#AztecWBB Set for Sunday Showdown with UCSB

After an eight-day hiatus, San Diego State returns to the court on Sunday when it plays host to UC Santa Barbara at Viejas Arena. Opening tip is set for 2 p.m. PT. A live video stream of the Aztecs-Gauchos clash will be available via the Mountain West Network on GoAztecs.com, with SDSU alumnus Chris Ello handling the play-by-play responsibilities.

Sunday's contest has also been designated Dads and Daughters Day, which features a free poster giveaway, commemorative photos and a postgame autograph session by the Aztec players.

SDSU has been idle since Thanksgiving weekend when it posted a 1-1 record at the 2014 San Juan Shootout in Guaynabo, Puerto Rico. The Aztecs opened with a 68-53 triumph over Idaho State, before falling to Michigan by a 70-50 count. Meanwhile, UCSB has lost seven straight to open the 2014-15 campaign after dropping an 81-55 decision to Washington State on Thursday.

SDSU will be facing the Gauchos for the third consecutive season after recording a 68-45 conquest at home in the first round of the WNIT in March 2013, followed by a 71-67 comeback win on the road last year, which gave Stacie Terry her first career victory as a head coach. The Aztecs sport a 16-6 all-time record in 22 varsity meetings against UCSB, including a 10-2 mark in San Diego.

SDSU is 97-84 overall against current members of the Big West Conference, including a 13-2 ledger in its last 15 meetings against that league dating back to the 2007-08 campaign. The Aztecs' only two defeats to Big West opponents during that stretch occurred at Vieias Arena against UC Irvine (2010) and Long Beach State (2014).

Through six games this season, freshman McKynzie Fort leads SDSU with 10.5 points and 2.5 assists per contest, while junior Erimma Amarikwa tops the squad with 6.5 rebounds per outing. Amarikwa recently surpassed the 500-point barrier for her career after posting a team-high 15 points off the bench against Idaho State. The Aztecs have also received important contributions from junior Ahialee Harvey, who has connected on a team-best 9-of-16 three-pointers (.563), while freshman Cheyenne Greenhouse has two double-digit scoring performances to her credit, including a team-high 13-point effort vs. Michigan on Nov. 29.

SDSU will play its next six games in Southern California, before leaving the Pacific time zone to open Mountain West play at Air Force on Dec. 31.

Scouting the Gauchos

UC Santa Barbara (0-7) is still searching for its first victory of the 2014-15 campaign after suffering an 81-55 defeat at the hands of Washington State at home on Thursday. In that game, senior guard Clair Watkins posted a career-high 18 points, while freshman forward Chaya Durr added a personal-best 10 points and five steals in just her second start in a Gaucho uniform.

For the season, Watkins leads UCSB with an average of 8.6 points and 7.0 rebounds per game, while point guard Onome Jemerigbe (8.1 ppg), an all-Big West freshman selection from a year ago, tops the squad with 2.7 assists per outing. In addition, freshman guard Makala Roper has been the Gauchos' main long-range threat, draining 11 of 32 shots (34.3 percent) from three-point territory. However, the rest of the team has converted just 4 of 52 tries from beyond the arc for a collective 17.9 percent (15-84).

UCSB has not fared much better from the rest of the floor, connecting on 28.2 percent of its overall field-goal attempts, while averaging just 44.6 points per game. Despite their offensive woes, the Gauchos are allowing opponents 62.1 points per contest, which ranks third in the Big West entering the weekend.

Now in her third year, head coach Carlene Mitchell has compiled a 41-62 record at the helm of the UCSB program, highlighted by a Big West tournament title and an NCAA appearance in 2012. Prior to her arrival on the Isla Vista campus, Mitchell served as an assistant for 10 seasons at Rutgers, including the final three as associate head coach under the tutelage of Hall of Famer C. Vivian Stringer.

A starting point guard at her alma mater Kansas State during her senior season in 1995-96, Mitchell also held assistant coaching positions at UMKC, Western Illinois and Oklahoma State before moving on to Rutgers.

Freshman forward Sabrina Callahan has San Diego ties, earning four varsity letters at La Jolla Country Day School from 2011-14.

With a Victory...

Flashback: Aztecs-Gauchos - 2013 Thunderdome Edition

San Diego State received double-digit scoring totals from four players and overcame a nine-point deficit early in the second half to fuel a 71-67 road win over UC Santa Barbara in its last visit to The Thunderdome on Nov. 30, 2013.

Cierra Warren led the Aztecs with 21 points on 9-for-10 shooting and pulled down a game-high seven rebounds, while Deidra Smith added career-best 12 points on 5-of-6 field goal attempts, as Stacie Terry picked up her first career victory as a head coach.

In addition, the SDSU cause was aided by Ariell Bostick, who contributed 11 points, including five clutch free throws in the second half, while Deajanae Scurry registered 10 points, six rebounds and two steals.

As a team, the Aztecs shot a blistering 65.9 percent from the floor, connecting on 27 of 41 shots, including a 70.6 percent clip (12-17) in the second half, while sinking 15 of 20 foul shots to help snap a four-game losing streak.

Still, the Gauchos gave the Aztecs everything they could handle and more as the two sides battled through 16 lead changes and seven ties. UCSB drained nine three-pointers on the afternoon, including six in the first half to build a 39-33 lead by intermission.

Nicole Nesbit led all players with 22 points, including a 5-for-8 effort from beyond the arc, while Destini Mason (20 pts) and Melissa Zornig (14 pts) finished in double figures for the Gauchos as well.

With the Aztecs trailing 16-14, Scurry hit a pair of jumpers during a 12-2 run that put the visitors up 26-18 by the 7:38 mark of the first half. However, a free throw by Onome Jemerigbe and consecutive three-pointers by Zornig and Nesbit sparked a 21-7 Gaucho outburst to close out the period.

SDSU committed five turnovers during that stretch, while UCSB sank 6-of-9 shots from the floor, including a Mason triple just before the halftime buzzer.

Following the break, Nesbit added to the Aztecs woes by draining another trey, which provided the host school with its biggest lead of the contest at 42-33 and forced a quick SDSU timeout with just 23 seconds elapsed in the second half.

The sideline huddle seemed to spark the Aztecs, who promptly reeled off six straight points on a pair of Smith baskets sandwiched around a layup by Danesha Long to pull within 42-39 at the 17:37 mark.

Mi'Chael Wright converted an old-fashioned three-point play on the Gauchos next possession, but SDSU answered with a pivotal 21-11 surge over the ensuing 10 minutes as a banked triple by Ahialee Harvey provided the Scarlet and Black a 60-53 cushion with 7:37 left. Warren scored 11 straight points during the run, including her first career three-pointer, while UCSB misfired on five straight shots

Following a media timeout, the Gauchos scored two quick buckets on a Nesbit triple and a Jemerigbe layup to trim the deficit to two at 60-58 with 5:31 remaining. However, the Aztecs kept UCSB at bay and eventually reclaimed a seven-point advantage at 69-62 after Bostick converted an and-one opportunity with just 1:34 left.

Still, the Gauchos managed to make things interesting down the stretch as a quick three-pointer by Zornig and a basket by Nesbit inched the hosts closer at 69-67 with 55 seconds to go. The two teams then traded possessions before Bostick and Harvey each sank one of two free throws during the final 19 seconds to secure the victory. In the interim however, the SDSU faithful was on the edge of its seats as a potential game-tying three-pointer by Nesbit from the top of the key went awry

Last Time Out: Aztecs-Michigan

San Diego State suffered a 70-50 defeat at the hands of Michigan to close out the 2014 San Juan Shootout on Nov. 29. The Aztecs (2-4) were unable to withstand the Wolverines' lethal combination of Siera Thompson and Katelynn Flaherty, who combined for 48 points and 11 three-point field goals on the afternoon.

In addition, SDSU was once again bitten by the turnover bug, as Michigan (5-1) converted 19 turnovers into 22 points to help secure its victory. Despite owning a 22-14 advantage in the paint, the Aztecs were also outrebounded by a 35-23 margin, including a 13-6 spread on the offensive glass.

As a team, SDSU shot 42.2 percent from the field (19-45), compared to the Wolverines' 45.1 percent clip (23-51). However, Michigan did most of its damage from long range, draining 12 of 23 three-pointers (52.2 percent) to keep the Aztecs in pursuit mode throughout the game.

Individually, Thompson finished with a game-high 25 points, featuring a 5-for-9 performance from beyond the arc while sinking all eight of her free-throw attempts. Flaherty was equally devastating to the SDSU psyche after totaling 23 points, highlighted by a 6-for-10 effort from three-point territory, while teammate Cyesha

Goree posted game highs of eight rebounds and four steals.

Conversely, Cheyenne Greenhouse was the lone Aztec in double figures, posting 13 points on 6-of-9 shooting to go with four rebounds, while senior Khristina Hunter contributed nine points and five boards of her own.

SDSU, which never led in the contest, found itself facing a pair of 15-point deficits in the first half, including a 32-17 spread at the 6:17 mark following Flaherty's second triple of the day. However, the Aztecs gradually climbed back into contention, fashioning a 16-7 spurt over the remainder of the period to pull within 39-33 by intermission. Ahjalee Harvey and sophomore Aleiah Brandon each buried a triple during that span, while Greenhouse added an old-fashioned three-point play to help resuscitate SD-SU's fortunes.

The Aztecs sustained their new-found momentum in the early moments of the second half, as two Hunter free throws and a layup by Chloe Johnson brought the Scarlet and Black to within striking distance at 39-37 with 16:50 remaining. However, SD-SU's long haul back into contention was quickly subdued after Michigan unleashed an 11-1 blitz over the ensuing four minutes to seize control of the game. Goree sparked the run with a threepoint play, while Flaherty drained a pair of treys on consecutive possessions.

The Aztecs trimmed the margin to single digits on three occasions, including a 57-48 spread following a Brandon jumper with 7:23 to go. However, Michigan responded with three quick triples by Flaherty, Madison Ristovski and Thompson to extinguish SD-SU's faint comeback hopes. The Aztecs didn't exactly help their cause down the stretch either, connecting on just one of their final eight field goal attempts while committing two turnovers.

Decembers to Remember

The Aztecs are a combined 33-13 during the month of December since 2006. Seven of those losses came to teams either ranked or receiving votes in the national poll, including a defeat to No. 23 Texas A&M and a setback to North Carolina State (rv) last year in the final of the San Diego Surf 'N Slam. The Aztecs have also come up short in previous years against No. 2 UConn, No. 7 Texas A&M, No. 14 Oklahoma State, No. 17 George Washington and USC (rv). The other six defeats were against UCLA in 2013, at Washington in 2012, at Washington State and against USD in 2011, vs. Pepperdine in overtime in 2009 and against Quinnipiac in the opener of the 2007 Surf 'N Slam. Of course, it should be noted that SDSU has played 34 of those 46 December contests at home.

Fort Named Top MW Preseason Freshman; Aztecs Picked Seventh

San Diego State point guard McKynzie Fort was tabbed as the Mountain West Preseason Freshman of the Year last month in a combined vote of the league's 11 head coaches and select media members.

Fort is the fifth consecutive Aztec player to garner top MW preseason freshman accolades, following in the respective paths of Chloe Johnson, Deajanae Scurry and Desi Culberson, as well as Melissa Sweat, who received such distinction prior to the 2010-11 campaign.

Fort, who led the powerful Etiwanda High School program to the Southern Regional finals of the CIF playoffs as a senior last season, was a first-team all-state selection and Baseline League most valuable player honoree before earning all-area recognition by the *Los Angeles Times*.

As a team, SDSU was predicted to finish seventh in the preseason poll released by the conference office. SDSU earned 134 points from the panel, trailing UNLV (143 pts.) by just nine points for sixth place.

Defending regular-season champion Colorado State was picked to repeat after receiving 21 of 28 first-place votes and 276 points, comfortably ahead of Boise State, which received four first-place votes and 241 points, while Wyoming was slotted for the third position with three first-place votes and 235 points.

This year marks the first time since the beginning of the 2007-08 campaign that SDSU has not been selected to finish among the top three places in the MW preseason rankings.

Noting the Newcomers

In addition to McKynzie Fort, the Aztecs' highly touted freshman class includes two other former prep stars in Cheyenne Green-

house (Riverside, Calif.) and Lexy Thorderson (Castle Rock, Colo.), both of whom could play significant roles in SDSU's fortunes this season. Greenhouse was a first-team all-CIF selection after leading Canyon Springs High to the Division I state championship as a senior in 2013-14. She also collected the Inland Empire League's most valuable player award and received first-team all-conference recognition for the fourth straight year.

Thorderson, meanwhile, garnered numerous postseason accolades at Rock Canyon High, where she finished her prep career as the school's all-time leading scorer. A nominee for the McDonald's All-America team, Thorderson led the state of Colorado in 3-point field goals made as a senior, earning second-team class 5A all-state distinction.

SDSU also solidified its depth for the 2015-16 season after junior Kym Ellison (Georgia Tech) and sophomore Geena Gomez (St. Joseph's) transferred to The Mesa in the summer of 2014. The two players will not be eligible to compete this season due to NCAA rules, but will serve as valuable assets to the team in practice.

2013-14 Rewind

After winning a program-record 27 games and capturing its second straight Mountain West regular-season championship, San Diego State faced a year of transition during the 2013-14 campaign. Not only did the Aztecs have to adjust to a brand new coaching staff, but they were also forced to overcome the loss of four senior starters who accounted for 64 percent of the team's scoring from the previous year. With five newcomers on board, growing pains were certainly inevitable. However, SDSU flashed its resiliency throughout the season, finishing with a 13-17 overall record and tying for sixth in the MW standings with a 9-9 mark. Below are some additional obstacles the Aztecs endured last year:

• SDSU had to replace two starters, Erimma Amarikwa and Ahjalee Harvey, who were lost for the year after suffering injuries during the non-conference schedule. As a result, the Aztecs employed 10 different starting lineups last season compared to just three in 2012-13.

• In addition, SDSU was faced with a difficult schedule featuring nine games against teams that advanced to postseason competition, including four squads that finished among the AP Top 25: South Carolina, Texas A&M, North Carolina State and USC.

 SDSU dropped four very close games during the non-conference slate by an average of three points in losses to Sacramento State, USC, San Diego and UCLA.

Despite these tribulations, the gritty Aztecs found success on the court during the 2013-14 campaign. Below are a few of the accomplishments of last year's squad:

• SDSU led the Mountain West as team in rebounding margin (+7.6) and rebounding defense (33.1/game).

 The Aztecs also ranked second in the conference in field-goal percentage (.419) and offensive rebounds (15.3/ game).

 SDSU averaged over 40 rebounds per contest (40.6) for the third straight season, representing its longest stretch since a six-year span from 1984-89.

• The Aztecs handed two-time defending MW tournament champion Fresno State its only home loss in conference play with a 70-69 upset on a late basket by Danesha Long. Coupled with a win at Fresno in 2013, SDSU is the only MW team to defeat the Bulldogs twice on the road in the past two years.

• The Aztecs topped the 80-point barrier in back-to-back conference games for the first time since joining the Mountain West after scoring 88 points in consecutive home victories over San José State and Utah State.

 Elsewhere, Stacie Terry tied for the second-highest victory total (13) ever by a first-year SDSU head coach in program history.

2014-15 By the Numbers

With a new season already underway, below are a few trends to watch in 2014-15:

• SDSU has claimed 36 of its last 47 home games and has gone 68-23 (.747) on the Viejas Arena floor since the start of the 2008-09 campaign.

• The Aztecs have recorded 65 Mountain West victories in the last six seasons after posting 31 wins in the league's first nine years.

• SDSU is 63-1 over the last three-plus seasons when leading with five minutes to go in the game, including its victory over Sacramento State in the 2014-15 opener on Nov. 14. The Aztecs' lone blemish during that stretch was a heartbreaking 59-58 defeat at Washington in December 2012.

• SDSU is 33-13 in December games dating back to the 2006-07 campaign, with seven of those losses coming against teams either ranked or receiving votes in the national polls.

The Aztecs have advanced to finals of the MW Championship in five of the last seven years after not winning a single game in the tournament's first eight years of existence.
 For the second straight season, SDSU will play 18 con-

ference games. The Aztecs will complete a home-and-away slate with eight squads, while facing San José State (home) and Utah State (away) just once.

SDSU Holds Groundbreaking Ceremony for Jeff Jacobs JAM Center

San Diego State held a ceremonial groundbreaking for the Jeff Jacobs JAM Center, the men's and women's basketball performance center, on Aug. 27. The JAM Center is scheduled to be completed by August 2015 and in time for the start of the 2015-16 campaign.

SDSU President Dr. Elliot Hirshman, men's hoops head coach Steve Fisher and Jeff Jacobs spoke before a selected group of invited guests, which included Steve and Lisa Altman, and Jim and Susan Morris, as well as members of both the Aztec men's and women's basketball programs. The master of ceremonies for the event was the voice of San Diego State men's basketball, Ted Leitner.

Preliminary site work started in July where the Jeff Jacobs JAM Center will be located, just south of the Fowler Athletics Center and east of the football practice fields. The facility, which will support the continued growth and development of the SDSU men's and women's basketball teams, includes two full-length courts, eight baskets, locker rooms, film rooms, team lounges, athletic training room and coaches locker rooms.

Hundreds of supporters contributed to the effort to make the Jeff Jacobs JAM Center a reality. In addition to the naming gift from Jeff Jacobs, Hal and Debby Jacobs, Steve and Lisa Altman and Jim Morris, creating the name "JAM" Center, sizeable donations were made from the Manna Charitable Foundation and the Walter and Betty Zable Foundation. The total cost of the project is \$14.5 million, of which \$12.5 million in private funding has been raised. No state funds will be used to construct this building.

The project was designed by JCJ Architecture and is being built by The Hunt Construction Group.

STACIE TERRY

Head Coach Second Season UT Arlington (1998)

S an Diego native Stacie Terry was named the eighth head coach in the history of the San Diego State women's basketball program on May 15, 2013.

During her first season on Montezuma Mesa, Terry was saddled with the unenviable task of replacing four senior starters who accounted for nearly 64 percent of the team's scoring offense from the previous year, as well as overcoming the loss of two key players - forward Erimma Amarikwa, a preseason all-Mountain West selection, and starting point guard Ahjalee Harvey - to injuries prior to conference play.

Despite those obstacles and a demanding schedule featuring nine games with teams that eventually advanced to postseason competition, Terry's squad flashed its resiliency during the 2013-14 campaign, finishing with a 13-17 overall record and a 9-9 mark in the MW.

Under Terry's guidance, the Aztecs led the league in rebounding margin and rebounding defense, while ranking second in field-goal percentage.

Individually, Terry also oversaw the progress of senior center Cierra Warren, who became the fifth SDSU player in the last six years to receive first-team all-MW recognition.

Prior to her arrival on The Mesa, Terry gained a wealth of experience as an assistant coach at the Division I level for 14 years, including five under head coach Nikki Caldwell, who transformed UCLA into a powerhouse before restoring LSU to national prominence.

During Terry's two seasons at LSU, the Lady Tigers compiled a 45-23 overall record and earned two NCAA tournament bids, including a Sweet 16 appearance during the 2012-13 campaign. During that season, the Lady Tigers also posted six victories against ranked opponents and finished with their second-highest scoring average (69.0) in the last seven years. Under Terry's guidance, forward LaShondra Barrett garnered first-team all-Southeastern Conference accolades and received honorable mention All-America distinction in 2012 before becoming a first-round draft choice of the WNBA's Washington Mystics.

Prior to her appointment at LSU, Terry served as an assistant under Caldwell at UCLA from 2008-11, helping the Bruins gain national acclaim with a pair of NCAA tournament appearances. During Terry's tenure, UCLA posted 72 overall victories, as the 2010-11 squad finished with a 28-5 record, setting a school record for fewest losses in a single season to go with a No. 7 national ranking. In addition, the Bruins signed the fourth-ranked recruiting class that season, according to ESPN Hoop-Gurlz, while Terry helped mentor first-team all-Pac-10 performers in Doreena Campbell, Darxia Morris and Jasmine Dixon, a 2012 honorable mention AP All-America selection, as well as all-conference freshman honorees Atonye Nyingifa and Markel Walker.

Terry spent the 2007-08 campaign at Southern Mississippi, as the Golden Eagles posted a 21-14 record and

earned a postseason berth in the Women's National Invitation Tournament (WNIT). While at Southern Miss, Terry spearheaded the development and coordination of the Lady Eagle recruiting campaign. Her responsibilities also included working with the perimeter players, scouting opponents and film breakdown, as well as coordinating all of the team's community service events.

Terry also coached for three seasons from 2004-07 as an assistant under Hall of Fame head coach Theresa Grentz at Illinois, where the Fighting Illini had three straight recruiting classes ranked among the top 25 in the nation, according to Blue Star Basketball, and made three consecutive trips to the WNIT. Her primary duties included defensive instruction and working with the perimeter players.

In addition, Terry coached at Dayton during the 2003-04 season following a three-year stint at Louisville from 2000-03. With the Cardinals, Terry's responsibilities encompassed recruiting, scouting, player development, summer camps and serving as a liaison for the program's community service outreach. Louisville captured the Conference USA regular-season title and earned a trip to the NCAA tournament in 2001 before making a WNIT appearance in 2002. She also assisted in signing the nation's 21st-ranked recruiting class in 2002-03, according to All-Star Girls Report. Terry recruited and coached all-Conference USA honoree Lori Nero, a draft choice of the WNBA's Houston Comets, as well as Sara Nord, who finished her collegiate career as the Cardinals' all-time assist leader and ranks among the top 15 scorers in school history.

Terry enjoyed a successful collegiate playing career at the University of Texas at Arlington, winning four varsity letters from 1994-98 under head coach Mike Dean. She earned first-team all-Southland Conference honors after leading the Mavericks in scoring with 17.4 points per game as a senior in 1997-98. Terry scored 1,169 points during her career at UTA and still ranks among the school's top 10 in three-point field goals made (third), assists (sixth), steals (seventh) and free-throw percentage (10th). She is just one of 17 players in Maverick history to surpass the 1,000-point plateau, while her .335 career three-point field-goal percentage is also a school and Southland Conference career record.

Terry played one season of professional basketball in Warsaw, Poland, averaging 12.0 points and 6.0 assists with the Polonia Phoenix, before returning to UT Arlington to begin her coaching career as a graduate assistant in 1999.

Terry prepped at El Capitan High and held the Vaqueros' career scoring record for three years following her graduation. She was inducted into the school's athletic hall of fame in 2008.
