San Diego State Postgame Notes vs. Wyoming

Final Score: (RV/RV) San Diego State 67, Wyoming (--) 41

Game Notes

- San Diego State sweeps Wyoming for the first time since 2012 and in doing so wins its 28th straight home game.
- The Aztecs move into sole possession of first place in the Mountain West standings, a full game ahead of Wyoming.
- San Diego State has won seven straight home games vs. Wyoming and by an average margin of 24.3 points per game.
- The Aztecs held Wyoming to its fewest points of the season (41).
- Of SDSU's seven straight home wins over Wyoming, six have been by double figures and five have been by at least 20 points.
- The Aztecs have now played 71 straight games without losing twice in a row.
- During SDSU's 28-game home winning streak, tonight marked the 10th time it has led wire-to-wire and the 21st time it has not trailed in the second half.
- Tonight marked the eighth time SDSU has held its opponent in the 40s in its last 14 home games.
- The Aztecs made 10 from three-point distance. They made a season-low two the entire game at Boise State on Sunday.
- San Diego State shot 50 percent from three (10-for-20), a game after connecting on a season-low 10.5 percent at Boise State.
- The Aztecs are 42-1 in their last 43 home games vs. non-top-25 teams.
- SDSU has won 21 straight Mountain West home games.
- San Diego State has not allowed an opponent to hit the 60-point mark in any of its 14 home games this season.
- The Aztecs held their ninth opponent this season to below 20 points in the first half.
- SDSU scored 36 points in the first half. The Aztecs had 18 points at Boise State and 46 for the game.
- The 14 first-half points allowed by San Diego State were the third-fewest allowed by the Aztecs this season and the fewest the Cowboys have scored this season.

Trends

- San Diego State improves to 17-0 this season when leading at halftime.
- SDSU improves to 14-3 this season when outrebounding its opponent.
- The Aztecs improve to 18-0 this season and have won their last 138 games when leading with five minutes to play.

Player Notes

Aqeel Quinn – 18 points (6-10 FG, 4-5 3FG), 3 rebounds, 3 assists, 2 steals

Rebounded from his five-point effort at Boise State with 18 points... He has reached double digits in scoring in eight of his last nine games... He has 12 double-figure scoring efforts on the year and 24 in his career... Led the team (tied) in scoring for the 10th time this year... Was 4-for-5 from behind the three-point arc... Prior to tonight, he was 0-for-7 in his last two games combined... SDSU improved to 7-2 this season (13-2 in Aztec career) when he connects on multiple three-point baskets... Had three assists, which was one off his season high.

Winston Shepard – 18 points, (7-13 FG, 2-3 3FG), 1 rebound, 3 assists, 2 steals

Reached double figures in scoring for the second straight game (15th time this season and 45th time of his career)... Led the team (tied) in scoring for the seventh time of the season and the 14th time of his career... Tied his season high with two three-pointers... He has made multiple three-pointers once this season and twice in his career with SDSU going 2-0 in those games... SDSU improved to 12-1 this season when he has multiple assists; he finished with three... Matched his career high with seven field goals... Had two steals, which was one off his season high.

Angelo Chol – 3 points, 7 rebounds

Led the team in rebounding for the third time this season.
