

LET THE SEASON BEGIN

- ◆ San Diego State will begin its 2011 volleyball season on Friday, Aug. 26, when it hosts UC Irvine as part of the Aztec Invitational presented by the DoubleTree Mission Valley. That match gets underway at 7:00 p.m. in Peterson Gym.
- ◆ The other tourney participants, Nevada and Portland, will square off in the Invitational opener at 5:00 p.m.
- ◆ On Saturday (Aug. 27), SDSU will play Portland at noon and conclude tourney play at 7:00 p.m. that night against Nevada.
- ◆ The complete tourney schedule is as follows:

SERIES RECORDS

- ◆ San Diego State's record against UC Irvine stands at 14-6 since the teams first squared off during the 1976 season. Last year the Anteaters took a five-set decision from the Aztecs at the Verizon Wireless Volleyball Challenge in Honolulu. The Aztecs are 10-3 all-time vs. the Anteaters in Peterson Gym, but UC Irvine has won the last two matches on SDU's home floor (2002 and 2008).
- ◆ San Diego State will be playing its first-ever volleyball matches against both Portland and Nevada.

HEAD COACH DEITRE COLLINS-PARKER

- ◆ San Diego State head coach Deitre Collins-Parker enters her third season with the Aztecs after being named the fourth head coach in program history prior to the 2009 campaign. Her two-year record at SDSU is 30-31.
- ◆ She previously served as head coach at UNLV for eight seasons (1996-2003) and at Cornell for five years (2004-2008). Her 15-year career record stands at 192-222 (.464).
- ◆ A three-time All-American as a player at the University of Hawai'i, she led the Rainbow Wahine to consecutive national titles (1983-84) and was named the national player of the year twice.
- ◆ She was a member of the U.S. Olympic Team and competed at the Goodwill Games and Pan Am Games prior to playing professionally in Europe for four years
- ◆ She is one of six players named to the NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball 25th Anniversary Team in October 2005 and was inducted into the AVCA Hall of Fame in the fall of 2008.

SCOUTING THE OPPosition

- ◆ UC Irvine returns four starters plus the libero from a team that finished the 2011 season with a record of 8-22 (3-13 Big West). Top veteran players include middle blocker Alexandra Hauser (1.13 kills/set, 0.75 blocks/set) and setter Marissa Alvarez (6.41 assists/set). Returning libero Kristin Winkler (4.20 digs/set) was an all-Big West selection last season. UCI's 2011 recruiting class received High Honorable Mention honors from *PrepVolleyball.com* for the third straight season.
- ◆ Portland is coming off a 12-18 campaign that saw it finish sixth in the West Coast Conference (5-9). The Pilots return five starters from that squad, losing their setter and libero. Top returnees include outside hitters Kati Hronek (3.04 kills, 0.66 blocks per set) and Ariel Usher (2.87 kills, 1.46 digs per set). Both were all-West Coast Conference honorable mention honorees in 2010. Also back is the team's leading blocker in Marissa Plummer (0.83 blocks per set).
- ◆ Nevada finished its 2010 season with an overall mark of 13-17 (7-9 in the Western Athletic Conference). Four starters return led by outside hitters Erin Garvey (2.09 kills, 0.47 digs per set) and Grace Anxo (2.09 kills, 1.65 digs per set). Also back are middle blocker Janelle Batista (0.83 blocks per set) and setter Tatiana Santiago (10.38 assists per set). Anxo was named to the Freshman all-WAC team last season.

NEW COACH ADDED

- ◆ Former Aztec player Melanie Greene has been named the Aztecs' new assistant coach for the 2011 season. She replaces Andrea Leonard, who took the head coaching position at Cal State San Marcos.
- ◆ A three-year starter as an outside hitter, she averaged 3.46 kills and 2.73 digs per

set while leading the team in kills and finishing among the top three in digs each season.

- ◆ During her senior season as team co-captain and MVP, Greene ranked fourth in the Mountain West in kill average (3.68 per game), recorded 12 double-doubles (kills-digs) and concluded her career ranked 13th in that category.
- ◆ Greene graduated from San Diego State in 2007 with a bachelor's degree in recreation administration. She completed her master's degree in leadership and organizational studies at Azusa Pacific in 2010.

FOR OPENERS

- ◆ San Diego State's record in season openers stands at 18-17 since the sport began at SDSU in 1976.
- ◆ This will mark the Aztecs' 12th season opener at home in the past 13 years (since 1999).
- ◆ SDSU has a record of 14-13 when it begins the season in Peterson Gym.

AZTEC VETERANS

- ◆ SDSU returns five starters plus the libero from a team that compiled a mark of 16-16 (8-8 MWC).
- ◆ Of the 19 players on this year's roster, 13 were members of the SDSU program last season.
- ◆ The Aztecs four returning starters include outside hitters Kyley Sexton (2.85 kps, 1.52 dps, 0.38 bps), Pajie Pearson (1.40 kps, 1.72 dps, 0.65 bps) and Raegan Shelton (2.86 kps, 0.89 dps, 0.49 bps) along with middle blocker Andrea Hannasch (2.59 kps, 1.23 bps) and setter Johnna Fouch (10.59 apg, 2.32 dps).
- ◆ Also back is libero Kristi Jackels, who averaged 3.70 digs per set.

- ◆ Other returnees who saw significant playing time include outside hitter Summer Nash (2.74 kps, 0.50 bps) and defensive specialist Kyla Oropenza (1.38 dps)

PRESEASON ALL-MWC

- ◆ Junior middle blocker Andrea Hannasch has been named to the preseason all-Mountain West Conference team.
- ◆ Hannasch was named to the all-MWC squad in 2010 after a season that included averages of 2.73 kills, 1.47 digs and 1.20 blocks per set in conference play.

TRANSFERS

- ◆ The Aztecs have added a trio of transfers from other four-year schools to the 2011 SDSU roster.
- ◆ Andrea Terpstra is a sophomore middle blocker who spent the past two seasons at the University of Pacific. She was a medical redshirt there during the 2010 campaign.
- ◆ Emily Harris is a sophomore middle blocker from Western Michigan who was a 2010 *PrepVolleyball.com* Senior Ace during her final year of high school.
- ◆ Courtney Vaccarello is a sophomore libero who played at the University of Oregon last season.

LOCAL WALK-ONS

- ◆ The SDSU roster contains a pair of talented walk-on players from local high schools.
- ◆ Lauren Hays played her prep volleyball at Patrick Henry High where she was a two-time all-CIF selection and three-time all-Eastern League honoree.
- ◆ Luciana Hanley is a libero/defensive specialist from Torrey Pines High who helped her team to Avocado League titles each of her final two seasons.

ATHLETIC RELATIVES

- ◆ Two members of the 2011 Aztecs have notable athletic connections in their family.
- ◆ Redshirt freshman Oni Lattin's grandfather, David Lattin, was a member of the 1966 Texas Western (now UTEP) basketball team under Don Haskins that upset Kentucky for the national title.
- ◆ Emily Harris' father, Al Harris, played defensive end and linebacker for the Chicago Bears from 1979-84 and 1986-88 before finishing his career with the Philadelphia Eagles from 1989-90.
- ◆ In addition, assistant coach Melanie Greene's dad, Ken Greene, played pro football with the San Diego Chargers and St. Louis Cardinals.

RETURNING LEAGUE LEADERS

- ◆ The Aztecs return four players who finished among the top 10 in the Mountain West in various categories during the 2010 season.
- ◆ Setter Johnna Fouch was first in the MWC in assists with an average of 10.59 per set.
- ◆ Andrea Hannasch finished fifth in blocking at 1.23 per set.
- ◆ Libero Kristi Jackels was sixth in digs with an average of 3.70 per set.
- ◆ Raegan Shelton averaged 2.86 kills per set to rank 10th in that category.

PRESEASON PROGNOSTICATIONS

- ◆ The Mountain West coaches and media poll has predicted the Aztecs to finish third in the eight-team league. It is SDSU's highest preseason conference ranking since joining the league in 1999.
- ◆ In the 12 years of the MW's existence, SDSU has finished second (2002), fourth (2000, 2001, 2003), fifth (2005), sixth (1999, 2004, 2006, 2009, 2010), seventh (2008) and eighth (2007) in the final league standings.
- ◆ Colorado State has been chosen to defend its Mountain West title from a year ago with New Mexico picked to finish second. The results of the preseason poll are as follows:
