WHAT'S ON TAP THIS WEEKEND IN AZTEC BASEBALL

- > The SDSU baseball team will open its 2017 Mountain West campaign with a three-game series at Nevada this weekend.
- > That set of contests will get underway on Friday, March 10, at 2:00 p.m. at Peccole Park.
- > Nevada and SDSU will also meet for games on Saturday (March 11) and Sunday (March 12) at 1:00 p.m. and noon respectively.

AZTECS ON THE AIR

- > All three of this weekend's contests at Nevada will have live video streaming on the Mountain West Network along with Live Stats. Links for those broadcasts and stats will be available at the SDSU web site (GoAztecs.com).
- > A total of 14 of SDSU's 31 home games this season will have live video streaming on the Mountain Digital Network with the next one scheduled for Saturday, March 18, vs. UNLV at 1:00 p.m.
- > In addition, nine contests will be broadcast live on ESPN 1700 in San Diego with the remaining 13 carried live on KCR.

SERIES RECORD

- > The Aztecs have a record of 13-23 against Nevada in a series that began in 1986.
- > Last season SDSU went 0-8 against the Wolf Pack, a mark that includes six regular-season losses along with two at the Mountain West Tournament.
- > The Aztecs' last victory over Nevada came during the 2015 Mountain West Tournament in Reno, Nev. The Wolf Pack has won 14 of the last 16 games vs. San Diego State.
- > SDSU has a mark of 6-10 vs. Nevada in San Diego, 3-10 in Reno and 4-3 at neutral sites.

SCOUTING THE WOLF PACK

- > Nevada comes into the weekend with a record of 3-9 overall and 1-2 in Mountain West play after dropping two of three contests at Fresno State last weekend. On Tuesday, they fell at St. Mary's by the score of 4-0.
- > The Wolf Pack is led offensively by third baseman Jordan Pearce (.310, HR, 4 RBI, right fielder Mike Echavia (.308, 4 2B, 5 RBI) and second baseman Keaton Smith (.306, 3 HR, 7 RBI).
- > Nevada has a team batting average of .250 along with a 6.38 earned run average.

ROTATION

- > Senior left-hander Brett Seeburger (2-0, 2.16) will open the Nevada series on the mound Friday afternoon.
- > Seeburger was named a second-team summer collegiate All-American by *Perfect Game* after pitching for the Brazos Valley Bombers in the Texas Collegiate League where he went 5-1 with a 1.01 earned run average.
- > On Saturday, it will be lefty Dominic Purpura (2-0, 4.15) to face the Wolf Pack with Sunday's starter expected to be either Hayden Petrovick (2-0, 2.00) or Logan Boyer (.).

SHEEHAN RETURNS

- > After redshirting during the 2016 season, senior Danny Sheehan has returned for his final year and claimed the starting shortstop role he held in 2015.
- > He is currently on an eight-game hitting streak during which he is batting .333 (10-for-30) with a double, three RBI and six runs scored.
- > After 13 games, he is tied for the team lead with 17 hits and nine RBI.
- > He is also tied for the team lead with two multiple-RBI games and for second with four multiple-hit contests.
- > Sheehan has been hit by pitch four times this season to bring his career total to 17. That ranks 17th on the SDSU all-time top 20 in that category.

VERDON STREAK ENDS

- > First baseman Jordan Verdon had a nine-game hitting streak, the longest by an Aztec this season, come to an end in the series finale vs. Cal Poly on Sunday (Mar. 5).
- > During that streak he went 13-for-37 (.351) with a double, two triples, five RBI and six runs scored.
- > In four games last week, he batted .467 (7-for-15).
- > He hit his team-leading third triple of the season at Long Beach State on Feb. 28.
- > Verdon is the only player in the Mountain West to have recorded more than two three-baggers this season.
- > He is the lone SDSU infielder without an error after 13 games (106 chances).

MARTINEZ SOLID AS DH

- > Senior Andrew Martinez continues to lead the team in batting in the role of designated hitter.
- > Through 13 games, he is hitting .349 with two doubles, a home run and seven RBI.
- > He has also drawn four walks for a .417 on-base percentage.
- > Martinez played the past three seasons at UC Irvine, graduating last year with one season of eligibility remaining after redshirting there one year (2013).
- > The native of nearby Chula Vista (Mater Dei HS), he chose to compete for the Aztecs in his final season.

SAYLOR STANDS TALL ON THE MOUND

- > Senior right-hander CJ Saylor had a hand in each of SDSU's three victories last week, recording saves in three of the Aztecs' four contests.
- > He recorded his second save of the year at Long Beach State on Tuesday (Feb. 28) when he came on in the eighth with the bases loaded for Long Beach State and finished the contest without allowing a run.
- > On Saturday (Mar. 4), he tossed the final inning as the Aztecs defeated Cal Poly, 6-4.
- > In the series finale vs. the Mustangs on Sunday (Mar.5), he again tossed the final inning to notch his fourth save.
- > Saylor has made six appearance this season and has accounted for one victory and four saves.
- > Saylor served as a catcher during the 2014 campaign when he hit .212 in 14 games.
- > As SDSU's closer in 2015, he compiled a record of 3-3 with 11 saves and a 5.02 earned run average.
- > In 2016, Saylor was one of SDSU's primary catchers, appearing in 30 contests and batting .289.
- > Saylor's four saves this season give him a career total of 15, a number that ranks fifth on the all-time Aztec saves list.

BROWN STREAK ENDS

- > Third baseman Andrew Brown had a seven-game hitting streak end in the series finale vs. Cal Poly on Sunday (March 5).
- > During that streak he batted .355 (11-for-31) with two doubles, a home run, six RBI and five runs scored.
- > He singled in the loss to USC on Tuesday and has now hit in eight the SDSU's last nine contests.
- > Brown leads the squad with 17 hits and two home runs. He is tied for the team lead with nine RBI.

PURPURA IMPRESSIVE

- > Senior left-hander Dominic Purpura picked up his second win in three the starts in the victory over Cal Poly last Saturday (Mar. 4) when he tossed five innings and left the game with a 6-4 lead.
- > He got his 2017 season off to a good start by tossing six scoreless innings in the win over Pacific on Feb. 19.
- > In that contest he scattered three hits and did not surrender a walk.
- > His six strikeouts in that game tied his SDSU career high.
- > His second start was a no decision as he went 6.1 innings vs. Notre Dame on Feb 25.
- > Purpura leads the staff in innings pitched (17.1) and has surrendered just two walks while striking out 13.

TREJO COMING ON

- > Over the past five contests, second baseman Alan Trejo has gone 8-for-24 (.333) with two doubles, a home run, three RBI and six runs scored.
- > He hit his first home run of the season last Saturday (Mar. 4) in the win over Cal Poly.
- > Trejo made his third appearance on the mound this season in the contest vs. USC on Tuesday (Mar. 7). He was charged with the loss to the Trojans after surrendering an unearned run in the seventh inning.

PITCHING DOMINATES

- > Over the past five games, the SDSU pitching staff has given up a total of seven runs (six earned), posting a 4-1 record with a 1.00 earned run average.
- > Opponents hit just .215 over the five games with 31 of their 35 hits being singles (other four were doubles).
- > Included in that run was a pair of shutout victories. The Aztecs recorded only one shutout during the 2016 season.

EARLY SCORING

- > Last Sunday's (March 5) contest vs. Cal Poly was the first game this season in which one of the teams did not score in the first inning.
- > Through the first 11 games of the year, either SDSU or its opponent had scored in the opening frame.
- > When the opponent scored in the opening inning, the Aztecs were 3-4.
- > When SDSU scored in the first frame, it has a record of 4-0.

STREAKS

- > Danny Sheehan's current eight-game hitting streak is the second longest for an Aztec this season.
- > Andrew Martinez's five game streak in the second-longest current hitting streak on the team.
- > Two Aztecs have reached base safely (via hit, walk or hit by pitch) in every game including Sheehan and Andrew Martinez.
- > Brown has recorded a team-leading six multiple-hit contests each with Sheehan, Brown, Jordan Verdon and David Hensley having two multiple-RBI games apiece.

AZTECS DEFEAT NO. 7/11 CAL STATE FULLERTON

- > On Tuesday, Feb. 21, the Aztecs did something they had not done since 1977: win a game at Cal State Fullerton as they defeated the Titans, 5-4, at Goodwin Field.
- > Since claiming a win in 1977, SDSU had played 15 contests in Fullerton without a victory.
- > Freshman Hayden Petrovick picked up the win with three late scoreless innings and senior CJ Saylor notched his first save of the year.

PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE

- > Senior left-handed pitcher Dominic Purpura has been tabbed to the Preseason All-Mountain West team in a vote of the league's coaches.
- > Purpura had an overall record of 4-2 with a 3.25 earned run average last season, leading the Aztecs in innings at 69.1.

SUMMER HONORS

- > Fifteen of SDSU's 19 returning players played summer baseball in 2016 in order to hone their talents, and three of them came away with various honors.
- > Brett Seeburger was named a Second Team Summer Collegiate Baseball All-American by Perfect Game after going 5-1 with a 1.01 earned run average for the Brazos Valley Bombers in the Texas Collegiate League.
- > Chase Calabuig (Dodge City A's) was a first-team all-Jayhawk League honoree and the league's Hitter of the Year.
- > Hunter Stratton was named to the Great West League South All-Star Team as a member of the Marysville Gold Sox.

DRAFTED AZTECS

- > Three current members of the SDSU squad have been drafted by Major League clubs.
- > That trio includes senior pitcher CJ Saylor (33rd rd. in 2012, Los Angeles Dodgers) along with junior outfielder Denz'l Chapman (32nd rd. in 2014, Oakland A's) and soph first baseman Jordan Verdon (24th rd. in 2015, New York Mets)

AZTEC NOTES

- > The Aztecs are 7-0 when leading after six or seven innings, and 8-0 when leading after eight.
- > SDSU has committed 11 errors in its first 13 contests for a .978 fielding percentage. The team record for fielding percentage in a season is .978 set during the 2013 campaign.
- > As a team, the Aztecs rank fourth in the Mountain West in hitting at .281. Their 3.49 earned run average ranks second and they are also second in fielding (.978).
- > Catcher Hunter Stratton recorded his first career double in the win over Cal Poly on Sunday (March 5). As a freshman he had a home run in eight at bats and last season had three triples.
- > In his last four relief appearances covering 5.2 innings, Logan Boyer has allowed one hit with eight strikeouts.
