Offensive Tidbits

• Several of the Aztec offensive players are on watch lists for the nation's top player at their position, including TE (now RT) Daniel Brunskill (Wuerffel), C Arthur Flores (Rimington), RB Donnel Pumphrey (Walter Camp, Maxwell, Doak Walker) and RG Nico Siragusa (Outland).

• Associate head coach and running backs coach Jeff Horton is in his second year as offensive coordinator at SDSU. In his sixth year overall at San Diego State, Horton has head coaching stints at Minnesota (interim in 2011), UNLV (1994-98) and Nevada (1993).

• SDSU is 43-11 in the Rocky Long era when scoring just 20 or more points.

• The Aztecs had a school-record 3,266 rushing yards last season (previous best was 2,869 in 2012).

• SDSU has a 1,000-yard rusher in six straight seasons for the first time in program history. Donnel Pumphrey (1,653) and Chase Price (1,008) gave San Diego State multiple 1,000-yard rushers for the first time in school history in 2015.

• The Aztecs have won 23 straight games when rushing for at least 200 yards (31-2 in the Rocky Long era).

• San Diego State had 200-plus rushing yards in 10 straight games last year in the same season for the first time in its Division I history (since 1969).

• SDSU has a 100-yard rusher in 27 of its past 36 games and has a total of 31, 100-yard rushers during that span.

• San Diego State is 20-1 in program history when it has two, 100-yard rushers, including three times last year - Oct. 3 vs. Fresno State, Nov. 14 vs. Wyoming and Nov. 28 vs. Nevada.

• The Aztecs have 234 passes without throwing an interception, the longest-ate streak in FBS).

• San Diego State's 13 games without throwing an interception is longest streak in terms of games played in at least 20 years (since 1996).

• SDSU has not turned the ball over its last 352 snaps from scrimmage (dates back to third quarter of Nov. 14 game vs. Wyoming, now five-plus games).

Defensive Tidbits

- Several of the Aztec defensive players are on watch list for the nation's top player at their position, including CB Damontae Kazee (Thorpe) LB Calvin Munson (Nagurski, Burkus).
- Rocky Long is serving as the team's defensive coordinator for the eighth straight season (includes all six as head coach). Since he's taken over as the defensive coordinator in 2009, SDSU's defense ranks 20th in yards allowed per rush (3.7), 24th in total defense (354.0), 30th in rushing yards allowed per game (143.1) and in points allowed per game (23.9).
- San Diego State had posted two of the best defensive seasons in each of the last two seasons and is off to another good start. Below are comparisons of the past two-plus seasons and total rankings over the last two-plus years:

- Since Oct. 3, 2014 (includes 24 SDSU games), San Diego State ranks fourth nationally in yards allowed per game (289.7).
- The Aztecs have allowed just 261 points in their last 18 games (14.5 ppg).
- SDSU had the ninth-best defensive third-down conversion percentage (28.9) in FBS last year are first this year (0.0) in 14 attempts

San Diego State has held 16 straight league opponents below 400 yards of total offense, the longest active streak in FBS (league games only), and 12 straight games overall (2nd in FBS).

- Over the Aztecs' last 15 Mountain West contests (does not include MW Championship), opponents have scored just 15.1 points per game vs. SDSU and only 263.9 yards per game.

SDSU has forced three or more turnovers in six of its last eight contests.

- Over the last 133 offensive drives vs. SDSU (since the second half at Penn State), opponents have totaled just 117 points, 2,682 yards, 49 three and outs, 153 first downs and 4.06 yards per play (660 plays). During that span, opponents have 37-for-150 on third-down conversions (24.7 percent).
