AZTECS TO CONCLUDE MOUNTAIN WEST SEASON AT BOISE STATE AND AIR FORCE

- San Diego State will wrap up its 2011 Mountain West regular season with a pair of matches on the road this week.
- ◆ The first contest will come on Thursday, Nov. 10, when the Aztecs visit Boise State at 7:00 p.m. (MT) for a match in Bronco Gym.
- ◆ SDSU will then square off against Air Force on Saturday, Nov. 12, at 5:00 p.m. (MT) on Falcon Court in the Cadet Gym in Colorado Springs.

SERIES RECORDS

- ♦ San Diego State holds a 28-2 mark in its previous 30 meetings with Air Force including a 3-0 win in Peterson Gym earlier this season. The teams first met in 1996 while both were members of the Western Athletic Conference. Air Force's wins over SDSU came in Colorado Springs in 1999. The Falcons ended a 22-match losing streak at the hands of the Aztecs last season when they won a four-set decision in Colorado Springs. The Aztecs are 15-0 vs. the Falcons in San Diego, 12-2 in Colorado Springs and 1-0 at neutral sites.
- ◆ The Aztecs and Boise State have met just twice previously with SDSU winning on both occasions. Most recently it was the Aztecs claiming a three-set win over the Broncos in mid-October this season. The first meeting between the teams occurred at the Red Raider Classic in Lubbock, Texas, during the 2005 season with SDSU taking a three-set win.

SCOUTING THE OPPOSITION

- ◆ Boise State enters the week with an overall record 15-13 and a 5-7 mark in conference play. The Broncos are led by outside hitters Liz Harden (2.66 kills, 0.83 digs per set) and Fiona Jones (2.46 kills, 2.47 digs per set). Middle blocker Brittany Reardon leads the conference with a .370 hitting percentage while Amanda Remy ranks third in the Mountain West in service aces at 0.30 per set.
- ◆ Air Force's record stands at 3-22 (0-12 Mountain West) as it prepares to host UNLV Thursday evening before facing San Diego State on Saturday. The Falcons have lost their last 13 matches, all by scores of 3-0. Air Force's top players include opposite hitter Cami Richan (3.00 kills, 1.89 digs per set) and middle blocker Ayesha Hein (2.40 kills, 0.64 blocks per set).

HEAD COACH DEITRE COLLINS-PARKER

- San Diego State head coach Deitre Collins-Parker is in her third season with the Aztecs after being named prior to the 2009 campaign. Her two-year record at SDSU is 46-40.
- She previously served as head coach at UNLV for eight seasons (1996-2003) and at Cornell for five years (2004-2008). Her 15-year career record stands at 207-230.
- A three-time All-American as a player at the University of Hawai'i, she led the Rainbow Wahine to consecutive national titles (1983-84) and was named the national player of the year twice.
- She was a member of the U.S. Olympic Team and competed at the Goodwill and Pan Am Games prior to playing professionally in Europe for four years.
- She is one of six players named to the NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball 25th Anniversary Team in October 2005 and was inducted into the AVCA Hall of Fame in the fall of 2008.

WIN NO. 200

- With the win over Wyoming on Sept. 29, Head Coach Deitre Collins-Parker recorded her 200th career victory.
- She is in her 15th season as a collegiate head coach having previously held that position at UNLV and Colgate.

TOURNAMENT SEEDING OUTLOOK

- This week's results will determine seedings for the Mountain West tournament to be held hosted by New Mexico in Albuquerque Nov. 17-19.
- The Aztecs are currently tied for second place with TCU and hold the tiebreaker over the Horned Frogs after defeating them in both meetings this season. Wins at Boise State and Air Force would lock up the No. 2 seed for San Diego State.
- TCU finishes it league season at home against Colorado State and Wyoming.
- Wyoming is in fourth place, one game behind the Aztecs and TCU. SDSU also has the tiebreaker against the Cowgirls. The teams split their two matches, but the Aztecs hold the edge in sets won.
- A three-way tie for second between SDSU, TCU and Wyoming would see the Aztecs receive the tournament's No. 2 seed as well.

MW PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- ◆ Outside hitter Paije Pearson was named the Mountain West Player of the Week for her efforts in the Aztecs' to two wins last week. It is the second weekly honor for Pearson in her SDSU career.
- She led the Aztecs with 13 kills in the 3-1 win over New Mexico on Thursday, Nov. 3. She also tied her career-high with four assists in the match to go along with seven digs and five blocks.
- In the 3-0 Senior Day win over TCU, Pearson was errorless in her attack with 10 kills on 20 attempts

(.500). She also has three assists, a service ace, six digs and four blocks in the match.

For the week, Pearson averaged 3.29 kills, 1.86 digs, 1.29 blocks and 1.00 assists per set, while hitting .354. She averaged 4.07 points per set over seven total sets.

HANNASCH LEADS THE OFFENSE

- Junior middle blocker Andrea Hannasch turned in her fourth double-double of the season with 10 kills and 10 digs in the win over New Mexico on Nov. 3.
- ◆ The 10 digs marked her season high.
- It was her first double-double this season with kills and digs. The other three came with kills and blocks.
- She has finished in double figure in kills in 11 of the last 13 matches.
- She matched her season high with three service aces in the three-set victory over TCU on Nov. 5.
- Hannasch set or tied five personal career highs in the win at TCU on Oct. 6.
- She set new career bests of 20 kills and 30 points at TCU on Oct. 6.
- She also tied her Aztec bests with three assists, three solo blocks and 11 total blocks.
- ◆ Her 20 kills and 11 blocks at TCU were her third double-double of the season and sixth of her career.
- Her .765 hitting percentage in the win over Boise State (Oct. 15) was a career high as she had no errors in the match on 17 attacks.
- She leads the San Diego State offense in kills, blocks and points.
- She ranks among the top 10 in the Mountain West in each of those categories as well as hitting percentage.

FOUCH ASSISTS

- Setter Johnna Fouch averaged 15.3 kills per set in the win over TCU on Nov. 5.
- ◆ Fouch leads the conference in all games with an average of 11.19 assists per set while her league-match average of 11.87 is also the best in the Mountain West.
- Her overall assist average ranks 24th in NCAA Division I this week.
- ◆ She set a career high with 65 assists in the victory at TCU on Oct. 6.
- She recorded a season-high 31 digs at Wyoming last Saturday (Oct. 29).
- It was the most digs in a match by an Aztec this season and one shy of her SDSU career high.
- Her average of 2.53 digs per set is second only to libero Kristi Jackels.
- ♦ Fouch set a career high with six blocks in the win over Wyoming on Sept. 29.
- She has recorded nine double-double performances (assists-digs) in 2011, the latest being a 54 assist-31 dig effort at Wyoming on Oct. 29.

NASH CONTRIBUTES

- Summer Nash had back-to-back doublefigure kills effort in last week's wins over New Mexico (Nov. 3) and TCU (Nov. 5).
- In those two contests she average 3.43 kills per set.
- She had a career-highs of five block assists and six total blocks in the four-set victory vs. New Mexico.
- Nash made a start at Wyoming on Oct. 29 after having appeared off the bench in the previous nine matches.
- She responded with eight kills, three digs and block in the three sets in which she played.
- Nash's 13 kills and 10 digs vs. Cal State Fullerton on Sept. 20 was her first double-double as an Aztec.
- ♦ Her season high of 16 kills came vs. Valparaiso on Sept. 17.

HARRIS ON THE BLOCK

- Middle blocker Emily Harris, a sophomore transfer from Western Michigan, has started each of the last 18 matches after not appearing in SDSU's first five contests of the year due to injury.
- She had a career-high 10 blocks in the match against New Mexico last Thursday (Nov. 3). She also had eight kills and a .333 hitting percentage in that contest.
- In SDSU's two matches last week, she recorded a total of 16 blocks for an average of 2.29 per set.

- ♦ Harris set career highs with 15 kills, 19.0 points and a .522 hitting percentage in the win at New Mexico on Oct. 9.

SHELTON SOLID UP FRONT

- Sophomore Raegan Shelton recorded her 10th and 11th double-figure kill efforts of the season with 10 against New Mexico and 14 vs. TCU last week.
- She has now had three straight doublefigure kill efforts after recording 13 at Wyoming on Oct. 29.
- She also added five digs, two service aces and an assist in that contest in Laramie.
- ♦ Against UNLV on Oct. 21, she tied her career highs of 21 kills and four blocks while setting a new personal best with 23.5 points.
- She had recorded a career-highs in those categories with 21 kills and 21.5 points at TCU on Oct. 6.
- Her eight digs at New Mexico on Oct. 9 tied her career best.
- Shelton is averaging 3.30 kills per set through 12 Mountain West matches to rank fifth in the league.

JACKELS DIGGING AWAY

- Libero Kristi Jackels recorded a total of 56 digs in the matches vs. New Mexico and TCU for an average of 8.00 per set.
- Her 32 digs against New Mexico tied her career high which she set at Brigham Young on Nov. 6, 2010.
- She has finished in double figures in digs in 21 of SDSU's 23 matches this year.
- ◆ Jackels has joined the 1,000 dig club for her two-plus year career as an Aztec and enters the week with 1,282 digs to rank fourth on the SDSU all-time list.
- She ranks third in the conference this week in digs in Mountain West play at 4.73 per set.
- She is also sixth in service aces at 0.29 service aces per set in league matches.

PEARSON SETS PERSONAL BESTS

- Senior Paije Pearson had back-to-back double-figure kill matches for just the second time this season with 13 vs. New Mexico and 10 vs. TCU last week.
- Her average of 3.29 kills per set over those two matches was over a point higher than her season average (2.15 kps).
- She had season highs of 12 digs and one solo block in the win at New Mexico on Oct. 9.
- Pearson set a personal career high with 17 kills and 20.0 points in the match at Tulane on Sept. 2.
- In the match at UC Riverside on Sept. 25, she set a career best with four service aces and tied her SDSU career high with four assists.
- Pearson had 15 kills and hit .423 (her highest attack percentage of 2011) in the four-set loss to Kansas on Sept. 16.
- In the season opener against UC Irvine she tied her Aztec career high with eight blocks in the win over the Anteaters.

SEXTON SERVES IT UP

- Senior outside hitter Kyley Sexton is averaging 0.27 aces per set, a mark which would rank seventh in the conference (all matches) if she had not missed several matches with an ankle injury in late September.
- She had a career-high four service aces in the victory over Nevada on Aug. 27.
- Her three blocks assists against Boise State on Oct. 15 tied her season high.
- Her season-high 19 kills vs. Portland on Aug. 27 is the second-highest total for an Aztec this fall.
- She recorded 13 kills in the win at TCU on Oct. 6, her second-best total of the 2011 campaign.

GOING LONG

- San Diego State's wins at TCU (Oct. 6) and New Mexico (Oct. 9) marked only the second time that the Aztecs have won back-to-back five-set matches on the road. The other occasion came during the 1988 season when they won at Fresno State and Pepperdine on consecutive days (Sept. 16-17).
- SDSU has only had three consecutive five-set matches once in school history. That came in 1986 when they defeated San Jose State, UCLA (away) and Cal State Fullerton from Sept. 29 to Oct. 3.
- San Diego State has a record of 4-3 in five-set matches this season.

SHELTON EARNS CONFERENCE AWARD

- Sophomore Raegan Shelton earned Mountain West Volleyball Co-Player of the Week honors for matches played from Oct. 3-9, 2011.
- She had a career-high 21 kills and 58 attempts on .241 hitting against the Horned Frogs, the most kills by an Aztec this season.
- Against New Mexico on Sunday, Shelton had 19 kills on .267 hitting and tied her career-high with eight digs.
- ◆ For the week, Shelton averaged 4.00 kills, 0.40 blocks and 1.50 digs per set, while hitting .252. She averaged 4.20 points per set over 10 total sets.

HANNASCH PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- Middle blocker Andrea Hannasch earned Mountain West Volleyball Player of the Week honors for matches played during the opening weekend of the 2011 season (Aug. 26-27). It is the third weekly honor of her career.
- Hannasch led SDSU to a 3-0 record and the Aztec Invitational tournament title. She was named Most Valuable Player of the tournament for her performances against UC Irvine, Portland and Nevada.
- ◆ She posted a double-double with 17 kills and 10 blocks in the 3-1 win over UC Irvine on Friday, Aug. 26. Her 23.5 points in the match were a career best.
- In the 3-2 win against Portland, Hannasch recorded 14 kills, six blocks, five digs and two service aces. The Aztecs beat Nevada, 3-0, in the nightcap with a team-high 12 kills and five blocks from Hannasch.
- ◆ For the week, Hannasch averaged 3.58 kills, 1.75 blocks, 1.17 digs and 0.33 aces per set, while hitting .398. She also accounted for 4.88 points per set.

FOUCH ALL-TOURNEY HONOREE

- Sophomore setter Johnna Fouch was named to the all-tournament team at the DePaul Invitational (Sept. 16-17).
- Over SDSU's three matches she averaged 12.30 assists per set and 2.60 digs per set.
- ◆ It was the second straight tournament in which Fouch was an all-tourney honoree as she received the same accolade at the Allstate Sugar Bowl Collegiate Classic in New Orleans Sept. 2-3.

ALL-TOURNEY AZTECS PART II

- Setter Johnna Fouch and outside hitter Paije Pearson were named to the alltourney team at the Allstate Sugar Bowl Collegiate Classic Sept. 2-3.
- ◆ Over the matches against Tulane and William and Mary on Sept. 2, Pearson averaged 2.75 kills, 1.50 digs and 3.12 points per set. She also recorded 0.50 blocks per set.
- ◆ Fouch, meanwhile, was the tournament's top setter with an average of 10.00 assists per set. She also finished with marks of 0.62 kills and accounted for 0.88 points per set from her setter position.

ALL-TOURNAMENT AZTECS PART III

- Andrea Hannasch and Kyley Sexton were named to the all-tournament team at the season-opening Aztec Invitational (Aug. 26-27).
- Hannasch averaged 3.58 kills, 1.75 blocks and 1.17 digs in wins over UC Irvine, Portland and Nevada.
- Sexton averaged 3.00 kills per set over the three matches and had six service aces and a .281 hitting percentage.

ATHLETIC RELATIVES

- Two members of the Aztecs have notable athletic connections in their family.
- Redshirt freshman Oni Lattin's grandfather, David Lattin, was a member of the 1966 Texas Western (now UTEP) basketball team under Don Haskins that upset Kentucky for the national title.
- ◆ Emily Harris' father, Al Harris, played defensive end and linebacker for the Chicago Bears from 1979-84 and 1986-88 before finishing his career with the Philadelphia Eagles from 1989-90.
- In addition, assistant coach Melanie Greene's dad, Ken Greene, played pro football with the San Diego Chargers and St. Louis Cardinals.

PRESEASON PROGNOSTICATIONS

- The Mountain West coaches and media poll has predicted the Aztecs to finish third in the eight-team league. It is SDSU's highest preseason conference ranking since joining the league in 1999.
- ◆ In the 12 years of the MW's existence, SDSU has finished second (2002), fourth (2000, 2001, 2003), fifth (2005), sixth (1999, 2004, 2006, 2009, 2010), seventh (2008) and eighth (2007) in the final standings.
- Colorado State has been chosen to defend its Mountain West title from a year ago with New Mexico picked to finish second. The results of the preseason poll are as follows:

AZTEC NOTES

- The win over TCU on Nov. 5 by scores of 30-28, 28-26, 26-24 marked the first time that SDSU was involved in a match in which every set went to extra points since rally scoring was introduced in 2001. Prior to rally scoring, SDSU never played in a match in which every set went to extra points (including two-set tournament matches).
- San Diego State's losses at Colorado State and Wyoming (Oct. 27 and 29) marked the first time that the Aztec had lost two matches in a row this season.
- The Aztecs longest winning streak of the season, four matches is also the team's longest streak since the 2007 campaign.
- Kyla Oropeza's 13 digs at Wyoming on Oct. 29 tied her career high as an Aztec.
- Defensive specialist Courtney Vaccarello tied her SDSU career high with nine digs vs. TCU on Nov. 5. She had just set that mark two matches earlier at Wyoming on Oct. 29.
- ♦ As a team, San Diego State stands first in kills and assists in league matches.
- San Diego State's .387 hitting percentage in the match vs. Wyoming on Sept. 29 was its highest of the season.
- Eleven different players have started matches for the Aztecs this season (not including libero Kristi Jackels). Only Johnna Fouch and Andrea Hannasch have started every match.
