

**(rv/rv) SDSU Aztecs****2014-15 Record: 16-5; 6-2 MW****Five Straight NCAA Appearances, Eight-Time MW Champions**

- The Aztecs have won at least 20 games in a school record nine straight seasons and 23 or more in six consecutive seasons.
- San Diego State has advanced to postseason play each of the last nine seasons (2006 NCAA, 2007-09 NIT, 2010-14 NCAA).

**Trends:**

- San Diego State is 5th nationally in winning percentage since the beginning of 2010-11, trailing Wichita State, Kansas, Gonzaga and Duke (through Jan. 28).
- San Diego State has won its last 135 games when leading with five minutes to play.

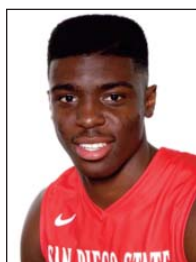
