Team Notes

- * The Aztecs overcame an eight-point second-half deficit tonight. Their effort is tied for the 10th largest second-half deficit overcome for a victory in the Steve Fisher era. ... It is their largest second-half deficit overcome for a victory since rallying from 11 down on Jan. 27, 2007, vs. Utah. ... It is the 12th time SDSU has overcome at least an eight-point deficit in the final half since the 1999-00 season.
- * SDSU had at least three players reach double figures in scoring for the 11th straight game. Tonight, SDSU finished with at least five players in double digits in the same game for the third time in 2007.
- * The Aztecs outrebounded Navy by a season-high 18 rebounds. Their previous best was a +14 effort at Fresno State on Nov. 11, 2007. ... SDSU's performance on the boards in terms of margin also ties for fifth-best in Cox Arena history.
- * Tonight's win is the 100th in Cox Arena history.

Player Notes

- * Lorrenzo Wade (18 points) reached double figures in scoring for the seventh straight game and for the 10th time this year. ... His sevengame streak with 10 or more points is a career long. His previous best came last season when he went six consecutive games with at least 10 points. ... Wade led the team in scoring for the fourth time this year. ... Wade's 18 points ties a season high.
- * Kyle Spain (14 points) posted his eighth game with at least 10 points. ... SDSU improves to 7-1 on the season and 23-3 in his career when he reaches double figures. ... He also had a team-best nine rebounds.
- * Jon Pastorek (10 points) recorded his second career double-figure scoring effort in his first career start. ... Set a season-best with his 10 points. ... He set a career high for free throws made (4) and attempted (4).
- * Kelvin Davis (15 points) connected on multiple three-point attempts for the eighth time this year en route to his eighth double-digit scoring performance.
- * Richie Williams entered the game in the second half and immediately contributed seven assists in just 17 minutes.
