BYU and No. 17 San Diego State will meet on the hardwood for the 78th time on Friday, Nov. 10, when the Cougars welcome the Aztecs to the Marriott Center. Tip is scheduled for 7 p.m.

Friday's game will be broadcast on Big 12 Now on ESPN+ with Dave McCann and Blaine Fowler on the call. It will also be broadcast live on BYU Radio Sirius XM 143, KSL 102.7/1160 AM and BYURadio.org/BYU Radio app with Jason Shepherd and Mark Durrant.

STRONG START TO THE SEASON

BYU won it's 14th straight season opener at home on Monday evening with a 110-63 victory over Houston Christian where the Cougars shot a program record 43 3-pointers.

The Cougars shot 47.6 percent from the floor, 34.9 percent from 3-point range and 83.3 percent from the free throw line. Their 15 makes from beyond the arc is tied for the fifth-most in a single game in program history. They outrebounded the Huskies, 59-25, including only allowing one offensive rebound. A turnover ratio of 3:1 was highlighted by 27 assists and only nine turnovers.

Spencer Johnson was one of five Cougars to score in double figures as the senior scored a career-high 20 points, going 8-of-16 from the floor, 2-of-9 from three and 2-of-2 from the free throw line. Trevin Knell was close to a career-high in his first game in 593 days as the redshirt junior made five 3-pointers en route to 19 points.

A TOTAL ECLIPSE OF THE CENTURY MARK

For the fifth time under head coach Mark Pope, BYU eclipsed the century mark in Monday's victory. The 110 points are the most scored under the former Kentucky Wildcat, two more than they scored in the season opening victory over Westminster (108-59) in 2020.

Monday's performance also marked the first time since November 21, 2000 that BYU has scored over 100 points in a season opener against NCAA Division I opposition. In a 100-63 victory over Elon, Mekeli Wesley scored 19 points in 21 minutes as the Coupars shot 71 percent from the floor.

The 110-point ouput by the Cougars was the second most by a school against a Division I opponent on the opening night of the season, only trailing Arizona's 122-point outburst in a win over Morgan State.

HE'S A MAN, HE'S 26

Johnson was the leading scorer for the Cougars for the eighth time in his career on Monday as the American Fork native finished with 20 points, making a career-high eight field goals. He is now one of 10 players to surpass 20 points in the season opener since 2010 joining the likes of Tyler Haws (3x), Alex Barcello (2x) and Jimmer Fredette

The senior guard scored 20+ twice during his one season at Salt Lake Community College including a 24-point, 8-reobund performance against Snow College.

The Cougars 43 3-point attempts on Monday were the second-most by any NCAA Division 1 school on opening day as High Point went 21-of-47 from 3-point range in their win over St. Andrews. Prior to Monday, BYU had only shot 40 3-pointers once in program history (40, Loyola Marymount, 2/13/2020)

CLOSING UP SHOP

Johnson scored 12 of 20 points on Monday in the second half, marking the third straight game dating back to last season that he has scored in double figures in the final 20 minutes.

To put that into perspective, he scored 10 or more points in the second half only five times in his previous 84 appearances for the Cougars.

HEPTADECAPHOBIA

BYU enters Friday contest 2-5 all-time against teams ranked 17th in the AP Poll dating back to their first meeting against a 17th ranked Saint Louis squad back on December 22, 1952.

THE SHOT DOCTOR

Knell had to wait 593 days to suit up for the Cougars following a NIT quarterfinal defeat to Washington State in 2022 and did not disappoint. The redshirt junior was in the starting lineup 25th time in his career, finishing with 19 points including tying a career-high with five 3-pointers. On an offense that had 1.41 points per possession, Knell had the top offensive player efficiency rating (27.3) with Noah Waterman coming in second (20.9).

He has now hit three or more 3-pointers 12 times, three away from getting his name in the Top 20. With his performance he also moved up to 16th on the all-time 3-point percentage list as he is now shooting 39.2 percent from deep.

FOUSS FIGHTIN' FOR EVERY INCH

In his two games against the Aztecs, Fousseyni Traore is averaging 11.5 points and 6.0 rebounds per game. As a true freshman in 2022-23, Traore finished with nine points and eight rebounds in his second collegiate game. In 24 minutes of action last season at Viejas Arena, the native of Bamako, Mali went 5-of-6 from the floor en route to 14 points against one of the best rim protectors in the country, Nathan Mensah.

Traore is six makes away from becoming the program's all-time leader in field goal percentage, having gone 294-of-492 (.598) from the floor in his 67 games as a Cougar. Alan Taylor is the current record holder having shot 57.7 percent (504-of-874) during his career from 1976-80.

Five Cougars scored in double figures as BYU opened the season on a high note with a 110-63 victory over Houston Christian on Monday evening at the Marriott Center. The Cougars shot 47.6 percent from the floor, 34.9 percent from three and 83.3 percent from the free throw line.

Spencer Johnson scored a career-high 20 points as the senior went 8-of-16 from the floor, 2-of-9 from 3-point range and 2-of-2 from the free throw line. He also dished out seven assists with no turnovers to go along with five rebounds. Trevin Knell was close to a season-high as the redshirt junior finished with 19 points, tying a career-high with five 3-pointers.

Noah Waterman had a BYU-high 16 points as the senior connected on three triples to go along with eight rebounds. Trey Stewart became the 35th different player to start a game under head coach Mark Pope as the junior finished with a career-high 10 points. Jaxson Robinson also contributed 13 points off the bench in 20 minutes of action.

ACTION JAXSON

Following his 13-point performance on Monday, Jaxson Robinson has now scored in double figures three of the four times he has come off the bench for the Cougars. He scored 13 and 11 in back-to-back games against Loyola Marymount and Pacific last season before returning to the starting lineup for BYU's run to the semifinals of the West Coast Conference tournament.

One of Pope's four ranked victories came against SDSU in his second season when the Cougars went into Viejas Arena and picked up a 72-62 victory behind a 20-point performance from Alex Barcello.

SCOUTING THE AZTECS

San Diego State is ranked in the Top 25 in both national polls (15th Coaches Poll, 17th AP Poll) after reaching the national title game last season before falling to UConn.

The Aztecs were picked to win the Mountain West after receiving 25 of the 31 first-place votes. They are also projected a No. 6 seed in Joe Lunardi's latest 68-team bracket.

Seventh year head coach Brian Dutcher improved to 152-47 in his coaching career as the Aztecs defeated Cal State Fullerton 83-57 in their season opener on Monday evening at Viejas Arena. In the victory, SDSU shot 45.2 percent from the floor, 29.0 percent from three and 64.3 percent from the free throw line. They held the Titans to just 20.8 percent from beyond the arc.

Jaedon LeDee lead the Aztecs as the Houston, Texas native recorded a 27-point, 10-rebound double-double with Micah Parrish and Reese Waters also reaching double figures. LeDee was 8-of-12 from the floor and 10-of-15 from the charity stripe with Parrish knocking down 5 3-pointers.

Last season against the Cougars, LeDee came off the bench to score a game-high 23 points as the Aztecs overcame a four-point halftime deficit. Darrion Trammell also had 21 points in that game with Lamont Butler recording five steals.

In Pope's previous four meetings against the Aztecs, BYU is averaging 71.0 points per game while shooting 43.9 percent from the floor, 30.8 percent from three and 78.9 percent from the free throw line. They also average 36.5 rebounds, more than 10 of those coming on the offensive glass.

LOOKING TO GO BACK-TO-BACK

BYU will look to score over 100 points in consecutive games for the first time since 2013 when they take the court on Friday. They last achieved the feat in the second and third games of the 2013-13 in wins over Stanford (112-103) and Mount St. Mary's (108-76). On that same note, San Diego State hasn't allowed an opponent to score 100 points since the Cougars defeated the Aztecs 100-90 on February 22, 2005 at the Marriott Center.


HOSTING THE RUNNER-UPS

THE HOME OF COUGAR BASKETBALL

The Marriott Center is one of the best home court advantages in all of college basketball, with the Cougars ranking the Top 25 in attendance 45 times including three seasons at No. 1. This season, BYU ranks 12th in total attendance (225,875) and 14th in average attendance (14,117/game).

In 2022-23, BYU was one of 17 schools in the country to average over 14,000 fans per games as the Cougars ranked 15th in average attendance (14,117). That number was good enough for the second-highest in the Big 12 trailing only Kansas (7th, 16,300)

COUGARS TRAVEL TO ITALY AND CROATIA

BYU spent time in Northern Italy and Croatia during August as part of its foreign trip that every NCAA program is allowed to take every four years. While in Europe, the Cougars mixed business with pleasure visiting Milan, Venice, Lake Como and Trieste in Italy before enjoying the coast of Croatia in Split and Dubrovnik. They also made a stop in Zadar, Croatia to spend time with family of BYU great Kresimir Cosic and play against his former club, KK Zadar.

On the court, BYU played four games with three of those games coming within a span of 72 hours in three different cities. They opened the tour with wins over Orange 1 Basketball Bassano and Pallacanestro Trieste, which included a 26-point performance from Jaxson Robinson. After suffering a setback to Cosic's beloved Zadar, the Cougs ended the trip with a 84-78 victory over a KK Split squad that featured former Loyola Marymount guard Cam Shelton.

SPEAKING OF TRAVELING THE WORLD

Speaking of international trips, the last time BYU won the NIT (1955-56) the Cougars took a 51-day trip across South America and Mexico during the summer of 1965. During the trip, BYU traveled an estimated 18,500 miles where they visited seven countries (Ecuador, Chile, Argentina, Uruguay, Paraguay, Brazil, Mexico). They went 19-3 on the trip, shooting over 65 percent from the floor and averaged 84.6 points per game.

Dick Nemelka averaged 20.0 points per game, leading the Cougars in scoring 16 times including a 34-point performance agaisnt Union Espanola (Chile). Steve Kramer, Jeff Congdon and Neil Roberts also averaged in double figures for the Cougars.

GO FORTH AND SERVE

Nine players have served two-year missions for the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints including Townsend Tripple, who returned from Argentina this past summer. Hall, Saunders and Stewart were all called to serve out of the country but labored stateside due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Knell, Baker, Johnson also invested two years of their lives teaching and serving throughout the world.

With the support of Simmons Center Board member Lee Anne Pope, her husband Coach Mark Pope, and the BYU Men's Basketball team, each team dunk raises money for BYU student cancer research. Mark Pope enters his fifth season as the head coach of BYU men's basketball having led the Cougars to a pair of postseason appearances during his tenure in Provo.

Pope is 87-41 including a 50-10 record at the Marriott Center since being named the 19th head coach in program history on April 10, 2019. He is one of four coaches in program history to win 20 or more games in their first three seasons at the helm.

BYU went 19-15 in its final season in the West Coast Conference with Fousseyni Traore, Spencer Johnson and Dallin Hall earning all-league accolades.

One of the Cougars 12 wins at the Marriott Center came against Utah on December 17, 2022, 75-66, where Rudi Williams scored a game-high 26 points off the bench. They also defeated No. 21 Creighton, 83-80, in the Jack Jones Hoopfest in Las Vegas with Williams once again leading them in scoring off the bench.

Led by Traore, BYU ranked 23rd in rebound margin and 61st in defensive rebounds per game. The sophomore, who ranked 22nd nationally in field goal percentage, earned All-WCC second team honors after leading the team in scoring and rebounding.

In 2021-22, he led the Cougars to a 24-11 record and No. 2 seed in the NIT, where they made a run to the quarterfinals with wins over Long Beach State and Northern Iowa. In a win over San Diego on January 20, 2022, Pope became the fastest coach in program history to win 60 games.

In his second season in Provo, BYU returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2015 led by AP All-American Alex Barcello. The Cougars finished the season at 20-7 and earned a No. 6 seed, their highest seed in March Madness since 2011.

The Cougars possessed one of the top offenses in the nation in 2019-20 as they were 24-8 including a 14-1 record at home before the NCAA Tournament was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. In his first season in Provo, BYU defeated No. 2 Gonzaga 91-78 on Senior Night to go along with wins over UCLA and Virginia Tech at the Maui Invitational.

They led the nation in 3-point field goal percentage, shooting 42.2 percent from beyond the arc while ranking in the Top 10 nationally in five other categories.

In four years at Utah Valley, Pope's Wolverine teams made improvements each season, going from 12 wins in 2015-16 to 25 victories in 2018-19. He also led Utah Valley to three-straight postseason appearances (2017, 2018, 2019) and back-to-back 20-win seasons (2017-18, 2018-19) — both are Wolverine records.

The 2018-19 season was highlighted by a then program-record 25 wins and an 11-4 non-conference record, the best non-league record in UVU history. His team finished 14-1 at home and owned a 22-game home win streak — also a Wolverine record and the second-longest streak in the country at the time.

In addition to the team success, Pope coached the Western Athletic Conference Player of the Year and Freshman of the Year.

Pope's 2017-18 campaign finished with a 23-11 record, including the best home mark in school history of 16-1. The season began with what was known as the #Toughest24 as Pope and the Wolverines opened on the road at No. 4 Kentucky and No. 1 Duke on consecutive nights. That season ended with a trip to the quarterfinals of the College Basketball Invitational.

In 2016-17, Pope led Utah Valley to 17 wins and a trip to the CBI. The Wolverines won a pair of road games — the school's first-ever postseason victories — to reach the semifinals of the CBI.

While on Dave Rose's staff at BYU from 2011-15, Pope helped the Cougars to four-straight 20-win seasons and four-straight postseason appearances — including three bids to the NCAA Tournament and trip to the semifinals of the 2013 NIT. Prior to coaching at BYU, Pope was director of basketball operations for Mark Fox at Georgia in 2009-10 and an assistant under Jeff Bzdelik at Wake Forest in 2010-11.

A 6-foot-10 post player, Pope helped Kentucky claim the 1996 NCAA National Championship and enjoyed a nine-year professional career that included seven seasons in the NBA and two in Turkey. Pope was drafted in the second round of the 1996 NBA Draft by the Indiana Pacers. Following the draft, Pope played his first season as a professional in Turkey for Efes Pilsen. He then played two seasons for the Indiana Pacers under head coach Larry Bird and helped the Pacers to the 1998 Eastern Conference Finals.

In 1999-00, Pope split time between the La Crosse Bobcats of the CBA and Ulkerspor in Turkey. He returned to the NBA the next season, playing for the Milwaukee Bucks under head coach George Karl. In 2000-01, he started 45 games and helped the Bucks reach the Eastern Conference Finals. After two seasons with the Bucks, Pope spent the 2002-03 season on injured reserve with the New York Knicks. He concluded his NBA career playing two seasons with the Denver Nuggets from 2003-05.

Pope began his collegiate career playing at Washington. As a freshman in 1991-92, he earned Pac-10 Freshman of the Year honors after setting a Washington freshman single-season record with 8.1

rebounds per game. He earned All-Academic honors from the Pac-10 as a sophomore in 1992-93.

Following his sophomore season, Pope transferred to Kentucky where he played for Rick Pitino. After redshirting in 1993-94, Pope helped the Wildcats win back-to-back SEC titles, advance to the NCAA Elite Eight in 1995 and win the NCAA National Championship in 1996. He averaged 7.6 points and 5.2 rebounds and was a team captain during Kentucky's championship season. Pope earned Academic All-SEC honors in 1995 and graduated from Kentucky with a degree in English in 1996.

Before joining the basketball staff at Georgia, Pope completed two years of medical school at Columbia University in New York. He did much of his pre-med course work while playing in the NBA. Pope and his wife Lee Anne have four daughters: Ella, Avery, Layla and Shay. Lee Anne worked at ESPN before serving as David Letterman's personal assistant for four years.


