### TEAM NOTES

- \* San Diego State is 4-0 for the second straight season. It is also the first time in SDSU's Division I history that it has started 4-0 in consecutive seasons.
- \* The Aztecs are 4-0 to begin a season for just the fifth time as a Division I school.
- \* SDSU improves to 7-2 under Steve Fisher in home openers and are winners of three straight.
- \* San Diego State improves to 9-0 against UC San Diego.
- \* The Aztecs had a season low in turnovers (6) and their fewest since having eight last season at Syracuse.
- \* Tonight's home-opening attendance of 6,706 is SDSU's largest since 1999-00.

### PLAYER NOTES

- \* Freshman Billy White made his first career start. ... He set a career high in points (20) and blocked shots (3) tonight. ... White posted his second career double-figure scoring effort of the year. ... He made his first nine baskets before missing with under six minutes left in the game. ... White led the team in scoring for the first time in his career and rebounding for the second time. ... White posted his first 20-plus point effort of his career.
- \* Junior Kyle Spain has made at least one three-point attempt in all four games this season. This is the first time in his career he has made at least one three-pointer in four straight games. ... He recorded his fourth straight double-figure scoring game (12) for the first time in his career.
- \* Junior Kelvin Davis scored in double-figures (15) for a third straight game after only scoring five in the season opener vs. Liberty.
- \* Junior Richie Williams made his first appearance of 2007-08 at the 16:34 mark of the first half.
- \* Sophomore Jon Pastorek recorded a season high in points (4) and minutes (15).
- \* Sophomore Jer'Vaughn Johnson scored his first points of the season.
