OFF THE BOUNCE (through the games of November 17)

- Following its 79-54 drubbing of Saint Mary's in its semifinal game of the 2023 Continental Tire Main Event, San Diego State is prepped for the championship game on Sunday against the University of Washington.
- The Aztecs and Huskies are meeting for the sixth time, with UW owning a 3-2 advantage in the all-time series. The teams have never met on a neutral floor, and in its three wins, the Huskies have won twice on its home floor and once in San Diego, while the Aztecs two wins have come on its home floor.
- San Diego State used a pair of 10-plus-to-zero point runs in the second half to pull away from Saint Mary's on Friday night enroute to a 25-point throttling, 79-54. It was the second time San Diego State has put a 25-point hammering in the last four years (also: a 74-49 at Cal Poly on Dec. 22, 2020). The Aztecs are the only program to dispose of the Gaels by more than 20 points in a regular-season neutral site game since at least the 1996-97 campaign.
- Since the start of the 2009-10 season, the Aztecs are among the elite at winning on neutral floors. In a minimum of 95 neutral site games since the beginning of the 2009-10 campaign, SDSU has more than doubled its win total compared to its losses (65-32; 67.0 percent). Gonzaga is the only other team in the top-10 who is not a member of a Power 6 basketball conference. (see graphic at bottom of the page).
- San Diego State is appearing in its fourth MTE in Las Vegas, all coming since the start of the 2010-11 season. In its "Sin City" MTEs, the Aztecs have an overall record of 6-1, were the champions of 2010 Las Vegas Holiday Hoops Classic (2-0) and 2019 Continental Tire Las Vegas Invitational (2-0), finished runner-up (1-1) in the 2015 Continental Tire Las Vegas Invitational, and plays for its third title in four attempts in its game against Washington.
- San Diego State, which won both the 2022-23 Mountain West regular season and tournament titles and reached the league tournament championship game for the sixth time in head coach **Brian Dutcher's** six seasons, looks for its unprecedented 17th Mountain West men's basketball title. Entering the 2023-24 season, San Diego State has won nine regular season and seven Mountain West tournament titles.
- For the fifth time since the start of the 2010-11 season, San Diego State opened the season ranked in the preseason AP Top 25 Poll. The Aztecs No. 17 ranking in the initial poll is the second highest in program history, trailing only the 2014-15 preseason poll in which it was No. 16. Since the start of the 2010-11 campaign, SDSU has appeared in the AP poll for 102 weeks, more than any program in the state of California, ahead of UCLA (86 weeks), Saint Mary's (53 weeks), Southern California (37 weeks) and California (11 weeks).
- San Diego State owns a 111-24 record (82.2 percent) since the start of the 2019-20 campaign. That is the third best record in the nation, trailing only Gonzaga (123-13, 90.4 percent) and Houston (121-22, 84.6 percent). The 10 winningest programs since 2019-20 are listed in the box below.
- San Diego State shot a season-best 51.8 percent from the floor against Saint Mary's. Taking into account that the Gaels shot just 42.9 percent from the charity stripe on 14 attempts, it marked just the sixth time in the Dutcher/Fisher era that the Aztecs finished a game with a better field goal percentage than its opponents free throw percentage.
- Senior **Jaedon LeDee** led the Aztecs' attack against Saint Mary's with his fourth 20-point effort (25 points) in as many games this season. In addition, the Houston, Texas native led the Scarlet and Black with eight rebounds. He is the first Aztec since at least the start

- SDSU has won 61 of last 66 games when leading at the half.
- SDSU has won its last 98-of-105 when having a higher FG pct.
- SDSU is 6th nationally in winning percentage (.760) since the beginning of the 2010-11 season.
- Since its founding in 1999, no men's basketball program has won more Mountain West championships (regular-season and tournament) than San Diego State's 16.
- Since 2006, SDSU's 14 appearances in its conference championship game are tied for second most in Division I.

of the Dutcher/Fisher era to open a season with four straight 20-plus point efforts. LeDee is the second player in the last 10 years to open a season with four 20+ point games while scoring on at least 55.0 percent shooting. The other was Dayton's Obi Toppin in 2019-20 who went on to win the Wooden Award. LeDee, through four games, has drawn 36 fouls (9.0 /game) which he has used to go to the charity stripe 35 times and where he has made 27 attempts (77.1 percent).

- Junior guard **Reese Waters**, a transfer from Southern California, reached double figure scoring, with 19 points against Saint Mary's, for the fourth game in a row. He shot .77.8 from the floor (7-of-9) and from the bonus distance (3-of-4).
- Senior guard **Micah Parrish** added 11 points with four assists and five rebounds. Elijah Saunders swatted a career-high four shots, the most by an Aztec since Nathan Mensah rejected five against Alabama in the Sweet 16 at the 2023 NCAA Men's Basketball Tournament.
- **Brian Dutcher** is in his seventh season as San Diego State's head coach and his 25th season on the Aztec sidelines. In his six-plus seasons as head coach, he has led the Aztecs to five conference titles, six Mountain West championship game appearances, a 154-48 overall record, the 2023 NCAA national championship game, has been named the national coach of the year, and twice the Mountain West Conference Coach of the Year.

 - In the last 98 home games against those same 24 opponents, and starting in 1999-2000, San Diego State is 89-11 (.890).
 - In program history against the 24 schools, the Aztecs are 470-325 (.591) overall.
- San Diego State opened the 2023-24 season hosting an in-state foe in Cal State Fullerton, and won 83-57, then defeated Long Beach State 88-76, Saint Mary's 79-54, and still has games against vs. California (11/25), at UC San Diego (12/1), UC Irvine (12/9), Stanford (12/21), Fresno State (1/3), at San Jose State (1/9), at Fresno State (2/24) & San Jose State (2/27).

DUTCHER KEEPS THE BALL ROLLING...AND ROLLING

Brian Dutcher has been on The Mesa for now 25 seasons, 18 of them as the top man on San Diego State Hall of Fame Head Coach Steve Fisher's bench. In that time, he's experienced 540 victories, 16 Mountain West titles and helped the Aztecs to 17 postseason tournaments, including 12 NCAA appearances, a three of Sweet 16 berths (2011, 2014, 20223) and last season past the Sweet 16, to the Elite 8, Final Four and 2023 national championship game.

- Since his ascension to the top job, prior to the 2017-18 season, he has captured six Mountain West crowns and guided his team to the championship game in the league tournament each of his first six years.
- In his inaugural campaign, in 2017-18, he was the only first-year Division I head coach to guide his team to the NCAA Tournament.
- He is the only head coach in program history to win at least 21 games in each of his first six seasons.
- His 151 wins in his first six seasons are a program record for victories in a coach's first six campaigns.
- His 154 wins to date are the most of any head coach who started at his current institution at the start of the 2017-18 season.
- Dutcher was ranked at the No. 24 head coach in the nation according to *CBS Sport.com* top-25 and 1 coaches ratings.

DUTCHER FEATURED IN CBS SPORTS "HOME COURT"

CBS Sports' original series "Home Court" returns with three episodes featuring San Diego State coach Brian Dutcher, UConn coach Dan Hurley, and Indiana coach Mike Woodson. All three episodes will premiere on CBS Sports Network, with Dutcher's interview with CBS Sports college basketball analyst Seth Davis. The episode of "Home Court: Brian Dutcher" will debut on CBS Sports Network on Sunday, Nov. 19, at 2 p.m. ET/11 a.m. PT.

Davis talked with Dutcher after San Diego State's first Final Four appearance in program history. The Aztecs reached the national championship game before falling to Connecticut to end their magical March Madness run. Dutcher and Davis talk about SDSU's success in the 2023 NCAA Tournament, his relationship with former Aztecs coach Steve Fisher and Dutcher's years as an assistant coach at Michigan.

SERIES HISTORY VS. WASHINGTON

- San Diego State trails Washington 3-2 in the all-time series and will be playing its first neutral site game against the Huskies.
- The Aztecs two victories over Washington, 70-63 on Dec. 8, 2013 and 93-78 on March 21, 2016 came at Viejas Arena.
- A win over the Huskies would be SDSU's third in the last four meetings regardless of location.
- Since the series began in the 2003-04 season with the first two games being a home and home with UW emerging the victor 92-81 on Dec. 27, 2003 in Cox Arena and 98-69 the following year in Seattle. The series then took a nine year hiatus and didn't resume until Dec. 8, 2013 with a 70-63 win for SDSU at Viejas Arena, the following season, on Dec. 1, 2014, in Seattle, Washington downed San Diego State 49-36 in a defensive struggle. The last matchup came on the aforementioned date in 2016 and saw the Scarlet and Black down UW 93-78 in the second round of the NIT at Viejas Arena.

Shepard, coming off the first triple-double in school history, and Kell both had big shots after the Huskies went on a 15-2 run to pull to 69-64 on a 3-pointer by Marquese Chriss with 7:35 to play. Shepard had two layups while Kell made four free throws and hit a 3-pointer that pushed the lead back to double digits.

Dejounte Murray scored 20 for UW (19-15). Chriss, who drew his fourth foul early in the second half, scored 19 before fouling out with 1:13 to go and SDSU leading 89-76. Andrew Andrews scored 17.

LAS VEGAS - Jaedon LeDee scored 25 points as San Diego State beat Saint Mary's 79-54 in the Main Event at T-Mobile Arena on Friday night.

LeDee added eight rebounds for the Aztecs (3-1). Reese Waters shot 7 for 9, including 3 for 4 from beyond the arc to add 19 points. Micah Parrish shot 2 for 7 (1 for 3 from 3-point range) and 6 of 7 from the free throw line to finish with 11 points.

Mitchell Saxen led the Gaels (2-2) in scoring, finishing with 16 points, eight rebounds and two blocks. Joshua Jefferson added 12 points and four assists. Aidan Mahaney also had eight points.

KEEPING IT THE FAMILY

With an opening on the coaching staff following the national championship game at the 2023 NCAA Tournament, head coach **Brian Dutcher** didn't look too far to fill the vacancy when he announced the hiring of one of the most beloved Aztecs of all time, **Aguek Arop**. Arop's responsibility to the program includes scouting, film preparation, camps and academics.

He earned a bachelor's degree in interdisciplinary studies in 2022 and is working on completing a master's degree in homeland security at San Diego State.

The native of Omaha, Neb., finished his five-year playing career at the national championship game of the 2023 NCAA Men's Basketball Tournament. A team captain in both the 2021-22 and 2022-23 seasons, he completed his career ranked No. 5 in conference victories (54), No. 6 in games played (135) and No. 7 in total victories (102) in the 102 years of SDSU men's basketball.

AZTECS FINISH AT A PROGRAM-BEST NO. 2 IN FINAL 2022-23 COACHES POLL

Reaching the 2023 NCAA Tournament national championship game, San Diego State garnered a No. 2 rank in the final Coaches Poll of the 2022-23 season.

The ranking is the highest in program history in the Coaches' final poll and the sixth time SDSU has been ranked at the end of the year by the coaches.
