Big Notes

- San Diego State is at least 4-1 on the season for the 10th time in the last 12 campaigns.
- San Diego State's neutral site game record is 14-6 since the start of the 2019-20 season.
- In Maui Invitational play, San Diego State stands at 6-5 in its 11 games in the event.
- San Diego State shot a season-low 38.1 percent and tied for the lowest shooting percentage in a game since Feb. 15, 2003 against Utah.
- San Diego State is 20-8 in the Dutcher era and has won 52 of its last 66 games on Tuesday.
- San Diego State lost for just the third time in the last 51 games in which it attempted more free throws than its opponent.
- San Diego State moves to 2-2 in its four semifinal games in the Maui Jim Maui Invitational.

Series Notes

• San Diego State 7-25 in the series against Arizona and has come out on the short end of the last five versus the Wildcats, including a 61-59 loss in the championship game of the 2014 Maui Invitational, the last time the teams met.

Team Notes

- Nathan Mensah won the opening tip and sent it to Darrion Trammell.
- Matt Bradley hit the team's first bucket, a 2-pointer, with 18:02 to play in the first half.
- San Diego State used a 10-2 run in the final 2:16 of half one to close a 35-23 deficit to 37-33. Darrion Trammell led the spurt with five points, including a 3-pointer with two seconds left before intermission.
- San Diego State opened the second half on an 8-3 run to take its first lead in the game 41-40 with 17:20 to play.
- Nathan Mensah has a block for the 14th time in the last 15 games.
- San Diego State is 63-16 in November since the beginning of the beginning of the 2010-11 campaign.

- SDSU outscored Arizona:
 - 23-14 off turnovers
 - 13-10 in second chance points
 - 18-8 on fast break attempts
 - 23-12 off the bench

Player Notes

Darrion Trammell – 21 points, 6-of-16 FG, 1-of-7 3FG, 8-of-9 FT, 2 rebounds, 2 assists, 3 steals

Matched his season-high with 21 points... Scored in double figures for the third time this season and the 52nd time in his career and surpassed 20 points for the second time as an Aztec and 24th time as a college player... Recorded season-bests with eight free throws and nine attempts... His 16 field goal attempts and seven 3-point attempts are a season-highs... Led the Aztecs in scoring for the second time this season and in assists for the fourth time.

Micah Parrish – 10 points, 4-of-7 FG, 2-of-5 3FG, 4 rebounds, 1steal

Scored in double figures for the second consecutive game as an Aztec and 35th time of his college career... In two games in the Maui Invitational, he is 10-of-15 (66.7 percent) from the floor & 5-of-10 (50.0 percent) from the bonus distance.

Nathan Mensah – 9 points, 3-of-3 FG, 3-of-4 FT, 7 rebounds, 2 steals, 1 block

Is the fifth Aztec to have a perfect shooting night, minimum 3 field goal attempts, grab seven rebounds, have two steals and a blocked shot since the start of the 1996-97 season, and is the first to do it against a ranked team.
