AZTECS HOST UNLY, NEW MEXICO THIS WEEK

- > San Diego State will play three of its final four regular-season matches at home, starting this week when it entertains UNLV and New Mexico at Aztec Court.
- > SDSU will battle the Rebels on Thursday, Nov. 9, beginning at 6 p.m. PT, before locking horns with the Lobos on Saturday, Nov. 11, starting at 1 p.m. PT.
- > In addition to live stats, both contests will feature streaming video via the Mountain West Network on GoAztecs.com.
- > The first 250 fans in attendance for the SDSU-UNLV clash will receive a free Aztec T-shirt, while free Aztec socks will be given away prior the SDSU-UNM match.
- > San Diego State split its two encounters last week, sweeping Fresno State at home (25-16 25-14, 25-20) on Halloween night before suffering a heartbreaking loss in five sets at Air Force (26-24, 19-25, 25-27, 25-20, 10-15), which snapped the Aztecs' five-match winning streak
- > With the results, SDSU remains tied with San José State for third place in the Mountain West with an 8-6 conference record.
- > The Aztecs' aforementioned victory stretch was their longest since 2012 when they defeated 11 straight opponents to close the regular season and win the Mountain West championship.
- > SDSU is 14-0 this year when maintaining a higher hitting percentage and 7-0 when out-blocking its opponents.

SERIES RECORD VS. UNLV

- > Despite suffering a 3-1 loss to Rebels in Las Vegas on Oct. 14, the Aztecs still lead the all-time series 26-19.
- > In that contest, all four sets were decided by four points or less (25-23, 22-25, 23-25, 21-25).
- > SDSU received a match-high 16 kills by Alexis Cage, while Hannah Turnlund (13) and Deja Harris (11) surpassed the double-digit plateau in put-aways.
- > Despite maintaining a 56-44 advantage in kills and a 78-66 margin in digs, the Aztecs were undone by 38 attack errors, hitting just .090 for the match, including a .031 clip over the final three sets.
- > In addition, SDSU was out-blocked 14.0 to 9.0, while UNLV served up six aces to help key its win.
- > The Aztecs are 17-3 against the Rebels all-time in San Diego and have won nine of the last 10 matches between the two squads in "America's Finest City," including a sweep in their 2016 home finale (25-23, 25-22, 25-13).

SERIES RECORD VS. NEW MEXICO

- > After posting a 3-1 triumph on Oct. 12 (20-25, 25-23, 25-16, 27-25), the Aztecs moved to 37-21 in the all-time series vs. the Lobos.
- > In that match, three SDSU players recorded double-doubles, including Alexis Cage, who posted a season-high 21 kills and added 15 digs, while Deja Harris produced another solid all-round effort with 12 put-aways to go with career-best 11 blocks (1 solo).
- > Not to be outdone, Gabi Peoples contributed 54 assists and 11 digs, while Devyn Pritchard finished with 29 dig for the second straight match.
- > The two sides logged 13.0 team blocks apiece, but the Aztecs maintained a collective advantage in both kills (66-47) and digs (68-54) while holding a slight edge in hitting percentage .202 to .173 to help fuel their win.
- > After recording a .112 dip over the first two sets, SDSU found its rhythm, hitting .303 in the final two frames to close out UNM.
- > The Aztecs are 21-7 vs. the Lobos all-time in San Diego and have won five straight against UNM on The Mesa, including a five-set victory in 2015 (16-25, 16-25, 25-15, 25-23, 15-9).
- > Baylee Little is SDSU's top returner from that match, posting 17 kills while hitting at a .394 clip. Alexandra Psoma, who suffered a season-ending knee injury on Sept. 28, also logged a double-double with 14 kills and 13 digs.

ON THE HORIZON

> Following Saturday's showdown, SDSU will play its final road match of the regular season on Wednesday, Nov. 15, when it travels to Wyoming for a mid-week clash, starting at 6:30 p.m. MT/5:30 p.m. PT.

SCOUTING THE OPPOSITION

> <u>UNLV (8-19, 4-10 MW)</u> has lost four straight matches, including a 3-1 setback against San José State (20-25, 21-25, 17-25) in its last outing at home on Nov. 4. In that match, the Spartans posted more kills (63-45) and a greater hitting percentage (.260-.197) to help defeat the Rebels. Individually, freshman Mariena Hayden leads UNLV with an average of 2.89 kills per set and tops the Mountain West with 35 service aces overall. In addition, sophomore Leka Kiner-Falefa occupies the fifth spot with 4.28 digs per set, while senior Ashley Owens ranks seventh with 1.21 blocks per frame. Sophomore setter Riley Jacobs also finds herself among the league leaders in assists (8th, 9.03/assists), while junior Elsa Descamps has chipped in 2.26 kills and 0.99 blocks per set. As a team, the Rebels are sixth in the MW this week with 2.27 blocks per set and rank seventh in digs (13.13/set). However, UNLV is currently at the bottom of the conference in kills (10.97/set), hitting percentage (.162), opponent hitting percentage (.224). The Rebels coached by Gindy Frederick, who is in her seventh season in charge of the Rebel program. Prior to her arrival in Las Vegas, Frederick was the head coach at Weber State (1985-88), Washington State (1989-2003), lowa (2004-07) and Luther College (2010). Her career record stands at 549-440, including a 122-89 mark at UNLV. San Diego State head coach Deitre Collins-Parker also served as the Rebels head coach for eight years from 1996-2003. With the Aztecs, Collins-Parker is 10-6 against her former school.

> New Mexico (14-13, 6-8 MW) had its three-match winning streak snapped in a 3-1 home loss to Nevada (19-25, 25-18, 29-31, 20-25) on Nov. 4. In that contest, the Lobos received double-digit kill totals from sophomore outside hitter Lauren Twitty (19), freshman outside hitter Hailey Rubino (18) and junior middle blocker Victoria Spragg (10), but it wasn't enough as the Wolf Pack benefited from 34 UNM attack errors and posted more team blocks 12.0 to 6.0. Entering the week, Twitty ranks third in the MW in kills (3.91/set), while senior libero Ashley Kelsey (4.40 digs/set) and junior setter Carson Heilborn (9.48 assists/set) occupy the fourth spot in their respective categories. Not to be outdone, junior middle blocker Mariessa Carrasco ranks eighth in the conference with a .313 hitting percentage. Twitty owns the league's highest three-set kill total so far this season with 25 at Wyoming on Sept. 23. She also committed just two attack error in that match, finishing with a .442 hitting percentage. Collectively, the Lobos lead the conference with 14.96 digs per set and rank fifth and sixth, respectively, in hitting percentage (.211) and kills (12.71/set). For the season, opponents are hitting .209 against New Mexico, including a .221 clip in Mountain West competition. UNM is coached by Jeff Nelson, who is in his 11th season on the Albuquerque campus. Prior to assuming the reins of the Lobo program, Nelson served as head coach at Texas Tech 1995-2002) and San Francisco (2003-06). In 2009-10, Nelson guided UNM to consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances. His career record stands at 444-277, including a 202-130 record with the Lobos.

WEEKLY WRAP

- > After posting its fifth straight victory with a sweep of Fresno State at home on Halloween night (25-16, 25-14, 25-20), San Diego State had its winning streak come to a halt in a hard-fought loss at Air Force (26-24, 19-25, 25-27, 25-20, 10-15) on Nov. 5.
- > Against the Bulldogs, the Aztecs avenged an earlier loss in Fresno, completing the match in just 1 hour and 13 minutes.
- > Despite trailing in team blocks (9.0-5.0), SDSU more than made up for it, maintaining a sizable 45-26 advantage in kills to key its victory.
- > The Aztecs out-hit Fresno State .326 to .116 for the match, limiting the visitors to a minus-.160 clip in the second set.
- > In addition, the Scarlet and Black owned a 6-1 edge in service aces and a 21-15 margin in digs.
- > SDSU was led by senior combo of Baylee Little (.444, 3 block assists) and Alexis Cage (.391, 2 aces), who collected 12 kills apiece, while junior Deja Harris finished with eight put-aways of her own to go with a pair of blocks.
- > In addition, the Aztecs received another solid performance from freshman Gabi Peoples, who finished with 34 assists and a pair of service aces, while senior Devyn Pritchard totaled eight digs and two helpers, along with a rare kill. Sophomore Ashlynn Dunbar also got into the act by launching seven non-returnables while recording five digs and two blocks.
- > Six days later at Air Force, SDSU compiled more kills (60-58) and maintained a sizable advantage in digs (81-68), but got out-hit (.183 to .103) and out-blocked (25.0 to 11.5) by the Falcons.
- > The Aztecs had four players post double-digit kill totals, including Hannah Turnlund (4 blocks), who blasted a career-high 16 put-aways, while Harris recorded 12 non-returnables of her own to go with eight blocks (2 solos), and a personal-best nine digs.
- > In addition, Little (.375) contributed 11 kills and three blocks, while Dunbar recorded her fourth double-double of the year with 10 put-aways and 15 digs. Allong the back row, Pritchard racked up a match-high 27 digs, while Alexis Cage just missed out on a double-double after logging nine kills and 12 digs. Elsewhere, Gabi Peoples (31 assists) and Indigo Thompson (22 assists) split time at the setter position.

AZTECS AMONG MOUNTAIN WEST LEADERS

- > Entering the week, Deja Harris, Devyn Pritchard and Gabi Peoples are among the MW leaders in various categories.
- > In overall matches, Harris ranks third in the league with a .336 hitting percentage and is fifth with 1.25 blocks per set.
- > Pritchard also occupies third position this week with 4.56 digs per frame.
- > Meanwhile, Peoples moved into the fifth slot with 9.41 assists per set.
- > As a team, SDSU ranks among the top half of the conference in kills (3rd, 13.47/set), assists (4th, 12.38/set) and digs (5th, 13.50/set).
- > In Mountain West matches, Pritchard maintains the top spot in digs (5.22/set); Peoples ranks second in assists (11.16/set), while Harris is fifth in blocks (1.33/set).
- > In addition, Baylee Little climbed into the ninth spot with a .323 hitting percentage.
- > Collectively against conference foes, the Aztecs rank second in the league in both kills (13.77/set) and digs (14.62/set).
- > In MW action, SDSU also finds itself among the top half of the league in opponent hitting percentage (3rd, .191), assists (3rd, 12.49/set) and blocks (2.39/set).

KEYS TO THE TURNAROUND

- > After starting Mountain West play with an 0-3 record, San Diego State has turned things around, winning eight of 11 matches to climb into a tie for third place in the conference race.
- > During that stretch, the Aztecs have maintained a statistical advantage in several categories, including kills (608-483) and digs (629-530).
- >~ SDSU has averaged nearly three kills more per set than its opponents (14.14-11.23).
- > Similarly, the Aztec defense has held firm, averaging well over two digs per set more than the opposition (14.63-12.33).
- > SDSU also owns a slight edge in hitting percentage (.209-.174) despite committing more attack errors during that span (288-230).
- > In addition, SDSU has benefited in the service department, committing 31 fewer errors than its adversaries (69-100).

SPREADING THE WEALTH

- > Over the last 11 matches, San Diego State has also received balanced offensive production, with the quartet of Alexis Cage (141), Deja Harris (125), Ashlynn Dunbar (116) and Hannah Turnlund (116) combining for 498 of the team's 608 kills (81.9 percent).
- > During that span, Cage, Harris and Turnlund have logged double-digit kill totals on eight occasions, while Dunbar has accomplished the feat seven times.
- > Cage has been particularly effective, averaging 3.28 kills and hitting .231 in 43 sets played, compared to the previous 16 matches when she averaged 2.03 kps and posted a .214 attack percentage.
- > Against Boise State, Cage posted her fifth double-double of the year with 16 kills and 13 digs.
- > In addition, the Aztecs have profited from the play of Baylee Little (78 kills, 31 blocks, .325) and Sam McGrath (77 digs, 12 aces).

POWER TO THE PEOPLES

- > Setter Gabi Peoples is enjoying a strong freshman campaign, averaging 9.41 assists and 1.47 digs in 91 sets played.
- > The Beaverton, Oregon, native has cracked the starting lineup 18 times this season, including the last 17 matches.
- > Against Mountain West opponents, Peoples has averaged 11.16 assists, 1.51 digs and 0.59 blocks per set.
- > Three weeks ago, Peoples averaged 12.67 assists per set (114 overall), including a career-high 62 helpers in SDSU's dramatic five-set victory over Boise State, to capture MW Offensive Player of the Week honors.
- > Not only were her 62 helpers a career high, the total marks second-best performance in the MW this season.
- > With her efforts, Peoples has compiled 40 or more assists in eight of her last 10 matches and has posted over 50 helpers three times this year.
- > Last month, she recorded her first two career double-doubles at New Mexico (54 assists, 11 digs) and UNLV (41 assists, 12 digs).

DIGGIN' DEVYN

- > Senior libero Devyn Pritchard has come on strong against Mountain West competition, averaging a conference-leading 5.22 digs per set in 12 league matches.
- > The Temecula, Calif., native also remained in third place this week with 4.56 digs per set in all matches.
- > On Oct. 19, Pritchard set a career high with 33 digs in a 3-2 thriller over Boise State, helping the Aztecs erase an 0-2 deficit in sets.
- > The 33 digs marked the highest total in a league match so far this year and tied for the second most overall, helping her garner MW Defensive Player of the Week accolades.
- > Last month, Pritchard posted back-to-back 29 dig performances on the road against New Mexico and UNLY for an average of 7.25 per set.
- > For the season, she has now surpassed the 20-dig plateau in nine matches this year, including six of her last 11 outings.

AZTECS COLLECT TWO MW WEEKLY AWARDS

- > San Diego State picked up two Mountain West awards on Oct. 23 as Gabi Peoples was named Offensive Player of the Week, while Devyn Pritchard was selected Defensive Player of the Week. The two accolades were the first career honors for the Aztec teammates.
- > In two matches, Peoples dished out 12.67 assists per set (114 total) averaging 4.10 helpers more than her season clip of 8.57 per frame entering the week, as the Scarlet and Black completed a 2-0 homestand with victories over Boise State and Utah State.
- > Against the Broncos, the freshman setter handed out a career-high 62 assists, which marks the highest total in the MW so far this year.
- With Peoples' crisp passing, SDSU had five players surpass the double-digit plateau in kills vs. Boise State.
- In the Aztecs' triumph over Utah State, Peoples contributed 52 assists, as three teammates reached double figures in kills.
- > Pritchard, meanwhile, posted 44 digs last week for an average of 4.89 per set and finished with a clean slate of zero reception errors.
- > Against Boise State, the senior libero recorded a career-high 33 digs, which marked the highest total in a MW match this year and tied for the second-most overall.
- > With her effort, Pritchard anchored a defense that limited the Broncos to 12.8 kills per set during the contest, which was 1.3 less than its league-leading season average of 14.1 entering the match.
- Two days later against Utah State, she registered a team-high 11 digs, contributing to a defense that held the Aggies to a .186 hitting percentage, .025 points below their season average of .211 entering the contest.

NOTHIN' LIKE HOME COOKIN'

> In 38 seasons of Aztec volleyball, San Diego State has compiled a 378-187 record (.669) at home, which represents the second-best home winning percentage among current Mountain West members.

- This year, the Scarlet and Black has posted an 8-4 mark on Aztec Court at Peterson Gym compared to a 4-7 ledger in true road matches. In addition, SDSU has gone 2-2 in neutral-site encounters.
- > In head coach Deitre Collins-Parker's tenure, the Aztecs have amassed a 75-33 record (.691) at home, including a 14-0 mark during the 2012 season when SDSU captured the Mountain West championship.

HEAD COACH DEITRE COLLINS-PARKER

- > San Diego State head coach Deitre Collins-Parker is in her ninth season with the Aztecs after becoming the fourth head coach in program history prior to the 2009 campaign. Her record at San Diego State stands
- Collins-Parker previously served as head coach at UNLV for eight seasons (1996-2003) and at Cornell for five years (2004-2008). Her career record stands at 306-316 (.492).
- > On Oct. 7. she collected her 300th career victory after the Aztecs defeated Air Force in four sets at home. > A three-time All-American as a collegiate player at the University of Hawai'i, Collins-Parker guided the
- Rainbow Wahine to consecutive national titles (1983-84) and was twice named the national player of the year.
- > Collins-Parker was a member of the U.S. Olympic Team and competed at the Goodwill Games and Pan Am Games prior to playing professionally in Europe for four years.
- > Collins-Parker is one of six players named to the NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball 25th Anniversary Team in October 2005 and was inducted into the AVCA Hall of Fame in the fall of 2008.
- > This past summer, Collins-Parker was head coach of the Mountain West All-Star volleyball team that competed in the European Global Challenge. Current Aztecs Baylee Little and Indigo Thompson were also named to that savad.

DEJA VU FOR HARRIS

- > Middle blocker Deja Harris was named Most Valuable Player of the Denver Invitational last month, marking the second time this season the Aztec junior received such distinction after earning the same honor following the Aztec Invitational last month.
- > In three matches, Harris hit a team-high .427, averaging 3.21 kills and 1.36 blocks per set. She was also part of an SDSU defense that limited the opposition to a collective .179 hitting percentage.
- > Against UCR, the Las Vegas, Nevada, native knocked down a match-high 16 kills and hit .464 to go with six blocks.
- > Harris completed her seventh match of the year with a .400 attack percentage or higher after hitting .429 with 14 kills vs. Gonzaga.
- > In the second stanza against the Zags, she hit .625 with six kills to help the Aztecs build a 2-0 lead in sets.
- > In addition, Harris also led all players in the Gonzaga match with a season high-tying seven block assists.
- > She completed the weekend against Denver with a team-high 15 kills and six blocks, including three solo stops.
- > In fourth set vs. the Pioneers, she hit .750 with six kills, including two during a 4-1 match-clinching run.

ALL-TOURNAMENT AZTECS-PART IV

- > In addition to Harris, Alexis Cage and Ashlynn Dunbar were both named to the Denver Invitational all-tournament team.
- > For the weekend, Cage averaged 2.14 kills and 2.86 digs per set to go with six block assists.
- > The Newport Beach, Calif., product recorded two double-doubles in the tournament, finishing with 11 kills and 11 digs vs. Gonzaga, before before amassing kills and 19 digs against Denver, the latter of which marked a season high and fell one short of a personal best.
- > Dunbar, meanwhile, turned in a fine all-round performance as well with 2.36 kills, 2.14 digs and 0.79 blocks per set.
- > The Seabrook, Texas, native logged her first career double-double with 10 kills and 14 digs vs. Gonzaga and just missed out on another one against Denver, finishing with a personal-best 14 kills and nine scoops.
- > She also tallied a season-high five block assists in the opener against UC Riverside.

ALL-TOURNAMENT AZTECS--PART III

- > Following the JLABS Challenge, held Sept. 8-9 at Aztec Court, Alexis Cage was named to the four-player all-tournament team, joining Long Beach State's Megan Kruidhof, Pacific's Emily Baptista and Loyola Marymont's Savannah Slattery.
- > For the weekend, Cage knocked down 29 kills (2.64/set) and posted 26 digs (2.36/set).
- > Against LBSU, Cage logged San Diego State's first double-double of the year, recording season highs of 15 kills and 13 digs while hitting .324.
- > In the victory over Pacific, Cage turned in another solid all-round performance with nine kills, four digs and three block assists.

ALL-TOURNAMENT AZTECS--PART II

- > Deja Harris and Ashlynn Dunbar were named to the seven-player all-tournament team at Michigan State's Spartan Invitaitional, held Sept. 1-2 in East Lansing, Michigan.
- > Harris hit .432 for the weekend and served up five aces to go with six blocks.
- > Against Texas A&M-Corpus Christi, the Aztec junior recorded her second-highest attack percentage of the year at. 643, blasting 10 kills with just one error in 14 attempts.
- > Harris also posted a career-high three service aces in the opener against Michigan State and finished with a .562 hitting percentage (11-2-16) vs. Marshall.
- > Meanwhile, Dunbar compiled a .361 attack percentage in three matches while adding four assists and two blocks.
- > Against Marshall, the SDSU sophomore hit .474 on 12 kills both season highs.
- In addition, Dunbar added tied her career best with two assists against TAMU-CC and came up with a pair of blocks.

HARRIS NAMED AZTEC INVITE MVP

- > Middle blocker Deja Harris earned Most Valuable Player honors at the season-opening Aztec Invitational.
- > In three matches, the SDSU junior led all regulars in the tournament field with a .434 hitting percentage, averaging 3.00 kills in 10 sets played.
- > In SDSU's sweep of Portland State, Harris hit a season-high .733 on a team-best 11 kills with no errors in 15 swings.
- > She also recorded double-digit kills vs. CSUN, launching 10 put-aways with just three errors on 16 attacks for a .433 hitting percentage.
- > Harris excelled on defense as well, averaging 1.30 blocks for the tourney.
- > In the Aztecs' aforementioned victory over PSU, she came up with match-high six block assists, including two during a decisive 13-0 run in the opening set.

STAFF ADDITIONS

- > The Aztecs have added a new assistant coach and volleyball operations assistant to their 2017 staff.
- > Ken Murczek, a 1998 San Diego State graduate, joins the SDSU program after spending the past season as head coach of the men's volleyball team at the University of Charleston in West Virginia.
- > Prior to his stint in the Mountain State, Murczek served as head coach of the women's teams at North Texas (2010-12) and Wake Forest (2013-15). He also had previous stops as an assistant coach at Virginia (2007) and Kansas (2008-09).
- > Murczek played two seasons for the SDSU men's volleyball team, helping the Scarlet and Black to a top-15 ranking as a senior in 1998.
- > In his current role with the Aztecs, Murczek will be responsible for offensive development and will train the setters and defensive specialists.
- > Last spring, Makayla Westphal was hired as volleyball operations assistant after serving as an intern for the director of operations at the University of Nebraska.
- > As a player, Westphal was a four-year starter as an outside hitter/defensive specialist at Nebraska Wesleyan, where she was a member of the AD31 All-Academic Team and was twice named a Pflieger-Olson Scholar-Athlete.
- > Westphal led the Prairie Wolves in service aces as a senior, helping the team to a 22-7 record.
- > Westphal also coached at the Volleyball Club Nebraska (VCN) girls' club in Lincoln, Nebraska, where she was an assistant for the 15 and 17 Black teams and head coach for the 14 Black squad. She also served as an evaluator for the girls' National Junior and High Performance Team tryouts conducted by USA Volleyball in Omaha.
