GAME STORYLINES

- ▶ This week's match-up is the 37th meeting between the teams with San Diego State holding a 23-11-2 advantage.
- ▶ The Aztecs have won 17 of the last 21 in the series, including nine of the last 10 at home.
- ▶ Hawai'i has lost consecutive games in the series in 2020 and '21 after winning back-to-back games in 2018 and '19.
- ▶ SDSU leads 11-4 in games played at home including a 2020 meeting in Carson, Calif., while its new Snapdragon Stadium was being built.
- ▶ Three of the last four meetings have been decided by seven points or less.
- ▶ The teams have met every year since 2012 as members of the Mountain West, which the Aztecs have won eight of the 10 match-ups.
- ▶ Hawai'i (1-4) is coming off a bye week and will be playing its Mountain West opener. UH last played at New Mexico State, Sept. 24 and lost 45-26 in Las Cruces, N.M.
- ▶ UH is 5-5 in Mountain West openers since joining the league in 2012, including a 3-3 mark in MW openers on the road. UH has won its last three MW openers on the road (2018, '19, '20).
- ▶ SDSU (2-3, 0-1 MW) dropped its MW opener last week at Boise State, 35-13. The Aztecs led 13-0 at the half but were shut-out 35-0 in the second half. SDSU recorded only 114 yards of total offense in the game.
- ▶ UH has lost both of its road games this season by an average of 32.5 points/game.
- ▶ UH head coach Timmy Chang won his only meeting against SDSU as a player, leading the Warriors to a 41-40 come-from-behind victory in the 2002 regular season finale in Honolulu. Chang threw for 437 yards and three touchdowns and directed a game-winning TD drive with 4:45 remaining for UH's 10th win of the season.
- ▶ UH has not committed a turnover in each of its road games at Michigan and New Mexico State. Hawai'i has won the turnover battle in each of its last three games.
- ▶ SDSU defensive tackle Justus Tavai spent four seasons with the Rainbow Warriors, logging 19 starts in 25 career games over the 2019-21 seasons. Justus' brother Jonah also plays for the Aztecs.
- ▶ UH defensive line coach Eti Ena's younger brother is SDSU defensive line coach Justin Ena. The brothers are meeting for just the second time as coaches. Eti's Cal Poly squad defeated Justin's Weber State team, 30-24 in 2014. The brothers also coached together at Eastern Washington during the 2021 spring season.

NEW HOME STADIUM

For the next several years, UH will play its home games on-campus at the retrofitted Clarence T.C. Ching Athletics Complex. The stadium seats approximately 9,000 with plans to expand in 2023. Previously, Hawai'i played its home games at Aloha Stadium, which was shuttered at the conclusion of the 2020 season. UH had an all-time record of 211-145-4 in 46 seasons at Aloha Stadium.

INTERVIEW POLICY

MEDICAL POLICY

The UH Sports Media Relations Office abides by federal law pertaining to the releasing of injury information. We will not disseminate any information about a student-athletes' injury without written consent. The only information given to the media will be if a student-athlete is "probable," "questionable," or "doubtful" to play. However, the student-athlete may release information about his/her injury.

WE ARE THE "RAINBOW WARRIORS"

In an effort to standardize the school's nicknames, UH officially changed its men's team nickname to "Rainbow Warriors" on July 1, 2013. The school's women's teams are still referred to as "Rainbow Wahine." The word "Wahine" (pronounced wah-EE-nay) means woman in the Hawaiian language. The rainbow has been part of the nickname since 1923 and Warriors were first adopted in 1974.

WHAT'S AN 'OKINA?

What's that punctuation mark in the word Hawai'i? In the Hawaiian language, it's called an 'okina, which translated literally in English means separator. Phonetically it is referred to as a glottal stop, similar to the sound that would be made in the English oh-oh. The 'okina is actually a letter in the Hawaiian language and typed out looks like a backwards, inverted apostrophe. The practice of the UH Sports Media Relations office is to use the 'okina in all Hawaiian words in which they occur.

LAST TIME OUT

LAST WEEK VS. NEW MEXICO STATE NMSU 45, UH 26 — Sept. 24, 2022 Aggie Memorial Stadium (12,879); Las Cruces, N.M.

- ▶ UH lost to NMSU for the first time in 11 all-time meetings. UH was also undefeated in its previous four visits to Las Cruces.
- ▶ The Aggies scored 45 points, their most-ever against UH. The previous high was 34 points (2011, '21), which they eclipsed in the first half alone (35 points).
- ▶ UH set new season highs in points (26) and total offense (411).
- ▶ UH threw its first touchdown pass of the season when Brayden Schager found Jalen Walthall for a 16-yard score. UH entered the game as one of two teams in the nation to have not thrown a TD pass with the other being South Florida.
- ▶ UH won the turnover battle for the third straight game and the offense enjoyed a turnover free game for the second time in the last three games.
- ▶ UH scored a touchdown on its opening drive for the second time this year (also vs. Vanderbilt in season opener).
- ▶ UH's 90-yard drive in the second quarter that ended in a 23-yard Matthew Shipley field goal, was the team's longest drive this season.
- ▶ Matthew Shipley converted field goals of 23 and 30 yards. The junior has made good on 16 of his last 17 field goal attempts from 40 yards and in, dating back to last season.

- ▶ Jalen Walthall scored his first career touchdown on a 16-yard pass from Brayden Schager in the third quarter. It was the first touchdown pass of the season for Schager, who made his second start of the season and the fifth of his career.
- ▶ Schager finished with a career-high 261 yards on 22-of-39 passing. The 39 attempts tied a career high.
- ▶ Virdele Edwards II recorded his second interception of the season with a third-quarter pick. Both of his interceptions have come on the road (also at No. 4 Michigan).
- ▶ Meki Pei made his first career start for the Rainbow Warriors at safety. The Washington transfer finished with a career-high six tackles and added a pass breakup and quarterback hurry.
- ▶ Caleb Phillips led UH with a career-high eight catches for 138 yards. It was the best performance by a UH player this year in both receptions and receiving yards.
- ▶ Entering this week, no other FBS tight end had as many receiving yards (per CFBStats.com) as Phillips' 138.
- ▶ Both James Phillips (24 yards) and Caleb Phillips (40 yards) recorded career long catches in the game.
- ▶ Caleb Phillips' 40-yard catch in the fourth quarter was UH's longest pass play of the year.

HAWAI'I-SDSU SERIES HISTORY

- ▶ SDSU leads the all-time series 23-11-2, including a 11-4 advantage at home. The Aztecs have won 17 of the last 21 in the series, including nine of the last 10 at home

LAST MEETING VS. SAN DIEGO STATE SDSU 17, UH 10 — Nov. 6, 2021

Ching Complex (6,239); Honolulu, O'ahu

- ▶ A fake field goal by the Aztecs, resulting in a 13-yard rushing touchdown, gave them a 14-7 advantage at halftime.
- ▶ A Matthew Shipley field goal cut the deficit to 17-10 with 3:00 left and UH's defense forced a SDSU punt. However, the Warriors stalled at the SDSU 18-yard line as time expired.
- ▶ UH was held to a season low 260 yards of offense and its 10 points also tied a season low.
- ▶ UH held SDSU to just 227 yards, a season-low for an opponent.
- ▶ Chevan Cordeiro completed 19-of-34 for 175 yards and one touchdown – a 19-yard pass to Calvin Turner Jr., in the first quarter that tied the score at 7-7.
- ▶ The game marked UH's first home game without crowd restrictions.

TEAM NOTES

HAWAI'I IN THE MOUNTAIN WEST

- ▶ Hawai'i begins its 11th season in the Mountain West in 2022 and owns a 26-54 (.325) all-time mark—14-27 at home and 12-27 on the road.
- ▶ Since the conference moved to two divisions in 2013, UH is 14-26 against the West and 7-17 versus the Mountain.
- ▶ UH has not won a Mountain West title however they were the West Division representatives in 2019, falling to champion Boise State.

UH ON NATIONAL TELEVISION

- ▶ UH has made 121 all-time appearances on national TV and owns a 29-90-2 (.248) record.
- ▶ Hawai'i is 9-17 on national television dating back to 2019 including an 0-2 mark this season.
- ▶ Hawai'i has dropped seven of its last eight national TV games dating back to last year.
- ▶ UH is scheduled to play two more games on national television in 2022—at San Diego State (CBSSN) and at Fresno State (FSN).

SCORING NOTES

- ▶ This season, UH has been out-scored 125-44 in the first half and 102-43 in the second half.
- ▶ UH has trailed at halftime in four of five games this season. In those four games, UH has been out-scored 119-30
- ▶ UH's 42-point halftime deficit at Michigan was its largest since 2015 when it trailed 49-0 at Boise State.
- ▶ After being out-scored by a combined 42-0 in the third quarter in its first two games, UH has held its last three opponents to a combined seven points in the third quarter.
- ▶ UH's season-high halftime point total was 14 against Duquesne.

ROAD WARRIORS

- ▶ In the last decade (not including 2020 COVID season), UH has played no less than six road games each year, including a program-high seven in 2021.
- ▶ UH will make six road trips this season, includ-

ON THE CONTINENT

▶ Since 2016, UH is 14-23 in road/neutral site games and 11-12 in MW road games.

▶ In the eight seasons prior, UH went 11-37 in road/neutral site games and 9-23 in Mountain West contests.

HOME SWEET HOME

▶ UH has a 5-4 record since moving into Clarence T.C. Ching Complex last season.

▶ Hawai'i went 4-2 in its inaugural season of 2021 and are 1-2 this season.

▶ UH sold out its first two games (9,346) of the 2022 season.

▶ Ching Complex was retrofitted to seat more than 9,000 after UH's former home, Aloha Stadium was shuttered following the 2020 season. Aloha Stadium was home to UH football for 46 seasons.

MISCELLANEOUS TEAM NOTES

▶ UH won its 19th consecutive game against an FCS team with a 24-14 victory over Duquesne. The streak dates back to the 2001 season. Hawai'i's last loss to an FCS opponent was to Portland State in 2000 at Aloha Stadium.

▶ UH's season-opening loss to Vanderbilt was its first at home to a Power 5 school since 2014, when it fell to Oregon State. Hawai'i had won its last three home games against Power 5 teams

▶ UH played before its second biggest crowd in history (110,012) at Michigan, Sept. 10. The top mark was six years ago at the same venue when 110,222 attended UH and Michigan's first-ever meeting in Ann Arbor.

▶ UH had just one penalty for 10 yards against Michigan. The last time UH committed just one penalty was in its 2018 win over Navy.

▶ UH did not commit a turnover in two games this season—Michigan and New Mexico State.

TROPHY GAMES

▶ UH will play three of its four rivalry trophies in 2022 —Paniolo (vs. Wyoming, Oct. 29), Island Showdown (vs. UNLV, Nov. 19), and Dick Tomey Legacy (at San José State, Nov. 26).

▶ The Warriors reclaimed the Paniolo Trophy after a season-ending win over the Cowboys in Laramie last season.

▶ UH and Air Force play for the Kuter Trophy, which the Falcons own by virtue of a 2019 win.

WATCH OUT

▶ Five Warriors were named to Watch Lists for three different national awards.

▶ PK **Matthew Shipley** was named to the Lou Groza Award watch list while DL **Jonah Kahahawai-Welch** is on the Wuerffel Trophy watch list. Kahahawai-Welch, WR **Jonah Panoke**, DL **Blessman Ta'ala** and OL **Solo Vaipulu** each earned a spot on the Polynesian College Football Player of the Year watch list.

OFFSEASON NOTES

▶ A turbulent offseason saw former head Todd Graham resign and more than 20 players enter the transfer portal. Former record-setting quarterback Timmy Chang was hired as the 25th head coach in program history on Jan. 22, 2022.

▶ Among the list of starters who left the UH program and entered the transfer portal included QB **Chevan Cordeiro** (San Jose State), LB **Darius Muasau** (UCLA), DB **Khoury Bethley** (Arizona State), DL **Jonah Laulu**, RB **Dae Dae Hunter** (Liberty), WR **Nick Mardner** (Cincinnati), CB **Cameron Lockridge** (Fresno State), and DL **Justus Tavai** (San Diego State).

▶ Cordeiro, Muasau, Hunter, and Tavai all started for their respective teams in their season openers.

NOTES FROM 2021 SEASON

▶ UH concluded the 2021 regular-season with a losing record for the first time since 2017.

▶ Hawai'i earned a bowl invitation for a program-record fourth consecutive year in 2021 and fifth time in the last six seasons.

▶ UH would have played in the EasyPost Hawai'i Bowl for the 10th time in program history, however the game was canceled due to COVID concerns within the Warrior program.

OFFENSE NOTES

QUARTERBACK SHUFFLE

▶ UH has started two different quarterbacks this season. **Brayden Schager** got the start in the season-opener against Vanderbilt and two weeks ago at New Mexico State while transfer **Joey Yellen** has started three games.

▶ Schager, who made three starts as a true freshman in 2021, has thrown for 659 yards on 63-of-108 passing with one touchdown and four interceptions on the year.

▶ Last week at New Mexico State, the Dallas, Texas native threw for a career-high 261 yards and a touchdown. Schager also passed for 230 yards against Western Kentucky. He did not play against Michigan due to an undisclosed injury.

▶ Schager is 2-3 in his career as the starting quarterback which includes a win in his starting debut over nationally ranked Fresno State last season.

▶ Yellen, who came in relief of Schager in the third quarter of the Vandy game, played the entire first quarter against WKU. The Pitt transfer completed 10-of-20 for 89 yards against Vandy and 4-of-11 for 36 yards versus WKU. He was 13-of-36 for 113 yards against Michigan and 13-of-20 for 86 yards versus Duquesne.

'BOW BITES

- ▶ OL **Micah Vanterpool** has a YouTube channel "Big MiK" with over 700 subscribers and hosts a podcast "Big MiK Takes the Mic".
- ▶ QB **Brayden Schager** and his family founded the HP Buddy Bowl, an annual football event in Texas for special-needs youth. As a 10-year-old, he had the top bracket out of 8.5 million entries in ESPN's 2013 NCAA Tournament basketball pool.
- ▶ WR **Dior Scott** was prominently featured in Netflix's hit series "Last Chance U" which chronicled the 2019 season of Laney College in Oakland, Calif. Scott and former UH WR Jared Smart were teammates on the 2018 Laney squad that captured the CCCAA Championship.
- ▶ DB **Noa Kamana** comes from a football-playing family as his father Carter (Michigan State), brother Tim (Wyoming), grandfather John (USC), and uncle John Jr. (USC) all played collegiate football.
- ▶ DB **Eli Matagi Thompson** was named after his uncle Eli Thompson who was committed to play at UH but who passed away his senior year of HS. Fire knife dances for his father's luau company "Tihati Productions."
- ▶ WR **Grey Ihu** is named after Earl Grey tea, a favorite of his mom's.
- ▶ LB **Riley Wilson**'s father played for the legendary Ohio State coach Woody Hayes.
- ▶ WR **Jonah Panoke** and DL **John Tuitupou** each have three children while LB **Logan Taylor** has two children.
- ▶ Utah transfer OL **Luke Felix-Fualalo** is the tallest Warrior at 6-8 while RB **Robbie Paikai** is the shortest at 5-4.
- ▶ DB **Isalah Malloe** is the son of former UH assistant and current UCLA assistant Ikaika Malloe. WR **Tamatoa Mokiao-Atimalala**'s brother Titus played at UCF and now plays for UCLA. DB **Von Killin**'s brother Adrian was a running back at UCF and played for Philadelphia Eagles (2020) and Denver Broncos (2021). LS **Solomon Landrum**'s father Mike played tight end for the Atlanta Falcons. DL **Mataio Soli**'s father Junior also played at Arkansas and was a fifth-round draft pick by the San Diego Chargers.
- ▶ Two players last played football in 2019—RB **Keith Moton III** (Westview HS, Ore.) and DB **JoJo Forest** (Oregon State) while OL **Micah Matearagi** (Virginia) last played in 2018.
- ▶ RB **Naszjae "Mojo" Bryant-Lelei** changed his last name in the off-season to recognize his Polynesian family connections.
- ▶ LB **Noah Kema** and LB **Demarii Blanks** were JUCO All-Americans at Snow College and College of San Mateo, respectively.
- ▶ WR **Chuuky Hines**'s mother is from Hawai'i and is of Micronesian and Hawaiian descent. His first name Chuuky translates to "mountain" in the Micronesian language of Chuukese.
- ▶ WR **Chad Owens Jr.** and TE **Landon Sims** both don their famous UH football fathers' jersey numbers. Owens wears #2 and Sims wears #30, for his father Travis.

ONE PARSON PARTY

- ▶ **Dedrick Parson** leads the team in rushing with 266 yards on 67 carries and four touchdowns. He also has 11 receptions for 52 yards.
- ▶ Parson has scored in four of five games this year and has a team-leading six rushing touchdowns. He has scored at least one touchdown in 9-of-18 career games at UH and has five multi-touchdown games.
- ▶ Parson's six touchdowns is tied for 12th nationally and third in the Mountain West.
- ▶ The Philadelphia, Pa., native had team-highs of 13 carries for 82 yards against Vanderbilt, including a 37-yard touchdown run. He also rushed 11 times for 58 yards and two touchdowns against Duquesne, and 16 times for 69 yards and two more scores at New Mexico State.
- ▶ Parson was the team's second-leading rusher (636 yds.) last season and had a team-leading eight touchdowns and was the third-leading receiver in terms of receptions with 28 catches for 279 yards and another score.

KING PHILLIP

- ▶ **Caleb Phillips**' 138 yards receiving against New Mexico State is the most in a single-game by an FBS tight end this season.
- ▶ The total is the most by a UH tight end in more than 50 years and the third-most in recorded history behind Henry Savio (151 at UC Santa Barbara, 1971) and McKinley Reynolds (at Cal State LA, 1968).
- ▶ The Encinitas, Calif., native has 168 yards on 11 receptions this season which is the eighth-most yards by a Group of 5 tight end this season.

O-LINE EXPERIENCE

- ▶ Entering the 2022 season, UH's offensive line unit was among the most experienced in the country, ranking sixth nationally in number of starts.
- ▶ **Iim Manning** has started 52-of-54 career games and earned all-Mountain West honorable mention honors in 2021.
- ▶ **Solo Vaipulu** is in his fifth year with the program and has the second-most career starts (40) but has yet to see action this season. **Micah Vanterpool** has 21 career starts while **Eiiki Tanuvasa** has made 11 starts.

MORE OFFENSIVE NOTES

- ▶ UH's 184 yards of offense against Duquesne was its lowest total since 2015 versus Air Force (178). Its 93 passing yards was also its lowest since 2015 (88 at Boise State).
- ▶ UH threw five interceptions against Western Kentucky, the most since throwing five in the 2010 Hawai'i Bowl versus Tulsa.
- ▶ Since 2000, UH is 73-10 when generating 500+ yards of total offense.

DEFENSE NOTES**THE GODFATHER**

- ▶ Linebacker **Penel Pavihi** enters his sixth season in the program having appeared in 52 career games, with 34 starts.
- ▶ Scored his first career touchdown against

Duquesne on a 50-yard interception return in the fourth quarter. It was his second career pick. Also recorded the first sack of the season and fifth of this career with a takedown of Joe Mischler in the third quarter.

- ▶ The native of American Samoa has been a part of three bowl squads and 32 career victories.
- ▶ Team's leading returning tackler with 47 (28 solo) last season also leads the team this season with 27 tackles (17 solo).
- ▶ In his career, has 182 total tackles, 16.5 tackles-for-loss, five sacks, two interceptions, three fumble recoveries, and one forced fumble.

"HAUS" CALL

- ▶ Defensive back **Malik Hausman** recorded a pair of interceptions against Duquesne, both of them in the second half and both of them in the endzone to squash a pair of scoring drives. He also had three pass breakups in the game.
- ▶ The Las Vegas, Nev., native is the first UH player to come away with multiple interceptions and at least three pass breakups in a game since Nov. 24, 2012 (John Hardy-Tuliau).
- ▶ The Arizona transfer leads the team with three interceptions. His six passes defended is tied for 10th nationally.

IRON MAN

- ▶ Defensive lineman **Blessman Ta'ala** has not missed a single game in four seasons at UH.
- ▶ An all-Mountain West honorable mention selection in back-to-back seasons, he has played in 56 straight games, starting 43 of them at nose tackle.
- ▶ The Aua, American Samoa native has 112 total tackles, 16.0 tackles-for-loss, 3.0 sacks, and two blocked punts in his career, which began in 2018.

SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES**ROCKET SHIP**

- ▶ **Matthew Shipley** is in his third season as the team's starting placekicker.
- ▶ The Liberty Hill, Texas native has converted 6-of-7 field goal attempts this season with a long of 40.
- ▶ In his career, made 32-of-42 field goal attempts and 76-of-76 PAT attempts.
- ▶ Starting punter for the second straight season and has an average of 39.6 yards on 27 punts.
- ▶ Last season was 18-of-21 in field goals which were the most by a UH kicker in a single-season since Tyler Hadden in 2014 (18).
- ▶ Among 20 semifinalists for the Lou Groza Award as the nation's best placekicker and UH's first semifinalist since Jason Elam in 1992. He is also on the preseason watch list this year.

BIG LEG

- ▶ **Kyler Halvorsen** is averaging 64.0 yards on 20 kickoffs this season with 14 touchbacks. He is tied for 31st nationally in kickoff average.
- ▶ Last season, finished ninth nationally in kickoff average (64.0 yards) and had touchbacks on more than half of his kickoffs (40-of-72).
- ▶ Over his career, he has 54 touchbacks and four kicks out of bounds.

► The "Braddahood" movement began as an organic, team-unifying slogan created by the players to show solidarity amid an offseason of controversy.

► WR **Jonah Panoke** was one of the leaders of the movement which has since taken over as the team's motto and endorsed by head coach **Timmy Chang**, whose alma mater Saint Louis School, uses the term "The Brotherhood." Panoke is also a Saint Louis School alum.

CAPTAINS

► Four players were voted captains for the 2022 season: center **Eliki Tanuvasa**, running back **Dedrick Parson**, linebacker **Penei Pavahi**, and defensive lineman **Blessman Ta'ala**.

**** STAR WARRIORS

► This year's roster includes several 4-star athletes, all of whom transferred into the Rainbow Warrior program.

► Among those include Washington State transfer QB **Cammon Cooper** (247Sports, Rivals), Pitt transfer QB **Joey Yellen** (ESPN), Arkansas transfer DL **Mataio Soli** (247Sports, Rivals), and Nebraska transfer DL **Wynden Ho'ohuli** (247Sports, ESPN, Rivals).

WALK-ON U.

► UH has a reputation of turning walk-ons into stars most notably Colt Brennan, who finished his career as a Heisman Trophy finalist.

► Four former walk-ons have started this season including OL **Eliki Tanuvasa**, DB **Leonard Lee**, DL **John Tuitupou**, and OL **Stephan Bernal-Wendt**.

► In addition, others who joined as walk-ons and received scholarships include QB **Jake Farrell**, DB **Nalu Emerson**, and DB **Noa Kamana**.

SCHOOL HOUSE SHUFFLE

► This offseason, UH raided the transfer portal welcoming 17 FBS transfers and two FCS transfers.

► Among the FBS transfers, 16 are from Power 5 schools—**McKenzie Barnes** (Arizona), **Cammon Cooper** (Washington State), **Steele Dubar** (Colorado), **Virdel Edwards II** (Iowa State), **Andrew Faoliu** (Oregon), **Luke Felix-Fualalo** (Utah), **JoJo Forest** (Oregon State), **Malik Hausman** (Arizona), **Wynden Ho'ohuli** (Nebraska), **Devyn King** (Maryland), **Solomon Landrum** (Mississippi), **Kaulana Makaula** (USC), **Micah Mariteragi** (Virginia), **Meki Pei** (Washington), **Mataio Soli** (Arkansas), and **Joey Yellen** (Pittsburgh).

► Other transfers for 2022 include **Anthony Sagapolutele** (UNLV), **Jordan Murray** (Missouri State), and **Jojo Falu** (Cal Poly).

► In total, UH has 20 FBS transfers and eight FCS transfers on its roster.

ALL IN THE FAMILY

► The 2022 squad features six second-generation Rainbow Warriors—**Wynden Ho'ohuli** (Watson, 2000-05), **Kila Kamakawiwo'ole** (Kila, 2002-05); **Chad Owens, Jr.** (Chad Sr., 2001-04), **Landon Sims** (Travis, 1989-92), **Ethan Spencer** (Sean), and **Matagi Thompson** (Afatia, 1998-2000).

► Three others have older brothers who once

sued up for UH—**Andrew Choi** (Zeno), **Sergio Muasau** (Darius), and **Kamuela Borden** (brothers Kawika & Noah). Borden's sister Anika also competed for UH's track and field team.

DIVERSITY U

► One of the most diverse teams in the country, UH has players from 18 states, encompassing five time zones, and five countries.

► Forty percent of the 117-man roster hail from Hawai'i (47) while California (23) and Texas (12) combined make up almost a third. In addition, five players each are from Arizona and Florida.

► UH also has players from American Samoa (6), Australia (2), and Canada (1).

► Honolulu prep football powerhouse Saint Louis School, whose motto is "The Brotherhood" has the most players of any Hawai'i high school on the current Rainbow Warrior roster.

TIMMY CHANG

Head Coach; 1st Season

Overall Record: 1-4 (1)

Record at UH: 1-4 (1)

Former record-setting quarterback Timmy Chang was hired as the University of Hawai'i's 25th head football coach in program history on Jan. 22, 2022.

Chang spent the last five seasons as the wide receivers and tight ends coach at Nevada, before recently following former Wolf Pack head coach Jay Norvell at Colorado State. During his five seasons at Nevada, Chang helped direct one of the most potent offensive attacks on the West Coast while the Wolf Pack earned a bowl bid in each of the last four seasons.

In 2021, Nevada placed three different pass catchers on the Fred Biletnikoff Award Watch List, including two-time All-Mountain West selections Romeo Doubs and Cole Turner. The receiving corps helped power a Wolf Pack passing game that finished fourth nationally.

Prior to his time at Nevada, Chang had two stints as an offensive coordinator. In 2016, he served as the offensive coordinator at Emory & Henry College in Virginia. During that season the Wasps averaged 33.0 points and 463.5 yards per game.

Previously, Chang spent two seasons at Jackson State University in Jackson, Miss., as his run-and-shoot offense had the Tigers humming as well. Jackson State led the Southwestern Athletic Conference and finished among the leaders nationally in multiple offensive categories, including passing yardage, completions, completion percentage and total offense.

Chang first got his coaching start as an offensive assistant at SMU under his collegiate head coach, June Jones, for two seasons. He assisted in all aspects of the Mustangs' offense with a primary focus on the Mustang quarterbacks. In Chang's first season in 2012, SMU earned an invite to the Hawai'i Bowl where they defeated Fresno State.

A four-year starter for Hawai'i from 2000-04, Chang set the NCAA's all-time passing (17,072) and total offense (16,910) records. The Honolulu native finished his career with 117 total touchdowns, which ranked third at the time. A two-time Hawai'i Bowl Most Outstanding Player, Chang led UH to three bowl appearances and a program-record 29 wins at quarterback. In his final season as a Warrior, he was a finalist for the Johnny Unitas Award, given to the nation's top senior quarterback.

Following his illustrious collegiate career at UH, Chang played professional football in the National Football League, Canadian Football League, and NFL Europe for four seasons. He retired from professional football in 2009 and returned to Hawai'i to complete his bachelor's degree.

COACHES NOTES

▶ Head coach **Timmy Chang** is one of 22 minority head coaches in FBS football and one of three Polynesians (Kalani Sitake-BYU and Ken Niumatalolo-Navy). Among the full-time assistant coaches, UH is tied with Miami (Fla.) for the national lead with eight minority assistants.

▶ In addition to **Chang** (2000-04), several former Warriors are on the coaching staff: ILB coach **Chris Brown** (1998-2002), CB coach **Abe Elimimian** (2001-04), RB coach **Keiki Misipeka** (2001), QC **Jordan Pu'u-Robinson** (2012-14), GA **Alema Kapoi** (2020-21), and intern **Samson Anguay** (2013-14, '16).

▶ Among the full-time staff, Chang coached with both **Thomas Sheffield** and **Josh Brown** at Nevada. In addition, **Silas Clapham** (Dir. of Player Personnel), **Cade Socha** (Quality Control) and **Jimbo Davis** (Quality Control) also were on staff at Nevada.

▶ **Elimimian** enters his eighth season on the coaching staff while working for his fifth head coach (Norm Chow, Chris Naeole-interim, Nick Rolovich, Todd Graham, Timmy Chang). The former UH cornerback earned first-team all-conference honors and played in three bowl games. His younger brother Solomon (2005-08) is UH's all-time tackles leader and retired CFL linebacker, who was the league's Most Outstanding Player in 2014.

▶ Defensive coordinator **Jacob Yoro**, who joined the program in 2017, spent one season as co-coordinator in 2020. Yoro, who prepped at powerhouse Saint Louis School under legendary coach and former UH assistant Cal Lee, previously served as DC at Pacific University (Ore.) from 2010-14.

▶ WR coach **Jared Ursua** is the older brother of former UH receiver John Ursua.

▶ OC **Ian Shoemaker** and DL coach **Eti Ena** both coached at Eastern Washington last season. Prior to EWU, Shoemaker was head coach at Central Washington from 2014-19 while accumulating a win percentage of .704. In addition to Shoemaker, Ena coached alongside Yoro and Josh Brown at Cal Poly.

▶ OL coach **Roman Sapolu**'s father is former UH All-American Jesse Sapolu, who earned four Super Bowl rings with the San Francisco 49ers. Brother Landon also suited up for the Rainbow Warriors.

▶ LB coach **Chris Brown** still owns two UH weightlifting records—bench press (500lbs) and squat (605lbs).

▶ The 11 full-time coaches have a combined 35 children. RB coach **Keiki Misipeka** has eight children, all of whom begin with the letter K and have Hawaiian first names.

- ▶ Vanderbilt wins the first meeting between the teams. The teams will meet next year (2023) in Nashville.

GAME NOTES

- ▶ The loss was UH's first-ever to the Aggies, as the Rainbow Warriors came in to the game 10-0 all-time versus New Mexico State.
- ▶ UH was also undefeated in its previous four visits to Las Cruces.
- ▶ The Aggies scored 45 points, their most-ever against UH. The previous high was 34 points (2011, '21), which they eclipsed in the first half alone (35 points).
- ▶ UH has dropped 21 of its last 23 non-conference regular-season road games dating back to 2010.
- ▶ The Warriors set new season highs in points (26) and total offense (411).
- ▶ UH threw its first touchdown pass of the season when Braden Schager found Jalen Walthall for a 16-yard score. UH entered the game as one of two teams in the nation to have not thrown a TD pass with the other being South Florida.
- ▶ UH won the turnover battle for the third straight game and the offense enjoyed a turnover free game for the second time in the last three games.
- ▶ Caleb Phillips led UH with a career-high eight catches for 138 yards. It was the best performance by a UH player this year in both receptions and receiving yards.
- ▶ Jalen Walthall scored his first career touchdown on a 16-yard pass Schager.
- ▶ Virdell Edwards II recorded his second interception of the season with a third-quarter pick. Both of his interceptions have come on the road (also at Michigan).
