Aztecs Set for UC San Diego in Final Non-Conference Game of 2022

The San Diego State softball team wraps up its non-conference portion of the schedule with a single game at UC San Diego at 5 p.m. PT Wednesday. The Aztecs (29-12, 13-2 MW), who are 23rd in the latest D1Softball rankings, and Tritons (20-20, 8-7 BW) are meeting for the first time since 1989.

Wednesday's game at Triton Field on UCSD's campus will ESPN3 Watch ESPN broadcast on and (https://es.pn/3rxAqpN).

SDSU is coming off another series win over Boise State last weekend, coming back from a 6-2 setback on Thursday with back-to-back 3-2 victories on Friday and Saturday, respectively, including a 13-inning triumph on Friday. San Diego State has won five consecutive MW series for the first time since 2014-15 (last three series of 2014, first two of 2015). It is the first time that the Aztecs have won five straight MW series in the same season since the league went to the three-game format in 2012.

SDSU (29-12) already has one more win than last year when it finished 28-16 with 10 regular-season games to play, not including postseason. San Diego State (13-2) has also equaled its conference win total from last year when it finished 13-11 in league play.

Mac Barbara leads the Aztecs in most offensive categories, including batting average (.405, T-73rd in NCAA), hits (51, T-41st in NCAA), doubles (10), home runs (13, T-33rd in NCAA), RBIs (49, T-7th in NCAA), total bases (102, T-16th in NCAA), slugging percentage (.810, T-34th in NCAA), walks (27, T-33rd in NCAA) and on-base percentage (.506, 45th in NCAA). Barbara has reached base in 35 consecutive games, the longest streak in the country this year (overall or active).

Bella Espinoza (.382, 30 R, 50 H, 7 RBI, 11 SB) and Jillian Celis (.338, 21 RBI, 26 R, 7 2B, 4 3B, 6 SB) are also hitting over .300 for SDSU.

Maggie Balint (13-5, 1.56 ERA, 5 SV, .175 opp. avg.) has won seven of a possible 10 MW Pitcher-of-the-Week awards, and is tied for third in the country in saves (5), ninth in strikeouts (211), 16th in strikeouts per seven innings (10.63), 17th in strikeout-to-walk ratio (7.28), 36th in ERA (1.56) and 38th in hits allowed per seven innings (4.43).

Dee Dee Hernandez (8-3, 1.81 ERA, 3 SV) and Dani Martinez (4-3, 3.59 ERA) rank among the nation's best in walks allowed per seven innings (14th (0.86) and 13th (0.85)) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (29th (6.11) and 40th (5.60)), respectively.

- Helped lead SDSU to seven straight NCAA tournaments from 2009-15 and a combined 398-264 (.601) record in her 13 seasons on The Mesa as an assistant coach, associate head coach and head coach in waiting.
- Over her first nine seasons as an assistant and associate coach, the Aztecs improved their batting average from .275 in 2008 (the year before she arrived) to a school-record .356 mark in 2017, and also in runs per game (3.98 to 6.61), home runs per game (0.23 to 1.09 (0.92 in 2017)), slugging percentage (.348 to .516) and on-base percentage (.347 to .418).
- Was the head coach of the National Pro Fastpitch's Chicago Bandits for the 2018 season, leading the Bandits to the NPF Championship series in her first year.
- Also has served as an assistant coach for the Women's National Team and USA Softball Junior Women's (19-Under) Selection Camps.
- As a player, was a three-time U.S. Olympian, winning gold medals in 2000 and 2004, and a silver medal in 2008. Also helped the United States National Team to a World Cup championship (2006), two World Championships (2002 and 2006) and two Pan American gold medals (1999 and 2003).
- Was a standout player at UCLA, finishing her four-year career with four NCAA records - 90 home runs, .945 slugging percentage, 240 walks and 81 intentional walks. She was a fourtime first-team NFCA All-American (1997, 1999, 2001-02) and a three-time Pac-10 Player of the Year (1999, 2001-02).
- In 1999, Nuveman Deniz led the Bruins to a national championship, batting .446 during the season with 31 home runs and

Scouting UC San Diego

UC San Diego enters the San Diego State game with a 20-20 record, including an 8-7 mark in the Big West. The Tritons are coming off consecutive 2-1 series losses to perennial Big West contenders Cal State Fullerton (April 15-16) and Long Beach State (April 8-9).

UCSD is hitting .248 as a team, including three players over .300 in Sophia Real (.400, 1 HR, 9 RBI, 17 R, 12 BB, .513 SLG%, .484 OB%), Isabel Lavrov (.339, 4 HR, 23 RBI, 24 R, 15 BB, 11 SB, .522 SLG%, .418 OB%) and Keila Bosinger (.314, 6 HR, 20 RBI, 23 R, 8 2B, 2 2B, 8 SB 11 B, .562 SLG%, .381 OB%).

The UC San Diego State pitching staff, meanwhile, has combined for a 3.02 ERA with 280 strikeouts in 269 innings. Jada Cecil has been particularily impressive with a 13-3 record and 1.71 ERA in 127 innings, striking out 185 and limiting the opposition to a .164 average. Gabby Williams (4-6, 2.82 ERA, 67.0 IP), Kaia Simpson (3-10, 5.17 ERA, 46.0 IP) and Shelby Thompson (0-1, 5.79 ERA, 29.0 IP) have also logged innings for the Tritons.

Aztecs Up to 23rd in D1Softball Rankings; Receiving Votes in Two Major Polls

San Diego State is 23rd in the latest D1Softball rankings, where were released Monday on D1softball.com. The Aztecs (29-12, 13-2 MW) moved up one spot from last week's No. 24 ranking after claiming a weekend series over Boise State.

SDSU is ahead of No. 24 Notre Dame and No. 25 Illinois in the rankings, while No. 20 Oregon State, No. 21 Nebraska and No. 22 Michigan are also near San Diego State. The Aztecs have a win over current No. 12 Washington and a 7-6, eight-inning loss to current No. 7 Northwestern. Oklahoma remains atop the rankings with a 38-1 record, while Alabama, Virginia Tech, Florida Sate and UCLA round out the top 5.

San Diego State and No. 18 UCF are the only Group of 5 teams in the rankings.

The Aztecs have won all five MW series this season and are first in the league standings, 2 1/2 games ahead of Utah State (9-3). SDSU, which plays host to the Aggies from May 6-8, has already won series against the next three teams in the league standings in UNLV (8-4), Boise State (7-5) and Colorado State (5-7).

For the eighth time over the last nine weeks, San Diego State is receiving votes in the ESPN.com/USA Softball Collegiate Top 25 Poll. The Aztecs received 11 votes in the latest poll, which is voted on by coaching representatives of 10 Division I conferences as well as members of the media who consistently cover Division I softball across the country.

The 11 votes are the 29th-most votes in the poll. Notre Dame is ranked 25th in the poll with 44 points. Stanford leads the receiving votes group with 36 points, followed by Arizona (26), South Florida (22), SDSU (11), Mississippi State (10), Louisiana (9), Missouri (9), Illinois (8) and USC Upstate (3).

SDSU previously had three votes in the Feb. 22 poll (T-34th most in the country), 12 on March 1 (32nd), four on March 8 (31st), four on March 15 (29th), none on March 22, six on March 29 (T-32nd), six on April 5 (T-34th) and five on April 12 (T-31st).

Oklahoma has all 25 first-place votes and 625 points overall.

San Diego State is also receiving votes in the USA Today/NFCA poll for the second straight week. The Aztecs have a single vote, which is the 33rd most in the poll. Nebraska is No. 25 with 57 votes, while Stanford (24), USC Upstate (15), Oregon State (13), Louisiana (10), USF (9), Missouri (5), Mississippi State (3) and the Aztecs (1) are all receiving votes.

Oklahoma has all 32 first-place votes and 800 points overall.

Mac Barbara Slugging Her Way into SDSU History

Mac Barbara is off to one of the best individual starts in program history.

Through 41 games, Barbara is batting .405 with 13 home runs, 49 RBIs, 10 doubles, an .810 slugging percentage and a .506 onbase mark. Among the NCAA leaders, Barbara ranks in a tie for seventh in RBIs (49), a tie for 16th in total bases (102), a tie for 33rd in home runs (13) and walks (27), a tie for 34th in slugging percentage (.810), a tie for 41st in hits (51), 45th in on-base percentage (.506) and a tie for 73rd in batting average (.405).

Barbara's 13 home runs in 41 games are already tied for the seventh most in San Diego State single-season history. Barbara also ranks in a tie for third in RBIs (49), fourth in on-base percentage (.506), slugging percentage (.810) and OPS percentage (1.316), sixth in batting average (.405), tied for seventh in home runs (13), tied for eighth in total bases (102), ninth in extra-base hits (24) and tied for ninth in walks (27).

Maggie Balint Pitching Her Way into the SDSU Record Books

Maggie Balint is having her best season as an Aztec and one of the best seasons of her career. Balint, who was 28-4 with a 1.51 ERA at Oregon from 2017-18 en route to being named a all-region, all-Pac-12 and all-Pac-12 freshman pick as a freshman in 2017, is currently 13-5 with a 1.56 ERA in 139 innings. The right-hander has struck out 211 against just 29 walks, limiting the opposition to a .175 average. Balint, who has been named the MW Pitcher of the Week seven times in 10 tries this season, is ranked among the NCAA and SDSU single-season bests.

In the NCAA, Balint is tied for third in saves (5), ninth in strikeouts (211), 16th in strikeouts per seven innings (10.63), 17th in strikeout-to-walk ratio (7.28), 36th in ERA (1.56) and 38th in hits allowed per seven innings (4.43).

Among the Aztec single-season leaders, Balint currently ranks first in strikeouts per seven innings (10.63), fourth in strikeout-to-wall ratio (7.28) and opponent average (.175), tied for fourth in strikeouts (211) and saves (5), sixth in winning percentage (.722), eighth in WHIP (0.84) and 10th in hits allowed per seven innings (4.43).

Despite only being in her third season with the Aztecs, on the career charts Balint ranks second in strikeouts per seven innings (8.11) and opponent average (.194), third in winning percentage (.679), fourth in saves (9), fifth in WHIP (0.98) and hits allowed per seven innings (4.90), sixth in strikeouts (449) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.08), tied for sixth in solo shutouts (since 1999) (12), and tied for 10th in wins (38) and total shutouts (16).

Highest School Winning Percentage in Play

At 29-12, the Aztecs are threatening to finish with one of the highest winning percentages in program history. The .707 winning percentage is currently the second-highest in school history, trailing a 44-17 season (.721) in 2008. SDSU still has 10 regular-season games to play and possible postseason play.

SDSU Wins the 31st Annual Campbell/Cartier Classic

For the record sixth time in the 31 years of the Campbell/Cartier Classic, San Diego State captured the tournament title from Feb. 17-20.

The Aztecs secured the tourney title for the third straight year after going 4-1, including wins over their final four games (8-0 in five innings over Army West Point on Friday, 7-3 over Army West Point and 11-0 in five innings over Southern Utah on Saturday, and 3-0 over California Baptist on Sunday. SDSU's lone setback was a 6-4 decision on Thursday when it entered the final inning with a 4-1 lead. Following the Aztecs (4-1) were California Baptist (3-1), CSUN (3-2), Southern Utah (1-4) and Army West Point (1-4).

San Diego State's six Campbell/Cartier Classic titles are the most in the history of the tournament. Below is a look at the past win-

Aztecs Excel in Lid-Lifters

San Diego State has excelled in season-opening games since records were first kept in 1980.

Following a 3-1 victory over Middle Tennessee on Feb. 10, the Aztecs improved to 32-11 (.744) in lid-lifters in recorded program history.

SDSU has won nine of its last 10 season openers, 20 of its last 22 and 23 of its last 26.

San Diego State's only blemishes in the past 26 season-openers came in 2018 (lost to No. 25/25 Georgia, 23-2), 2012 (lost to Texas Tech. 5-4) and in 2000 (lost to UIC. 5-3).

Over the last 26 openers, the Aztecs have outscored their opponent, 149-81, or 5.7-3.1 per game in lid-lifters.

SDSU ended up recording back-to-back shutouts over the Toreros on 2021 opening day, the first time it had consecutive shutouts on a opening day since 2008.

Aztecs Picked to Win the Mountain West with UNLV

The San Diego State softball team has been picked to win the Mountain West along with UNLV in a preseason poll voted on by the league's nine head coaches, the conference announced Feb. 3. The Aztecs have won a MW-record seven regular-season titles.

Both the Aztecs and Rebels received 57 points, but UNLV (5) had more first-place votes than SDSU (3). Fresno State had the other first-place vote and is tied with Boise State for third with 43 points, while Nevada was predicted fifth with 42 points. Rounding out the poll was Colorado State (35) in sixth, New Mexico (17) in seventh, and San José State and Utah State tied for eighth with 15 points.

Last year, San Diego State finished with a 28-16 record, its best winning percentage (.636) since the 2015 squad went 38-20 (.655) before falling in the NCAA Los Angeles Regional final to UCLA. It was also the ninth-best record in program history.

Stacey Nuveman Deniz Named Program's Fifth Head Coach

San Diego State's Stacey Nuveman Deniz was named the softball head coach, director of athletics John David Wicker announced on June 8. A three-time U.S. Olympian, Nuveman Deniz is just the fifth head coach in program history after spending the last 13 seasons with the Aztecs as an assistant, associate head coach and head coach in waiting under SDSU's all-time winningest coach Kathy Van Wyk.

"I am humbled and honored to have this opportunity to lead San Diego State Softball into the future," Nuveman Deniz said. "Kathy Van Wyk spent 25 years building this program, and now it is my turn to take the reins and continue that growth. I would like to thank (SDSU director of athletics) John David Wicker for this opportunity and for the unwavering support he has shown me. The University, the city of San Diego and our incredible community have captured my heart and I truly am an Aztec for Life. I can't wait to get started."

Nuveman Deniz, who was hired at San Diego State following her stint with the U.S. team at the 2008 Beijing Olympics, helped SDSU to seven straight NCAA tournaments from 2009-15 and a combined 398-264 (.601) record in her 13 seasons on The Mesa. Over her first nine seasons as an assistant and associate coach, the Aztecs improved their batting average from .275 in 2008 (the year before she arrived) to a school-record .356 mark in 2017, and also in runs per game (3.98 to 6.61), home runs per game (0.23 to 1.09 (0.92 in 2017)), slugging percentage (.348 to .516) and on-base percentage (.347 to .418).

In 2018, Nuveman Deniz was the head coach of the National Pro Fastpitch's Chicago Bandits, leading the team to the NFP Championship season series in her first year. In the spring of 2010, Nuveman Deniz served as an assistant coach for the Women's National Team Selection Camp, at the Canadian Open Fast Pitch Women's International Championship and at the World Cup of Softball VI. She was also named to the USA Softball Coaching Pool in 2014 and was an assistant coach at the USA Softball Junior Women's (19-Under) National

Team (JWNT) Selection Camp in January 2015.

In addition to her two Olympic gold medals (2000 and 2004) and silver medal in 2008, Nuveman Deniz helped the United States National Team to a World Cup championship (2006), two World Championships (2002 and 2006) and two Pan American gold medals (1999 and 2003). Her 2004 Olympic gold medal team, meanwhile, was inducted into the U.S. Olympic hall of fame in July 2012.

Nuveman Deniz was a standout at UCLA, finishing her four-year career with four NCAA records - 90 home runs, .945 slugging percentage, 240 walks and 81 intentional walks. She was a four-time first-team NFCA All-American (1997, 1999, 2001-02) and a three-time Pac-10 Player of the Year (1999, 2001-02). Nuveman Deniz is also ranked first in school history in games played (264), total bases (653) and on-base percentage (.600).

Among the current all-time NCAA leaders, Nuveman Deniz ranks first in home runs per game (0.34), total bases (653) and intentional walks (81), second in slugging percentage (.945), third in home runs (90) and walks (240), fifth in RBIs (299), seventh in batting average (.466).

In 1999, Nuveman Deniz led the Bruins to a national championship, batting .446 during the season with 31 home runs and 91 RBIs. For her efforts in the national title run, Nuveman was named to the all-Women's College World Series team. Nuveman Deniz was inducted into UCLA's hall of fame in October 2012.

Nuveman Deniz graduated from UCLA in 2002 with a degree in sociology and public policy and later earned her master's in kinesiology from Texas Women's University in 2012.

Canadian Olympian Victoria Hayward Named Assistant Coach

Victoria Hayward was named an assistant coach for the San Diego State softball team, head coach Stacey Nuveman Deniz announced Aug. 26, 2021. Hayward recently represented Canada at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics and has been a member of the Canadian Senior National Team since 2009.

Hayward has nine years of experience in the college ranks, most recently serving as the director of operations at UCF in 2019 and as an assistant coach at Maryland in 2018.

Prior to Maryland, Hayward helped guide UMass to back-to-back winning seasons in 2016 and 2017. UMass was one of the top hitting teams in the Atlantic 10 in 2017, finished second in regular-season standings and advanced to the A10 title game. At UMass, Hayward helped nine batters/position players earn all-conference honors and three Minutewomen hitters garnered NFCA All-Region selections during her tenure.

Hayward spent the 2015 season as a graduate assistant at LSU under head coach Beth Torina. The Tigers opened the year with 25 consecutive victories and spent three weeks as the top-ranked team in the country, before ending the season with a 52-14 record and a third-place finish at the Women's College World Series (WCWS). LSU's coaching staff was named the Division I South Region Staff of the Year by the National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA).

As a player, Hayward made the Canadian squad in 2009 at 16 years old, becoming the youngest player ever to join the senior team. Hayward has been a mainstay in the outfield and has won numerous medals in international competition. She was the 19th overall selection in the 2014 National Pro Fastpitch Draft by the Pennsylvania Rebellion.

In college, Hayward starred at national power Washington, helping the Huskies to four NCAA tournaments. Hayward was a 2014 All-American, a four-time all-Pac-12 selection and a three-time Academic All-Pac-12 honoree (2011-14). UW won four NCAA Regional Championships during her career and advanced to the Women's College World Series in 2013. She finished her Washington career ranked seventh in runs (176), 10th in triples (7) and 12th in average (.351), while stealing a league-best 28 bases as a senior without committing an error.

SDSU Adds Former UCLA Star and U.S. Olympian Rachel Garcia to Staff

Rachel Garcia, one of the most decorated players in NCAA softball history, has joined San Diego State as a volunteer assistant coach, head coach Stacey Nuveman Deniz announced Jan. 7.

Garcia, who most recently helped the United States to a silver medal at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics in the summer, garnered numerous accolades during her time at UCLA, including twice being named the Collegiate Woman Athlete of the Year (Honda Cup) for all sports (2019 and 2021) and three times the Honda Sports Award for softball (2018, 2019 and 2021). Garcia also won the Senior CLASS Award in 2021.

Garcia, who redshirted in 2020 while playing for Team USA on its Stand Beside Her Tour, also has been chosen twice as the USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year (2018-19), and once each as the NFCA National Pitcher of the Year (2019) and the NFCA National Player of the Year (2018). Garcia was also the 2017 NFCA National Freshman of the Year.

In the circle, Garcia was 99-17 with a 1.43 ERA with 11 saves for her career with the Bruins, striking out 996 against 172 walks in 749 innings. Garcia tossed 28 shutouts and 66 complete games, while limiting the opposition to a .172 batting average. Her 2019 NFCA pitcher-of-the-year season featured a 29-1 record with a 1.14 ERA and seven shutouts in 202 innings, striking out 286 as UCLA captured the NCAA title.

At the plate, Garcia hit .337 for her career with 43 home runs, 175 RBIs, 103 runs and 32 doubles, while owning a .594 slugging percentage and a .430 on-base mark. When she was named the NFCA Player of the Year in 2018, Garcia hit .339 with 11 home runs and 54 RBIs in 61 games.

Garcia is also a four-time NFCA All-American (first team in 2018, 2019 and 2021, second team in 2017), four-time NFCA All-Region selection (2017, 2018, 2019 and 2021), three-time Pac-12 Player of the Year (2018, 2019 and 2021), 2019 Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year, 2017 Pac-12 Freshman of the Year and four-time all-Pac-12 selection (2017, 2018, 2019 and 2021).

Throughout her career, Garcia was a multi-time national player of the week (three times by USA Softball and twice by NFCA) and a two-time NFCA national player of the week. Additionally, Garcia was an 11-time Pac-12 Pitcher of the Week and a four-time Pac-12 Player of the Week.

Garcia has been with the USA National Team since 2018, helping the squad wind the gold medal at the 2018 WBSC Women's World Championship, and the 2019 USA Softball International Cup, Pan American Games and Japan Cup, before settling for a silver medal at Tokyo last summer.

San Diego State Releases 2022 Schedule

San Diego State softball head coach Stacey Nuveman Deniz has announced a 52-game schedule for the 2022 season, highlighted by three home tournaments, including the 31st annual Campbell/Cartier Classic.

The Aztecs, who have won a league-best seven Mountain West titles, are scheduled to play 12 games against teams that made last year's NCAA tournament and five conference champions.

SDSU begins its season at home for the first time since 2007 when it plays host to the SDSU Season Kickoff from Feb. 10-13. San Diego State opens with Middle Tennessee on Thursday, followed by games against 2021 NCAA tournament teams UIC (Horizon League champion) and Stanford on Friday, UIC once again on Saturday and Cal Poly on Sunday.

The Aztecs continue their 11-game homestand to open the season on Feb. 16 vs. San Diego.

SDSU then plays host to the 31st annual Campbell/Cartier Classic from Feb. 17-20. San Diego State will meet CSUN on Thursday, Army West Point on Friday, Army West Point and Southern Utah on Saturday, and California Baptist on Sunday.

The Aztecs then head to the always competitive Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic from Feb 24-26, which will take place at Big League Dreams Park in the Palm Springs area in Cathedral City, California. SDSU is slated to play three teams that made the NCAA tournament a year ago, including Northwestern and Washington on Saturday, and Missouri on Sunday. San Diego State opens the weekend with Friday night agmes against Cal State Fullerton and UC Davis.

The Aztecs return to America's Finest City to host the San Diego Classic from March 3-6 along with USD and UC San Diego. SDSU will take on three conference champions and NCAA tournament qualifiers in Brigham Young (Thursday), Boston Univ. (Friday) and Long Beach State (Saturday), along with California (Friday), Yale (Saturday) and Stony Brook (Sunday).

San Diego State wraps up its regular-season tournament play from March 10-13 at the Torero Classic, hosted by San Diego. The Aztecs are scheduled for games against the Toreros on Thursday, Valparaiso and Weber State on Friday, Weber State again on Saturday and CSUN for a second time this season on Sunday.

SDSU kicks off Mountain West play at home against Colorado State on March 19-20 before traveling to Fresno State for a series from

San Diego State follows with a home series against Nevada from April 1-3 and then a road trip to UNLV from April 8-10.

Next up for the Aztecs is a weekend home series with Boise State from April 14-16 and its final non-conference game of the season on April 20 at UC San Diego.

SDSU finishes the MW regular season with a road series at San José State from April 29-May 1, a home series with Utah State from May 6-8 and a road series at New Mexico from May 12-14.

The NCAA Regional kicks off postseason play from May 19-22 at 16 campus sites.
