### SDSU Kicks Off 2018 Campaign at Arizona State's Kajikawa Classic

The San Diego State softball team begins its 2018 season with six games this weekend at Arizona State's Kajikawa Classic in Tempe, Ariz.

The Aztecs begin the tournament with a pair of games on Thursday against No. 25/25 Georgia (11:30 a.m. MT) and Stanford (7:15 p.m. MT), followed by another doubleheader on Friday vs. Western Michigan (5:15 p.m. MT) and Northwestern (7:30 p.m. MT). SDSU finishes out the weekend with single games against Nebraska (2 p.m. MT Saturday) and UC Davis (2 p.m. PT Sunday).

San Diego State has historically played well in season-opening games under 22nd-year head coach Kathy Van Wyk. The Aztecs have won five straight season-opening games, 16 of their last 17 season-openers and 19 of the 21 lid-lifters in head coach Kathy Van Wyk's 21-year tenure. Since records were first kept in 1980, the Aztecs are 28-10 (.737) in their opening games.

SDSU is coming off a 31-18 overall record in 2017 - its 12th consecutive 30-win season - and a 15-9 mark and runner-up finish in MW play. San Diego State led the country last year with a .356 average, shattering its previous best of .310. In all, the Aztecs set seven school records, including batting average, on-base percentage (.418), slugging percentage (.516), hits (497), RBIs (295), sacrifice flies (23) and runs (324, tied).

SDSU has been picked to win the Mountain West this year and is receiving 12 votes in the preseason USA Today/NFCA Top 25 poll, which is tied for the 35th most with Notre Dame.

**KATHY VAN WYK**  
HEAD COACH | 22ND SEASON | CS FULLERTON, 1983

- As a player, Van Wyk earned All-America honors and won the Broderick Award, given to the best player in the nation, in 1982 after going 35-1 with a 0.18 ERA. The victories remain a school single-season record and .972 winning percentage was an NCAA Division I record until 2001. Her phenomenal season included four no-hitters, six one-hitters, back-to-back perfect games, 26 shutouts and 270 strikeouts.
- Is the school's all-time winningest coach with 716 career victories, including a program-best 44 wins in 2008
- Earned her fifth Mountain West Coach of the Year award in 2014 after leading the Aztecs to a 16-8 mark in league play. She also won the award in 2002, 2006, 2008 and 2013.
- Has led SDSU to 11 NCAA tournament appearances (2001, 2003, 2006, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2015)
- Guided San Diego State to its seventh MW regular season title in 2014 with a 16-8 record. The team's other championships came in 2002, 2003, 2006, 2008, 2012 and 2013.
- Coached her eighth All-American in 2017 when Jenavee Peres was named a second-team NFCA All-American. Peres became the Aztecs' first-ever second-team NFCA All-American (SDSU's three other NFCA All-Americans were on the third team).
- Has coached 77 all-conference selections, 39 NFCA all-West Region selections, nine MW Pitchers of the Year, nine MW Freshmen of the Year, four MW Players of the Year and 132 conference player/pitcher of the week winners

**This Weekend's Information**

The Aztecs kick off their 2018 campaign this weekend at the Kajikawa Classic in Tempe, Ariz. This season's classic features 76 games to be played on five separate fields, and includes 28 total teams.

Arizona State has hosted this even since 1966. From 1966-1990, it was named the 'Sun Devil Invitational', which found its name changed in 1991 to the Coca-Cola Classic. It remained that until 1999 when the name changed yet again to the 'Fiesta Bowl Tournament.' Six years later in 2005, the name was changed one final time to the 'Kajikawa Classic', after "Mr. Sun Devil" himself, Bill Kajikawa, a legendary coach and founder of Sun Devil athletics.

SDSU is playing in this tournament for the first time since 2014, when it went 4-1 in the tourney. San Diego State has appeared in the Kajikawa Classic four times since 2010, registering a 15-7 (.682) record, including the 4-1 mark in 2014, 3-2 in 2013, 3-3 in 2012 and 5-1 in 2010.

San Diego State kicks off the 2018 slate on Thursday (Feb. 8) with games against No. 25/25 Georgia (11:30 a.m. MT) and Stanford (7:15 p.m. MT), followed by another doubleheader on Friday (Feb. 9) with games vs. Western Michigan (5:15 p.m. MT) and Northwestern (7:30 p.m. MT), and single games against Nebraska (Saturday, Feb. 10 at 2 p.m. MT) and UC Davis (Sunday, Feb. 11 at 2 p.m. PT).

with 57 points and the other two first-place votes, while Fresno State (44), Utah State (43) and Nevada (37) rounded out the top five. Colorado State (30) is slated to come in sixth, and Boise State (27), UNLV (14) and New Mexico (9) are pegged to finish seventh, eighth and ninth, respectively.

The Aztecs are coming off a 31-18 overall record in 2017 - their 12th consecutive 30-win season - and a 15-9 mark and runner-up finish in MW play. SDSU, however, did not receive an at-large bid into the NCAA tournament, despite finishing second in the sixth-best conference in the nation (out of 32 leagues).

San Diego State led the country last year with a .356 average, shattering their previous best of .310. In all, the Aztecs set seven school records, including batting average, on-base percentage (.418), slugging percentage (.516), hits (497), RBI's (295), sacrifice flies (23) and runs (324, tied).

**SDSU Receiving Votes in USA Today/NFCA Preseason Poll**

San Diego State is receiving votes in the USA Today/NFCA Division I Top 25 Coaches Poll, which was released Jan. 30. The Aztecs totaled 12 points, tied with Notre Dame for the 35th-most points in the preseason poll.

Defending national champion Oklahoma is ranked first with 799 points and 31 of the 32 first-place votes, while Florida picked up the other first-place vote with 762 points. Oregon came in third with 719 points, and Washington (674) and UCLA (48-15) rounded out the top five.

SDSU is 59 points away from the top 25 and No. 25 Georgia (71). Texas State leads the receiving votes group with 35 points, followed by California (30), South Carolina (29), Marshall (17), Mississippi State (17), Missouri (15), Florida International (14), North Dakota State (14), Illinois (13), San Diego State (12), Notre Dame (12), Ohio State (9), St. Francis (Pa.) (7), North Carolina (4), Arkansas (2), McNeese State (2), Wisconsin (2), Cal State Fullerton (1), Fresno State (1), Louisiana Tech (1), Texas (1) and USC Upstate (1).

The poll is voted on by 32 NCAA Division I head coaches, one representing each conference.

The Aztecs are scheduled to play four teams that are ranked in the USA Today/NFCA Division poll, including No. 5 UCLA, No. 16 Minnesota, No. 17 Kentucky and No. 25 Georgia. Other SDSU opponents on docket who are receiving votes are Cal State Fullerton, Fresno State, North Dakota State, Notre Dame and Ohio State.

San Diego State, however, did not receive any votes in the ESPN/USA Softball poll.

**Aztecs Excel in Lid-Lifters**

San Diego State has excelled in season-opening games since Kathy Van Wyk took over the reigns of the program in 1997.

With a 7-1 win over South Dakota last year, the Aztecs have won five straight season-opening games, 16 of their last 17 season-openers and 19 of the 21 lid-lifters in head coach Kathy Van Wyk's 21-year tenure.

SDSU's only blemishes in the past 21 season-openers under Van Wyk came in 2012 (lost to Texas Tech, 5-4) and in 2000 (lost to Illinois-Chicago, 5-3).

Over the 21 years under Van Wyk, San Diego State has outscored its opponent, 122-47, or 5.80-2.23 per game in lid-lifters.

Since records were first kept in 1980, the Aztecs are 28-10 (.737) in their opening games.

**Aztec Softball to Have 15 Games Broadcast on Mountain West Network**

The San Diego State softball team will have at least 15 games on the Mountain West Network this season.

### San Diego State Receives NCAA Plaque for Highest 2017 Batting Average

The San Diego State softball team received a plaque from the NCAA last September for leading the country in batting average during the 2017 season.

The Aztecs hit a remarkable .356 for the 2017 campaign, easily outdistancing runner-up James Madison at .347. Minnesota (.342), Arizona (.341) and Georgia (.338) rounded out the top five.

SDSU's .356 average shattered its previous best of .310, which was set in 2015. In all, San Diego State set seven school records, including batting average, on-base percentage (.418), slugging percentage (.516), hits (497), RBIs (295), sacrifice flies (23) and runs (324, tied).

Jenavee Peres (Garden Grove, Calif.) led the way last year for San Diego State, easily breaking the previous school record batting average of a .429 batting average with her .454 and tied a SDSU best with five sac flies. She also ranked second in school single-season history in slugging percentage, RBIs and OPS percentage (1.332), third in runs and total bases, fourth in on-base percentage, tied for fourth in extra-base hits (29), fifth in hits and home runs, and tied for seventh in times hit by pitch (5).

Peres was named a NFCA Second-Team All-American for her efforts, the first time San Diego State has ever had a player on the second team (Aztecs' previous three NFCA All-America selections were third-team picks). She was also a first-team all-NFCA West Region honoree, the Mountain West Player of the Year and a first-team all-MW selection.

Joining Peres on the all-conference first team last year was Sydnee Cable (Huntington Beach, Calif.), Zaria Meshack (Vallejo, Calif.), Molly Sturdivant (Santa Ana, Calif.) and Shelby Thompson (Benicia, Calif.), who was also the MW Freshman of the Year, while Katie Byrd (Santee, Calif./West Hills HS) earned second-team all-MW accolades. Byrd, Meshack, Meshack and Taylor Stewart (Bellflower, Calif.) also earned second-team all-NFCA West Region accolades, while Cable was a third-team selection.

Byrd batted .361 with three home runs, 35 RBIs, 42 runs, 16 doubles, a .519 slugging percentage and a .428 on-base percentage, and Sturdivant batted .381 on the season with eight home runs, 45 RBIs, 25 runs, 14 doubles and 30 walks, while registering a .664 slugging percentage and a .482 on-base mark. Meshack finished the 2017 campaign with a .415 average, 34 runs, 61 hits, a .459 on-base percentage and seven stolen bases, while Stewart batted .340 with two homers, 14 RBIs, 12 runs, seven doubles and 19 walks, while posting a .462 slugging percentage and a .430 on-base mark. Thompson hit .333 with seven home runs, 31 RBIs, 26 runs, five doubles, two triples, 20 walks and six stolen bases, while posting a .556 slugging percentage and a .434 on-base percentage, and Cable batted .371 with six homers, 43 RBIs, 23 runs, eight doubles and nine walks.

### SDSU Softball Announces 2018 Schedule

San Diego State softball head coach Kathy Van Wyk has announced a 52-game schedule for the 2018 season, highlighted by two home tournaments, including the 28th annual Campbell/Cartier Classic at SDSU Softball Stadium from Feb. 15-18.

The Aztecs, who have won a league-best seven Mountain West titles in the 18-year history of the conference, are scheduled to play 17 contests against teams that made last year's NCAA tournament.

On the docket for San Diego State in 2018 is a game against a 2017 Women's College World Series qualifier (UCLA), four against teams that finished among the top 25 in the NCAA RPI (Georgia, Kentucky, Minnesota and UCLA), 11 games against the top 50 and 35 games versus the top 100.

The Aztecs begin their season on the road for the 11th straight year, playing at the Kajikawa Classic in Tempe, Ariz., from Feb. 8-11. SDSU kicks off the 2018 slate on Thursday, Feb. 8 with games against Georgia (NCAA tournament qualifier) and Stanford, followed by another doubleheader on Friday, Feb. 9 with games vs. Western Michigan and Northwestern, and single games against Nebraska (Saturday, Feb. 10) and UC Davis (Sunday, Feb. 11).

Following a mid-week road matchup at UC Riverside on Wednesday, Feb. 14, San Diego State opens the home portion of its schedule with the 28th annual Campbell/Cartier Classic from Feb. 15-18. All four of the Aztec opponents in the Classic made last year's NCAA tournament, including NCAA regional qualifier Kentucky (Thursday, Feb. 15), North Dakota State and UIC on Friday, Feb. 16, and Cal State Fullerton (Sunday, Feb. 18).

SDSU then takes its talents to the always competitive Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic in Cathedral City, Calif. (near Palm Springs) from Feb. 22-25. San Diego State is scheduled to play Liberty on Thursday, Feb. 22, Northwestern (again) and Notre Dame (NCAA tournament qualifier) on Friday, Feb. 23, Bethune-Cookman on Saturday, Feb. 24 and UC Davis again on Sunday, Feb. 25.

The Aztecs return to America's Finest City the following weekend (March 1-4) for the San Diego Classic I, which they co-host with Univ. of San Diego. On the slate for SDSU are UCF on Thursday, March 1, NCAA tourney team and No. 13 in the final RPI Minnesota and CSUN on Friday, March 2, Boston Univ. on Saturday, March 3 and UCLA (No. 2 in the final RPI) on Sunday, March 4.

San Diego State makes the short drive north for the Louisville Slugger Classic from March 9-11, co-hosted by Cal State Fullerton and Long Beach State. The Aztecs are scheduled to play Ohio State (NCAA tourney qualifier) and Boston Univ. (second time in six days) on Friday, March 9 in Fullerton, Michigan State and Long Beach State on Saturday, March 10 in Long Beach, and Sunday, March 11 in Fullerton again against Cal State Fullerton for the second time of the season.

SDSU continues its season-long nine-game road trip with a midweek matchup against Fairfield (NCAA tournament qualifier) on Wednesday, March 14 at USD Softball Complex in San Diego.

San Diego State kicks off the 2018 MW schedule with a weekend series at San José State from March 16-18, followed by a home non-conference meeting with San Diego on March 27.

The rest of the season are MW matchups for the Aztecs, including weekend series against Boise State (March 29-31), at UNLV (April

**Kathy Van Wyk Named to Cal State Fullerton Hall of Fame Class**

San Diego State softball head coach Kathy Van Wyk was announced as an inductee to Cal State Fullerton's 2017 Hall of Fame class. One of seven inductees to the school's seventh class, Van Wyk was honored on Oct. 27 at the Embassy Suites in Brea, Calif.

Van Wyk made the most out of her one season at CSUF in 1982, going 35-1 with a 0.18 ERA in the circle en route to winning the Broderick Award, given out annually to the nation's best player. Her .972 winning percentage was an NCAA Division I record (30 or more decisions) until 2001 when Jennie Finch of Arizona went 32-0. Her 33-game winning streak during the season remains a NCAA record, while her 0.18 ERA still ranks as the eighth-lowest mark in NCAA history. Her phenomenal season included four no-hitters, six one-hitters, back-to-back perfect games, 26 shutouts (tied for the ninth most in NCAA history) and 270 strikeouts.

Van Wyk began her collegiate player career at Texas Women's University, where she garnered 1979 Texas AIAW Player-of-the-Year accolades and later inducted into the TWU Hall of Fame. She transferred to Cal State Fullerton after TWU dropped its softball program.

Van Wyk recently finished up her 21st season as the Aztec head coach. The all-time winningest coach in school history (716 wins), Van Wyk has been named the Mountain West Coach of the Year five times and has led SDSU to 11 NCAA tournament appearances and seven MW regular-season titles.

Van Wyk has coached eight All-America selections, including Jenavee Peres (second-team NFCA All-American) last year. She has also coached 74 all-conference selections, 39 NFCA all-West Region picks, nine MW Pitchers of the Year, nine MW Freshmen of the Year, four MW Players of the Year and 132 conference player/pitcher of the week winners.

Prior to San Diego State, Van Wyk spent 10 seasons as a player and an assistant coach at Cal State Fullerton. She was an assistant coach from 1983-87, helping the Titans to the 1986 NCAA national title.

Van Wyk also has playing stints at the Italian Azzanase club, and with the U.S. softball team in 1985 and 1989, and was a five-time Amateur Softball Association All-American. Additionally, she has coaching stints with the Rod Carew Baseball School, Azzanase (Italy), Walkerville Softball Club (Australia) and the Dutch National Team.

**Stacey Nuvevan Deniz Named Head Coach of Chicago Bandits**

San Diego State softball associate head coach Stacey Nuvevan Deniz was recently named the head coach of the Chicago Bandits, general manager Toni Calmeyn announced.

Nuvevan Deniz will lead the Bandits, who have won four National Pro Fastpitch titles (2008, 2011, 2015-16), for their season, which runs from June through August, while maintaining her coaching duties with the Aztecs.

Nuvevan Deniz enters her 10th season at SDSU, serving as the recruiting coordinator and the hitting instructor. Nuvevan Deniz was promoted to assistant head coach from an assistant coach in 2010 and was moved to associate head coach in 2013.

In addition to her two Olympic gold medals (2000 and 2004) and silver medal in 2008, Nuvevan Deniz has helped the United States National Team to a World Cup championship (2006), two World Championships (2002 and 2006) and two Pan American gold medals (1999 and 2003).

Most recently, her 2004 Olympic gold medal team was inducted into the U.S. Olympic hall of fame in July 2012, while Nuvevan Deniz was inducted into the UCLA hall of fame in October 2012.

In the spring of 2010, Nuvevan Deniz served as an assistant coach for the Women's National Team Selection Camp, at the Canadian Open Fast Pitch Women's International Championship and at the World Cup of Softball VI. She was also named to the USA Softball Coaching Pool in 2014 and was an assistant coach at the USA Softball Junior Women's (19-Under) National Team (JWNT) Selection Camp in January 2015.

Nuvevan Deniz helped SDSU to seven straight NCAA Regional bids from 2009-15 and a combined 308-180 (.631) record in her nine seasons on The Mesa. Over her nine seasons as an assistant and associate coach, the Aztecs have improved their batting average from .275 in 2008 (the year before she arrived) to a school-record and NCAA-leading .356 last year. In all, San Diego State set seven school records a year ago, including batting average, on-base percentage (.418), slugging percentage (.516), hits (497), RBIs (295), sacrifice flies (23) and runs (324, tied).

**Three Softball Players Named NFCA All-America Scholar-Athletes**

Current San Diego State senior Alex Formby, and SDSU graduates Ashley Ercolano and Frankie Orlando earned NFCA All-America Scholar-Athlete honors for the 2016-17 academic year, the National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA) recently announced. To be considered for the award, the student-athletes must have earned a 3.5 grade-point average or higher for the academic year.

Formby has spent the last two years with the Aztecs after transferring from Virginia for the 2016 campaign. The right-handed pitcher has one 18-14 with a 4.01 ERA and 10 saves over her two seasons with SDSU, starting 20 times and appearing in 65 games. She has pitched 193 2/3 innings, striking out 127. Heading into her final campaign, Formby ranks third all-time at San Diego State in saves (10) and 10th in win percentage (.563).

Last season, Formby went 7-4 with a 4.55 ERA and a team-high five saves, striking out 44 against 28 walks in 77 innings. In 2016, she was 11-10 with a 3.66 ERA and five saves over 116 2/3 innings, striking out 83 against 57 walks, while being named a second-team

all-Mountain West pick. She's also two-time MW Scholar-Athlete and a two-time MW Spring All-Academic Team selection. Formby currently has a 3.66 cumulative GPA and is majoring in communication.

Ercolano spent the last three years of her softball career at San Diego State after transferring from UC Riverside for the 2015 season. After redshirting 2015, she played in 38 games with 13 starts in the following seasons. Ercolano batted .205 with a home run, eight RBIs, five runs and three walks in her last year as an Aztec. Over her four-year career, she batted .259 with 13 homers, 56 RBIs and 37 runs, while going 12-16 with a 5.03 ERA on the mound in 213 innings. Ercolano played in 12 games last season, including the final home game when she helped SDSU beat UNLV with a grand slam.

Ercolano was a MW Scholar-Athlete and a member of the MW Spring All-Academic Team in 2016. She majored in psychology and has cumulative 3.68 grade-point average for the 2016-17 academic year.

Orlando played in 143 games over her career with 101 starts, mostly at catcher, and posted a .251 average with 43 RBIs, 18 doubles and 25 runs. She had just 10 errors in 469 chances in her four seasons with the team. Orlando appears four times in the SDSU record books, including a .983 fielding percentage as a freshman, the fifth-best by an Aztec rookie in school history.

Last season Orlando played in 35 games with 22 starts, recording career highs with a .321 batting average, a .359 slugging percentage and a .354 on-base percentage, while committing just one error in 45 chances on the field. Academically, Orlando is a three-time MW Scholar-Athlete and a three-time MW Spring All-Academic Team member. She majored in criminal justice and graduated with a 3.81 GPA for the 2016-17 academic year.

### Softball Signs Five to National Letters of Intent

San Diego State softball head coach Kathy Van Wyk has announced Nov. 13 the signing of five student-athletes to National Letters of Intent. The five California products join a program that has won a Mountain West-best seven regular-season championships in the 18-year history of the league.

"I'm so excited for our 2018 signing class," Van Wyk said. "We once again have five-tool student-athletes who are going to challenge our returners for playing time and make our program better. I expect each of them to make an immediate impact once they arrive to San Diego State."

Maddison Ayers (Elk Grove, Calif./Sheldon High) has earned four letters so far at Sheldon High School as a shortstop. A two-time second-team all-Delta League selection, Ayers helped the Huskies to three straight section titles and back-to-back league championships. A scholar-athlete all four seasons so far, Ayers recently led SHS to a No. 11 ranking in the nation and No. 4 mark in California. According to MaxPreps, Ayers has compiled a .310 batting average over her career with seven home runs, 23 doubles, 49 runs and 46 RBIs, while drawing 22 walks. She plays her club ball with All-American Sports Academy in Brentwood, Calif., and plans to major in kinesiology when she gets to SDSU.

Paige Barth (Newbury Park, Calif./Newbury Park High), meanwhile, plays multiple positions at Newbury Park High School. A four-year letterwinner, Barth has led the Panthers to a 44-13-1 record (.767) over the past two seasons. Barth is coming off a 2017 season where she hit .438 with four homers, eight doubles, 32 runs, 27 RBIs and nine stolen bases (according to MaxPreps). Over her career so far, Barth is batting .336 with six home runs, 15 doubles, five triples, 60 runs and 49 RBIs.

Jessica Cordola (Santa Clarita Valley, Calif./Saugus High) comes to The Mesa out of Saugus High School where she has earned four letters. A corner infielder, Cordola is coming off a 2017 season where she was named an all-Santa Clarita Valley second-team selection and a first-team all-Foothill League pick for a second consecutive year. Cordola, who led the Centurions to a co-Foothill League title last year, also plays her club ball for Team Easton in Tustin, Calif. She plans to major in business at San Diego State.

Kylie Fraser (Redondo Beach, Calif./Redondo Union High) will be expected to play catcher and at the corner infielder spots with the Aztecs. A four-year member at Redondo Union High School, Fraser brings a wealth of accolades to SDSU, including as second-team all-area selection (2017) and a three-time all-Bay League honoree with the past year on the first team. Fraser has led the Sea Hawks to the 2016 CIF championship game, and consecutive Bay League titles (2015-16). A scholar-athlete, Fraser has also been a two-year captain. She plays her club ball with the Ohana Tigers in Cerritos, Calif., and is intending to major in environmental science at San Diego State.

Paris Nguyen (Lake Elsinore, Calif./Temescal Canyon High), the final member of the Aztecs' 2017 signing class, played multiple positions at Temescal Canyon High School in nearby Lake Elsinore, Calif. Nguyen was an all-Sunbelt League selection last year as well as an academic all-league honoree. She was also an all-valley athlete, an all-inland second-team pick and an all-Southwestern League honoree in 2016. Nguyen played the beginning of her high school career at Murrieta Mesa HS, batting .348 with three home runs, nine doubles, three triples, 31 runs and 35 RBIs from 2015-16 (according to MaxPreps). A multiple time scholar-athlete, Nguyen plays her club ball for Jets Gold and plans to major in business at SDSU.
