GAME STORYLINES

- **THE SERIES.** BYU and San Diego State are facing off for the 37th time. The two former conference foes have spent time in multiple conferences together, most recently as members of the Mountain West Conference from 1999-2010. The two schools last met in 2012 in the Poinsettia Bowl when BYU defeated the Aztecs 23-6 behind Kyle Van Noy's historic performance. The current New England Patriot linebacker posted eight tackles, 3.5 tackles for loss, 1.5 sacks and scored two defensive touchdowns on a fumble recovery and pick-six.
- **PLAYING IN SAN DIEGO.** This will be the Cougars' 31st game in San Diego, in San Diego County Credit Union Stadium and its various names over the years. BYU played in 11 Holiday Bowls, two Poinsettia Bowls and 17 road games against the Aztecs in San Diego. The Cougars are 17-11-2 in San Diego.
- **BOWL ELIGIBLE OPPONENTS.** With San Diego State this weekend, BYU will have faced eight bowl eligible teams this season. One more opponent could get bowl eligible with Liberty needing one more FBS win. If the Flames get bowl eligible and with the Cougars playing in a bowl game, it will be the most (10) bowl eligible teams the Cougars have ever played in a single season.
- **HAWAIIAN STYLE.** Following the win over Idaho State, BYU formally accepted an invite to the 2019 SoFi Hawaii Bowl. It is the 14th time in 15 seasons the Cougars will go bowling and will be the team's 37th overall bowl appearance. BYU will await to find out its bowl opponent as the bowl season approaches.
- **NOVEMBER WINS.** BYU is 4-0 in the month of November this year and 11-4 under Kalani Sitake in November. In the independence era (2011-present) BYU is 24-8 in November.
- **COLLEGE FOOTBALL 150.** 2019 represents the 150th year of college football, celebrating the first game played between Rutgers and Princeton, Nov. 6, 1869. Throughout the 2019 season, watch for special ways college football programs honor the rich tradition that is college football, starting with a uniform patch the Cougars will wear each game and the CFB150 logo as the 50-yard markers on the field.

Coach Sitake and select players will be available following the NCAA mandatory cooling off period. For road games, BYU will conduct interviews outside the locker room or in a location designated by the host school.

AZTECS RALLY FALLS SHORT AT HAWAII

HONOLULU (AP) -- Jason-Matthew Sharsh caught 10 passes for 95 yards and a touchdown on Saturday night, and Hawaii held off San Diego State 14-11 in a battle for the Mountain West Conference West Division title.

The Rainbow Warriors (8-4, 5-3) tied the Aztecs (8-3, 5-3) in the standings after the final conference game for both teams. With the head-to-head tiebreaker, Hawaii earned a spot in the Mountain West championship game and will face No. 20 Boise State on Dec. 7.

Cole McDonald's 5-yard TD pass to Sharsh opened the scoring in the first quarter, and Fred Holly III's 11-yard TD run made it 14-3 in the third.

Ryan Agnew scored on a 5-yard keeper and ran in the two-point conversion to cut the Aztecs' deficit to 14-11 with 12:58 left in the game.

San Diego State drove 50 yards to the Hawaii 31 to set up Matt Araiza with a 48-yard attempt with 8 seconds left. Araiza missed, and Hawaii ran out the clock for the win.

INDEPENDENCE: YEAR NINE

The 12-game independent schedule for 2019 features seven teams that played in a bowl game in 2018. Three games are against Pac-12 opponents. BYU also takes on the SEC's Tennessee on the road and features games against Mountain West foes Utah State, Boise State and San Diego State. Independents UMass and Liberty also appear on the schedule along with Mid-American favorite Toledo, USF from the American and FCS level Idaho State.

The Cougars will host six home games including Utah, USC, Washington, Boise State, Liberty and Idaho State. BYU is on the road against Tennessee, Toledo, South Florida, Utah State, UMass and San Diego State.



BOWLING OPPONENTS

Of BYU's 12 opponents in 2019, seven played in bowl games in 2018 including Utah, Washington, Toledo, USF, Boise State, Utah State and San Diego State. There are currently eight bowl eligible bowl opponents on the 2019 schedule, with one more teams in the mix to get eligible in the last game of the year.

LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 30,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 63,470 after various refurbishments. For the 2012 season the stadium featured new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands. BYU's winning percentage at LaVell Edwards Stadium is ranked No. 14 among teams playing in their current stadium.

MISSIONS

Brigham Young University is owned and operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The missionary emphasis of the Church is perhaps one of its most recognized characteristics.

Since the organization of the Church in 1830, over one million missionaries have served. The Church operates more than 400 missions around the world in over 150 nations speaking more than 160 languages. More than 67,000 missionaries representing the Church are serving proselytizing missions around the world. Most of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 18 and 26. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours — seven days a week for two years (or 18 months for women and couples) — teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

About 65 percent of the current team has served a mission. Members of the team have served in 28 different countries and six of the seven continents around the globe. More than 30 members of the team (previous signees or on roster) are currently serving in the mission field.

POLYNESIAN PIPELINE

The Polynesian Islands have become a hotbed for recruiting in recent years, but BYU has been one of the pioneers in bringing these players from Tonga, Samoa, the Hawaiian Islands and all of Polynesia to the forefront of college football since the early 1950s. About 40 members of the current roster are of Polynesian descent.

Some of BYU's most celebrated and decorated players have come from the Pacific islands, including All-Americans, national record holders, players who have gone on to compete in the NFL and now, several members of BYU's current coaching and support staff.

Kalani Sitake was named BYU's 14th head coach on Dec. 19, 2015, becoming the first Tongan head football coach in the NCAA. His staff includes Polynesians Ilaisa Tuiaki, Fesi Sitake, Nu'u Tafisi, Jack Damuni, Jasen Ah You, Alema Fitsemanu, Vince Feula, Matt Ah You and Harvey Unga.

MCCHESEY, WILSON LEAD BYU TO 56-24 WIN OVER UMASS

AMHERST, Mass. — Led by freshman Jackson McChesney's 228 rushing yards and four touchdown passes from quarterback Zach Wilson, the BYU football team topped UMass 56-24 Saturday afternoon at McGuirk Alumni Stadium.

True freshman Jackson McChesney led all rushers with a career-high 228 yards on 15 attempts and two touchdowns. McChesney's 228 rushing yards is the sixth most in rushing yards in a game in BYU history and the most by a BYU freshman. The Cougars finished the game with 628 total offensive yards the second time this season after putting up 639 yards against Utah State. BYU tallied 320 rushing yards and 308 passing yards.

In the first half, BYU (7-4) totaled 440 total yards and 49 points, with Wilson doing all his work in the first two quarters. The sophomore went 17 of 20 for 293 passing yards and four touchdowns with three rushing attempts for 20 yards. Joe Critchlow became BYU's signal caller for the second half going 4 of 7 for 15 passing yards.

Talon Shumway made an impact for the receivers with four catches for 92 yards and one touchdown. Six different BYU players scored touchdowns in the game with McChesney, Lopini Katoa and Aleva Hifo scoring rushing touchdowns while Shumway, Tyler Algeier, Katoa and Gunner Romney tallied receiving touchdowns.

On the defensive side, JJ Nwigwe recorded his first career interception while Dayan Ghanwoloku set the BYU record since 2000 with his seventh career fumble recovery.

Algeier got the Cougars on the board first with a 57-yard catch and run making it all the way into the end zone to put BYU up 7-0 with nine minutes left in the first quarter.

Two big catches from Shumway, followed by a 20-yard reception for Matt Bushman got BYU in the red zone. Katoa quickly got into the end zone from three yards out for his first touchdown of the game putting BYU ahead 14-0 with just over 14 minutes to go in the second quarter.

After UMass went three-and-out, Wilson threw a ball deep down field 48 yards to Talon Shumway in the end zone on the first play of the drive to go up 21-0 with 12:27 left on the clock until halftime. The Cougars added another touchdown on the next drive as Katoa caught a screen pass and took it 14 yards in the end zone making the score 28-0.

On the next drive, after a 15-yard catch from Micah Simon, McChesney got into the end zone taking the ball 44 yards and gave BYU another score to make it 35-0 with 7:10 left on the clock.

An interception by Nwigwe put the BYU offense on the 22 yard line, and Romney caught an 18-yard pass in the end zone to make it 42-0. The Cougar tacked on one more touchdown going into half time as Hifo ran five yards pushing the score to 49-0.

UMass came out looking to score in the second half. After a muffed BYU fair-catch, the Minutemen recovered the ball and quickly got in the end zone for their first score of the day to make it 49-7. UMass added a field goal on its next drive to make the score 49-10 with 7:13 left in the third quarter. Before the quarter ended, BYU tacked on another 12-yard McChesney rushing touchdown to push the score to 56-10.

The Minutemen answered back with a touchdown of their own putting up another seven points, but still trailed BYU 56-17 with over eight minutes to go in the game. Before the game could end UMass scored one last touchdown before BYU finished the final drive of the game taking a knee making the final score 56-24.

- 42** BYU scored 42 points in the second quarter, setting a new school record for most points scored in a quarter. The previous record was 36 points, set against Washington State in 1990. BYU has outscored opponents 129-48 in the second quarter.
- 200+** BYU has passed for 200+ yards in every game this year. Including the final two games of 2018, the Cougars have gone for 200+ in 13 straight games. The last time BYU had 200+ in more consecutive games was a string of 19, spanning the 2007-08 seasons. 2008 was the last year BYU threw for at least 200 in every game.
- 228** Jackson McChesney ran for 228 yards, the most ever by a freshman at BYU. It also ranked No. 6 in Cougar history for the most rushing yards in a single game.
- 400** There are four players on the roster with more than 400 receiving yards, led by Matt Bushman (538), Micah Simon (514), Talon Shumway (456) and Aleva Hifo (419). BYU has not had four players on the team with 400 or more receiving yards in a season since 2015, when five players finished with more than 400.
- 500x3** With an 18-yard reception against Idaho State, Matt Bushman has more than 500 receiving yards for the third consecutive season, only the third tight end in BYU history to do so. Consensus All-Americans Dennis Pitta and Gordon Hudson are the only other tight ends, while Bushman became just the 12th overall player to do it at BYU.

THE BYU OFFENSE

- **QUARTERBACK STARTS.** With redshirt freshman quarterback Jaren Hall starting at USF due to Zach Wilson's injury, it marked the sixth consecutive year the Cougars have started at least two different players at quarterback through a single season. When Baylor Romney started vs. Boise State it marked the second time in three years that at least three different players have started a game at quarterback. The 2013 season was the last time BYU started the same player under center for an entire season (Taysom Hill). Since 2009, BYU has had at least two different starting quarterbacks in all but two seasons (2009 and 2013).
- **FRESHMAN START.** With Hall getting the call at USF and Romney vs. Boise State, it made it six times since 2010 BYU has started a freshman signal caller. (2010 Jake Heaps, 2012 Taysom Hill, 2015 Tanner Mangum, 2017 Joe Critchlow and 2018 Zach Wilson).
- **COACHING EXPERIENCE.** The BYU offensive staff has more than 85 years of coaching experience. Jeff Grimes has the most with more than 25 years. Tight ends coach Steve Clark has been coaching since 1994 and passing game coordinator Aaron Roderick has 20 years in the profession. Roderick, Clark and wide receivers coach Fesi Sitake have all been offensive coordinators at the college level.
- **FEARSOME FOURSOME.** The Cougars top four receivers are all upperclassmen, with three seniors (Micah Simon, Talon Shumway and Aleva Hifo) and a junior in Matt Bushman. Simon leads in receptions with 41 while Bushman (38), Shumway (34) and Hifo (34) are right behind. Bushman leads in receiving yards with 538 while Simon is also a member of the 500 club with 514. Shumway and Hifo are next with 456 and 419, respectively. Bushman and Shumway lead in touchdowns with four apiece while Hifo has three and Simon has two.
- **FOUR QBs ON THE ROSTER WITH WINS.** BYU is one of only two FBS schools (UCF) with four quarterbacks on the roster that have started and won at least one game in their career. Zach Wilson, Jaren Hall, Baylor Romney and Joe Critchlow have all won games as a starting quarterback at BYU. The Cougars have won games with three different starting quarterbacks this year, one of only five schools this season to accomplish that task.

THE BYU DEFENSE

- **STAYING FRESH.** BYU uses a lot of personnel on defense, making a lot of rotations to every position to keep guys fresh on the field. Ten different players have started games on the defensive line, eight at linebacker, six at safety and six at corner this year. Coming off of injury, BYU will add back starters Chris Wilcox and Troy Warner to the rotation.
- **KAUFUSI INTERCEPTIONS.** In the game against No. 14 Boise State, brothers Isaiah and Jackson Kaufusi both came away with interceptions. It was Isaiah's second of the season, while Jackson caught the first of his career and returned it 13 yards.
- **NO BIG PLAYS.** The BYU defense has allowed just 34 plays of 20 yards or more this season, ranking No. 9 nationally. Of the 34 plays, 25 have come via the pass, ranking No. 12 nationally while allowing only nine rushing plays of 20 yards or more ranks 17th.

KALANI SITAKE**HEAD COACH****YEARS AT BYU**

4th year at BYU

YEARS OVERALL

4th year as head coach, over 15 years in coaching

Kalani Sitake (pronounced kah-lah-nee see-tah-kay) enters his fourth season overseeing the BYU football program in 2019.

A former Cougar running back (1994, 1997-2000), Sitake is the 14th head coach in BYU history and just the fourth since 1972, when Hall of Fame coach LaVell Edwards took over the program. Sitake is the first former player under Edwards to be named head coach at BYU.

Named BYU's head coach on December 19, 2015, Sitake returned to his alma mater with 15 years of coaching experience, including seven seasons a defensive coordinator and four years as an assistant head coach. He came to BYU from Oregon State, where he served as assistant head coach and defensive coordinator in 2015 under head coach Gary Andersen. Sitake spent the prior 10 seasons at the University of Utah under head coach Kyle Whittingham. He started at Utah in 2005 as the linebackers coach and was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 before also being named assistant head coach in 2012. He coached 12 all-conference honorees at Utah, including Morris Trophy winners Star Lotulelei (2011) and Nate Orchard (2014).

During his career, Sitake has helped mentor 23 NFL Draft picks, including BYU linebackers Sione Takitaki and Fred Warner and running back Jamaal Williams. Takitaki was a third-round pick of the Cleveland Browns in this year's draft and Warner was one of the league's top rookies after being taken in the third round in 2018 by the San Francisco 49ers. Williams, who was selected in the fourth round by the Green Bay Packers in the 2017 NFL Draft, finished his BYU career as the school's all-time leading rusher after averaging the nation's fifth-best per-game totals at 137.5 yards per outing for Sitake's Cougars in 2016.

Sitake has coached in 10 bowl games during his career and has been on the winning side in nine of those 10 contests, including a 2-0 mark as a head coach. BYU is coming off a 49-18 victory over Western Michigan in last year's Famous Idaho Potato Bowl and defeated Wyoming 24-21 in the 2016 Poinsettia Bowl.

Sitake began his coaching career in 2001 as the defensive backs and special teams coach at Eastern Arizona before becoming a defensive graduate assistant at BYU in 2002 under Gary Crowton. Sitake then joined the staff at Southern Utah where he coached running backs, tight ends and offensive line during the 2003 and 2004 seasons.

He began his BYU playing career in 1994 prior to serving a two-year mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints to Oakland, California. After returning and redshirting in 1997, Sitake was a three-year starter at fullback for the Cougars from 1998-2000 under Edwards. A team captain as a senior, Sitake's last game as a player was also the last game coached by the legendary Edwards, who was a great mentor for Sitake.

Born in Nuku'alofa, Tonga, and raised in Laie, Hawai'i and Provo, Utah, Sitake is the nation's first FBS head football coach of Tongan descent. He graduated from BYU in 2000 with a bachelor's degree in English. Sitake and his wife Timberly have three children, Skye, Sadie and Kelaokalani (KK).
