- The Aztecs have won at least 20 games in four straight seasons and in six of the last eight campaigns under Fisher.
- San Diego State has advanced to postseason play each of the last four seasons (2006 NCAA, 2007 NIT, 2008 NIT, 2009 NIT).

 • - SDSU has won 36 of the last 39 dating back to the 2006-07 season when scoring at least 70 points.
