#### **AZTEC HEADLINES**

- Winners of two straight and four of its last five, San Diego State hits the road Saturday to battle firstplace Colorado State in a key Mountain West clash in Fort Collins, Colo. Game time is slated for 2 p.m. MT (1 p.m. PT), and a live video stream via the Mountain West Network will be available on www.goaztecs.
- The Aztecs are coming off a convincing 88-72 victory over Utah State on Jan. 25 to cap a 2-0 homestand.
  Against the Aggies, sophomore Deajanae Scurry scored a career-high 22 points on 9-of-13 shooting, to go with a game-best nine rebounds, while freshman Ariell Bostick notched a personal-best 18 points and a game-high six assists.
- Not to be outdone, senior Cierra Warren punctuated a spectacular homestand, finishing with 20 points and seven rebounds en route to collecting her sec-

- ond MW Player of the Week award this season.

  Warren, who averaged 25.5 points and 10.5 rebounds in two games last week, is ranked second in the MW overall in field-goal percentage (.557), fifth in scoring (14.9 ppg) and 10th in rebounding 6.4/gm). The Aztec center owns two of the top single-game performances in the league this season (14 FGs at Sacramento State and 9-of-10 FGs at UCSB) and has eclipsed the 20 point-barrier on six occasions this year
- As a team, SDSU tops the MW with a .430 fieldgoal percentage overall and ranks first in rebounding defense (34.6/gm) and rebounding margin (+5.2).
- Elsewhere, the Aztecs rank among the conference leaders for all games in field-goal percentage defense (4th - (.399)). offensive rebounding (5th - 14.9/gm), steals (5th - 8.1/gm).

#### #AztecWBB Travels to MW Leader Colorado State on Saturday

San Diego State faces its first repeat opponent of the Mountain West slate on Saturday when it travels to the Front Range of the Rockies to battle Colorado State inside Moby Arena. The Aztecs are fied for fifth in the MW standings, two-and-a-half games behind the Rams, who knocked off Nevada at home on Wednesday, 71-64. SDSU will be looking to avenge a narrow 64-61 defeat to CSU in its conference opener on Jan. 2 at Viejas

Arena. The Aztecs held a slim 54-52 advantage with 6:26 remaining, but missed on five straight field-goal attempts over a span of four-plus minutes, while the Rams sank five of six free throws to vault in front for good.

Despite the setback, San Diego State still maintains a 27-19 lead in the all-time series. The Aztecs have emerged victorious on four of their last six visits to Fort Collins, including a 48-44 decision a year ago. In that game, SDSU jumped out to a 17-0 lead, but had to withstand a furious second-half rally by the Rams to earn the win.

#### Scouting the Rams

Colorado State (15-4, 7-1 MW) is one of the surprise teams in the Mountain West so far this year, occupying the top spot in the conference standings after it was picked to finish seventh in the league's preseason poll. The Rams have won four straight and 11 of their last 12, including a 71-64 triumph at home over Nevada on Wednesday.

Individually, CSU is led by the duo of senior Sam Martin (11.9 ppg) and sophomore Caitlin Duffy (11.5 ppg), while juniors AJ Newton (10.6 ppg) and Gritt Ryder (10.0 ppg) have posted double-digit scoring averages as well.

Duffy tops the MW with a .849 free-throw percentage and ranks third in three-point field goal accuracy (.411) and sixth in three-pointers made (2.05/gm), just behind teammate Newton (2.10/gm). In addition, Martin finds herself among the conference leaders in blocked shots (2nd - 1.6/gm) and field-goal percentage (3rd - (.522)), while Ryder enters the weekend ranked third in assists (4.8/gm) and assist-to-turnover ratio (2.0).

Duffy led the Rams with 20 points in the previous meeting with the Aztecs on Jan. 2, sinking five of seven shots from beyond the arc, while Martin, Newton and Alicia Nichols finished with eight points each.

As a team, CSU is second in the MW behind SDSU with a .421 fieldgoal percentage, while its .318 percentage from three-point range ranks fifth. In addition, the Rams find themselves among the league leaders in scoring defense (2nd - 63.5 ppg), scoring margin (2nd -(+7.9)), free-throw percentage (3rd - (.737)) and scoring offense (4th

Head coach Ryun Williams is in his second season at the helm of the Rams after a four-year stint at his alma mater South Dakota, where he guided the Coyotes to the second round of the WNIT in 2012. Prior to his tenure at South Dakota, Williams spent 10 seasons at Division II Wayne State (Neb.), highlighted by a berth in the 2008 NCAA regional semifinals.

#### With a Victory...

An SDSU win over Colorado State on Saturday will mean:

- The Aztecs win for the second straight year in Fort Collins.
- SDSU extends its winning streak to a season-best three games and improves to 5-3 in conference play.
- The Aztecs move to 5-2 this year in games played on a Saturday.

#### Of Note

San Diego State is undefeated this season:

- When finishing with fewer turnovers than the opposition (6-0), but is 1-10 when it commits more miscues.
- When leading with with five minutes remaining in regulation (6-0) and 57-1 since the start of the 2011-12 campaign.
- When leading at the half (4-0), but is 3-10 when trailing at intermission.

In addition, the Aztecs are 6-1 so far this year when scoring more than 70 points in a game. However, SDSU is just 1-9 when it is held below the 70-point plateau.

#### Mid-Season Analysis

The fact that San Diego State sits at 7-10 heading into the month of February can be at least partially attributed to the following factors:

- ▶ Three-Point Field Goals The Aztecs' opponents have drained a staggering 145 three-point field goals on the season for an average of 8.5 per game. Conversely, SDSU has connected on just 57 treys for the year and has averaged just 3.5 three-point baskets in its last 10 outings after hitting a season-high eight vs. UCLA on Dec. 15. As a result, the opposition is outscoring the Scarlet and Black by over 15 points per game on triples alone. In addition, the Aztecs have allowed their opponents to shoot over 36 percent from beyond the arc, which ranks near the bottom of 343 Division I teams entering the week.
- ►Turnovers The Aztecs are committing nearly three turnovers more per game (19.1-16.3) than their foes this season, which ranks ninth in the MW. Last season, SDSU was just one of three teams in the league to finish with a positive turnover margin (+2.9), along with Fresno State and Colorado State. Opponents have capitalized on the Aztecs' miscues by maintaining a combined 358-277 advantage in points off turnovers.

However, SDSU has made steady progress in recently, committing 35 fewer miscues (82-117) combined in victories over Miami (OH), UC Riverside, Air Force, Fresno State, San José State and Utah State. ►Schedule - The Aztecs have played one of the toughest schedules in the country so far this year, featuring a pair of games against AP Top 25 foes in No. 19 South Carolina and No. 23 Texas A&M. In addition,

NC State has cracked the AP Top 25 for the past four weeks. Entering

Saturday's contest, the combined record of SDSU's opponents stands at 160-120 (.571).

► Experience - San Diego State's starting lineup against USU featured five players who have combined for just 67 starts in an Aztec uniform prior to Jan. 25. With that lack of experience, growing pains are certainly inevitable.

Despite the adversity, five of the Aztecs' 10 losses have come by a mere 15 points. The youthful SDSU squad has displayed much resiliency during the early part of the season, overcoming a 14-point deficit on Dec. 28 against UC Riverside and nearly rallying from a pair of 19-point deficits at Sacramento State and USC. In fact, the Aztecs owned late leads at Sac State and against San Diego, only to cede go-ahead three-pointers by the opposition.

#### Cleaning Up the Glass

Over the first seven games, San Diego State got out-rebounded by an average margin of 15.6-9.9 on the offensive glass. As a result, the Aztecs' foes maintained a 110-55 advantage in second-chance points during that stretch. However, SDSU has gradually reversed that trend, out-rebounding their last 10 opponents on the offensive boards by a 185-119 margin and maintaining a 159-94 spread in second-chance points.

#### **Spreading the Wealth**

A total of nine Aztecs have scored in double digits at least twice this season, while five have accomplished the feat on five or more occasions. That is especially notable since SDSU has carried no more than 11 active players on its roster this year. In addition, the Aztecs have played five games this season in which four players scored in double figures, including three straight outings against Miami (OH), UC Riverside and NC State. The last time SDSU had four players reach double figures in three consecutive outings occurred in 2009 vs. Pepperdine, Long Beach State and Loyola Marymount.

#### Nothin' Like Home Cookin'

Despite its rather modest 5-5 home record to start the season, SDSU has posted a 65-20 ledger (.765) on the Viejas Arena court since the beginning of the 2008-09 campaign and has captured 32 of its last 39 on The Mesa.

#### The Last Time Out - SDSU vs. Utah State

Powered by the trio of sophomore Deajanae Scurry, senior Cierra Warren and freshman Ariell Bostick, San Diego State won its second straight game last Saturday with an impressive 88-72 victory over Utah State in a Mountain West battle at Viejas Arena.

The Aztec troika combined for 60 of the team's 88 points on a collective 21-for-38 effort (55.2 percent) from the field as SDSU raised its record to 7-10 on the year and 4-3 in conference play.

Scurry recorded a career-high 22 points, draining 9-of-13 field-goal attempts, including four during a three-minute stretch in the second half to help extinguish a late Aggie threat. In addition, Warren notched 20 points on 6-of-10 shooting and added eight free throws, while Bostick finished with a personal-best 18 points of her own to go with a game-high six assists.

On the flip side, USU (8-10, 2-5 MW) dropped its fifth in a row despite 25 points from the conference's leading scorer Jennifer Schlott. The Aggies were plagued by 26 turnovers, including seven apiece by Schlott and teammate Elise Nelson, as the Aztecs parlayed those miscues into 33 points.

As a team, SDSU connected on 31 of 62 attempts (50 percent) from the floor, including a 6-for-13 clip from three-point range, while USU went 29-for-66 on the day (44 percent), including a 1-for-9 performance from beyond the arc in the first half. The Aztecs also got to the foul line more often, draining 20-of-29 free throws, compared to the Aggies' 9-for-12 effort from the charity stripe.

The two sides combined for seven lead changes and two ties in the first seven minutes of action until SDSU went in front for good at 15-12 following a three-pointer by junior Desi Culberson. USU responded with a layup by Ingrida Strikas, but a triple by senior Danesha Long at the 9:31 mark capped a 9-0 blitz to put the Aztecs up 24-14, forcing the Aggies into pursuit mode for the remainder of the contest.

The lead eventually swelled to 20 points on three occasions, including a 47-27 spread at intermission after freshman Chloe Johnson converted a fancy reverse layup to beat the horn.

In all, SDSU shot 18-for-31 from the floor (58 percent) in the first half and scored 22 points off 16 USU turnovers, while the visitors tallied just six points on 10 Aztec blunders.

SDSU seemed primed to run away with the contest after Warren drained an easy layup on the first possession of the second half to give the hosts their largest lead of the game at 49-27. However, the Aztecs went into a funk, misfiring on 12 of 13 field goal attempts over the ensuing nine minutes, while committing seven turnovers. In the interim, the Aggies crawled back into contention, aided by the hot shooting of Lynette Johnson, who scored nine points during a 23-8 USU outburst, which narrowed the gap to 57-50 by spurt with 10:56 left on the clock.

Following a pair of Aztec misses, the Aggies had a chance to cut the deficit to four, but Schlott's three-point attempt rimmed out as Long corralled

the rebound and was subsequently fouled. The SDSU guard sank both free throws, while Warren made a layup shortly thereafter to pump new life into the host school

USU answered with a trey by former Aztec Jasmine Porter, who transferred to the Aggie squad following the 2011-12 campaign, but Bostick came up huge at the other end, converting an and-one opportunity, while Warren promptly drained two foul shots to give SDSU a 66-53 cushion with 8:12 to go.

Scurry took over at this juncture, scoring eight of the Aztecs' next 11 points, as SDSU's lead ballooned to 20 once again at 77-57 with 5:05 remaining. USU connected on just one of five field goals and committed four turnovers during that fateful three-minute span. Despite a pair of triples by Schlott and another by Shelby Cloninger, the Aggies were never able to get any closer than 16 points the rest of the way as Bostick nailed six free throws down the stretch to help keep the visitors at bay.

## Warren Garners Second MW Player of the Week Award

Senior Cierra Warren was named the Mountain West Women's Basketball Player of the Week for the second time this season on Jan. 27, after helping the Aztecs to home wins over San José State and Utah State.

For the week, Warren averaged 25.5 points, 10.5 rebounds and 2.0 assists to go with a blocked shot and two steals, shooting a combined 51.6 percent from the floor on 16 of 31 field-goal attempts and 79.2 percent from the charity stripe on 19 of 24 free throws.

Against SJSU, Warren posted career highs of 31 points and 14 rebounds, including a personal-best nine caroms on the offensive glass, to complete her third double-double of the season. In addition, she finished with a collegiate-high 11 free throws on 12 attempts (91.7 percent), opening with seven straight to surpass her career best in the first eight minutes of the game alone.

Warren continued her stellar play vs. USU, finishing with 20 points and seven rebounds while shooting 60 percent from the field (6-10) en route to her sixth 20-plus point performance of the year.

#### Déjà Vu All Over Again

With the scoring totals of Deajane Scurry (22 pts.) and Cierra Warren (20 pts.) against Utah State, SDSU finished with two 20-point players in the same game since Chelsea Hopkins (22 pts.) and Courtney Clements (21 pts.) accomplished the feat against SMU at home on Dec. 28, 2012. Ironically, that game ended with the identical score as the Aztecs-Aggies clash, an 88-72 victory for San Diego State.

#### **Good Will Hunter**

Junior Khristina Hunter has seen her role increase significantly this season with starting assignments in all but the first two games. The Fairfield, Calif., native has been averaging 10.6 points, 7.9 rebounds and 1.7 steals in her last 10 outings, highlighted by her third career double-double vs. Air Force on Jan. 11, when she scored a career-high tying 20 points to go with a collegiate-best 17 rebounds. The feat was even more remarkable when one considers that she had 15 points and 13 boards by halftime.

In addition, Hunter posted a personal-high nine field goals against the Falcons, a figure she matched a week later at UNLV on Jan. 18.

#### **Long Story Short**

Senior Danesha Long came up huge at Fresno State on Jan. 15, sinking the game-winning 15-foot jumper with 4.9 seconds left to give the Aztecs a 70-69 upset victory. Long set a career-high with 18 points, including a personal-best 4-for-4 effort from three-point range to help saddle the Bulldogs with their first conference loss of the year.

Over the last nine games, Long has averaged 11.0 points and 5.0 rebounds and has become SDSU's main

three-point threat, draining 11 of 31 attempts (.355 pct.) from beyond the arc during that stretch.

Earlier, Long was named to the all-tournament team at the San Diego Surf 'N Slam, helping the Aztecs to a win in the opener against UC Riverside with a career-best 10 rebounds.

#### Scorching the Nets

San Diego State has finished with a .600 or better field-goal percentage in two games already this season (.623 - at Sacramento State and .652 - at UCSB) after recording just two overall between 2000 and 2013. The two percentages mark the top team performances in the Mountain West so far this year.

#### **#AztecWBB Inks Pair to NLIs**

San Diego State head coach Stacie Terry inked her first pair of recruits on Nov. 15, with the signing of Cheyenne Greenhouse (Riverside, Calif.) and Lexy Thorderson (Castle Rock, Colo.) to National Letters of Intent. The two high school seniors are set to join the Aztecs for the 2014-15 season.

Greenhouse signs with SDSU out of Canyon Springs High School, where she captured CIF Division 1A co-player of the year honors as a junior last season after leading the Cougars to the Southern Section championship and a berth in the semifinals of the CIF regional tournament.

A 5-11 guard, Greenhouse averaged 18.4 points, 5.5 rebounds, 2.4 assists and 2.1 steals during the 2012-13 campaign, earning first-team all-state CIF Division 1A recognition while landing a spot on Max-Preps all-state first team.

"Cheyenne is going to be very important to us because she has can play multiple positions," Terry said. She will add tremendous athleticism to our program with her great leaping ability. Cheyenne is also a very intelligent player and her basketball IQ is off the charts."

Greenhouse makes her signing official as a threestar recruit, according to ESPN HoopGurlz. A threetime all-Inland Valley League selection for head coach Gail Hale at Canyon Springs, Greenhouse also brings three years of club experience with her to The Mesa, having played for Cal Swish in 2011, followed by a two-year stint with the West Coast Premier program. She intends to study biology or pre-medicine.

Thorderson, meanwhile, garnered first-team all-Continental Leagues accolades as a junior last year at Rock Canyon High School after averaging a team-best 16.1 points to go along with 5.7 rebounds, 2.6 assists and 1.3 steals. Under the tutelage of head coach Robbie Ballard, the 6-0 guard/forward received Colorado 5A honorable mention all-state distinction on two occasions in 2011 and 2013.

In a game against eventual state champion Regis Jesuit last February, Thorderson scored 32 points to earn player of the game honors by MaxPreps. Earlier in the season, she also gained recognition as the Denver Post's female student-athlete of the week.

"Lexy's addition will enable us to extend our offense because she is deadly from three-point range," Terry said. "Her ability to knock down that jumper will also help open up the game for our post players."

Thorderson, who also competed at the USA Basketball U16 national team trials in 2011, has a basketball pedigree in her family. Her father Eric Thorderson played collegiately at Wayne State (Mich.) from 1980-85, while two of her sisters, Ali and Abby, earned varsity letters at Weber State. She is undecided on a major at San Diego State, but is considering a career in physical therapy and physical education.

#### **Noting the Newcomers**

Of the 12 student-athletes on the current roster, five players will be wearing an Aztec uniform for the first time this season. Cierra Warren practiced with the squad last year but did not compete after transferring from Louisville, while Deidra Smith utilized her redshirt campaign as well, following her transfer from Boston College. In addition, sophomore Deajanae Scurry missed the latter half of the 2012-13 campaign to concentrate on academics.

With San Diego State losing nearly 67 percent of its scoring offense from a year ago, three true freshmen look to gain significant experience this season. Guard Ariell Bostick (Oakland, Calif.) led Bishop O'Dowd High School to a pair of CIF titles, while forward Alyssa Lawrence (New Rochelle, N.Y.) was an all-league and all-section honoree during her prep career. Not to be outdone, Chloe Johnson (Phoenix, Ariz.), who was named the Mountain West preseason freshman of the year, brings strong credentials with her to The Mesa after earning all-state honors for prep powerhouse St. Mary's High, which finished with a No. 1 national ranking in 2011-12

#### **Meet the New Staff**

The talent at Viejas Arena is not just limited to the playing court as head coach Stacie Terry has assembled a prolific staff in her first season on The Mesa. Assistant coaches Jesse Clark, Aisha Veasley and Ciara Carl bring a vast array of experience with them to "America's Finest City", while Mike Bynum returns for his fourth season as the Aztecs' director of player development.

A native of Tacoma, Wash., Clark spent seven years as an assistant at Saint Mary's College, where he helped the Gaels to four straight WNIT berths, including a quarterfinal appearance in 2012-13. He also had stints at Stanford, San Francisco, CSU Bakersfield and Pacific Union.

Veasley, who enjoyed a successful playing career at UCLA, returns to her Southern California roots after two productive stops as an assistant at Tulsa and Colorado. While at CU, Veasley played a pivotal role as the team's recruiting coordinator, helping to land three top-40 classes.

Carl also has ties to the area, having graduated from Point Loma Nazarene and coaching with San Diego club teams. Most recently, she served an assistant at Metro State in Denver, Colo., following a two-year run at Division II power Cal Poly Pomona.

#### Aztecs Garner MW Preseason Honors

San Diego State received three preseason Mountain West individual honors on Oct. 15, as forward Erimma Amarikwa was named to the all-conference team, center Cierra Warren was selected newcomer of the year, while guard Chloe Johnson was tabbed the MW preseason freshman of the year.

As a team, the Aztecs were picked to finish third in the MW preseason poll, which was conducted in a combined

panel of the league's 11 head coaches and select conference media members. SDSU collected 196 points and picked up two first-place votes, trailing second-place Wyoming, which received 212 points and four first-place votes, while preseason favorite Fresno State garnered 238 points and 17 first-place votes.

#### **SDSU Basketball Performance Center**

San Diego State Director of Athletics Jim Sterk announced on Nov. 12 that a proposed 23,500-square-foot basketball performance center is under design, with a plan to break ground on the project in late spring 2014.

The \$14.5 million facility, which will be located just south of the Fowler Athletics Center and east of the football practice fields, will include two full-length courts, eight baskets, locker rooms, film rooms, team lounges, athletic training room and coaches locker rooms to help support the Aztec men's and women's championship basketball programs.

Although a majority of the funds have been pledged, fundraising continues for the project which is tentatively scheduled to be completed in 2015.

"This is an exciting day to be able to announce this project is moving forward," Sterk said. "It is a project that will greatly benefit our already successful men's and women's basketball programs. It is also an important day because we are going public with our drive to raise funds for the project and hope that the community that has enjoyed San Diego State basketball will get behind this project."

"The basketball performance center is more than just a building, it is our classroom," SDSU women's basketball head coach Stacie Terry said. "The facility will provide an opportunity for our student-athletes to enhance their individual games, which will in turn benefit our program. It also keeps San Diego State competing at the highest level not only in basketball, but in recruiting as well."

#### Two For The Show

Former SDSU All-Americans Courtney Clements and Chelsea Hopkins both earned roster spots with the WNBA this past season after completing their illustrious careers for the Scarlet and Black following the 2012-13 campaign. Clements joined the Atlanta Dream as a free-agent rookie last May, while Hopkins was signed by the San Antonio Silver Stars in September.

Clements appeared in 30 games for Atlanta in 2013, becoming the first former Aztec to compete for a WNBA title after the Dream advanced to finals against the eventual champion Minnesota Lynx. The Long Beach native totaled 59 points (2.2/gm) on the year to go with 26 rebounds, eight assists and five steals. Against the Seattle Storm on July 14, Clements recorded a season-best 12 points before logging season highs of five rebounds and 29 minutes played vs. San Antonio on Sept. 15.

Hopkins, meanwhile, averaged 14.3 minutes in three games during a late-season tour of duty with the Silver Stars, finishing with six points, six rebounds and five as

## **STACIE TERRY**

## Head Coach First Season Texas-Arlington (1998)

Stacie Terry was named the eighth head coach in the history of the San Diego State women's basketball program on May 15, 2013. A native of San Diego, Terry gained a wealth of experience as an assistant coach at the Division I level over the past 14 years, including the last five under head coach Nikki Caldwell, who transformed UCLA into a powerhouse before restoring LSU to national prominence.

During Terry's two seasons at LSU, the Lady Tigers compiled a 45-23 overall record and earned two NCAA tournament bids, including a Sweet 16 appearance during the 2012-13 campaign. This past season, the Lady Tigers also posted six victories against ranked opponents and finished with their second-highest scoring average (69.0) in the last seven years. Under Terry's guidance, forward LaShondra Barrett garnered first-team all-Southeastern Conference accolades and received honorable mention All-America distinction in 2012 before becoming a first-round draft choice of the WNBA's Washington Mystics.

"I am honored and humbled to be the next head coach at San Diego State University," Terry said. "I want to thank Jim (Sterk) and his staff for this amazing opportunity. This is such a special place for me. Not only is this my dream job, but it is home. SDSU is a first class university that has all the resources in place to be successful. I am so eager to get started and confident that we can continue the winning tradition that Aztec supporters have become accustomed to both on and off the court."

Prior to her arrival at LSU, Terry served as an assistant under Caldwell at UCLA from 2008-11, helping the Bruins gain national acclaim with a pair of NCAA tournament appearances. During Terry's tenure, UCLA posted 72 overall victories, as the 2010-11 squad finished with a 28-5 record, setting a school record for fewest losses in a single season to go with a No. 7 national ranking. In addition, the Bruins signed the fourth-ranked recruiting class that season, according to ESPN HoopGurlz, while Terry helped mentor first-team all-Pac-10 performers in Doreena Campbell, Darxia Morris and Jasmine Dixon, a 2012 honorable mention AP All-America selection, as well as all-conference freshman honorees Atonye Nyingifa and Markel Walker.

Terry spent the 2007-08 campaign at Southern Mississippi, as the Golden Eagles posted a 21-14 record and earned a postseason berth in the Women's National Invitation Tournament (WNIT). While at Southern Miss, Terry spearheaded the development and coordination of the Lady Eagle recruiting campaign. Her responsibilities also included working with the perimeter players, scouting opponents and film breakdown, as well as coordinating all of the team's community service events.

Terry also coached for three seasons from 2004-07 as an assistant under Hall of Fame head coach Theresa Grentz at Illinois, where the Fighting Illini had three straight recruiting classes ranked among the top 25 in

the nation, according to Blue Star Basketball, and made three consecutive trips to the WNIT. Her primary duties included defensive instruction and working with the perimeter players.

In addition, Terry coached at Dayton during the 2003-04 season following a three-year stint at Louisville from 2000-03. With the Cardinals, Terry's responsibilities encompassed recruiting, scouting, player development, summer camps and serving as a liaison for the program's community service outreach. Louisville captured the Conference USA regular-season title and earned a trip to the NCAA tournament in 2001 before making a WNIT appearance in 2002. She also assisted in signing the nation's 21st-ranked recruiting class in 2002-03, according to All-Star Girls Report. Terry recruited and coached all-Conference USA honoree Lori Nero, a draft choice of the WNBA's Houston Comets, as well as Sara Nord, who finished her collegiate career as the Cardinals' all-time assist leader and ranks among the top 15 scorers in school history.

Terry enjoyed a successful collegiate playing careerat Texas-Arlington, winning four varsity letters from 1994-98 under head coach Mike Dean. She earned first-team all-Southland Conference honors after leading the Mavericks in scoring with 17.4 points per game as a senior in 1997-98. Terry scored 1,169 points during her career at UTA and still ranks among the school's top 10 in three-point field goals made (third), assists (sixth), steals (seventh) and free-throw percentage (10th). She is just one of 17 players in Maverick history to surpass the 1,000-point plateau, while her .335 career three-point field-goal percentage is also a school and Southland Conference career record.

Terry played one season of professional basketball in Warsaw, Poland, averaging 12.0 points and 6.0 assists with the Polonia Phoenix, before returning to Texas-Arlington to begin her coaching career as a graduate assistant in 1999.

Terry prepped at El Capitan High and held the Vaqueros' career scoring record for three years following her graduation. She was inducted into the school's athletic hall of fame in 2008.
