Aztecs Take on No. 22/20 LSU Friday in First Game of NCAA Tempe Regional

San Diego State begins postseason play this weekend when it travels to Arizona State for the NCAA Tempe Regional.

The Aztecs (37-14) earned the No. 3 seed in the double-elimination regional after winning the 2022 Mountain West regular season with a 20-4 record and will face second-seeded and No. 22/20 LSU (34-21) at 5 p.m. PT Friday. The No. 8 overall seed and No. 8/5 Arizona State (39-9) will play Cal State Fullerton (36-20) in the following game at 7:30 p.m. PT. The NCAA Tempe Regional is the toughest in the country according to average RPI (36.25).

SDSU is playing in its 12th NCAA tournament but first since 2015. San Diego State, which also made the tournament in 2001, 2003, 2006, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013 and 2014, is 16-22 all-time in the NCAA championships, has advanced to five NCAA regional finals and won at least one game in the double-elimination regional in 10 of its previous 11 appearances.

The regional winners will advance to super regional competition for a best-of-three series from May 26-29 at eight campus sites. The remaining eight teams will advance to the Women's College World Series (WCWS) from June 2-10 at ASA Hall of Fame Stadium in Oklahoma City, an eight-team, double-elimination tournament with the championship final being a best-of-three series.

Mac Barbara, the MW Player of the Year, leads the Aztecs in almost every offensive category, including average (.395), hits (62, tied), doubles (14), home runs (15), RBIs (56), slugging percentage (.783), on-base percentage (.497), total bases (123) and walks (33 (8 intentional)). Bella Espinoza, who joined Barbara and pitcher Maggie Balint on the all-MW first team, is hitting .388 (62-for-130) with team highs of 34 runs, 62 hits (tied) and 13 stolen bases (tied). Second-team all-MW selection Taylor Adams has raised her batting average 106 percentage points since April 1 and is batting .352 (38-for-108).

Balint, the MW Pitcher of the Year, is 18-5 with six saves and a 1.50 ERA, striking out 263 against 35 walks in 177 innings, while limiting the opposition to a .173 average. Balint won nine of a possible 14 MW Pitcher-of-the-Week awards, tied for the most in league history with former San Diego State greats Christina Ross (2008) and Samantha Beasley (2010).

STACEY NUVEMAN DENIZ
HEAD COACH | 1ST SEASON (14TH OVERALL) | UCLA, 2002

- Was named San Diego State's fifth head coach in program history on June 8, 2021, taking over for SDSU's all-time winningest head coach Kathy Van Wyk.
- Helped lead SDSU to seven straight NCAA tournaments from 2009-15 and a combined 398-264 (.601) record in her 13 seasons on The Mesa as an assistant coach, associate head coach and head coach in waiting.
- Over her first nine seasons as an assistant and associate coach, the Aztecs improved their batting average from .275 in 2008 (the year before she arrived) to a school-record .356 mark in 2017, and also in runs per game (3.98 to 6.61), home runs per game (0.23 to 1.09 (0.92 in 2017)), slugging percentage (.348 to .516) and on-base percentage (.347 to .418).
- Was the head coach of the National Pro Fastpitch's Chicago Bandits for the 2018 season, leading the Bandits to the NPF Championship series in her first year.
- Also has served as an assistant coach for the Women's National Team and USA Softball Junior Women's (19-Under) Selection Camps.
- As a player, was a three-time U.S. Olympian, winning gold medals in 2000 and 2004, and a silver medal in 2008. Also helped the United States National Team to a World Cup championship (2006), two World Championships (2002 and 2006) and two Pan American gold medals (1999 and 2003).
- Was a standout player at UCLA, finishing her four-year career with four NCAA records - 90 home runs, .945 slugging percentage, 240 walks and 81 intentional walks. She was a four-time first-team NFCA All-American (1997, 1999, 2001-02) and a three-time Pac-10 Player of the Year (1999, 2001-02).
- In 1999, Nuveman Deniz led the Bruins to a national championship, batting .446 during the season with 31 home runs and 91 RBIs.

- * All 12 NCAA tournament appearances have come this century, including 2001, 2003, 2006, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015 and now 2022.
- * San Diego State is 16-22 all-time at the NCAAs, with two of the losses coming at the hands of Arizona State (2009 and 2011) and one to Cal State Fullerton (2009). The Aztecs will play either ASU or CSF as early as Saturday.
- * SDSU has advanced to five NCAA regional finals (2001, 2006, 2011, 2012 and 2015) out of its 11 previous appearances, but has never made it to the NCAA Super Regionals.
- * San Diego State has won at least one game in the double-elimination regional in 10 of its previous 11 appearances. Ironically in 2009 while playing in the same NCAA Tempe Regional, the Aztecs lost both of their games, falling to Arizona State, 5-0, and Cal State Fullerton, 8-2.
- * SDSU is 16-14 in the tournament when playing as a neutral team (0-8 as the road squad).
- * San Diego State is 4-8 all-time in Tempe in the NCAA tournament, going 0-2 in 2009, 2-2 in 2011, 1-2 in 2013 and 1-2 in 2014. The Aztecs made the NCAA Tempe Regional final in 2011 before being eliminated by host Arizona State, 6-1.
- * SDSU is the No. 3 seed in the four-team regional for its sixth consecutive NCAA tournament appearance (also 2011-15). San Diego State is 8-10 all-time as the No. 3 seed, advancing to three regional finals (2011 in Tempe, 2012 in Los Angeles and 2015 in Los Angeles).
- * The Aztecs are playing in the tournament's toughest regional for the fourth time over its last five appearances (also 2012, 2013 and 2015). The exception was the 2014 season in Tempe, which still featured ninth-ranked Arizona State and No. 20 Michigan. This year's Tempe Regional averages a 36.25 RPI, just ahead of the Knoxville Regional (37.00). More on that below.
- * Five current SDSU players have previous NCAA tournament experience while playing for other schools, including three of San Diego State's four pitchers on the staff. Maggie Balint is 2-0 with a 2.62 ERA across 18 2/3 innings and six appearances while at Oregon (2017-18), striking out 19 with five walks. Allie Light, meanwhile, tossed two scoreless innings of relief with two strikeouts last year for Arkansas, and Dani Martinez is 0-2 with a 12.83 ERA in six innings while at Cal State Fullerton (2019 and 2021), striking out two with two walks. Danielle Romanello was 0-for-4 as a pinch hitter while at Florida (2018-19) and Alexa Schultz was 0-for-1 in five appearances at Oklahoma (2018-19).

Aztecs Playing in the Toughest NCAA Regional (Again)

No stranger to playing tough competition, San Diego State will once again play in the toughest region out of the 16 regionals of the NCAA tournament.

This weekend's NCAA Tempe Regional features Arizona State (No. 10 in the final regular season RPI), LSU (No. 22), the Aztecs (No. 49) and Cal State Fullerton (No. 64), which comes out to an average RPI of 36.25. The next-toughest regional based on average RPI is the Knoxville Regional, which has Tennessee (No. 12), Ohio State (No. 25), Oregon State (No. 37) and Campbell (No. 74), and an average RPI of 37.00.

This marks the fourth time in SDSU's last five appearances that it has played in the toughest region. In 2012, San Diego State played with a group at the NCAA Los Angeles Regional that averaged 30.75 (next best was 31.50). In 2013 at the NCAA Tempe Regional, the Aztecs' quartet averaged a 36.00 RPI (next toughest was 39.75). In 2015, SDSU played at the NCAA Los Angeles Regional, which had an average RPI of 31.00 (No. 2 was Eugene Regional at 36.00). The only exception to the rule over the last five appearances was 2014 at the NCAA Tempe Regional, where San Diego State still had No. 4/4 Arizona State and No. 13/13 Michigan to contest with.

Mac Barbara a Finalist for Schutt Sports/NFCA Division I National Freshman of the Year

San Diego State softball's Mac Barbara (Long Beach, Calif.) was named a finalist for the 2022 Schutt Sports/NFCA Division I National Freshman of the Year, the NFCA announced May 12. A redshirt freshman, Barbara is one of 10 finalists for the award.

The winner of the 2022 Schutt Sports/NFCA Division I National Freshman of the Year will be announced on Tuesday, May 31 prior to the start of the NCAA Women's College World Series in Oklahoma City.

Barbara, who also was named the Mountain West Player of the Year, is batting .395 (62-for-157) with 15 home runs, 56 RBIs, 29 runs, 14 doubles, 33 walks and six stolen bases for a .783 slugging percentage and a .497 on-base percentage. Barbara, who reached base safely in 40 consecutive games from Feb. 17-May 6, which was the longest streak in the country this year and set a program record, ranks among the top 50 in the country in RBIs (T-18th, 56), total bases (24th, 123), slugging percentage (38th, .783), on-base percentage (44th, .497), walks (T-47th, 33) and home runs (T-49th, 15).

Among the Aztec single-season leaders, Barbara is third in RBIs (56), fourth in on-base percentage (.497), slugging percentage (.783), OPS percentage (1.280) and extra-base hits (40), fifth in walks (33), tied for sixth in home runs (15) and doubles (14), and seventh in batting average (.395) and total bases (123).

Barbara began her career at Ole Miss, playing 12 games in 2020 during the COVID shortened season and in four games in 2021 before leaving to play for the Italian National Team.

Aztecs Dominate Mountain West Awards

San Diego State softball head coach Stacey Nuveman Deniz was named the Mountain West Coach of the Year, while redshirt freshman Mac Barbara (Long Beach, Calif.) and senior Maggie Balint (West Grove, Pa.) were selected as the MW Player and Pitcher of the Year, respectively, the league announced May 11. It is just the fifth time in league history that a team has swept the three aforementioned awards and the second occasion by the Aztecs (also Patrice Jackson, Rebecca Arbino and Kathy Van Wyk in 2013).

The postseason awards are voted on by the league's nine coaches and take into account MW games only.

Barbara and Balint were joined on the all-MW first team with freshman Bella Espinoza (Huntington Beach, Calif.), while senior Taylor Adams (Mill Creek, Wash.), freshmen Dee Dee Hernandez (La Crescenta, Calif.) garnered second-team accolades and AJ Murphy (Goodyear, Ariz.).

In her first season as SDSU's head coach, Nuveman Deniz has San Diego State on the verge of its league-record eighth MW regular-season title and first NCAA tournament appearance since 2015. The Aztecs sit atop the league standings with an 18-3 record, two games ahead of Boise State (16-5) and three ahead of UNLV (15-6). SDSU, which is 35-13 overall, has already won series against both Boise State and UNLV, and need just one win this weekend at New Mexico to clinch at least a share of the MW title and the league's automatic bid to the 2022 NCAA tournament, regardless of what happens in any other series. Two victories by San Diego State will clinch an outright league championship. Nuveman Deniz is the second Aztec head coach to be named the MW Coach of the Year, joining Van Wyk, who won the award in 2002, 2006, 2008, 2013 and 2014.

Nuveman Deniz has taken over the pitching staff this year and has San Diego State leading the league in every major category in league games, including ERA (1.88), opposing batting average (.189), strikeouts (189), wins (20), winning percentage (.833), saves (4) and WHIP (0.89). In all games, the Aztecs lead the country with a 6.42 strikeout-to-walk ratio, while ranking 24th in ERA (2.09) and 27th in winning percentage (.725).

Barbara, meanwhile, is SDSU's fifth league player of the year, following in the footsteps of Haley Miles (2012 co-player of the year), Jackson (2013), Lorena Bauer (2015) and Jenavee Peres (2017). In conference play, Barbara hit .406 (28-for-69) with five home runs, 24 RBIs, 12 runs, six doubles, a triple, 21 walks (eight intentional) and three stolen bases, while owning a .739 slugging percentage and a .544 on-base mark.

Overall, Barbara is batting .395 (62-for-157) with 15 home runs, 56 RBIs, 29 runs, 14 doubles, 33 walks and six stolen bases for a .783 slugging percentage and a .497 on-base percentage. Barbara, who reached base safely in 40 consecutive games from Feb. 17-May 6, which was the longest streak in the country this year and set a program record, ranks among the top 50 in the country in RBIs (T-18th, 56), total bases (24th, 123), slugging percentage (38th, .783), on-base percentage (44th, .497), walks (T-47th, 33) and home runs (T-49th, 15).

Balint became San Diego State's 10th MW Pitcher of the Year, the most in league history, but first since Danielle O'Toole in 2014. The Aztecs' other winners are Sandra Durazo (2001), Bre DeSanto (2002), Celena Velasquez (2003 and 2004), Christina Ross (2006 and 2008), Samantha Beasley (2010) and Arbino (2013). It was her third straight time making the all-MW team, making her the third SDSU pitcher to accomplish that feat along with Velasquez (2003-06) and Ross (2006-08).

Balint, who tied Ross and Beasley for the most pitcher-of-the-week awards in league history (9) this year, finished 10-1 with four saves and a 1.36 ERA in league play across 97 2/3 innings, striking out 129 against 20 walks while limiting the opposition to a .168 average. In all games, Balint is 18-5 with six saves and a 1.50 ERA, striking out 263 batters against 35 walks in 177 innings, while limiting her opponents to a .173 average. Among the national leaders, Balint is tied for third in saves (6), ninth in strikeout-to-walk ratio (7.51), 13th in strikeouts (263), 16th in strikeouts per seven innings (10.40), 21st in ERA (1.50) and 30th in hits allowed per seven innings (4.39). On May 4, Balint was one of 13 athletes chosen in the 2022 Athletes Unlimited Softball Draft Class.

Espinoza made the first team as well, becoming just the fourth San Diego State true freshman to make an all-conference first team since the league went to two teams (first and second) in 2014, joining Jaylene Ignacio (2014), Peres (2015) and Shelby Thompson

(2017). In the midst of a standout freshman campaign, Espinoza hit .390 (32-for-82) in league games with 16 runs, six RBIs, and six stolen bases. Overall, Espinoza is batting .388 (62-for-160) with team highs of 34 runs and 13 stolen bases (tied).

Adams became just the third Aztec to make four all-conference teams along with Velasquez (2003-06) and Thompson (2017-21). In league games, Adams hit .415 (22-for-53) with two homers, 14 RBIs, 10 runs, four doubles and 12 walks, owning a .604 slugging percentage and a .515 on-base mark. In all games, Adams is batting .352 (38-for-108) with four home runs, 21 RBIs, 20 runs, six doubles, 16 walks and eight stolen bases for a .537 slugging percentage and a .441 on-base percentage.

Hernandez joined Adams on the second team and was 6-1 in league action with a 2.08 ERA in 37 innings, striking out 30 with just four walks. Overall, Hernandez is 9-4 with three saves and a 1.81 ERA, strikeout out 64 against 10 walks.

Murphy batted .325 (25-for-77) in league play with two home runs, 13 RBIs and seven runs while committing just two errors in 66 chances at shortstop. Overall, Murphy is hitting .299 (40-for-134) with two homers, 24 RBIs and 17 runs.

Bella Espinoza Named MW Freshman of the Week

San Diego State softball's Bella Espinoza (Huntington Beach, Calif.) has been named the Mountain West Freshman of the Week for the fourth time this season, the league announced Tuesday.

Espinoza helped the Aztecs (37-14) to a series win at New Mexico last weekend, going 4-for-10 (.400) with four RBIs, two runs and a stolen base. Espinoza had at least one hit in all three games and recorded a putout in her only fielding chance in right field.

Espinoza had a career-high three RBIs in SDSU's 7-1 win on Thursday, first coming through with a two-run single with the bases loaded and later adding a fielder's choice RBI. Espinoza followed with a 2-for-2 outing, an RBI and two runs in San Diego State's 12-3, five-inning victory on Friday. Espinoza finished her weekend with a single and stolen base in the Aztecs' 4-3 loss on Saturday.

Espinoza, who was named a first-team all-Mountain West selection last week, is batting .388 (62-for-160) with team highs of 34 runs and 13 stolen bases (tied). Espinoza is tied for first in the MW in hits (62), fourth in batting average (.388) and tied for fifth in stolen base (13). Among the SDSU single-season leaders, she is tied for third in singles (61) and 10th in batting average (.388). Among San Diego State true freshmen all-time, Espinoza is first in singles (61), second in batting average (.388), tied for second in hits (62), third in runs (34) and fifth in stolen bases (13).

Not only is San Diego State winning at a tremendous clip, but the Aztecs have been particularly impressive on the road. SDSU is 12-2 on the road this season, which is the fourth-best record in the country. Below is a look at the top-five best road teams in the nation as of May 10.

Mac Barbara Slugging Her Way into SDSU History

Mac Barbara is putting together one of the best offensive seasons in program history. Through 51 games, Barbara is batting .395 (62-for-157) with 15 home runs, 56 RBIs, 29 runs, 14 doubles, 33 walks and six stolen bases for a .783 slugging percentage and a .497 on-base percentage. Among the NCAA leaders, Barbara is tied for 18th in RBIs (56), 24th in total bases (123), 38th in slugging percentage (.783), 44th in on-base percentage (.497), tied for 47th in walks (33), tied for 49th in home runs (15), tied for 61st in doubles (14), 75th in batting average (.395) and tied for 80th in hits (62).

Barbara's 15 home runs in 51 games are tied for the sixth most in San Diego State single-season history. Barbara also ranks third in RBIs (56), fourth in on-base percentage (.497), slugging percentage (.783), OPS percentage (1.280) and extra-base hits (40), fifth in walks (33), tied for sixth in doubles (14), and seventh in batting average (.395) and total bases (123).

With two home runs against Stony Brook on March 6, Barbara became the fastest player in program history to reach 10 home runs in a season, doing so in SDSU's 21st game of the season. Barbara is currently five home runs behind the school record of 20 set by Hayley Miles in 2012.

Barbara Reaching Base at a Historic Clip

Not only is Barbara among the top sluggers in the country, she is getting on at an impressive clip too. In fact, Barbara reached base safely in 40 consecutive games, which started with a Feb. 17 game against CSUN and ended May 7. Barbara reached via error on May 7 but that does not count per the NCAA. The 40-game streak was longest streak in the country this season.

On the year, Barbara has reached base safely in 48 of the team's 51 games, only failing to do so against Stanford on Feb. 11, San Diego on Feb. 16 and Utah State on May 7.

Maggie Balint Pitching Her Way into the SDSU Record Books

Maggie Balint is having her best season as an Aztec and one of the best seasons of her career. Balint, who was 28-4 with a 1.51 ERA at Oregon from 2017-18 en route to being named a all-region, all-Pac-12 and all-Pac-12 freshman pick as a freshman in 2017, is currently 18-5 with six saves, a 1.50 ERA in 177 innings. The right-hander has struck out 263 against just 35 walks, limiting the opposition to a .173 average. Balint, who was named the MW Pitcher of the Week nine times in 14 tries this season, is ranked among the NCAA and SDSU single-season bests.

In the NCAA, Balint is tied for third in saves (6), ninth in strikeout-to-walk ratio (7.51), 13th in strikeouts (263), 16th in strikeouts per seven innings (10.40), 21st in ERA (1.50) and 30th in hits allowed per seven innings (4.39).

Among the Aztec single-season leaders, Balint ranks first in winning percentage (.783) and strikeouts per seven innings (10.40), tied for first in saves (6), second in opponent average (.173), third in strikeouts (263), fourth in strikeout-to-walk ratio (7.51), eighth in WHIP (0.825) and 10th in hits allowed per seven innings (4.39).

Despite playing two-plus seasons with SDSU, Balint ranks second in opponent average (.191) and strikeouts per seven innings (8.25), third in winning percentage (.705), fourth in saves (10) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.32), fifth in WHIP (0.964) and hits allowed per seven innings (4.84), sixth in strikeouts (501) and solo shutouts (since 1999) (13), ninth in wins (43) and tied for ninth in total shutouts (since 1983) (17).

Maggie Balint Drafted to Athletes Unlimited

San Diego State Maggie Balint (West Grove, Pa.) was one of 13 athletes chosen in the 2022 Athletes Unlimited Softball Draft Class, which was announced May 4 as part of the espnW Summit in New York.

Athletes Unlimited Softball begins this summer with a two-week competition called AUX Softball, which will take place June 13-25, coinciding with the 50th anniversary of Title IX on June 23. AUX Softball will feature 42 athletes playing 18 games at SDSU Softball Stadium with all 18 games broadcast live exclusively on ESPN platforms. Balint is 18-5 with six saves and a 1.50 ERA, striking out 263 batters against 35 walks, while limiting her opponents to a .173 average.

The 13 draftees were each introduced by either a member of the Athletes Unlimited Softball Player Executive Committee or one of several special guest. Balint was announced by the 2021 Big 12 Pitcher of the Year Carrie Eberle.

Start Me Up

San Diego State had an incredible start to the Mountain West season. The Aztecs started 10-0 in league action and finished 20-4 in MW play. In league games SDSU outscored its opposition, 123-56, in 24 games (5.1-2.3).

San Diego State won all eight of its MW series this season and won the league by one game over Boise State.

The 10-0 start was San Diego State's best conference start since the 2006 season, when the Aztecs started out 13-0.

A Dirty Dozen

The Aztecs secured the tourney title for the third straight year after going 4-1, including wins over their final four games (8-0 in five innings over Army West Point on Friday, 7-3 over Army West Point and 11-0 in five innings over Southern Utah on Saturday, and 3-0 over California Baptist on Sunday. SDSU's lone setback was a 6-4 decision on Thursday when it entered the final inning with a 4-1 lead.

Following the Aztecs (4-1) were California Baptist (3-1), CSUN (3-2), Southern Utah (1-4) and Army West Point (1-4).

San Diego State's six Campbell/Cartier Classic titles are the most in the history of the tournament. Below is a look at the past winners:

Aztecs Excel in Lid-Lifters

San Diego State has excelled in season-opening games since records were first kept in 1980.

Following a 3-1 victory over Middle Tennessee on Feb. 10, the Aztecs improved to 32-11 (.744) in lid-lifters in recorded program history.

SDSU has won nine of its last 10 season openers, 20 of its last 22 and 23 of its last 26.

San Diego State's only blemishes in the past 26 season-openers came in 2018 (lost to No. 25/25 Georgia, 23-2), 2012 (lost to Texas Tech, 5-4) and in 2000 (lost to UIC, 5-3).

Over the last 26 openers, the Aztecs have outscored their opponent, 149-81, or 5.7-3.1 per game in lid-lifters.

SDSU ended up recording back-to-back shutouts over the Toreros on 2021 opening day, the first time it had consecutive shutouts on a opening day since 2008.

Stacey Nuveman Deniz Named Program's Fifth Head Coach

San Diego State's Stacey Nuveman Deniz was named the softball head coach, director of athletics John David Wicker announced on June 8. A three-time U.S. Olympian, Nuveman Deniz is just the fifth head coach in program history after spending the last 13 seasons with the Aztecs as an assistant, associate head coach and head coach in waiting under SDSU's all-time winningest coach Kathy Van Wyk.

"I am humbled and honored to have this opportunity to lead San Diego State Softball into the future," Nuveman Deniz said. "Kathy Van Wyk spent 25 years building this program, and now it is my turn to take the reins and continue that growth. I would like to thank (SDSU director of athletics) John David Wicker for this opportunity and for the unwavering support he has shown me. The University, the city of San Diego and our incredible community have captured my heart and I truly am an Aztec for Life. I can't wait to get started."

Nuveman Deniz, who was hired at San Diego State following her stint with the U.S. team at the 2008 Beijing Olympics, helped SDSU to seven straight NCAA tournaments from 2009-15 and a combined 398-264 (.601) record in her 13 seasons on The Mesa. Over her first nine seasons as an assistant and associate coach, the Aztecs improved their batting average from .275 in 2008 (the year before she arrived) to a school-record .356 mark in 2017, and also in runs per game (3.98 to 6.61), home runs per game (0.23 to 1.09 (0.92 in 2017)), slugging percentage (.348 to .516) and on-base percentage (.347 to .418).

In 2018, Nuveman Deniz was the head coach of the National Pro Fastpitch's Chicago Bandits, leading the team to the NFP Championship season series in her first year. In the spring of 2010, Nuveman Deniz served as an assistant coach for the Women's National Team Selection Camp, at the Canadian Open Fast Pitch Women's International Championship and at the World Cup of Softball VI. She was also named to the USA Softball Coaching Pool in 2014 and was an assistant coach at the USA Softball Junior Women's (19-Under) National Team (JWNT) Selection Camp in January 2015.

In addition to her two Olympic gold medals (2000 and 2004) and silver medal in 2008, Nuveman Deniz helped the United States National Team to a World Cup championship (2006), two World Championships (2002 and 2006) and two Pan American gold medals (1999 and 2003). Her 2004 Olympic gold medal team, meanwhile, was inducted into the U.S. Olympic hall of fame in July 2012.

Nuveman Deniz was a standout at UCLA, finishing her four-year career with four NCAA records - 90 home runs, .945 slugging percentage, 240 walks and 81 intentional walks. She was a four-time first-team NFCA All-American (1997, 1999, 2001-02) and a three-time Pac-10 Player of the Year (1999, 2001-02). Nuveman Deniz is also ranked first in school history in games played (264), total bases (653) and on-base percentage (.600).

Among the current all-time NCAA leaders, Nuveman Deniz ranks first in home runs per game (0.34), total bases (653) and intentional walks (81), second in slugging percentage (.945), third in home runs (90) and walks (240), fifth in RBIs (299), seventh in batting average (.466).

In 1999, Nuveman Deniz led the Bruins to a national championship, batting .446 during the season with 31 home runs and 91 RBIs.

For her efforts in the national title run, Nuvevan was named to the all-Women's College World Series team. Nuvevan Deniz was inducted into UCLA's hall of fame in October 2012.

Nuvevan Deniz graduated from UCLA in 2002 with a degree in sociology and public policy and later earned her master's in kinesiology from Texas Women's University in 2012.

Canadian Olympian Victoria Hayward Named Assistant Coach

Victoria Hayward was named an assistant coach for the San Diego State softball team, head coach Stacey Nuvevan Deniz announced Aug. 26, 2021. Hayward recently represented Canada at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics and has been a member of the Canadian Senior National Team since 2009.

Hayward has nine years of experience in the college ranks, most recently serving as the director of operations at UCF in 2019 and as an assistant coach at Maryland in 2018.

Prior to Maryland, Hayward helped guide UMass to back-to-back winning seasons in 2016 and 2017. UMass was one of the top hitting teams in the Atlantic 10 in 2017, finished second in regular-season standings and advanced to the A10 title game. At UMass, Hayward helped nine batters/position players earn all-conference honors and three Minutewomen hitters garnered NFCA All-Region selections during her tenure.

Hayward spent the 2015 season as a graduate assistant at LSU under head coach Beth Torina. The Tigers opened the year with 25 consecutive victories and spent three weeks as the top-ranked team in the country, before ending the season with a 52-14 record and a third-place finish at the Women's College World Series (WCWS). LSU's coaching staff was named the Division I South Region Staff of the Year by the National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA).

As a player, Hayward made the Canadian squad in 2009 at 16 years old, becoming the youngest player ever to join the senior team. Hayward has been a mainstay in the outfield and has won numerous medals in international competition. She was the 19th overall selection in the 2014 National Pro Fastpitch Draft by the Pennsylvania Rebellion.

In college, Hayward starred at national power Washington, helping the Huskies to four NCAA tournaments. Hayward was a 2014 All-American, a four-time all-Pac-12 selection and a three-time Academic All-Pac-12 honoree (2011-14). UW won four NCAA Regional Championships during her career and advanced to the Women's College World Series in 2013. She finished her Washington career ranked seventh in runs (176), 10th in triples (7) and 12th in average (.351), while stealing a league-best 28 bases as a senior without committing an error.

SDSU Adds Former UCLA Star and U.S. Olympian Rachel Garcia to Staff

Rachel Garcia, one of the most decorated players in NCAA softball history, has joined San Diego State as a volunteer assistant coach, head coach Stacey Nuvevan Deniz announced Jan. 7.

Garcia, who most recently helped the United States to a silver medal at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics in the summer, garnered numerous accolades during her time at UCLA, including twice being named the Collegiate Woman Athlete of the Year (Honda Cup) for all sports (2019 and 2021) and three times the Honda Sports Award for softball (2018, 2019 and 2021). Garcia also won the Senior CLASS Award in 2021.

Garcia, who redshirted in 2020 while playing for Team USA on its Stand Beside Her Tour, also has been chosen twice as the USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year (2018-19), and once each as the NFCA National Pitcher of the Year (2019) and the NFCA National Player of the Year (2018). Garcia was also the 2017 NFCA National Freshman of the Year.

In the circle, Garcia was 99-17 with a 1.43 ERA with 11 saves for her career with the Bruins, striking out 996 against 172 walks in 749 innings. Garcia tossed 28 shutouts and 66 complete games, while limiting the opposition to a .172 batting average. Her 2019 NFCA pitcher-of-the-year season featured a 29-1 record with a 1.14 ERA and seven shutouts in 202 innings, striking out 286 as UCLA captured the NCAA title.

At the plate, Garcia hit .337 for her career with 43 home runs, 175 RBIs, 103 runs and 32 doubles, while owning a .594 slugging percentage and a .430 on-base mark. When she was named the NFCA Player of the Year in 2018, Garcia hit .339 with 11 home runs and 54 RBIs in 61 games.

Garcia is also a four-time NFCA All-American (first team in 2018, 2019 and 2021, second team in 2017), four-time NFCA All-Region selection (2017, 2018, 2019 and 2021), three-time Pac-12 Player of the Year (2018, 2019 and 2021), 2019 Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year, 2017 Pac-12 Freshman of the Year and four-time all-Pac-12 selection (2017, 2018, 2019 and 2021).

Throughout her career, Garcia was a multi-time national player of the week (three times by USA Softball and twice by NFCA) and a two-time NFCA national player of the week. Additionally, Garcia was an 11-time Pac-12 Pitcher of the Week and a four-time Pac-12 Player of the Week.

Garcia has been with the USA National Team since 2018, helping the squad win the gold medal at the 2018 WBSC Women's World Championship, and the 2019 USA Softball International Cup, Pan American Games and Japan Cup, before settling for a silver medal at Tokyo last summer.
