Thank you for your interest in San Diego State University. The Aztec media relations staff has produced the 2003 media guide to assist in your coverage of SDSU football. Please contact a member of the staff with any questions, concerns or requests.

### Game Credentials

All requests for photo and press credentials should be submitted to the media relations office on official letterhead at least one week in advance of the game. Credentials will be mailed only when specifically requested, and at the risk of the applicant. Those not delivered by mail, in person, or through the visiting director of media relations will be left at the Qualcomm Stadium Press Entrance (Gate H). Requests should be directed to Kevin Klintworth. Credentials will be issued to working media only. Family and friends are not allowed in the press area.

### Game Parking

Parking passes at Qualcomm Stadium are limited, but will be issued as available to accredited media. Media parking is in the H1 lot and game credentials can be used to access the lot. Visiting media parking should be requested through the university's media relations department.

### Campus Parking

Media wishing to attend Aztec workouts during the week will need to obtain a special parking permit from the media relations office, located in suite 3014 of the Aztec Athletic Center. The credential is good for parking in Lot 107, located immediately behind the Tony Gwynn Stadium scoreboard.

### Aztec Athletics Center

The Aztec Athletics Center is the new home of San Diego State athletics. The four-story facility is located at 5302 55th Street in San Diego, just west of Cox Arena and adjacent to the football practice facility and Tony Gwynn Stadium. The football offices are located on the second floor and media relations

is officed in Suite 3014. All major news conferences take place in the first-floor auditorium while most of Tom Craft's seasonal media gatherings will be on the second floor.

### Tuesday Luncheons

This fall, San Diego State will host a Tuesday media luncheon with head coach Tom Craft and requested Aztec football players. The location will be the second floor of the Aztec Athletic Center. Craft will be available at 11 a.m. After a break for lunch, SDSU players will be available. **Player requests should be made by noon on Mondays during game week.**

### Craft Opportunities

Coach Tom Craft will have a weekly gathering with media each Sunday afternoon at 3 p.m. during the season. He is also available Tuesday mornings on the Mountain West Conference coaches teleconference (schedule to be announced), his weekly media luncheon, and daily after practices. His radio show (time still to be determined) will also air weekly. The best time to contact the head coach is weekday mornings before noon. All interviews with Craft should be arranged through the media relations office.

### Qualcomm Stadium

Qualcomm Stadium is the home of the San Diego State Aztecs, the San Diego Chargers and the San Diego Padres, as well as the site of Super Bowl XXXVII last January. The stadium is located off Interstate 8, just west of Interstate 15. Enter from the north off of Friars Road. The media entrance and media will call are at Gate H (just south of the Aztec ticket office). Will Call is located at Gate F. The open-air press box can be reached by taking Elevator 4 to stadium level 2A.

### Press Box Services

All working media will be provided with pregame



notes, a game program, flip card, quarterly and final statistics, including postgame notes and quotes. An in-house public address system as well as television monitors will provide constant updates and replays during the game. Video and audio of Tom Craft's postgame news conference will also be available in the press box. Pregame meals are available through the stadium food service in the media's working area. There is a charge for the meal under the same arrangement currently in place for the San Diego Padres. All postgame notes and final stats will be available on goaztecs.com following the game.

## Telephones/Faxing

The media relations office will provide four charge-per-call phones in the visiting media's section of the press box for all home games. The phones are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Media requiring special service are urged to order individual phone lines through Gary Brashear at Qualcomm Stadium, (619) 281-1500. Those requiring their own phone instruments should make arrangements through their local AT&T representative. Phone lines for originating radio stations, as designated by the opposing athletic department, will be provided through the MWC co-op agreement.

## Postgame

Following each game, the Aztec locker room will be closed for a 10-minute cooling-off period before being opened to the media. At Qualcomm, head coach Tom Craft will be available in an interview area near the Aztec locker room. Due to the large number of night games and the deadlines they inflict upon working media, no formal postgame format involving the visiting coaches or players will be held.

## Weekly Releases

The media relations office will once again be e-mailing its weekly football releases this season. The updates will be sent via fax only when specifically requested. The release will be posted at www.goaztecs.com on Sunday evenings in both text and Adobe Acrobat formats. To receive the weekly release via e-mail on Sundays, please contact Kevin Klintworth at kklintwo@mail.sdsu.edu.

## SDSU Practices

Most SDSU practices are open to both the media and public and will be staffed by a member of the Aztec Media Relations office. Electronic media wishing to shoot video during practice are asked to tape during the first 30 minutes of workouts only. Requested coaches and players will be made available for interviews following each practice.

## Practice Schedule

A typical San Diego State week in the fall will include a brief workout on Sunday afternoons. Monday is an off day with Tuesday, Wednesday and

Thursday workouts normally scheduled from 3:30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m.

## Player Interviews

Aztec players are available daily after practice for interviews (including phone interviews). No interviews will take place on Monday, the team's off day during the week. There is also limited availability on Fridays and all Saturday interviews will be postgame. All player requests should be made through the media relations office.

## Interview Requests

For interviews with a member of the San Diego State football staff, including Head Coach Tom Craft, contact Associate Athletic Director for Media Relations Kevin Klintworth or Assistant Media Relations Director Peggy Curtin at (619) 594-5547. For video or phone needs, please contact Peggy Curtin.

## Mountain West Teleconference

Head Tom Craft, as well as the other seven Mountain West Conference coaches, are available each Tuesday during the season on the league's teleconference. Contact the Mountain West office at (719) 488-4040 for more information.

## Photographers

Only accredited photographers on assignment will be issued sideline credentials for Aztec home games -- per NCAA guidelines. The NCAA also specifies that photo shooting must take place outside the restraining line that encircles the playing field and outside of the team areas (25-yard line to 25-yard line).

## Web Sites

San Diego State University will issue web site credentials to individuals affiliated with national or regional television or news organizations. Other credentials could be issued when requests are made by the visiting team's media relation office.

Members of the media are invited to attend the SDSU Football Kickoff Luncheon, scheduled for Aug. 19th, at the Town and Country Hotel in Mission Valley. Please RSVP to a member of the SDSU media relations staff if you plan to attend the event.

## Out-Of-Town Media

Members of the media who cannot attend weekly news conferences on the Aztec campus should contact the media relations office for interviews with SDSU players and coaches. Head coach Tom Craft normally has sessions with regional and national media on Wednesday mornings, including opponents' radio networks as well as television talent and producers.

## The Mighty 1090



In 2003, San Diego State football has joined forces with The Mighty 1090 AM (XPRS) for broadcast of all Aztec home and away games.

The station will serve as the flagship for San Diego State football and men's basketball broadcasts, and will also feature a variety of other Aztec programming, including coaches shows. The station may also feature play-by-play of other Aztec sporting events.

"We are truly excited about 1090's commitment to San Diego State," said Joe Moeller, who serves as the school's senior associate athletic director. "It is an arrangement that will benefit both parties. We love the all-sports format and 1090 seems truly excited about helping us promote all our athletic programs in a variety of ways."

John Fricke will serve as the play-by-play voice for the 2003 Aztec football season, bringing national experience in both television and radio.

Fricke began his career as an original member of the Cable News Network (CNN) in Atlanta in 1980. He spent 10 years as a sports anchor at CNN and also served as a senior producer at the network. Fricke was the host of CNN's College Football

Preview and anchored the first-ever sportscast on CNN2, now Headline News, in 1982.

On the collegiate level, Fricke was the play-by-play announcer for both football and men's basketball at Wake Forest (1989) and Tennessee-Chattanooga (1992-94). He has also spent time at the University of Nebraska.

Locally, Fricke was the studio host for Fox Sports Net's Southern California Sports Report and was

the host of the Emmy-award winning Monday Night Football show on San Diego's ABC affiliate, KGTV.

Prior to joining 1090 AM, Fricke was the morning show host with former NFL football players Sean Salisbury and Billy Ray Smith on XTRA Sports 690.

Currently, Fricke is The Mighty 1090's mid-day host alongside Mike Costa from 12 to 3 p.m.

The Mighty 1090, with studios in La Jolla, was launched in March. It has an all-sports format with heavy emphasis on local programming. The station's 50,000-watt signal blankets the Los Angeles and San Diego markets and extends north of Santa Barbara. It will also be the flagship station for the San Diego Padres, beginning with the 2004 season.

## Aztecs Sports Weekly



For the fifth consecutive year, San Diego State University will join forces with Channel 4 San Diego to produce Aztecs Sports Weekly.

The 30-minute magazine show will highlight the week in San Diego State athletics with action footage, interviews and features. The fall telecasts place an emphasis on the Aztec football season.

Each week head coach Tom Craft and at least one player guest preview the upcoming game and review the previous week's action.

The show is hosted by Billy Ray Smith. The former Arkansas Razorback is well known in Southern California for his broadcasting work as well as his

days as a member of the San Diego Chargers.

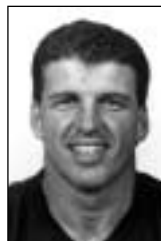
The show's producer is Jason Bott.

Each edition of Aztecs Sports Weekly is telecast several times with the initial telecast taking place each Wednesday evening.

Exit airport on Harbor Drive south. Turn left on Grape Street and stay in the right lane to take Interstate 5 south. Exit Highway 163 north. Take Interstate 8 east to College Avenue. Turn right (south) on College Avenue and right again on Montezuma. Turn right on 55th Street. The Aztec Athletics Center is on the left, south of Peterson Gym and across the street from Cox Arena. Parking is available just south of the building in Parking Structure V.

### Lindbergh Field To Qualcomm Stadium

Exit airport on Harbor Drive south. Turn left on Grape Street and stay in the right lane to take Interstate 5 south. Exit Highway 163 north. Take Interstate 8 east to Interstate 15 north. Exit Friars Road west. The stadium is on the left. Enter the stadium parking lot at the second entrance. Media parking is provided just outside Gate H.
