NEWS AND NOTES (through Nov. 8 games)

- San Diego State opens its 95th season of basketball and 17th under two-time national coach of the year Steve Fisher.
- Fisher, who received his bachelor's (1967) and master's degrees (1968) from Illinois State, is facing the Redbirds for just the second time. His 1990 Michigan team defeated the Redbirds, 76-70, in the first round of the NCAA tournament in Los Angeles.
- The Aztecs and Redbirds are meeting for the fourth time with ISU owning a 2-1 series lead. The teams have not met since Dec. 29, 1973, when the Aztecs posted a 97-88 win in Peterson Gym.
- The Aztecs are once again selected to win the Mountain West title, receiving 28 of 31 first-place votes in the league's media poll.
- SDSU has won 13 straight non-conference home games and 55 straight non-league games vs. unranked foes. Illinois State comes in unranked in both major top-25 polls.
- The Aztecs have gone 82 consecutive games without suffering consecutive losses. That is the second-longest active streak in the nation (Arizona, 83). SDSU has won a national-high 18 consecutive games immediately following a loss. The streak is in jeopardy Friday as the Aztecs were eliminated from the NCAA tournament in the third round by eventual NCAA champion Duke.
- SDSU is one of eight schools nationally to appear in at least six straight NCAA tournaments (beginning with 2000). See list below
- SDSU is one of nine schools in the country to make the round of 32 in each of the last three NCAA tourneys. See list below
- Since the beginning of the 2010-11 campaign, San Diego State ranks seventh nationally in winning percentage with a 141-36 record (79.7 percent). The Aztecs trail only Wichita State, Gonzaga, Duke, Kentucky, Kansas and Arizona. See list below
- Since the beginning of the 2009-10 season, San Diego State's 90-7 (92.8 percent) home record is fourth nationally, trailing only Kentucky, Kansas and Duke.
- The Aztecs are 30-1 in their last 31 home games, holding opponents to 49.4 points, 34.4-percent field-goal shooting and 23.8-percent three-point accuracy during that stretch.
- Illinois State has advanced to postseason play each of the last two seasons and has posted four consecutive winning seasons.
- Since the beginning of the 2011-12 campaign, the Redbirds rank third in the Missouri Valley (79-58, 57.7 percent), trailing only Wichita State and Northern Iowa in win percentage.
- San Diego State claimed a share of the 2015 Mountain West regular-season title (tied with Boise State) for the fifth time in the last six seasons. The Aztecs own a league-high nine Mountain West championships. Prior to Friday's game, SDSU will unveil its championship happer.
- Senior forward **Winston Shepard** is San Diego State's leading returner in scoring (11.1 ppg), rebounding (5.3 rpg) and assists (1.9). A member of the preseason all-conference team, Shepard is 16 points shy of becoming the 30th player in school history to reach 1,000 career points.
- Senior forward **Skylar Spencer**, the 2015 Mountain West Defensive Player of the Year, is already the school's all-time blocked shot leader with 231. He is 13 blocks shy of the conference record held by Wyoming's Justin Williams (244). In his career, Spencer is a 57.8-percent shooter from the floor (167-289).
- Sophomore guard **Trey Kell** has returned to his natural two-guard position after playing major portions of his minutes during his true freshman season at point guard. He had just seven turnovers in his final 12 games a year ago, dishing out 23 assists during that stretch

A WIN WOULD...

- Give SDSU its third straight season-opening win.
- Be the Aztecs' sixth consecutive season-opening victory at Viejas Arena.
- Be San Diego State's fifth straight home win in the month of November.
- Give SDSU its 14th straight non-conference home win, which would tie for the fourth-longest in school history.
- Give San Diego State's its second straight win in the Mountain West-Missouri Valley Challenge.
- Be the Aztecs' ninth straight victory on a Friday.

SDSU IN THE MOUNTAIN WEST-MISSOURI VALLEY CHALLENGE

- San Diego State is 3-1 all-time in the MW-MV Challenge.
- The Aztecs have wins at Drake (2009), vs. Wichita State (2010) and at Missouri State (2012). The one setback occurred at home vs. Creighton (2011).
- SDSU's average margin of victory has been 11.0 points. The loss to Creighton was a 85-83 decision.

FISHER A REDBIRD

- Steve Fisher was an Illinois State basketball player from 1964-67 and earned varsity letters in 1966-67.
- Fisher wore No. 31 during his time in Normal.
- In Fisher's last season, he and Illinois State beat San Diego State in the NCAA Division II quarterfinals in triple overtime, 77-76. The game took place in Evansville, Ind.
- This is the second time Fisher will coach against his alma mater. The first time occurred while he was at Michigan in the 1990 NCAA tournament (W, 76-70).

SERIES HISTORY VS. ILLINOIS STATE

- Illinois State leads the all-time series, 2-1.
- All three games have been high-scoring affairs. The average score has been Illinois State 88, San Diego State 85.
- The first two meetings took place in the Midwest (Evansville, Ind. and Normal, Ill.), but the series is evening out with the 2015-16 season opener serving as the second straight game out West.
- The Redbirds won the first two meetings, but the Aztecs won the last get-together, 97-88, inside Peterson Gym in 1973. Peterson Gym

- San Diego State is 10-25 vs. the current alignment of the Missouri Valley Conference.
- SDSU's record vs. current Missouri Valley teams: Missouri State (2-0), Northern Iowa (1-1), Drake (3-4), Illinois State (1-2), Indiana State (1-3), Evansville (1-4), Wichita State (1-5), Southern Illinois (0-2), Bradley (0-4).
- Under Steve Fisher, the Aztecs are 6-0 vs. the current MVC with its last meeting at the 2012 Diamond Head Classic where they beat Indiana State, 62-55.
- SDSU's record under Fisher vs. current Missouri Valley teams: Missouri State (2-0), Drake (1-0), Indiana State (1-0), Northern Iowa (1-0), Wichita State (1-0).

POPE NAMED TO JULIUS ERVING AWARD WATCH LIST

- Malik Pope was named to the Julius Erving Small Forward of the Year Award Watch List in October.
- Pope is one of 20 up for the annual honor named after the Hall of Famer and 11-time NBA All-Star.
- The award, which is in its second year, recognizes the top small forwards in Division I. The watch list, meanwhile, was selected by a national committee comprised of top college basketball personnel.

FAVORITES IN THE MOUNTAIN WEST

- San Diego State was picked to win the MW once again, earning 22 of 25 first-place votes and 272 points.
- The Aztecs were picked ahead of Boise State (234 points; 2 first-place votes), Utah State (190), UNLV (185), Fresno State (182; 1), New Mexico (164), Colorado State (144), Wyoming (101), Nevada (97), Air Force (51) and San José State (30).
- SDSU has been picked to win the league two years in a row (shared title last year with Boise State) and in five of the last seven seasons
- Along with the announcement of the Aztecs being the preseason favorites, Winston Shepard was named to the preseason all-conference team after earning honorable mention all-MW recognition in 2014-15.

GETTING IN A STANCE

- Defense has been a staple at San Diego State and the Aztecs are coming off one of their best efforts in school history.
- Last year, San Diego State ranked second nationally in scoring defense (53.9), fourth in fewest fouls per game (14.1), seventh in field-goal percentage defense (38.4), 16th in three-point field-goal percentage defense (30.3) and 24th in blocked shots per game (5.0).
- SDSU was fourth nationally last year in points allowed per possession at .0890, trailing only Virginia (.0862), Kentucky (.0865) and Arizona (.0883).
- In the Mountain West, San Diego State ranked first in scoring defense (53.5) and field-goal percentage defense (37.9). The Aztecs are second in three-point field-goal percentage defense (30.0), blocked shots per game (5.0), fewest personal fouls per game (14.2) and steals per game (6.9).

- San Diego State set a Mountain West record last season by allowing 52.7 points in 18 conference games. The previous record was held by the 2003-04 Air Force squad (54.4).
- Last year, San Diego State set Division I era school records for opponent points per game (53.9) and opponent field-goal percentage (38.4).
- SDSU has held 18 of its last 24 opponents to 59 points or less, including 11 opponents to 49 points or less during that stretch.

NEARLY UNBEATABLE

- SDSU truly has a homecourt edge and its record inside Viejas Arena speaks for itself. The Aztecs are 93-7 in their last 100 home games.
- Since the start of 2005-06, the Aztecs are 143-16 inside Viejas and have suffered just one three-loss season at home (2007-08).
- Only 11 teams have won inside Viejas Arena since the start of 2005-06. Of the 11, five were non-conference foes.

PASSING MARKS IN NON-CONFERENCE ACTION

■ San Diego State has won 57 of its last 59 non-conference games vs. unranked foes in the regular season.

FISHER THE 2015 WOODEN LEGENDS OF COACHING AWARD RECIPIENT

- Steve Fisher was the recipient of the John R. Wooden Legends of Award back in April in Los Angeles following the Final Four.
- The prestigious award recognizes coaches who exemplify Wooden's high standards of coaching success and personal integrity.
- Adopted in 1999, Fisher was the first coach of a Southern California school to win the award.
- The honorees are selected based on character, success on the court, graduation rates of student-athletes, coaching philosophy and identification with the goals of the John R. Wooden Award.

- SDSU's last regular-season loss to an unranked non-conference opponent prior to the Dec. 7 defeat at Washington came on Dec. 19, 2009, at Arizona State. The Aztecs also lost at Cincinnati on Dec. 17.
- Since that Dec. 19, 2009, loss, the Aztecs have gone 65-8 in non-conference action vs. all foes.

THE DEFENSE DOES NOT REST

- SDSU has held its last 28 non-conference opponents to 70 points or less in games played at home.
- In those 28 games, San Diego State is 27-1 with the only loss coming to No. 6/5 Arizona last season.

VETERAN GROUP

- The Aztecs feature a roster that has a total of 587 games under their collective belt, which is more than both of the program's NCAA Sweet 16 squads. The 2010-11 group entered the year with 523 career games played, while the 2013-14 team boasted 450 career Division I outings at the start of that campaign.
- San Diego State returns from a year ago, 58.4 percent of its scoring, 72.5 percent of its rebounding, 56.0 percent of its assists, 91.6 percent of its blocked shots, 52.6 percent of its steals, 63.4 percent of its minutes played and 51.3 percent of its made three-point field goals.

DON'T TRAIL WHEN THE CLOCK HITS 5:00

■ San Diego State has won 145 straight games when leading with five minutes to play. Last season, SDSU went 25-0 when ahead with five minutes left on the game clock.

TOUGH STRETCH

- San Diego State will endure a season-opening stretch that may be tougher than an NBA schedule.
- The Aztecs are set to play seven games in 14 days, starting Nov. 13 in San Diego and ending Nov. 27 in Las Vegas, Nevada.
- SDSU will have two one-day preps and one no-day prep. The Aztecs will have one day to prepare between at Utah on Nov. 16 and at home vs. San Diego Christian on Nov. 18. The other is at home vs. Little Rock on Nov. 21 before facing East Carolina on Nov. 23.
- The zero-day turnaround happens in Las Vegas, Nevada when San Diego State plays California on Nov. 26 and then turns around to face either Richmond or West Virginia on Nov. 27.

AZTECS SIGN JALEN MCDANIELS

- On the first day of the signing period, San Diego State signed Jalen McDaniels to a National Letter of Intent.
- A 6-9, 195-pound forward, McDaniels hails from Federal Way High School in Federal Way, Washington.
- Scout rankings: Four stars, No. 84 nationally
- 247Sports rankings: Four stars, No. 120 nationally
- Rivals rankings: Three stars, No. 127 nationally
- ESPN rankings: Three stars
- As a junior last season, he helped Federal Way High to the Class 4A state championship where he posted 16 points and eight rebounds.

STREAKING THROUGH CALIFORNIA

- SDSU had won 47 straight games vs. teams from the state of California, a streak that dated to Dec. 2, 2009, before falling at Fresno State, 59-57, on Jan. 3.
- The Aztecs are now 49-1 in their last 50 vs. California schools.
- San Diego State had also beaten five Pac-12 schools during this remarkable run.
- The 47-game winning streak vs. California schools was the longest active streak in the country ahead of second-place BYU (22 straight vs. Colorado teams) and Pittsburgh (22 straight vs. Pennsylvania teams).
- Since the start of the 2010-11 season, San Diego State owns the best record of any school in California (141-36).

TOUGH TICKET

- Entering this season, the Aztecs have played in 55 straight home sellouts at Viejas Arena.
- The 2015-16 campaign represents the fourth straight year SDSU is sold out on a season-ticket basis.
- San Diego State has led all California Division I schools in average home attendance the last five seasons.
- By averaging 12,414 fans at its home games in 2014-15, SDSU ranked 27th nationally.

ATOP THE MOUNTAIN

■ Since the beginning of the Mountain West in 1999-00, SDSU has the most men's basketball championships than any other current member of the league, which is a remarkable feat considering the Aztecs went 0-14 in league play the first season (1999-2000) and

AZTEC CALENDAR INCORPORATED ON HYPER ELITE DISRUPTION UNIFORMS

- Similar to the Aztec football team, SDSU men's basketball has incorporated the Aztec Calendar into their new Nike Hyper Elite Disruption uniforms.
- The Calendar, which was used by the Aztecs and is a piece of Mexican history dating back to the 1400s, is featured on the back panel of the uniform top.
- All of Aztecs' markings on the uniform, from the San Diego State across the chest, to the name and number on the back, to SDSU's primary logo on the shorts, are tackle-twill. The shorts, meanwhile, feature a 26-degree speed graphic on each of the sides.

PROGRAM NOTES

- San Diego State is coming off its school-record sixth straight NCAA tournament appearance, which is the eighth-longest active streak nationally entering the 2015-16 season.
- SDSU is the only school from the state of California to earn an NCAA tournament berth six years in a row. There are 24 Division I schools that reside in The Golden State.
- The Aztecs advanced to the Round of 32 last season and are one of nine schools nationally to make it to at least the third round in each of the last three seasons.
- SDSU is one of five schools to have won at least 23 games and reached the NCAA tournament in each of the last six seasons. The other four are Duke, Gonzaga, Ohio State and Wisconsin.
- San Diego State owns six of the Mountain West's last eight NCAA tournament victories (current members only) after reaching the Round of 32 last season.
- SDSU won 27 games in 2014-15, and have won at least 23 games in seven straight seasons (27.4 wins per year). The Aztecs have also won at least 25 games in six of the last seven years, including the last two campaigns (29.0 wins per year).
- San Diego State has won at least 20 games (25.8 wins per year) and advanced to the postseason 10 consecutive years (seven NCAAs, three NITs).
- The Aztecs shared the 2014-15 Mountain West regular-season championship and enter the 2015-16 campaign as the back-to-back regular-season champions. SDSU has won a conference-record nine league titles.
- SDSU has outright won or shared the Mountain West regular-season crown five times in the last six years.
- SDSU finished the 2014-15 campaign ranked 27th in the final KenPom rankings and was fourth in defensive adjusted efficiency (89.0). The Aztecs also finished seventh in defensive effective field-goal percentage (43.5), 15th in defensive two-point field-goal percentage (42.3) and 22nd in three-point field-goal percentage (30.6).
- Last season, the Aztecs appeared in the Associated Press Top-25 Poll seven times and was either in the rankings or receiving votes in 17 of the 19 weeks. SDSU was ranked as high as 13 (Dec. 1).
- San Diego State appeared in the USA Today Coaches Top-25 Poll all 20 editions of the 2014-15 rankings. The Aztecs, however, were ranked 11 times and rose to as high as 14 (Dec. 1). SDSU finished the season in the receiving votes category.

- Film room equipped with 80-inch short throw projector with write-on capability


