2011 MOUNTAIN WEST CONFERENCE TOURNAMENT

- ◆ After a three-year hiatus, the Mountain West will resume its annual conference volleyball championship tournament this week. All eight league finishers will compete in the single-elimination event with tournament seedings determined by the final conference standings.
- ◆ By virtue of its league finish, San Diego State will be the number-two seed at this week's Mountain West Tournament. The tourney gets underway on Friday, Nov. 18, at the University of New Mexico's Johnson Center in Albuquerque.
- ◆ Colorado State is the number-one seed as it won the regular-season league title for the third consecutive year.
- ◆ SDSU's second-place seeding means it will face UNLV (the number-seven seed) in the first game on opening day of the tourney. That contest is scheduled for Friday at noon (MT).
- ◆ If the Aztec win their opener, they would face the winner of the TCU-Boise State match Saturday evening at 5:00 p.m. (MT).
- ◆ All seven matches played during the Mountain West Tournament will be televised live on The Mtn network.
- ◆ For the complete tournament schedule, see below. (All times are Mountain Time.)

HEAD COACH DEITRE COLLINS-PARKER

- ◆ San Diego State Head Coach Deitre Collins-Parker is in her third season with the Aztecs after being named to the position prior to the 2009 campaign. Her record at SDSU is 47-39.
- ◆ She previously served as head coach at UNLV for eight seasons (1996-2003) and at Cornell for five years (2004-2008). Her 16-year career record stands at 209-230.
- ◆ A three-time All-American as a player at the University of Hawai'i, she led the Rainbow Wahine to consecutive national titles (1983-84) and was named the national player of the year twice.
- ◆ She was a member of the U.S. Olympic Team and competed at the Goodwill and Pan Am Games prior to playing professionally in Europe for four years.
- ◆ She is one of six players named to the NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball 25th Anniversary Team in October 2005 and was inducted into the AVCA Hall of Fame in the fall of 2008.

WIN NO. 200

- ◆ With the win over Wyoming on Sept. 29, Head Coach Deitre Collins-Parker recorded her 200th career victory.
- ◆ She is in her 16th season as a collegiate head coach having previously held that position at UNLV and Colgate.

SERIES RECORDS

- ◆ The Aztecs' all-time record against UNLV stands at 21-13 since the teams first met during the 1985 campaign when both were members of the Western Athletic Conference. San Diego State had won the last five encounters between the teams before the Rebels captured a three-set win in Las Vegas on Sept. 23. SDSU returned the favor on Oct. 18, defeating the Rebels in three sets at Peterson Gym.

BEST FINISH SINCE...

- ◆ San Diego State's second-place finish in the Mountain West was its best since the 2002 campaign when it ended the league season in the same position.
- ◆ The Aztecs' 10-4 conference record is also its best since that same season when it finished 11-3. It is the first time SDSU has been over the .500 mark in its league record since that same season.
- ◆ The team's 17 total wins is its highest victory total since the 2003 campaign when it went 18-14.

HANNASCH LEADS THE OFFENSE

- ◆ Junior middle blocker Andrea Hannasch turned in her fourth double-double of the season with 10 kills and 10 digs in the win over New Mexico on Nov. 3.
- ◆ The 10 digs in that match marked her season high.
- ◆ It was her first double-double this season with kills and digs. The other three came with kills and blocks.
- ◆ She matched her season high with three service aces in the three-set victory over TCU on Nov. 5.
- ◆ Hannasch set or tied five personal career highs in the win at TCU on Oct. 6.
- ◆ She set new career bests of 20 kills and 30 points at TCU on Oct. 6.
- ◆ She also tied her Aztec bests with three assists, three solo blocks and 11 total blocks.
- ◆ Her 20 kills and 11 blocks at TCU were her third double-double of the season and sixth of her career.
- ◆ Her .765 hitting percentage in the win over Boise State (Oct. 15) was a career high as she had no errors in the match on 17 attacks.
- ◆ She leads the San Diego State offense in kills, blocks and points.
- ◆ She ranks among the top 10 in the Mountain West in each of those categories as well as hitting percentage.

FOUCH ASSISTS

- ◆ Johnna Fouch leads the conference in all games with an average of 11.22 assists per set while her final league-match average of 11.84 was the best in the Mountain West by one assist per set.
- ◆ Her overall assist average ranks 23rd in NCAA Division I this week.
- ◆ She set a career high with 65 assists in the victory at TCU on Oct. 6.
- ◆ Fouch averaged 15.3 kills per set in the win over TCU on Nov. 5.
- ◆ She recorded a season-high 31 digs at Wyoming last Saturday (Oct. 29).
- ◆ It was the most digs in a match by an Aztec this season and one shy of her SDSU career high.
- ◆ Her average of 2.61 digs per set is second only to libero Kristi Jackels.
- ◆ Fouch set a career high with six blocks in the win over Wyoming on Sept. 29.
- ◆ She has recorded nine double-double performances (assists-digs) in 2011, the latest being a 54 assist-31 dig effort at Wyoming on Oct. 29.

NASH CONTRIBUTES

- ◆ Summer Nash has recorded a dozen kills in each of SDSU's last four matches.
- ◆ Over that span she is averaging 3.69 kills, 1.38 digs and 1.00 block per set while hitting .322.
- ◆ In the contests vs. Boise State and Air Force last week, she was the only player on either team to record double figures in kills.
- ◆ Her .478 and .455 hitting percentages respectively in those matches were her season-best and second-best.
- ◆ She had a career-highs of five block assists and six total blocks in the four-set victory vs. New Mexico on Nov. 3.
- ◆ Nash made a start at Wyoming on Oct. 29 after having appeared off the bench in the previous nine matches.
- ◆ She responded with eight kills, three digs and block in the three sets in which she played.
- ◆ Nash's 13 kills and 10 digs vs. Cal State Fullerton on Sept. 20 was her first double-double as an Aztec.
- ◆ Her season high of 16 kills came vs. Valparaiso on Sept. 17.

HARRIS ON THE BLOCK

- ◆ Middle blocker Emily Harris, a sophomore transfer from Western Michigan, has started each of the last 20 matches after not appearing in SDSU's first five contests of the year due to injury.
- ◆ In last week's matches at Boise State and Air Force, she averaged 2.5 kills and 1.17 blocks per set while hitting .433.
- ◆ She had a career-high 10 blocks in the match against New Mexico on Nov. 3. She also had eight kills and a .333 hitting percentage in that contest.
- ◆ In SDSU's last four matches, she recorded a total of 16 blocks for an average of 1.77 per set.
- ◆ Her overall average of 1.12 blocks per set ranks fifth in the Mountain West while her final mark of 1.20 in league matches was third in the conference stats.
- ◆ Harris set career highs with 15 kills, 19.0 points and a .522 hitting percentage in the win at New Mexico on Oct. 9.

SHELTON SOLID UP FRONT

- ◆ Sophomore Raegan Shelton recorded her 10th and 11th double-figure kill efforts of the season with 10 against New Mexico (Nov. 3) and 14 vs. TCU (Nov. 6).
- ◆ Against UNLV (O. 21), she tied her career highs of 21 kills and four blocks while setting a personal best with 23.5 points.
- ◆ She had recorded a career-highs in those categories with 21 kills and 21.5 points at TCU on Oct. 6.
- ◆ Her eight digs at New Mexico on Oct. 9 tied her career best.
- ◆ She was named MW Player of the Week after leading the Aztecs to road wins over New Mexico and TCU in early October.
- ◆ Shelton's final average of 3.12 kills per set in Mountain West matches ranked seventh in the league.

JACKELS DIGGING AWAY

- ◆ Libero Kristi Jackels recorded a total of 56 digs in the matches vs. New Mexico (Nov. 3) and TCU (Nov. 5) for an average of 8.00 per set over those seven sets.
- ◆ Her 32 digs against New Mexico tied her career high which she set at Brigham Young on Nov. 6, 2010.
- ◆ In SDSU's last four matches she is averaging 6.15 digs per set.
- ◆ She has finished in double figures in digs in 23 of SDSU's 25 matches this year.
- ◆ Jackels has joined the 1,000 dig club for her two-plus year career as an Aztec and enters the week with 1,306 digs to rank fourth on the SDSU all-time list.
- ◆ She finished third in the conference in digs in MW play at 4.65 per set.
- ◆ She was also fourth in service aces at 0.31 service aces per set in league matches.

PEARSON SETS PERSONAL BESTS

- ◆ Senior Pajje Pearson had back-to-back double-figure kill matches for the second time this season with 13 vs. New Mexico and 10 vs. TCU (Nov. 3 and 5).
- ◆ Her average of 3.29 kills per set over those two matches was over a point higher than her season average (2.15 kps).
- ◆ She had season highs of 12 digs and one solo block in the win at New Mexico on Oct. 9.
- ◆ Pearson set a personal career high with 17 kills and 20.0 points in the match at Tulane on Sept. 2.
- ◆ In the match at UC Riverside on Sept. 25, she set a career best with four service aces and tied her SDSU career high with four assists.
- ◆ Pearson had 15 kills and hit .423 (her highest attack percentage of 2011) in the four-set loss to Kansas on Sept. 16.
- ◆ In the season opener against UC Irvine she tied her Aztec career high with eight blocks in the win over the Anteaters.

SEXTON SERVES IT UP

- ◆ Senior outside hitter Kyley Sexton is averaging 0.31 aces per set, a mark which would rank third in the conference (all matches) if she had not missed several matches with an ankle injury in late September.
- ◆ She recorded a pair of aces in one set during last week's match vs. Air Force
- ◆ She had a career-high four service aces in the victory over Nevada on Aug. 27.
- ◆ Sexton's three blocks assists against Boise State on Oct. 15 tied her season high.
- ◆ Her season-high 19 kills vs. Portland on Aug. 27 is the second-highest total for an Aztec this fall.
- ◆ She recorded 13 kills in the win at TCU on Oct. 6, her second-best total of the 2011 campaign.

THE RECORD BOOK

- ◆ A trio of Aztecs have entered the SDSU career record listings this season.
- ◆ Libero Kristi Jackels' 1,306 digs is fourth on the career Aztec top 10. Third place is currently held by Juliana Cezar (1993-96) with 1,369 career digs.
- ◆ Sophomore setter Johnna Fouch has moved into the number-eight spot in career assists with 2,305. Former Aztec Leah Lathrop (2005-08) ranks seventh on the list with 2,624 assists.
- ◆ In addition, Andrea Hannasch is now ninth on the career blocks assists chart with 345. Eighth place is occupied by Shannon Matthews (1988-89) with 358.

- ◆ Five different Aztecs appear among the top 10 in the Mountain West in various statistical categories both overall and in Mountain West matches only. (Stats are per set except for hitting percentage).

GOING LONG

- ◆ San Diego State's wins at TCU (Oct. 6) and New Mexico (Oct. 9) marked only the second time that the Aztecs have won back-to-back five-set matches on the road. The other occasion came during the 1988 season when they won at Fresno State and Pepperdine on consecutive days (Sept. 16-17).
- ◆ SDSU has only had three consecutive five-set matches once in school history. That came in 1986 when they defeated San Jose State, UCLA (away) and Cal State Fullerton from Sept. 29 to Oct. 3.
- ◆ San Diego State has a record of 4-3 in five-set matches this season.

PEARSON WINS MW HONOR

- ◆ Outside hitter Paije Pearson was named the Mountain West Player of the Week on Nov. 7 for her efforts in the Aztecs' to two wins over New Mexico and TCU the previous week. It was the second weekly honor for Pearson in her SDSU career.
- ◆ She led the Aztecs with 13 kills in the 3-1 win over New Mexico on Nov. 3. She also tied her career-high with four assists to go along with seven digs and five blocks.
- ◆ In the 3-0 Senior Day win over TCU, Pearson was errorless in her attack with 10 kills on 20 attempts (.500). She also has three assists, a service ace, six digs and four blocks in the match.
- ◆ For the week, Pearson averaged 3.29 kills, 1.86 digs, 1.29 blocks and 1.00 assists per set, while hitting .354. She averaged 4.07 points per set over seven total sets.

SHELTON EARNS CONFERENCE AWARD

- ◆ Sophomore Raegan Shelton earned Mountain West Volleyball Co-Player of the Week honors for matches played from Oct. 3-9, 2011.
- ◆ She had a career-high 21 kills and 58 attempts on .241 hitting against the Horned Frogs on Oct. 6, the most kills by an Aztec this season.
- ◆ Against New Mexico on Sunday (Oct. 9), Shelton had 19 kills on .267 hitting and tied her career-high with eight digs.
- ◆ For the week, Shelton averaged 4.00 kills, 0.40 blocks and 1.50 digs per set, while hitting .252. She averaged 4.20 points per set over 10 total sets.

HANNASCH PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- ◆ Andrea Hannasch earned MW Volleyball Player of the Week honors for matches played during the opening weekend of the 2011 season (Aug. 26-27). It was the third weekly honor of her career.
- ◆ Hannasch led SDSU to a 3-0 record and the Aztec Invitational tournament title. She was named Most Valuable Player of the tournament for her performances against UC Irvine, Portland and Nevada.
- ◆ She posted a double-double with 17 kills and 10 blocks in the 3-1 win over UC Irvine on Friday, Aug. 26.
- ◆ In the 3-2 win against Portland, Hannasch recorded 14 kills, six blocks, five digs and two service aces. In the nightcap she had a team-high 12 kills and five blocks.
- ◆ For the week, Hannasch averaged 3.58 kills, 1.75 blocks, 1.17 digs and 0.33 aces per set, while hitting .398. She also accounted for 4.88 points per set.

FOUCH ALL-TOURNEY HONOREE

- ◆ Sophomore setter Johnna Fouch was named to the all-tournament team at the DePaul Invitational (Sept. 16-17).
- ◆ Over SDSU's three matches she averaged 12.30 assists per set and 2.60 digs per set.
- ◆ It was the second straight tournament in which Fouch was an all-tourney honoree as she received the same accolade at the Allstate Sugar Bowl Collegiate Classic in New Orleans Sept. 2-3.

ALL-TOURNEY AZTECS PART II

- ◆ Setter Johnna Fouch and outside hitter Paije Pearson were named to the all-tourney team at the Allstate Sugar Bowl Collegiate Classic Sept. 2-3.
- ◆ Over the matches against Tulane and William and Mary on Sept. 2, Pearson averaged 2.75 kills, 1.50 digs and 3.12 points per set. She also recorded 0.50 blocks per set.
- ◆ Fouch, meanwhile, was the tournament's top setter with an average of 10.00 assists per set. She also finished with marks of 0.62 kills and accounted for 0.88 points per set from her setter position.

ALL-TOURNAMENT AZTECS PART III

- ◆ Andrea Hannasch and Kyley Sexton were named to the all-tournament team at the season-opening Aztec Invitational (Aug. 26-27).
- ◆ Hannasch averaged 3.58 kills, 1.75 blocks and 1.17 digs in wins over UC Irvine, Portland and Nevada.
- ◆ Sexton averaged 3.00 kills per set over the three matches and had six service aces and a .281 hitting percentage.

ATHLETIC RELATIVES

- ◆ Two members of the Aztecs have notable athletic connections in their family.
- ◆ Redshirt freshman Oni Lattin's grandfather, David Lattin, was a member of the 1966 Texas Western (now UTEP) basketball team under Don Haskins that upset Kentucky for the national title.
- ◆ Emily Harris' father, Al Harris, played defensive end and linebacker for the Chicago Bears from 1979-84 and 1986-88 before finishing his career with the Philadelphia Eagles from 1989-90.
- ◆ In addition, assistant coach Melanie Greene's dad, Ken Greene, played pro football with the San Diego Chargers and St. Louis Cardinals.

AZTEC NOTES

- ◆ SDSU's current four-match win streak ties its longest of the season. Those win streaks in 2011 are the longest for the team since 2007 when it put together six victories in a row.
- ◆ The win over TCU on Nov. 5 by scores of 30-28, 28-26, 26-24 marked the first time that SDSU was involved in a match in which every set went to extra points since rally scoring was introduced in 2001. Prior to rally scoring, SDSU never played in a match in which every set went to extra points (including two-set tournament matches).
- ◆ San Diego State's losses at Colorado State and Wyoming (Oct. 27 and 29) marked the only time that the Aztec has lost two matches in a row this season.
- ◆ Kyla Oropeza's 13 digs at Wyoming on Oct. 29 tied her career high as an Aztec.
- ◆ Defensive specialist Courtney Vaccarello tied her SDSU career high with nine digs vs. TCU on Nov. 5. She had just set that mark two matches earlier at Wyoming on Oct. 29.
- ◆ As a team, San Diego State finished first in kills and assists in league matches. In all matches, the Aztecs rank second in the MW in those two categories and are first in service aces.
- ◆ San Diego State's .396 hitting percentage in the match vs. Air Force last Saturday (Nov. 12) was its highest of the season.
- ◆ The team's 11 service aces against Cal State Fullerton were a season high.
- ◆ SDSU has captured the titles at a pair of tournaments in 2011. The Aztecs won the Aztec Invitational with a 3-0 mark and were declared co-champions of the Sugar Bowl Collegiate Classic at Tulane along with Southern Illinois when that tourney was cut short due to weather.
- ◆ Eleven different players have started matches for the Aztecs this season (not including libero Kristi Jackels). Only Johnna Fouch and Andrea Hannasch have started every match. Paije Pearson has started 24 of 25 contests.
- ◆ The Aztec roster has three sophomore transfers from four-year schools: Andrea Terpstra (Pacific), Emily Harris (Western Michigan) and Courtney Vaccarello (Oregon).
