- The Aztecs' 8-0 start earlier this season was the best start by a Fisher team in his career as a head coach.
- The Aztecs went a perfect 8-0 in the month of November marking their first undefeated month (min. 3 GP) as a Division I program.
- Steve Fisher has 113 victories at San Diego State, surpassing Smokey Gaines for third all-time at SDSU.
- The Aztecs have won 14 of their last 17 (14-3), 24 of their last 29 (24-5) and 26 of their last 32 (26-6) games dating back to last season.
