The San Diego State men's soccer team looks to get back to its winning ways when it travels to the Pacific Northwest for two key Pac-10 games this weekend. The Aztecs will meet Oregon State (4-7-3, 1-3-1 Pac-10) at 7:30 p.m. Friday before playing Washington (8-4-1, 3-1-1 Pac-10) on Sunday at 1 p.m. Last week, SDSU fell to both squads at home, both by 2-1 scores.

Scouting the Beavers

Oregon State heads into the weekend with a 1-3-1 mark in the Pac-10 (4-7-3 overall). Last weekend, the Beavers defeated the Aztecs, 2-1, in San Diego despite being outshot, 15-4, over the final 59 minutes. On Sunday, Oregon State fell at UCLA, 3-0.

Robby Christner is tied for the Pac-10 lead with seven goals. Christner, who also has two helpers, is tied for second with 16 points. Danny Mwanga, who scored both goals against SDSU on Friday, is second on the team with eight points on four goals. Mike Miller (4-4-2, 1.27 GAA, 924:44) and Steve Spangler (0-3-1, 1.64 GAA, 384:03) have split time in net.

The Beavers lead the all-time series, 5-4-1. The series is tied, 3-3-1, in San Diego State's Pac-10 era.

Last Friday, the Aztecs overcame a sluggish start to dominate the final 59 minutes of the match, including putting up the final five corner kicks of the game. Redshirt senior Matt McManus scored for SDSU off assists from junior Nick Cardenas and sophomore Raymundo Reza. San Diego State outshot Oregon State, 19-12, for the game. Sophomore Michael Rocha came off the bench to record a game and career-high six shots, including three on net. Redshirt freshman Morgan Maestas made one save in the loss.

A Look at the Huskies

Washington comes into the weekend with only one loss in its last eight matches. Included in the impressive run is a 2-1, overtime victory over SDSU on Sunday. The Huskies (8-4-1 overall) sit in a tie for first place in the Pac-10 with a 3-1-1 record. Washington dropped from its No. 23 ranking with a loss to fellow first-place UCLA, but is still receiving votes by NSCAA/adidas and Soccer Times.

Raphael Cox (6 g, 5 a) and Brent Richards (6 g, 2 a) lead the high-powered Washington offense, which ranks 33rd in the nation with 1.85 goals per game, with 17 and 14 points, respectively. Cox's 1.42 points per game is tied for 42nd nationally. Rylan Hawkins (4-1-0, 0.84 GAA, 428:31) and Stephen Fung (4-3-1, 1.48 GAA, 788:32) have each logged minutes in net.

Washington has the advantage in the all-time series, 5-3-4.

Last weekend, the Huskies escaped San Diego with a 2-1, overtime victory despite being outshot, 19-10. Cox scored the game-winner after Richards tallied the first goal of the game in the second half. The Aztecs, who were playing without their top point scorer (junior Evan Toft) and top goal scorer (redshirt junior Matt McManus), received their goal from sophomore Khadim Diouf with assists to junior Nick Cardenas and sophomore Raymundo Reza. Senior Jorge Rosales played remarkable in net, making five brilliant saves.

SDSU suffered a heartbreaking 2-1, overtime loss to Washington on a Raphael Cox goal 3:32 into overtime ... For the game, the Aztecs outshot the Huskies, 19-10 ... F Khadim Diouf tallied the team's goal off assists from D Nick Cardenas and MF Raymundo Reza ... It was the second straight contest Cardenas and Reza each had assists on the same play ... Diouf had a game-high four shots, while MF Daniel Steres and MF Dennis Sanchez each had three attempts ... GK Jorge Rosales had an outstanding game, making five brilliant saves to earn Man of the Match.

At the Helm

Lev Kirshner is in his ninth year as the head coach and 12th season overall. Kirshner, just one of three coaches in the 40-year history of the program, has brought SDSU back to the national spotlight with back-to-back runner-up finishes in the Pac-10 and two trips to the NCAA tournament in the past three seasons.

Since the men's soccer team earned its full allotment of scholarships in 2005, the Aztecs have gone 29-24-16 (.536), including a 12-11-12 (.514) mark in the Pac-10.

Over his eight seasons, Kirshner has coached two All-America selections, three Academic All-America picks, eight professional players, five all-Far West selections and 33 all-conference picks.

Aztecs Celebrate 400th Victory in Program History

On Sunday, Sept. 14, the San Diego State men's soccer team picked up its 400th victory in program history with a 2-0 shutout versus Air Force in Denver. In its 41st season of Division I soccer, SDSU is now 401-261-84 (.594), including 29-24-16 (.536) in its three-plus years in the Pac-10.

Over the 40-plus years, the Aztecs have advanced to eight NCAA tournaments (1969, 1981-82, 1987-89, 2005-

06), including one final four. The final four appearance came in 1987 when San Diego State came from behind in each of its NCAA tournament games to win by 2-1 scores. The run was stopped in the NCAA championship game when host Clemson downed the Aztecs, 2-0. The 1987 squad joined the 1973 men's championship volleyball team as the only two Aztec teams to ever make a NCAA final.

In addition to its many team awards, SDSU has garnered numerous individual accolades as well. The program has produced two National Soccer Hall of Fame Members, five World Cup participants and/or Olympians, 26 national team members, four Hermann Trophy Candidates and 10 All-American selections.

Junior Nick Cardenas Named to 2008 M.A.C. Hermann Trophy Watch List

Junior defender Nick Cardenas (Thornton, Colo.) has been named to the 2008 Missouri Athletic Club's Hermann Trophy Watch List. Considered the highest individual honor in intercollegiate soccer, the recipients of the MAC's Hermann Trophy are selected by Division I head coaches who are current members of the National Soccer Coaches Association of America (NSCAA). Cardenas is one of 11 defenders and 18 juniors on the list.

Cardenas, a two-time NSCAA/adidas all-Far West team selection and all-Pac-10 pick, has eight goals and five assists over his two-plus seasons. The 2006 Pac-10 Freshman of the Year and an U.S. U-20 National Team Camp call-up, Cardenas has started 47 collegiate games, anchoring a defense that has posted 16 shutouts over the past two-plus years.

This season, Cardenas has three assists, which tie him for second on the team, while playing the most minutes (1,100) of the entire squad.

Last Tuesday, Cardenas was named *College Soccer News* National Team of the Week and the *TopDrawerSoccer.com* Men's Team of the Week for his play in helping the Aztecs to two crucial road results in Pac-10 action.

A list of 15 semifinalists will be selected by a coaches committee in November, with three finalists announced in early December. They will be invited to the Missouri Athletic Club in St. Louis, Mo., for a news conference on Jan. 9, 2009, where the winner will be announced, with a presentation banquet following.

Three Aztecs - Chris Keenan (1987), Marcelo Balboa (1988-89) and Kyle Whittemore (1988) - have been named Hermann Award finalists, but no SDSU athlete has ever won the award. Most recently, Tally Hall was a semifinalist in 2006.

Aztecs Picked to Finish Fifth in Pac-10

Despite returning 10 starters, including five all-conference selections, from last season's runner-up squad, the San Diego State men's soccer team has been picked to finish fifth in the Pac-10 Conference in the preseason poll voted on by the league's coaches Wednesday.

SDSU picked up 11 points, two behind fourth-place Washington (13). California was selected to repeat as league champions with 24 points, including four of the six first-place votes.

The Golden Bears were followed by UCLA (20 points) and Stanford (17 points), which each picked up one first-place vote. The Huskies (13), Aztecs (11) and Oregon State (5)

Last season, San Diego State finished 8-7-4 overall and 4-4-2 in Pac-10 play, ending up in a three-way tie for second with Stanford and UCLA.

SDSU, which has never been picked higher than fourth in its four preseason polls, has finished the season better than each of its predicted finishes. In its inaugural Pac-10 season in 2005, the Aztecs were picked sixth, yet managed a fourth-place finish. San Diego State finished second in each of its past two seasons despite being picked fourth and fifth, respectively, in the preseason poll.

Bring 'em On

Year after year the Aztecs play one of the toughest schedules on the West Coast and this year is certainly no exception.

In fact, the 2008 schedule may be the toughest of Kirshner's nine-year tenure as eight of the 18 games (44.4 percent) are against teams who made the 2007 NCAA tournament. In addition, nine of the contests (50 percent) are versus teams who finished the season with a 37 RPI rating or better.

"It is one of the best, if not the best, schedules we have had in San Diego State history in terms of quality, the diversity of teams we are playing and the breadth of the location of where we are playing," Kirshner said. "We would not do this if we didn't think our team was prepared for it."

Of SDSU's 12 opponents thus far this season, five are currently nationally-ranked and another has been ranked this season. In fact, four of its losses (and one tie) have come against teams in the top 33 of the latest edition of the RPI (Released Oct. 14). The road doesn't get any easier as the Aztecs travel to Oregon State and Washington.

An Offensive Machine

Head coach Lev Kirshner said before the season that he thought this would be the most athletic and versatile team he has been a part of in his 12 seasons (ninth as head coach) at San Diego State. If the first half of the season are any indication, he might be right.

The Aztecs have put up 19 goals in 12 games and are scoring 1.58 goals per contest. After scoring twice in a tough, 3-2 overtime loss to Michigan in the opener on Sept. 5, in which SDSU outshot the visitors, 15-10, it tacked on six more goals in a 6-0 rout on Sept. 7 against Albany. The following weekend in Denver, San Diego State had three goals in two matches, including two in a shutout against Air Force. Four weeks ago, the team managed just one goal in two games, despite outshooting the opposition, 32-19. After getting shut out at Dartmouth on Sept. 28, SDSU rebounded with three goals in the team's 3-3 tie at UCLA on Oct. 5. The last two weekends, the Aztecs scored in each of their two games. Last season, the team didn't record its 19th goal until its 14th game of the season, a 3-0, victory over Oregon State on Oct. 28.

The 19 tallies have come from seven different Aztecs, including a team-best four by redshirt junior Matt McManus, and three each by junior Evan Toft, sophomore Raymundo Reza, and true freshmen Daniel Steres and Joe Corona. Sophomore Khadim Diouf has two tallies, while redshirt junior Jamel Wallace has also scored for SDSU. Overall, 12 different players have contributed at least one point on the season for San Diego State.


In the Pac-10 rankings, the Aztecs lead the league with 16.75 shots per game. SDSU is also second in assists per game (1.67).

In Toft We Trust

San Diego State junior Evan Toft is having, in what the Aztec coaching staff expected, a breakout season early in 2008. The Aurora, Colo., native has amassed three goals and four assists through 11 games (team has played 12).

Toft registered at least one point in the team's first four games this season, the longest streak on the team this season. In the Sept. 5 opener against Michigan, Toft assisted on Raymundo Reza's goal just 6:34 into the match. On Sept. 7, Toft collected one goal and one assist in SDSU's 6-0 rout over Albany. On Sept. 12, Toft wasted no time in his return to Colorado as his 30-yard shot found the back of the net just 59 seconds into the match in San Diego State's 2-1 loss to Denver. He followed that up the game-winning helper (along with Nick Cardenas) to Jamel Wallace in the Aztecs' 2-0 victory over Air Force. On Oct. 5 at UCLA, Toft earned his fourth assist of the season on the first of Matt McManus' two goals. On Oct. 12 at California, Toft registered his third goal of the season on a penalty kick.

Among the Pac-10 leaders this season, Toft is seventh in shots per game (2.64) and assists per game (0.36). In his third year, Toft is the Aztec active leader in points (23) and assists (13). The 2007 second-team all-Pac-10 selection also has five career goals.

He's Baaaaaaack!

After missing almost a year of collegiate soccer, redshirt sophomore Brad Byrns is back to man the posts for the 2008 Aztecs.

Byrns made his return Oct. 5 at UCLA, making five saves in the 3-3, double-overtime tie. It was his first match since Oct. 12, 2007, when he made four saves against Cal despite playing the final part of the game with a broken elbow. He then made five stops in a shutout against Cal on Oct. 10. Although Byrns hasn't played in each of the past two matches because of an injury, his return could greatly help SDSU.

Last season, Byrns earned honorable mention all-Pac-10 honors despite going down with an injury 10 games into the season. Byrns led the Aztecs to a 6-1-2 record when he was in net with a 0.73 goals against average and five shutouts. To show his importance, one has to just look at what the team did when he played (6-1-2) and what they did when he did not (2-6-2).

On the season, Byrns led the Pac-10 in shutouts per game (0.56), was second in goals against average (0.73) and third in save percentage (82.5).

For his career, Byrns is 7-1-3 with a 0.89 goals against average.

Reza Roof

San Diego State sophomore Raymundo Reza is coming out of the gates firing on all cylinders after a fantastic first weekend. Reza, who had one point on an assist in his first season on The Mesa in 2007, picked up two goals and an assist for five points to help the Aztecs to a runner-up showing at the Courtyard Marriott San Diego Central Tournament the weekend of Sept. 5-7.

Reza, who moved to his natural position of midfield this year after playing in the back most of last season, scored his first collegiate goal just 6:34 into the opener against Michigan on Sept. 5. The Denver, Colo., later chipped in with an assist on a Daniel Steres goal in the 87th minute which effectively put the game into overtime. In the Michigan match, Reza set career highs in points (3), goals (1), shots (5) and shots on goal (4). Against Albany on Sept. 7, Reza added other tally in the 59th minute. He added two shots in 66 minutes. For his efforts, Reza was named to the all-tournament team.

Through 12 games, Reza is second on the team with nine points on three goals and three assists. He also ranks second on shots on goal (12) and third in shots (24).
