### WHAT'S ON TAP THIS WEEKEND IN AZTEC BASEBALL

- ◆ San Diego State will resume Mountain West action as it travels to Colorado Springs, Colo., for a three-game conference series at Air Force.
- ◆ That set gets underway on Friday, March 18, with a contest scheduled to start at 3:00 p.m. (MT) at Falcon Field.
- ◆ The Aztecs and Falcons will also hook up for games on Saturday (March 19) and Sunday (March 20) at 1:00 p.m. (MT) each day.

### SERIES RECORD

- ◆ San Diego State's all-time record against Air Force stands at 100-21 since the teams first met in 1961.
- ◆ The Falcons are one of three teams against which SDSU has recorded 100 wins. The other two are New Mexico (108) and Utah (102).
- ◆ The Aztecs have won the last 53 of the last 58 meetings between the teams including five regular-season contests and one game at the conference tournament last season.
- ◆ The Aztecs are 54-8 vs. the Falcons in San Diego and 39-13 at Air Force's home field. The Aztecs have won all seven meetings at neutral sites.

### SCOUTING THE FALCONS

- ◆ Air Force's record stands at 9-4 overall and its leads the league with a 3-1 conference record heading into the weekend. The Falcons have won five of their last seven outings.
- ◆ The Falcon offense has been led by center fielder Adam Groesbeck (.453, 3 doubles, 4 triples, 12 RBI), designated hitter Brady Haslam (.436, 4 doubles, 15 RBI), and third baseman Nic Ready (.386, 4 doubles, 14 RBI).
- ◆ Air Force averages 8.5 runs per game and is tied for the Mountain West with 22 stolen bases led by Groesbeck with 10.
- ◆ The Falcons are hitting .338 as a team with a 3.91 earned run average.

### ADKISON HITS AWAY

- ◆ Sophomore Tyler Adkison hit safely in all three games last weekend with two starts and an appearance off the bench in right field.
- ◆ Over the weekend he went 5-for-8 (.625) three RBI and six runs scored (two in each game).
- ◆ He also hit his first home run of the year and recorded a double.

### TREJO STREAKING

- ◆ Shortstop Alan Trejo is on a 12-game hitting streak during which he is batting .434 (23-for-53) with two doubles, nine RBI and 10 runs scored.
- ◆ He has been in double figures in hits in seven of SDSU's last nine contests.

- ◆ He leads the Aztecs with 27 hits on the season. No other player has as many as 19.
- ◆ The only contest in which he did not record a hit this season was on Feb. 23 at UC Irvine.
- ◆ In addition to starting every game at shortstop, Trejo has also made two relief appearances on the mound.

### NAVARRO'S FIRST HIT

- ◆ After going hitless in his first six collegiate plate appearances, freshman Niko Navarro came through with an important single in the win over Fresno State on Sunday (March 6).
- ◆ He was called upon to pitch hit in the bottom of the eighth inning with the

bases loaded, one out and SDSU trailing, 4-2.

- ◆ Navarro proceeded to deliver a single to right field to drive home two runs and tie the game.
- ◆ SDSU added a third run one batter later and went on to win, 5-4.

### WYLIE GOES DEEP

- ◆ Second baseman Justin Wylie hit a leadoff home run in the contest at Cal State Fullerton on Tuesday to give SDSU an early 1-0 lead.
- ◆ It was his team-leading second homer of the season
- ◆ Wylie leads the Aztecs with 14 RBI this season.
- ◆ He recorded the game-winning RBI in each of SDSU's first two wins.
- ◆ Wylie has hit safely in eight of SDSU's last nine games and has recorded nine RBI in the last five contests.

### CALABUIG KEEPS ON HITTING

- ◆ After hitting just .111 (3-for-27) over the first eight games of the season, center fielder Chase Calabuig caught fire and had hit safely in six of the last seven contests prior to Tuesday's game at Fullerton.
- ◆ He had a five-game hitting streak come to an end in the game vs. Northwestern on March 11.
- ◆ In those most recent seven games he has gone 12-for-28 (.429) with a double, three RBI and five runs scored.
- ◆ He has also drawn four walks and been hit by pitch for a .515 on-base percentage over that period.

## PYATT DEBUTS

- ◆ Redshirt freshman Harrison Pyatt turned in his third straight impressive start of the season vs. Northwestern last Thursday (March 10) on March 1.
- ◆ In that contest he tossed 6.2 innings allowing a run on a seven hits with a walk and six strikeouts.
- ◆ In his previous start vs. San Diego, he went six innings giving up no runs on one hit with three walks and seven strikeouts.
- ◆ Pyatt made his Aztec debut with the start at UC Irvine on Tuesday, Feb. 23.
- ◆ He pitched five innings allowing one run on just three hits while striking out four.
- ◆ In his three starts, he has a 1.02 earned run average (17.2 IP) while in his two relief stints his ERA is 18.00 (1 IP).
- ◆ Pyatt has struck out 18 in 18.2 innings and opponents are hitting .203 against him.

## NEW STARTING PITCHERS

- ◆ Two first-year Aztecs made their collegiate starting debuts on the mound last week and both responded well.
- ◆ Freshman Dominic Purpura started the series opener vs. Fresno State on March 4 and tossed 3.1 innings allowing just a hit with two walks and a strikeout.
- ◆ Junior Adrian Orozco made his first start on Saturday (March 5) vs. Fresno State and went 2.2 innings allowing just a hit while striking out four as he retired the first eight batters he faced.

## HELDMAN SAVES

- ◆ Senior Brian Heldman recorded his (and SDSU's) first save of the 2016 season in the win at UC Irvine last week.
- ◆ He tossed the final two innings allowing one hit and hitting a batter to preserve the Aztecs' two-run lead.
- ◆ The save was the second of Heldman's two-year Aztec career.
- ◆ Last season he served primary as a late-inning set-up reliever.

## GOOD START

- ◆ Two Aztec newcomers recorded hits in their first collegiate at bat during the season-opening series vs. No. 14 Oregon.
- ◆ Jordan Verdon singled to right center field in his first plate appearance in Friday night's contest.
- ◆ Fellow freshman Dean Nevarez delivered a single to center in his first plate appearance as a pinch hitter in Saturday's game.

## STREAKS

- ◆ Alan Trejo has the team's longest current hitting streak at 12 games.
- ◆ The next best current streak of seven games belongs to Jordan Verdon.
- ◆ Trejo has reached base safely (via hit, walk or hit by pitch) in all 16 games this season while Chase Calabuig has done so in the past eight contests.
- ◆ Trejo also leads the Aztecs with nine multiple-hit contests.



### NEW COACHES

- ◆ The Aztecs have added a pair of new coaches to their staff for the 2016 season: Pitching Coach Sam Peraza and Volunteer Assistant Joey Centanni.
- ◆ Peraza arrives at SDSU after two seasons at Florida International. He also had previous experience at Cal State Northridge, Cal State Los Angeles and Eastern Oklahoma State.
- ◆ He is a 2002 graduate of San Diego State, where he pitched during the 2002 season.
- ◆ Centanni played four seasons as a pitcher and first baseman at Pacific, graduating in 2009. After college, he spent one season in the Baltimore Orioles organization before an injury ended his playing career.
- ◆ He later served as an associate scout for the Orioles in the San Diego area and coach locally at Francis Parker High School.

### VETERAN HONOREES

- ◆ Five players who earned individual honors a year ago return for the 2016 season.
- ◆ Second baseman Alan Trejo was named to the all-tournament team at the 2015 NCAA Regional at Lake Elsinore, Calif.
- ◆ Pitcher Jacob Erickson, outfielder Spencer Thornton and designated hitter Justin Wylie earned all-tourney recognition at the 2015 Mountain West Conference Tournament.
- ◆ Outfielder Chase Calabuig was named a Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American and a second-team all-Mountain West selection.

### RETURNING POSITION STARTERS

- ◆ Among the returning starters are two members of the Aztec infield and two outfielders.
- ◆ The infielders include second baseman Alan Trejo (.266, 20 RBI) and first baseman Andrew Brown (.295, 17 doubles, 32 RBI).
- ◆ Brown is likely to begin the 2016 season as the Aztecs' third baseman.
- ◆ Also back are a pair of outfielders: Spencer Thornton (.317, 7 2B, 23 RBI) and Chase Calabuig (.305, 8 2B, 25 RBI).

### RETURNING ON THE MOUND

- ◆ The Aztecs return eight full-time pitchers from last season's staff along with three others who could see time on the mound as well as at positions in the field.
- ◆ In addition to projected starters Marcus Reyes, Cody Thompson and Brett Seeburger, other top returnees includes relievers Jacob Erickson (2-1, 2.64; all-tourney at the Mountain West Tournament) and Brian Heldman (3-1, 3.52, 1 save).
- ◆ Second baseman Alan Trejo, outfielder Chase Calabuig and catcher CJ Saylor could also see spot duty on the mound if needed.

### SAYLOR RETURNS BEHIND THE PLATE

- ◆ Junior CJ Saylor will resume duties at the catching position this season after serving at the Aztecs' closer a year ago.
- ◆ In 2015 he compiled a record of 3-3 with 11 saves and a 5.02 ERA.
- ◆ He began his SDSU as a catcher where he hit .212 in 14 games as a redshirt freshman in 2014.
- ◆ Saylor could see occasional action on the mound this season as well.

### PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE

- ◆ Outfielder Chase Calabuig has been tabbed to the Preseason All-Mountain West team in a vote of the league's coaches.
- ◆ Calabuig batted .305 with eight doubles and 25 RBIs as season en route to second-team all-conference honors at the end of the 2015 campaign.
- ◆ He was also named a Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American by *Collegiate Baseball* magazine.

### COLLEGE SPORTS MADNESS ALL-MW

- ◆ *College Sports Madness* also named Calabuig to its All-Mountain West first team while four other Aztecs earned second-team honors.
- ◆ That quartet included outfielder Spencer Thornton and third baseman Andrew Brown along with pitchers Marcus Reyes and Cody Thompson.

### DRAFTED AZTECS

- ◆ Three current members of the SDSU squad have been drafted by Major League clubs.
- ◆ That trio includes junior catcher CJ Saylor (33rd rd. in 2012, Los Angeles Dodgers) along with sophomore outfielder Denz'l Chapman (32nd rd. in 2014, Oakland A's) and freshman first baseman Jordan Verdon (24th rd. in 2015, New York Mets).

### AZTECS PICKED AS CO-FAVORITES

- ◆ San Diego State has been picked as co-favorite along with New Mexico to win the Mountain West title in the conference's preseason baseball poll.
- ◆ In a vote of the seven MWC head coaches, the Aztecs received three first-place votes and tallied 32 points as did the Lobos. Fresno State picked up the remaining first-place vote and tied for third in the poll with Air Force.

### AZTEC NOTES

- ◆ As a team, the Aztecs hit .358 during the three-game series vs. Northwestern last weekend to boost the team batting average from .254 to .276.
- ◆ After hitting just one triple over the first 13 games (by catcher Hunter Stratton vs. Bryant on Feb. 26), the Aztecs hit two (Dean Nevarez and Justin Wylie) on March 11 vs. Northwestern.
- ◆ David Hensley went 5-for-10 over the three games vs. Northwestern and scored a run in each of those contests.
- ◆ Freshman infielder Jordan Verdon has hit safely in each of the last seven contests, going 9-for-21 (.429) with a triple, two RBI and four runs scored.
- ◆ Freshman right-hander Chris Collins has made five relief appearances out of the bullpen and allowed one earned run over 6.1 innings pitched for a 1.42 earned run average.
- ◆ Shortstop Alan Trejo and center fielder Chase Calabuig are the only two players to have started all 16 games this season at the same position.
- ◆ One other Aztec has started all 16 games, but not at the same position each time: Justin Wylie (2B-DH).
