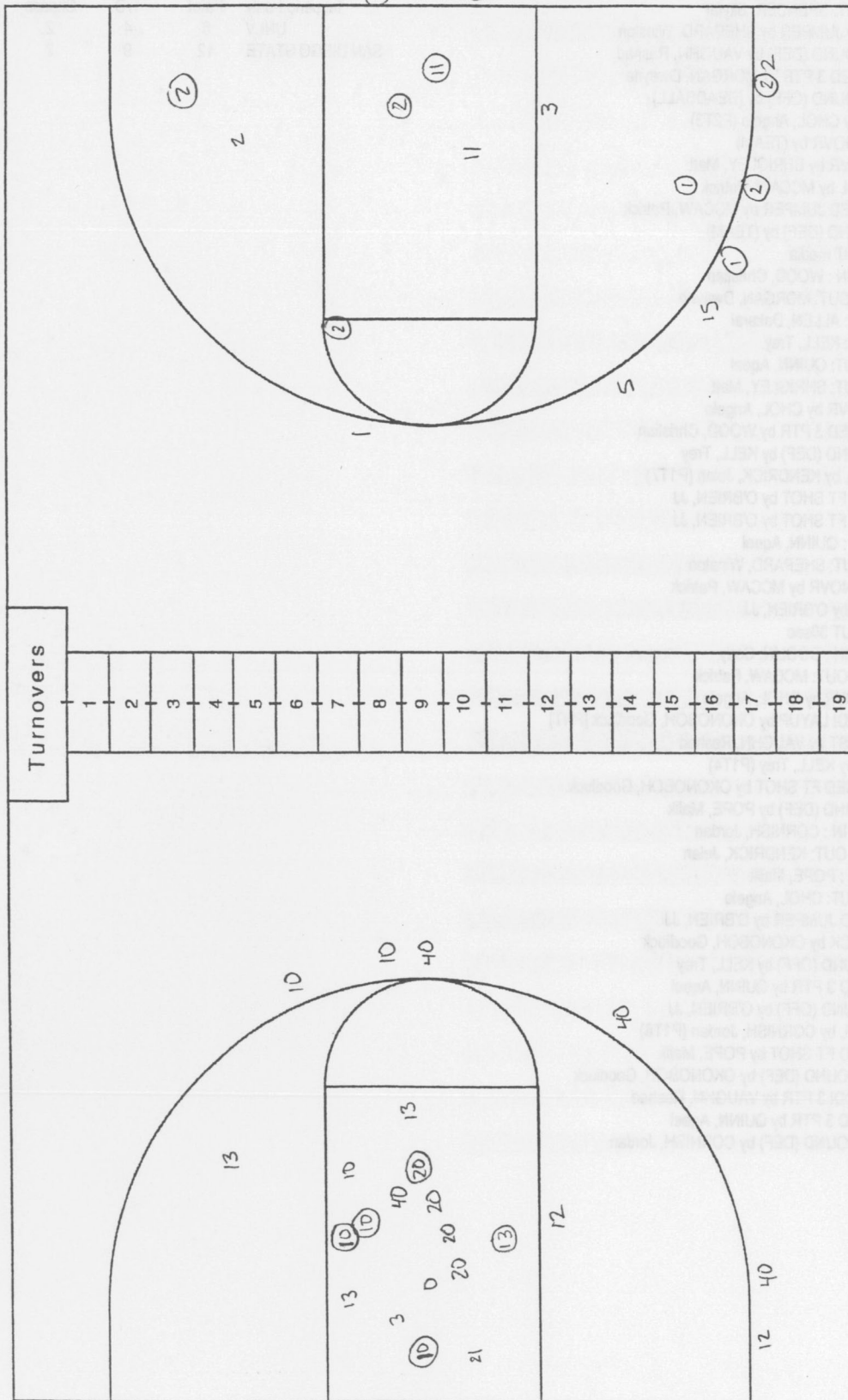

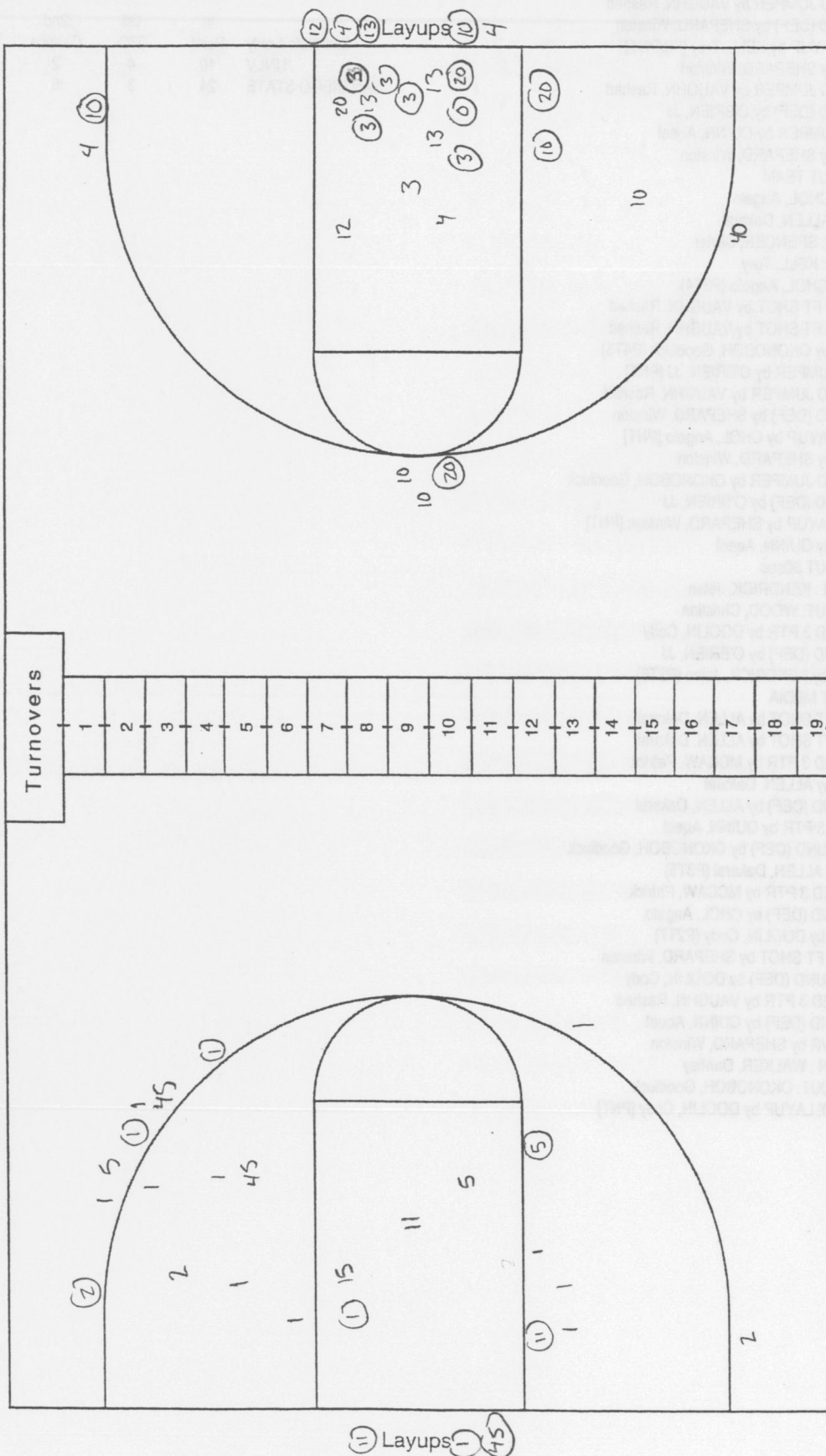

Game Notes

- The Aztecs overcame an 11-point second-half deficit to win, marking the 11th time an SDSU team has overcome a second-half hole of at least 11 points in the Steve Fisher era.
- The 11-point second-half rally for victory is tied for the seventh largest for an SDSU squad since the 1996-97 season.
- San Diego State rallied from a seven-point halftime deficit to win. The effort was the best of the season. The largest halftime deficit overcome for a victory this season was a one-point hole vs. Utah on Nov. 18, 2014.
- SDSU won its 133rd straight game when leading with five minutes to play. The Aztecs led, 45-43, when the clock struck 5:00.
- No team has shot 50.0 percent from the field at Viejas Arena in the last 26 games.
- The Aztecs have won 69 straight home games when holding their opponent to 60 points or less.
- SDSU wins its 25th straight home game, which extends the program record.
- San Diego State wins its third consecutive game to improve to 14-4 and 4-1 in the Mountain West play.
- The Aztecs have held all 11 home opponents to under 60 points this season.
- San Diego State defeats UNLV for the fourth straight time, which is its second-longest winning streak in series history.
- Since 2009, SDSU is 13-4 vs. the Runnin' Rebels. Over the last 13 meetings, SDSU is 10-3 vs. UNLV.
- The Aztecs held their opponent's bench without a point for the second straight game. SDSU's bench has scored 43 over those two games.

Player Notes

Aqeel Quinn – 14 points, 3 rebounds, 2 assists

Reached double figures in scoring for the second straight game, marking the first time he has accomplished the feat this season... The double-digit scoring effort was his sixth of the season and 18th of his career... Led the team in scoring for the sixth time of his career (all this season).

JJ O'Brien – 11 points, 10 rebounds, 2 assists, 1 steal

Posted his second double-double of the season and the seventh of his career... Scored in double figures for the eighth time this season and the 35th time of his career... San Diego State-UNLV Postgame Quotes

Head Coach Steve Fisher Radio:

On finding a way to win:

"I'm proud of our team Ted. It's a 40 minute game, you've got to be a grinder. We told them at halftime that they can't let a good team shoot 10 for 17. They made a couple of hard shots but, they made some dunks they made a couple of open threes, you can't give those up. You have to make it tough twos. We have a lot of kids that love to win and will play for the team. The very last play AQ (Aqeel Quinn) was trying to run a play that we call "ghost", he was open but Trey (Kell) was unguarded in the corner. If he makes one more pass we would have had a great shot instead of a good shot. We shot 6 for 24 at half time. We shot 53-percent in the second half, we had 21 field goals for the game, and we had 14 assists. We did the right thing and made the right plays in the second half. We got good shots and in the second half we made them. One more thing, our two warriors, JJ O'Brien and Aqeel Quinn. They played 38 and 34 minutes and didn't have any turnovers between the two of them. They did the right thing, they made the right plays, had the right read, and they did the right kinds of things. Those kinds of right things that don't show up in the scorebook."

On JJ O'Brien playing 38 minutes:

"Sometimes you have to say, 'I know he is tired but, he is 23 he can't be that tired,' we all rationalize a little bit. JJ is smart and he knows when to take a deep breath, he does the things that get us a win."

On UNLV's Rashad Vaughn:

"They (UNLV) love this atmosphere. They love this stage to be on. They were skipping around and excited to be here. It wasn't a false bravado they knew they were going to come out and play pretty well and they did. They shot the lights out in the first half and controlled the tempo of the game. Fortunately we were able to make stops when we had to. I think that they went almost five minutes until they finally got that layup at the end by (Cody) Doolin. They helped us secure a tough, hard fought win."

On making halftime adjustments:

"Dutch (Brian Dutcher) told them to put the ball in the high post more. We had several low post touches in the first half, a couple which were turnovers and not completed passes. But Dutch said lets go for high post touches, and I think that really impacted what we were able to do offensively. Sometimes it was high post then low post but we put the ball into the high post more often in the second half. And we said that we need to guard. If they shoot 58 percent in the second half we are not going to win. Guard your man harder."

On defending Christian Wood:

"We wanted to double him when he got into the post. And we needed to have what we call a hover hand to crowd him on the perimeter. He will jab-step at you and if you back off he will rise up and shoot that long range shot, and he can make a shot."

On the effort of the Aztecs:

"I love this team. And we have the ability to go to the bench. I can't say enough about what Dakarai Allen brings to the game when he comes out. He could care less if he ever touches the ball on offense. But he is going to guard like crazy and rebound the ball; he will do whatever he can to help us win. Trey (Kell) came in and made a couple of nice plays for us. I think everyone that got in made excellent contributions."

On outscoring UNLV's bench:

"That is what we hope to do. You have to come out and play with no agenda, not come out and worry about what you can do if you get 20 seconds or two minutes. D'erry! (Williams) was in for two minutes and he hounded Doolin at the point. Two minutes while someone was resting and they didn't have any progression offensively. Everybody has a roll and everybody plays their roll. When you do that you have a chance."

On upcoming away games:

"If I had deep pockets I would reach in and get that charter again, boy was that nice. We are going to fly into Denver International and take that tram ride and take that bus ride. We intend to go in and be successful and happy when we come back home on Wednesday with a victory in a place that will be tough."

On the crowd:

"Yes, we had a great crowd. I think sometime you get jaded and complain when you see some empty seats. We have a spectacular crowd that gets involved, stays engaged, and supports their team in a fashion that, as a coach that has done this a long time, can appreciate. We need you when we come back, I know it is against Fresno State and we are away for the next two, but we need you out here."

Steve Fisher (press conference)**Opening statement:**

"This was, needless to say, not only a good win but an important win. We were riding high after a win in Laramie, Wyoming, which we hadn't done in the previous two years. You can't get it back when you have a home game. We talked about the importance of this game. We also talked about a UNLV team that was going to come in and play as hard as they could and (play) good basketball. When I came out early with under three minutes on the clock (before the start of the game), I saw them skipping on the floor and excited that there were 12,414 in here. They were excited to play, and it wasn't the fearful excitement. We didn't guard particularly well in the first half and they made some hard shots. That combination is not good and 6-for-24 is even worse. (In the second half), we didn't give them the layups they had in the first half where they didn't get the satisfaction of seeing it go through the hoop after a couple minutes so we got ourselves a really good team victory."

On JJ O'Brien's performance and leadership:

"I'm so happy for JJ and obviously happy because of a lot of things. We don't win without a JJ O'Brien in the program on the team. He's a quiet leader. He says a few things at the right moment in the locker room that are very impactful. He did it before Wyoming and yesterday leading into the game with Vegas. He's a maturing, young guy who can play basketball. I loved his stat line, 11 points, 10 rebounds and 38 minutes. I know that's a lot of minutes but we kept him in. I'm happy for him and glad to see he's using that backboard on the shots where he gets inside too. He did a great job for us. He was the guy that we started on (Christian) Wood and doubled him as he got close to the post but JJ knows how to play. He got close on him, was on the perimeter and didn't let him step him back and shoot the three-pointer that he is so skillful at. It was a good game for all and a terrific game for JJ."

On SDSU's comeback and ability to close out the game:

"If you guard hard, you have a chance. We were fighting from behind the whole game. We went behind by 11 early in the second half and finally caught them at 40-40. When Dakarai (Allen) missed it and fell down, they go the other way and hit a three for a five-point swing, putting them at 43-40. With a team that didn't have veterans and a team that hadn't have said 'next play,' they might have let up just a little bit but they didn't. They almost went the last five minutes without a point until (Cody) Doolin hit that layup at the very end of the game. We never ever have talked about the streak under five minutes remaining. We never look at the clock but we want to make sure we're playing harder than our opponent, especially when winning is on the line."

On the winning streak with five minutes remaining:

"It's impressive that we're able to do that and we want to keep it going. We had a (43)-game winning streak against California schools that Fresno State ended. We don't want this one to end. We would like for this one to go on until long after I'm gone."

On players doing their job:

"You reevaluate the question of, am I doing exactly what I need to do to help us win. We've come back and have been fortunate to have only basketball to deal with since the start of the conference season. That helps everyone. When we start school on Wednesday, we'll have an added job and a big reason why they are here - to go to class. They start school on Wednesday which means we're going to miss the first day of class coming back from Air Force. We've competed hard and we've talked about everyone doing their job. You guard your man so we don't have to help you out all the time. When someone gets beat, help them. Be confident about your shot when you get it. At halftime, I thought we moped off the floor and I complained about that. You've got to act like you expect to win. You have to act like you expect to make those shots. When you get your shot, shoot it but don't take a bad shot just to shoot it. We're supposed to get better as the season goes on."

SDSU Senior Forward JJ O'Brien**On the team's winning streak when leading with five minutes left:**

"I don't think we think of the streak when we're up. We just see that we're up and we want to keep pushing forward."

On being aware of the streak:

"I don't know if we (play) for the streak, we (play) to win. The streak is a great accomplishment but we don't do it for the streak. When we're up five with five minutes to go we want to win, that's just what it is."

On guarding Christian Wood:

"Anybody who I'm guarding, I take it personally. I knew he was a great player, (UNLV) has great scorers. I just tried to watch film to see what he did best and take that away from him. I think I did a good job of that, but every night, whoever I'm guarding, I take it personal."

SDSU Junior Forward Winston Shepard

On the team's ability to close out opponents at the end of the game:

"Under five minutes, that's pretty much crunch time. We have to make big time plays, and I thought that's what we did. I think coach said the last 4:57 they didn't score until (Cody) Doolin made that layup. That's big time defense, and that's what we pride ourselves on."

On JJ O'Brien's performance:

"He was really solid today, as he always is. Today he brought it. Chris Wood brings a lot of match-up problems but I think a player like JJ (O'Brien) makes it tough for him. Chris Wood has been going against a lot of slower big guys who can't really move their feet. JJ (O'Brien) is pretty much a perimeter guy, so I think that made it pretty tough for Chris Wood."

SDSU senior guard Aqeel Quinn

On slowing down freshman guard Patrick McCaw:

"When he ran along the baseline - New Mexico used to run that - I remember from last year and the year before that. We were pretty used to it, you just have to chase. It's pretty tough chasing him on the baseline, but you just have to win the last step and make sure you have help. We were trailing them on the baseline, and it was a team effort. It wasn't just me and Dakarai (Allen), the bigs were helping and stunting, the point guard at the top was stunting and helping everybody out. It was a team effort, it wasn't just one guy."

On why McCaw slowed down:

"I don't know what he was going through personally, but I just know we like to keep the pedal to the metal, so if he was tired I really wouldn't know. We like to go full throttle."

On the team's feelings after gaining the lead after being down:

"I think after the Wyoming game, not just this game, it pretty much brought us together as a unit. As far as this game, it was a tough one. I know there was a lot of talking and chitter-chattering between all five of us that were on the floor at that point like, 'we need to get a stop, it's time to score on the other end.' It's just pretty fun to see the whole team, everybody coming together as one. It's pretty fun when that happens."

On the team's confidence when they are able to pull each other up:

"It's a confidence booster, energy booster, especially when you have the crowd behind you too. That helps a lot, but this is definitely a confidence booster."

On having a teammate like JJ O'Brien:

"JJ is pretty even keel, so it's hard to see how he's feeling or what he's thinking in the first place. Just being that he's a fifth-year senior, you pretty much know he's going to come with the effort. Coming in Christian Wood is definitely highly talented, and I know JJ wanted to show off his skills as well."

On difference in the team's chemistry in the past two games:

"The continuity, the way we're talking to each other, the way we hug each other, the way we slap each other and give each other high-fives, it's just a whole different aura and feeling in the locker room right now. If you come in the locker room, you can feel it yourself. We're definitely coming together right now."

On the environment in the locker room at halftime:

"Coach was on us. When coach is like that, and gets fired up, it pretty much fires the whole group up. You don't really get to see him yelling and screaming like that, so when he does come in like that it tells us we need to pick it up. We responded well."

On JJ being the 'glue' of the team:

"JJ has been in the system, you can't say enough about him. He does everything right every day. He goes to lift, he doesn't skip anything. He just does everything right, and he's starting to speak up a lot more. The maturation of JJ is lovely to see."

On getting Angelo Chol the ball:

"Angelo is a beast, I think Winston (Shepard) said that in the beginning of the year. I think you guys are definitely starting to see it now. We see it every day at practice, and it's not a pretty sight to see. I'm just happy he's on a roll now, and every time he gets the ball (I think he's over 75 percent shooting), he's scoring. We do need to give him the ball."

UNLV head coach Dave Rice

On the game's final five minutes:

"I think we had a hard time getting a basket, and that probably took away a little of our energy on the defensive end. I'm very, very proud of our effort. Of course we wanted to win the game, but the main thing I was looking for coming into the game was our energy and our team chemistry, and I thought both those things were good. We played hard, I thought we were patient on the offensive end for three-fourths of the game. In the end, we didn't have quite enough to get over the hump."

On JJ O'Brien's impact on the game:

"JJ's a fifth-year senior, he's played a lot of college basketball games and has a high basketball IQ. I think he's one of those guys who could care less if he ever scores, but if he needs to score, he can. He made a big 3-pointer when (SDSU) was struggling against the zone. He's a winning player. There's a reason why he's won so many games in his college career, and there's a reason why we were recruiting him (when he transferred) out of Utah."

On turning the ball over so much late in the game:

"That has been one of our tough things. When you look at our stats in conference play, our stats are pretty impressive until you look at defensive rebounding and turnover margin. In a game like this, a low-possession game against a team that's going to hold the ball, you can't give up turnovers for touchdowns so to speak. So we have to do a better job of that. But overall, the effort was very good today."

On Chris Wood's performance:

"I think (SDSU) was very physical with him. Every time he caught the ball on the block they doubled him, and I thought he did a good job of throwing it out. Chris is a good player and he's still adjusting to drawing a lot of attention. San Diego State is very good defensively and extremely physical. They were able to do it by committing only nine fouls, and when you're able to do that, it's very impressive. Give a lot of credit to San Diego State for being as physical as they were."

UNLV guard Patrick McCaw**On the game's final five minutes:**

"We lost some of our intensity down the stretch. I think the last seven minutes of the game, we started falling off with our energy. We fought hard, but we just came up short in the game."

On if their offensive struggles affected their defense down the stretch:

"I think sometimes that what happens. When (SDSU) gets so many touches and starts scoring against our zone, it broke us down."

On what SDSU does defensively that's different from what he's seen this season:

"They pressured us the whole game. I think they pressed all 40 minutes. It's a different look than we've seen all year. They trap, we just had to get used to it. We attacked them well, it's just a different look for us."

On the game's final five minutes:
