyball and competed in track and field ... was an all-league high jumper.




