#### #AztecWBB Closes Out Homestand against CSUN Saturday

San Diego State wraps up its two-game homestand on Saturday when it entertains CSUN at 2 p.m. PT inside Viejas Arena. A live video stream of the Aztecs-Matadors clash will be available on GoAztecs.com, with SDSU alumnus Chris Ello handling the play-by-play responsibilities.

The Aztecs are coming off a tough 69-48 loss on Thursday to Washington, which received votes in both the AP and coaches polls earlier this week and entered the contest averaging over 87 points per game. SDSU was led by senior Kristina Hunter, who scored 12 points on 6-of-10 shooting to go along with seven rebounds. The Aztecs also received a boost from sophomore Ariell Bostick, who finished with 10 points and a game-high three steals in her first appearance of the season after suffering a knee injury last February, while freshman McKynzie Fort contributed 10 points of her own. On the flip side, CSUN won for the eighth time in 10 outings on Thursday with a 77-71 come-from-behind victory over Northern Arizona on the road.

Despite the relative proximity of both schools, SDSU will be facing the Matadors for just the 11th time in school history. The Aztecs hold an 8-2 advantage in the series, including a 5-0 mark in San Diego. However, CSUN registered a 71-52 triumph at The Matadome in the last meeting between the two programs back in December of 2003.

Saturday's showdown will be SDSU's third of four scheduled encounters with Big West opponents this season. The Aztecs dropped a 74-62 decision to Long Beach State in the second game of the year on Nov. 16, before rebounding with a 64-58 victory over UC Santa Barbara on Dec. 7. After engaging the Matadors, SDSU will head north to the Inland Empire to battle UC Riverside on Tuesday, Dec. 23, to close out its non-conference slate.

The Aztecs have emerged triumphant in 14 of its last 16 meetings against current members of the Big West. In addition to the aforementioned loss to Long Beach State, SDSU suffered a narrow 68-66 defeat to UC Irvine at home during that span in November 2010.

Entering the weekend, the Aztecs find themselves among the top half of the Mountain West in several categories, including three-point field goal percentage defense (2nd - .284), rebounding defense (2nd - 35.9/gm), rebounding margin (4th - (+2.3)) and field-goal percentage (5th - (.403)).

Individually, Hunter and junior Deidra Smith are tied for the 10th spot in the league with seven blocks apiece, while junior Erimma Amarikwa ranks 12th with 6.4 rebounds per contest.

## Scouting the Matadors

CSUN (8-2) is off to its best 10-game start in its Division I history after rallying for a 77-71 victory at Northern Arizona on Thursday. In that contest, the Matadors were led by reigning Big West Player of the Year Ashlee Guay, who tossed in 24 points, highlighted by a 3-for-5 effort from three-point territory, while Janae Sharpe added 20 points, including eight free throws. CSUN trailed by as many as nine points in the first half, before taking the lead for good, 69-68, on a jumper by Cinnamon Lister with 4:06 left in the game.

For the season, the Matadors are shooting 39.5 percent from the field, including a 30.5 percent clip from beyond the arc and 74.1 percent from the charity stripe, which ranks 35th in the country. CSUN also finds itself among the national leaders in turnovers committed, landing in the 40th spot this weekend with an average of just 13.8 miscues per game.

Individually, the Matadors have been paced by the senior duo of Sharpe (15.5 ppg) and Guay (15.3 ppg), who also share the team lead with 3.8 assists per contest, while Lister (13.3 ppg) has been averaging double digits in scoring as well. Lister and Guay are CSUN's main three-point threats, combining for 36 of the team's 62 triples, while senior Camille Mahlknect tops the squad in rebounding (9.6/gm), field-goal percentage (.507) and blocks (2.8/gm), which ranks 23rd in the nation.

Guay is one of two San Diego area natives on the Matador roster, joining sophomore Emily Cole, who has played in all 10 games as a reserve. Guay graduated from the Academy of Our Lady of Peace in 2011, while Cole is a 2013 alumnus of West Hills High School.

Head coach Jason Flowers is in his fifth season at the helm of the CSUN program and has amassed a 63-73 overall record. During the 2013-14 campaign, Flowers guided the Matadors to the Big West regular-season and tournament title to earn that conference's Coach of the Year award for the second time in three seasons.

Stacie Terry has coached against CSUN on one previous occasion during her first year as an assistant at UCLA, as her Bruin squad captured a 96-53 decision in November 2008.

### With a Victory...

An SDSU win over CSUN on Saturday will mean:

- The Aztecs move to 3-2 at home this season.
- SDSU raises its all-time record to 9-2 against the Matadors.
- The Aztecs improve to 35-15 in December games since 2006.
- SDSU wins for the 15th time in its last 17 meetings against Big West opponents.

### The Last Time Out: Aztecs-Washington

Despite limiting the nation's seventh-best scoring offense to its lowest output of the season, San Diego State came up short in a 69-48 defeat to Washington on Thursday night at Viejas Arena.

The Aztecs fought valiantly, but were unable to contain the individual exploits of Husky guard Kelsey Plum, who led all scorers with 30 points on 12-of-21 shooting, including a 4-for-8 clip from three-point range.

With the loss, SDSU falls to 3-6 on the season, while Washington, which benefited from two timely second-half runs, raises its record to 9-1 overall.

The Huskies shot 59 percent from the field after intermission (17-29) to break open a tight game, while the Aztecs experienced the opposite fate, connecting on just 28 percent of its attempts from the floor in the second half (9-28). In addition to 18 turnovers, which Washington converted into 19 points, SDSU's woes were compounded by a 2-for-17 effort from beyond the arc, along with a 42-26 scoring deficiency in the paint.

Still, the Aztecs managed to keep things close during the first 32 minutes of the contest, thanks in part to the play of sophomore Ariell Bostick, who made her first appearance since suffering a devastating knee injury last February. The SDSU guard finished with 10 points and a game-best three steals off the bench, joining senior Khristina Hunter (12 pts.) and freshman McKynzie Fort (10 pts.), who reached double figures as well. Hunter also grabbed seven rebounds to tie junior Erimma Amarikwa (7 pts.) for team-high honors.

Conversely, Plum's heroics were buffeted by Jazmine Davis (9 assists), who scored 12 of her 16 points in the second half, while teammate Aminah Williams added 11 points and a game-best nine rebounds to help the Huskies secure their ninth consecutive victory.

The two sides plodded through a defensive struggle in the first half, combining to make just 38 percent of their field-goal attempts (20-53). With the score tied at 12-12 midway through the opening period, Fort drained a jumper, while Hunter followed a layup to give

the Aztecs their biggest lead of the night, before the Huskies reeled off eight straight points, capped by a Talia Walton basket, to vault in front for good at 20-16.

Shortly thereafter, Fort nailed two additional jumpers sandwiched around an Amarikwa free throw to pull the host school to within 22-21 at the 2:26 mark, but two quick layups by Plum short-circuited SDSU's momentum.

After Aztec junior Deidra Smith sank one of two free throws in the closing seconds of the first period, Washington methodically gave itself some breathing room over the first 12 minutes of the second half, utilizing a 19-10 run to increase its advantage to 45-32.

SDSU tried to rally as five quick points by Bostick and an Amarikwa foul shot trimmed the margin to 45-38 with 8:17 to go. However, Washington put the game out of reach with a 15-2 flurry over the next 4:25, punctuated by Plum's back-to-back triples and a Davis jumper.

Despite sinking six straight free throws down the stretch, the Aztecs were unable to match the Huskies' firepower for the remainder of the game, converting just two of their final 14 field-goal attempts, which ultimately sealed their fate.

### Noting the Washington Game

■ The Aztecs posted their highest free-throw percentage of the season (.714) after draining 10 of 14 attempts from the charity stripe.

■ For just the second time this season, SDSU finished with more offensive rebounds (14-11) than the opposition.

■ With her three takeaways, Ariell Bostick has recorded at least one steal in five straight games dating back to last year and in 17 of 24 career outings.

■ McKynzie Fort posted her sixth double-digit scoring performance of the year and attempted a season-high 12 field goals.

■ Freshman A.J. Hawley made her first appearance as an Aztec in the second half.

### Welcome to the Club

Senior Khristina Hunter and junior Erimma Amarikwa each surpassed 500-point barrier for their careers earlier this season. Amarikwa achieved the milestone with a 15-point performance against Idaho State at the San Juan Shootout on Nov. 27, while Hunter

accomplished the feat with a basket and a free throw at USD on Dec. 9. In addition, the Fairfield, Calif., native eclipsed the 400-rebound plateau with eight boards against the Toreros.

Elsewhere, senior Desi Culberson (430) is also on pace to reach 500 career points before the season ends, junior while Ahjalee Harvey recently notched her 100th field goal in an Aztec uniform.

### Decembers to Remember

The Aztecs are a combined 34-15 during the month of December since 2006. Eight of those losses came to teams either ranked or receiving votes in the national poll, including a defeat to Washington (rv) on Thursday, following a pair of setbacks to No. 23 Texas A&M and North Carolina State (rv) last season. The Aztecs have also come up short in previous years against No. 2 UConn, No. 7 Texas A&M, No. 14 Oklahoma State, No. 17 George Washington and USC (rv). The other six defeats were against UCLA in 2013, at Washington in 2012, at Washington State and against USD in 2011, vs. Pepperdine in overtime in 2009 and against Quinnipiac in the opener of the 2007 Surf 'N Slam. Of course, it should be noted that SDSU has played 36 of those 49 December contests at home.

### Fort Named Top MW Preseason Freshman; Aztecs Picked Seventh

San Diego State point guard McKynzie Fort was tabbed as the Mountain West Preseason Freshman of the Year in a combined vote of the league's 11 head coaches and select media members on Oct. 14.

Fort is the fifth consecutive Aztec player to garner top MW preseason freshman accolades, following in the respective paths of Chloe Johnson, Deajanae Scurry and Desi Culberson, as well as Melissa Sweat, who received such distinction prior to the 2010-11 campaign.

Fort, who led the powerful Etiwanda High School program to the Southern Regional finals of the CIF playoffs as a senior last season, was a first-team all-state selection and Baseline League most valuable player honoree before earning all-area recognition by the *Los Angeles Times*.

As a team, SDSU was predicted to finish seventh in the preseason poll released by the conference office. SDSU earned 134 points from the panel, trailing UNLV (143 pts.) by just nine points for sixth place.

Defending regular-season champion Colorado State was picked to repeat after receiving 21 of 28 first-place votes and 276 points, comfortably ahead of Boise State, which received four first-place votes and 241 points, while Wyoming was slotted for the third position with three first-place votes and 235 points.

This year marks the first time since the beginning of the 2007-08 campaign that SDSU has not been selected to finish among the top three places in the MW preseason rankings.

### Noting the Newcomers

In addition to McKynzie Fort, the Aztecs' highly touted freshman class includes two other former prep stars in Cheyenne Greenhouse (Riverside, Calif.) and Lexy Thorderson (Castle Rock, Colo.), both of whom could play significant roles in SDSU's fortunes this season. Greenhouse was a first-team all-CIF selection after leading Canyon Springs High to the Division I state championship as a senior in 2013-14. She also collected the Inland Empire League's most valuable player award and received first-team all-conference recognition for the fourth straight year.

Thorderson, meanwhile, garnered numerous postseason accolades at Rock Canyon High, where she finished her prep career as the school's all-time leading scorer. A nominee for the McDonald's All-America team, Thorderson led the state of Colorado in 3-point field goals made as a senior, earning second-team class 5A all-state distinction.

SDSU also solidified its depth for the 2015-16 season after junior Kym Ellison (Georgia Tech) and sophomore Geena Gomez (St. Joseph's) transferred to The Mesa in the summer of 2014. The two players will not be eligible to compete this season due to NCAA rules, but will serve as valuable assets to the team in practice.

### 2013-14 Rewind

After winning a program-record 27 games and capturing its second straight Mountain West regular-season championship, San

Diego State faced a year of transition during the 2013-14 campaign. Not only did the Aztecs have to adjust to a brand new coaching staff, but they were also forced to overcome the loss of four senior starters who accounted for 64 percent of the team's scoring from the previous year. With five newcomers on board, growing pains were certainly inevitable. However, SDSU flashed its resiliency throughout the season, finishing with a 13-17 overall record and tying for sixth in the MW standings with a 9-9 mark. Below are some additional obstacles the Aztecs endured last year:

- SDSU had to replace two starters, Erimma Amarikwa and Ahjalee Harvey, who were lost for the year after suffering injuries during the non-conference schedule. As a result, the Aztecs employed 10 different starting lineups last season compared to just three in 2012-13.
- In addition, SDSU was faced with a difficult schedule featuring nine games against teams that advanced to postseason competition, including four squads that finished among the AP Top 25: South Carolina, Texas A&M, North Carolina State and USC.
- SDSU dropped four very close games during the non-conference slate by an average of three points in losses to Sacramento State, USC, San Diego and UCLA.

Despite these tribulations, the gritty Aztecs found success on the court during the 2013-14 campaign. Below are a few of the accomplishments of last year's squad:

- SDSU led the Mountain West as team in rebounding margin (+7.6) and rebounding defense (33.1/game).
- The Aztecs also ranked second in the conference in field-goal percentage (.419) and offensive rebounds (15.3/game).
- SDSU averaged over 40 rebounds per contest (40.6) for the third straight season, representing its longest stretch since a six-year span from 1984-89.
- The Aztecs handed two-time defending MW tournament champion Fresno State its only home loss in conference play with a 70-69 upset on a late basket by Danesha Long. Coupled with a win at Fresno in 2013, SDSU is the only MW team to defeat the Bulldogs twice on the road in the past two years.
- The Aztecs topped the 80-point barrier in back-to-back conference games for the first time since joining the Mountain West after scoring 88 points in consecutive home victories over San José State and Utah State.
- Elsewhere, Stacie Terry tied for the second-highest victory total (13) ever by a first-year SDSU head coach in program history.

### 2014-15 By the Numbers

With a new season already underway, below are a few trends to watch for the remainder of the 2014-15 campaign:

- SDSU has claimed 37 of its last 49 home games and has gone 69-24 (.742) on the Viejas Arena floor since the start of the 2008-09 campaign.
- The Aztecs have recorded 65 Mountain West victories in the last six seasons after posting 31 wins in the league's first nine years.
- SDSU is 65-1 over the last three-plus seasons when leading with five minutes to go in the game, including its victory over UC Santa Barbara on Dec. 7. The Aztecs' lone blemish during that stretch was a heartbreaking 59-58 defeat at Washington in December 2012.
- SDSU is 34-15 in December games dating back to the 2006-07 campaign, with eight of those losses coming against teams either ranked or receiving votes in the national polls.
- The Aztecs have advanced to finals of the MW Championship in five of the last seven years after not winning a single game in the tournament's first eight years of existence.
- For the second straight season, SDSU will play 18 conference games. The Aztecs will complete a home-and-away slate with eight squads, while facing San José State (home) and Utah State (away) just once.

### SDSU Holds Groundbreaking Ceremony for Jeff Jacobs JAM Center

San Diego State held a ceremonial groundbreaking for the Jeff Jacobs JAM Center, the men's and women's basketball

performance center, on Aug. 27. The JAM Center is scheduled to be completed by August 2015 and in time for the start of the 2015-16 campaign.

SDSU President Dr. Elliot Hirshman, men's hoops head coach Steve Fisher and Jeff Jacobs spoke before a selected group of invited guests, which included Steve and Lisa Altman, and Jim and Susan Morris, as well as members of both the Aztec men's and women's basketball programs. The master of ceremonies for the event was the voice of San Diego State men's basketball, Ted Leitner.

Preliminary site work started in July where the Jeff Jacobs JAM Center will be located, just south of the Fowler Athletics Center and east of the football practice fields. The facility, which will support the continued growth and development of the SDSU men's and women's basketball teams, includes two full-length courts, eight baskets, locker rooms, film rooms, team lounges, athletic training room and coaches locker rooms.

Hundreds of supporters contributed to the effort to make the Jeff Jacobs JAM Center a reality. In addition to the naming gift from Jeff Jacobs, Hal and Debby Jacobs, Steve and Lisa Altman and Jim Morris, creating the name "JAM" Center, sizeable donations were made from the Manna Charitable Foundation and the Walter and Betty Zable Foundation. The total cost of the project is \$14.5 million, of which \$12.5 million in private funding has been raised. No state funds will be used to construct this building.

The project was designed by JCY Architecture and is being built by The Hunt Construction Group.

# STACIE TERRY

## Head Coach Second Season UT Arlington (1998)

San Diego native Stacie Terry was named the eighth head coach in the history of the San Diego State women's basketball program on May 15, 2013.

During her first season on Montezuma Mesa, Terry was saddled with the unenviable task of replacing four senior starters who accounted for nearly 64 percent of the team's scoring offense from the previous year, as well as overcoming the loss of two key players - forward Erimma Amarikwa, a preseason all-Mountain West selection, and starting point guard Ahjalee Harvey - to injuries prior to conference play.

Despite those obstacles and a demanding schedule featuring nine games with teams that eventually advanced to postseason competition, Terry's squad flashed its resiliency during the 2013-14 campaign, finishing with a 13-17 overall record and a 9-9 mark in the MW.

Under Terry's guidance, the Aztecs led the league in rebounding margin and rebounding defense, while ranking second in field-goal percentage.

Individually, Terry also oversaw the progress of senior center Cierra Warren, who became the fifth SDSU player in the last six years to receive first-team all-MW recognition.

Prior to her arrival on The Mesa, Terry gained a wealth of experience as an assistant coach at the Division I level for 14 years, including five under head coach Nikki Caldwell, who transformed UCLA into a powerhouse before restoring LSU to national prominence.

During Terry's two seasons at LSU, the Lady Tigers compiled a 45-23 overall record and earned two NCAA tournament bids, including a Sweet 16 appearance during the 2012-13 campaign. During that season, the Lady Tigers also posted six victories against ranked opponents and finished with their second-highest scoring average (69.0) in the last seven years. Under Terry's guidance, forward LaShondra Barrett garnered first-team all-Southeastern Conference accolades and received honorable mention All-America distinction in 2012 before becoming a first-round draft choice of the WNBA's Washington Mystics.

Prior to her appointment at LSU, Terry served as an assistant under Caldwell at UCLA from 2008-11, helping the Bruins gain national acclaim with a pair of NCAA tournament appearances. During Terry's tenure, UCLA posted 72 overall victories, as the 2010-11 squad finished with a 28-5 record, setting a school record for fewest losses in a single season to go with a No. 7 national ranking. In addition, the Bruins signed the fourth-ranked recruiting class that season, according to ESPN HoopGurlz, while Terry helped mentor first-team all-Pac-10 performers in Doreena Campbell, Darxia Morris and Jasmine Dixon, a 2012 honorable mention AP All-America selection, as well as all-conference freshman honorees Atonye Nyingifa and Markel Walker.

Terry spent the 2007-08 campaign at Southern Mississippi, as the Golden Eagles posted a 21-14 record and

earned a postseason berth in the Women's National Invitation Tournament (WNIT). While at Southern Miss, Terry spearheaded the development and coordination of the Lady Eagle recruiting campaign. Her responsibilities also included working with the perimeter players, scouting opponents and film breakdown, as well as coordinating all of the team's community service events.

Terry also coached for three seasons from 2004-07 as an assistant under Hall of Fame head coach Theresa Greutz at Illinois, where the Fighting Illini had three straight recruiting classes ranked among the top 25 in the nation, according to Blue Star Basketball, and made three consecutive trips to the WNIT. Her primary duties included defensive instruction and working with the perimeter players.

In addition, Terry coached at Dayton during the 2003-04 season following a three-year stint at Louisville from 2000-03. With the Cardinals, Terry's responsibilities encompassed recruiting, scouting, player development, summer camps and serving as a liaison for the program's community service outreach. Louisville captured the Conference USA regular-season title and earned a trip to the NCAA tournament in 2001 before making a WNIT appearance in 2002. She also assisted in signing the nation's 21st-ranked recruiting class in 2002-03, according to All-Star Girls Report. Terry recruited and coached all-Conference USA honoree Lori Nero, a draft choice of the WNBA's Houston Comets, as well as Sara Nord, who finished her collegiate career as the Cardinals' all-time assist leader and ranks among the top 15 scorers in school history.

Terry enjoyed a successful collegiate playing career at the University of Texas at Arlington, winning four varsity letters from 1994-98 under head coach Mike Dean. She earned first-team all-Southland Conference honors after leading the Mavericks in scoring with 17.4 points per game as a senior in 1997-98. Terry scored 1,169 points during her career at UTA and still ranks among the school's top 10 in three-point field goals made (third), assists (sixth), steals (seventh) and free-throw percentage (10th). She is just one of 17 players in Maverick history to surpass the 1,000-point plateau, while her .335 career three-point field-goal percentage is also a school and Southland Conference career record.

Terry played one season of professional basketball in Warsaw, Poland, averaging 12.0 points and 6.0 assists with the Polonia Phoenix, before returning to UT Arlington to begin her coaching career as a graduate assistant in 1999.

Terry prepped at El Capitan High and held the Vaqueros' career scoring record for three years following her graduation. She was inducted into the school's athletic hall of fame in 2008.
