AZTECS SET TO WRAP UP 2013 SEASON

- San Diego State will conclude its 2013 volleyball season with a pair of road matches against Mountain West opposition this week matches.
- ◆ Up first is a contest at Colorado State on Wednesday, Dec. 27, in Moby Arena in Fort Collins, Colo., at 7:30 p.m. (MT).
- Two days later (Friday, Nov. 23), SDSU will face Wyoming at 7:00 p.m. at the UniWyo Sports Complex in Laramie.
- Both of those contests may be viewed live on the Mountain Digital Network with links available at www.GoAztecs.com.

SERIES RECORDS

- The Aztecs' all-time record against Colorado State stands at 15-34 since the teams met in the second round of pool play at the 1980 Association for Intercollegiate Athletics for Women (AIAW) Championships Regionals in Santa Barbara. The Rams have won 23 of the last 24 matches against the Aztecs including a three-set victory in San Diego earlier this season. SDSU's last victory in the series came last season (2012) in a four-set contest in San Diego. The Aztecs are 9-15 vs. the Rams at home, 5-17 away and 1-2 at neutral sites.
- ◆ San Diego State holds a 33-12 lead in its series with Wyoming since the teams first met in 1984. More recently, the Aztecs are 11-10 vs. the Cowgirls since the 2003 season including sweep of both matches vs. UW last season. Wyoming defeated SDSU in four sets in San Diego in mid-October. The Aztecs are 20-2 vs. the Cowgirls in San Diego, 11-10 in Laramie and 2-0 on neutral courts.

HEAD COACH DEITRE COLLINS-PARKER

- ◆ San Diego State head coach Deitre Collins-Parker is in her fifth season with the Aztecs after being named the fourth head coach in program history prior to the 2009 campaign. Her four-year record at SDSU is 86-62 (.581).
- She was named the 2012 Mountain West Coach of the Year after leading the Aztecs to a 23-8 overall record and their first conference title since 1995.
- She previously served as head coach at UNLV for eight seasons (1996-2003) and at Cornell for five years (2004-2008). Her 17-plus year career record stands at 248-253 (.495).
- ♦ A three-time All-American at the University of Hawai'i, she led the Rainbow Wahine to consecutive national titles (1983-84) and was named the national player of the year twice.
- She was a member of the U.S. Olympic Team and competed at the Goodwill Games and Pan Am Games prior to playing professionally in Europe for four years.
- She is one of six players named to the NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball 25th Anniversary Team in October 2005 and was inducted into the AVCA Hall of Fame in the fall of 2008.

SCOUTING THE OPPOSITION

◆ Colorado State enters the week with a record of 27-0 overall and 18-0 in the Mountain West. The Rams are ranked ninth in the nation in this week's AVCA poll and are one of two NCAA Division I teams in the nation (Missouri being the other) that is undefeated this season. CSU is led by Marlee Reynolds (3.10 kps, 0.72 bps) and Adrianna Culbert (2.70 kps, 2.74 dps). As a team the Rams lead the Mountain West in kills, blocks and hitting percentage.

Wyoming's record stands at 19-13 (9-9 MW) with the Cowgirls slated to host UNLV Wednesday evening. UW is led by Reese Plante (2.73 kps, 0.71 bps) and Bridget Shanahan (2.66 kps, 0.83 bps). Erin Kirby (2.42 kps) leads the Mountain West in blocking at 1.75 blocks per set while libero Becky Stewart is the conference leader in digs at 5.16 per set.

SENIOR DAY

- Last Saturday's match against Utah State was Senior Day at SDSU with eight members of the 2013 team honored as they played their final home match.
- That group includes Johnna Fouch, Emily Harris, Summer Nash, Kyla Oropeza, Justine Ricigliano, Christie Ring, Raegan Shelton and Courtney Vaccarello.

SHELTON FINISHING STRONG

- Senior outside hitter Raegan Shelton has been in double figures in kills in eight of the past nine matches and is averaging 3.87 kills per set over that span.
- In last week's two matches (vs. Boise State and Utah State) she averaged 4.17 kills per set and 5.07 points per set to go along with a .400 hitting percentage.
- Shelton made her return from a spell on the sidelines due to injury when she appeared in the final set against Wyoming on Oct. 17, registering a kill and three digs.
- She made her full return as a starter in the ensuing contest vs. Colorado State (Oct. 19) when she led the Aztecs with 11 kills and also had a block and three digs.
- A preseason all-conference selection, Shelton had been out since suffering a broken finger during the NAU Fiesta Bowl Tournament (Sept. 6-7).

HARRIS ON THE ATTACK

- Middle blocker Emily Harris tops the team in hitting percentage with a mark of .352.
- Her .337 career hitting percentage ranks fourth on the SDSU career list and 10th in the Mountain West record book heading into this week's match.
- She is leads the team in blocking with a mark of 1.12 blocks per set after averaging 1.29 bps in last week's two matches.
- She is one block assist shy of entering the SDSU career top 10 in that category despite being in only her third season as an Aztec.
- Harris' eight block assists in the win over Fresno State (Oct. 3) was her season high.

FOUCH ASSISTS

- Senior setter Johnna Fouch has recorded 11 kills over SDSU's last four matches with no errors for a .500 hitting percentage.
- Her 47 assists at Nevada on Thursday, Nov. 14, was her highest total in a match since she recorded 45 at UNLV in mid-September.
- She registered a season-high four block assists in that contest at Nevada as well and also tied her season high with three service aces.
- Her 15 digs in the three-set win over UNLV on Nov. 11 was her second-highest mark of the season.
- She recorded a double-double in the win over Boise State on Nov. 21 (43 assist-12 digs), to give her 11 on the season.

- During the NAU Fiesta Bowl Classic the weekend of Sept. 6-7, her 54 assists vs. Idaho established a tournament record for assists in a three-set match.
- The senior from Riverside, Calif., recorded a career high eight kills on 12 attempts with no errors for a .667 hitting percentage in the match vs. Texas-San Antonio (Aug. 31).

SANDBERG SOLID IN THE MIDDLE

- Kaja Sandberg averaged 2.50 kills per set in last week's two matches.
- She also average 1.25 blocks over the six sets in which she appeared last week.
- Sandberg is second on the team in blocking this season with a mark of 1.06 bps.
- She recorded a career-high eight block assists for the second time in three matches when she did so vs. Colorado State on Oct. 19.
- She had a .600 hitting percentage in the contest at Fresno State (Nov. 9) with six kills and no errors on 10 attacks.
- She had a number of career-bests during on Oct. 12 at Air Force. Those highs included kills (9), attempts (20), service aces (2), block assists (8) and total blocks (8) and points (15.0).

- Senior Summer Nash is averaging just under four kills per set (3.92) over SDU's last three matches.
- She has recorded double figures in kills in five of the last six contests.
- She matched her career high with 21 kills in the match at San Jose State on Nov. 7.
- She also had 21 kills this season in contests vs. Texas-San Antonio (Aug. 31) and Northeastern (Sept. 14).
- She leads the team in kills at 3.57 per set and in points at 3.99 per set.
- She has recorded three double doubles this season (kills-digs).

RING DEBUTS AT LIBERO

- Senior Christie Ring has been SDSU's libero over the past seven matches.
- During that span she is averaging 3.96 digs per set.
- Her 18 digs in the three-set win over Utah State last week was her second-highest mark of the season.
- In her second start at the libero position she turned in a career-high 21 kills in the match at San Jose State on Nov. 7.
- ◆ She also set a career best with six assists in the win over UNLV on Nov. 11.
- She had made her first start at the libero position on Nov. 2 vs. New Mexico and responded with 12 digs.

RICIGLIANO DIGS IT

- Justin Ricigliano is averaging over 2.00 digs per set this season.
- Her 14 digs at Utah State on Oct. 24 was her sixth double figure effort in that category this season.
- Making her first start at the libero position, she recorded a career-high 24 digs in the four-set win at Air Force on Oct. 12.
- Her previous personal best of 13 digs was set earlier this season in a five-set match at Louisiana State on Aug. 31.
- She has been in double figures in digs on six occasions in 2013.
- Ricigliano also turned in a career-high four assists in the win at Air Force.

WABER SOLID UP FRONT

- Michelle Waber registered 11 kills and a .321 hitting percentage in the win over Boise State last week (Nov. 21). She also tied her season high with eight digs in that contest.
- She had seen limited action in the previous matches prior to recording 12 kills in the three-set victory over UNLV on Monday (Nov. 11).

- Fouch ranks sixth on the Mountain West career assist list and needs 56 assists to move into the No. 5 spot.
- Her 44 career double-doubles is the most among active players in the Mountain West and is fourth on the all-time conference list.

AMONG THE LEAGUE LEADERS

- Seven Aztecs ranks among the top 10 in the Mountain West overall stats this week in various categories.
- Summer Nash ranks fourth in both points (3.99 per set) and kills (3.57 per set).
- Emily Harris is sixth in hitting percentage at .352 and seventh in blocking at 1.12 per set.
- Setter Johnna Fouch stands seventh in assist average at 9.51 per set.
- Libero Courtney Vaccarello ranks seventh in digs with an average of 3.53 per set.
- Michelle Waber is ninth in kill average at 3.07 per set.
- Raegan Shelton ranks sixth in kills (3.44 per set) and seventh in points at 3.66 per set.
- Kaja Sandberg is 10th in blocking at 1.06 blocks per set.

LEAGUE STAT LEADERS

- Six Aztecs also rank among the MW top 10 stats in conference matches.
- Summer Nash is seventh in kills (3.42 per set) and eighth in points (3.72 per set).
- Kaja Sandberg ranks eighth in blocks (1.12 per set).
- Emily Harris stands fifth in blocking at 1.26 per set and ninth in hitting percentage (.332).
- Courtney Vaccarello is eighth in digs (3.38 per set).

DEFENSIVE FOURSOME

- Four of San Diego State's defensive specialists recorded career highs in digs during SDSU's season-opening tournament at LSU (Aug. 30-31).
- Senior Courtney Vaccarello had 25 digs in the contest against LSU on Aug. 31.
- Defensive specialists Justine Ricigliano and Kyla Oropeza each notched personal bests in that same with 13 digs. It marked the second time that Oropeza had 13 digs in a match during her time as an Aztec.
- Ricigliano also marked a career best with four service aces vs. the Tigers.
- Christie Ring established her then-career high with 13 digs in the opener vs. UC Davis and also set a personal best of four assists against Texas-San Antonio.

ALL-TOURNEY AZTECS

- Summer Nash, Emily Harris and Michelle Waber earned all-tournament honors at the Holiday Inn Mission Valley Aztec Invitational (Sept. 13-14).
- Nash, who was also named the tourney MVP, averaged 3.83 kills and 1.67 digs per set over SDSU's three matches. Her kill average and mark of 4.33 points per set led all players.
- Harris, meanwhile, led all tourney players with an average of 1.42 blocks per set and also recorded 2.83 digs per set while hitting at a .429 clip.
- Waber had marks 3.42 kills and .50 blocks per set along with a .316 hitting percentage.

VACCARELLO ALL-TOURNEY AT NAU

- Libero Courtney Vaccarello was named to the all-tournament team at last weekend's Fiesta Bowl Tournament at Northern Arizona.
- The senior from San Jose, Calif., averaged 4.36 digs per set and also contributed eight assists and a service ace over the Aztecs' three matches.

ALL-TOURNEY AT LSU

- Three Aztecs were named to the alltournament team at Tiger Classic at LSU during the weekend of Aug. 30-31. That trio included setter Johnna Fouch along with outside hitters Summer Nash and Raegan Shelton.
- ◆ Fouch averaged 11.21 assists and 2.64 digs per set over her team's three matches and also hit .409 with 11 kills.
- Nash ended the weekend with marks of 3.83 kills and 2.00 digs per set and led the Aztecs with five service aces while Shelton averaged 3.23 kills per set.

AZTEC NOTES

- The Aztecs have been involved in seven five-set matches this season and have a mark of 1-6 in those contests including losing the last six in a row. Last year they went 7-3 in five-set contests.
- San Diego State is first in the Mountain West overall stats in assists at 13.44 overall and second in kills at 14.28 per set.
- As a team, SDSU ranks 17th in the nation in assists and 21st in kills. There are 325 schools competing in NCAA Division I volleyball.
- The Aztecs' longest win streak this season has been three matches (twice) while the longest losing streak has also been three contests (on two occasions).
- SDSU is 24-3 on its home court over the past two seasons.
