SDSU Softball to Face Three Top-15 Teams at Cathedral City Classic

The San Diego State softball team continues its demanding non-conference schedule this weekend at the prestigious Cathedral City Classic with three of its six games against top-15 programs.

The Aztecs (7-4), who are receiving votes in both the USA Today/USA Softball (two votes) and the ESPN.com/USA Softball (11 votes) national polls, will meet No. 6/6 Oklahoma (6 p.m. PT) and No. 8/8 Texas (8:30 p.m. PT) on Thursday, New Mexico State (8 p.m. PT) on Friday, Iowa State (10 a.m. PT) on Saturday and No. 14/15 Stanford (1 p.m. PT) and Cal State Northridge (3 p.m. PT) on Sunday.

This year's classic features 34 teams, including 14 ranked schools, that will play a combined 87 games over the five fields at the Big League Dreams Sports Park in Cathedral City, Calif. (near Palm Springs).

SDSU is coming off a 4-1 weekend at the 22nd annual Campbell/Cartier Classic, where it defeated (rv/rv) Notre Dame, (rv/-) Oregon State, Central Florida and UC Davis, before falling to No. 12/8 UCLA, 1-0, in a hard-fought game.

The San Diego State offense has homered 18 times in 11 games this season, which is already the sixth most in a season in program history and more than four of the program's seven NCAA tournament teams (2001 - 12, 2003 - 12, 2008 - 14, 2009 - 12).

Junior Kristin May (Corona, Calif.) leads the squad in batting average (.476), while sophomore Hayley Miles (Antelope, Calif.) is hitting .441 with four home runs, four doubles and a .524 on-base percentage from the leadoff spot. Lorena Klopp (San Diego/Steele Canyon HS), the program's all-time home run leader just 11 games into her sophomore season, has five homers and 11 RBIs.

The pitching trio of redshirt junior Rebecca Arbino (Clovis, Calif./Texas A&M) (1-1, 1.75 ERA, 20.0 IP), senior Bailey Micetich (Woodland, Calif.) (4-1, 2.48, 36.2) and junior Kameron May (Corona, Calif.) (2-2, 2.95, 21.1) have combined for a 2.42 team ERA over 78 innings.

HEAD COACH | 16TH SEASON | CS FULLERTON, 1983

- As a player, Van Wyk earned All-America honors and won the Broderick Award, given to the best player in the nation, in 1981 after going 35-1 with a 0.18 ERA. The victories remain a school single-season record and .972 winning percentage was an NCAA Division I record until 2001. Her phenomenal season included four no-hitters, six one-hitters, back-to-back perfect games, 26 shutouts and 270 strikeouts.
- Is the school's all-time winningest coach with 516 career victories, including a program-best 44 wins in 2008
- Earned her third Mountain West Conference Coach of the Year award in 2008 after leading the Aztecs to a 15-5 mark in league play. She also won the award in 2002 and 2006.
- Has led SDSU to seven NCAA tournament appearances (2001, 2003, 2006, 2008, 2009, 2010 and 2011)
- Guided San Diego State to its fourth MWC regular season title in 2008 with a 15-5 record. The team's other championships came in 2002, 2003 and 2006.
- Coached her fourth All-American in 2011 in Bailey Micetich. Micetich was an Easton Third-Team All-American.
- Has coached 49 all-conference selections, seven MWC Pitchers of the Year, five MWC Freshmen of the Year and 93 conference player/pitcher of the week winners

The 34-team Cathedral City Classic field showcases some of the most prestigious softball programs in the country, with 20 of the 64 2011 NCAA tournament teams participating. Of those 20 teams, 11 advanced to the NCAA Super Regional and five - Florida, Oklahoma State, Oklahoma, California and Missouri - competed in the 2011 Women's College World Series. In the latest national polls, 14 nationally ranked teams are in this year's Cathedral City Classic, while another three are receiving votes in one of the two national polls.

SDSU went 4-1 last weekend at the 22nd annual Campbell/Cartier Classic, where it defeated (rv/rv) Notre Dame, (rv/-) Oregon State, Central Florida and UC Davis, before falling to No. 12/8 UCLA, 1-0, in a hard-fought game.

Sophomore Hayley Miles (Antelope, Calif.) led San Diego State by hitting .400 (6-for-15) with two home runs, six RBIs and a double. Freshman Fiana Finau (San Diego/Hilltop HS) (.333, 2 HR, 2 RBI), senior Justeen Maeva (San Diego/Mira Mesa HS) (HR, 2 RBI) and sophomore Lorena Klopp (San Diego/Steele Canyon HS) (HR, 2 RBI) also homered for the Aztecs, while junior Kristin May (Corona, Calif.) battled injuries to hit .444 (4-for-9, 2 RBI) in nine plate appearances.

San Diego State fell to No. 12/8 UCLA, 1-0, on the final day of the 22nd annual Campbell/Cartier Classic on Sunday ... The Bruins' (10-0) run came on an illegal pitch in the top of the fifth inning by Aztec (7-4) RHP Rebecca Arbino ... The decisive inning started with Dani Yudin getting hit by a pitch. Sam Duran replaced Yudin, and moved to second base on a sacrifice bunt by Ally Carda and to third on a groundout by Marti Reed. With a 2-1 count, Arbino was called for an illegal pitch, which allowed Duran to score the only run of the game ... It was tough ending for Arbino, who allowed the lone run on just four hits (all singles), a walk and a hit batter over seven innings. She struck out four against a team that came into the game with a .412 team batting average, 13 home runs, 28 doubles and 81 runs in nine contests ... UCLA pitcher Jessica Hall was just as effective, giving up three hits (all singles) and a walk, while striking out six over the complete game shutout ... SDSU's best chance to score came in the sixth when SS Hayley Miles hit a one-out single up the middle and Tiffany Corder followed with an eight-pitch pinch-hit single. RF Patrice Jackson hit Hall hard on a 0-2 pitch, but it was right at Bruin 3B Stephany LaRosa, who touched third and beat Jackson with a throw to first to end the threat ... Miles singled and walked to lead the San Diego State offense, while Kristin May and Corder each added pinch-hit singles.

A Look at No. 6/6 Oklahoma

Oklahoma is off to a 6-1 start and is ranked sixth in both the USA Today/NFCA and ESPN.com/USA Softball national polls. The Sooners' lone loss came on Friday in a 1-0 setback to Georgia Tech, which SDSU beat, 3-2, earlier this season. Oklahoma has outscored its opposition, 50-4, this season.

Alee Allen leads OU with a .615 team batting average. Jessica Shults (.565, HR, 9 RBI) and Brianna Turang (.409, 3 SB) are also hitting above .400 for Oklahoma, which has a .331 team batting average, while Lauren Chamberlain (.389) has provided the power with team highs of four home runs and 11 RBIs. Keilani Ricketts leads a pitching staff that has a combined 0.80 ERA with a 3-1 record and 0.67 ERA over 27 innings. She has 49 strikeouts, while the opposition is batting just .094 against her. Michelle Gascoigne is 3-0 with a 1.29 ERA over 14 innings.

The Sooners lead the all-time series, 7-1, including a 4-0 win over San Diego State on Feb. 25, 2010 at the same Cathedral City Classic. All four runs were unearned in that game as current junior Kameron May (Corona, Calif.) had the Aztecs' only hit.

Scouting No. 8/8 Texas

Texas brings a 8-0 record into this weekend's action and a No. 8 national ranking in both the USA Today/NFCA and ESPN.com/USA Softball national polls. The Longhorns shut out their first five opponents and also have a win against then No. 10/7 Tennessee. UT has outscored its opponents, 76-9.

Texas is hitting .423 as a team, lead by Lexy Bennett (.609, 2 HR, 15 RBI), Taylor Thom (.550, HR, 9 RBI), Mandy Ogle (.550, HR, 9 RBI) and Karina Scott (.500, HR, 3 RBI). Additionally, the Longhorns have stolen 21 of their 22 attempts (95.5 percent), led by Brejae Washington's six swipes. Blaire Luna (4-0, 0.29 ERA, 24.0 IP) leads a pitching staff that has a 0.88 team ERA.

SDSU is tied, 1-1, with UT in the all-time series after splitting games in Austin in 2007.

A Glance at New Mexico State

New Mexico State is off to a 9-2 start after hosting tournaments the first two weekends with both of its losses coming against nationally ranked Nebraska (15-2 and 10-2).

The Aggies are hitting .372 and have 17 home runs. Tiare Jennings leads the way with a .545 average, six home runs and 25 RBIs. Amber Olive (.543), Briana Asato-Tovio (.467) and Malena Padilla (.435) are also above the .400 mark for NMSU. Celisha Walker leads a pitching staff that has a 5.12 ERA with a 3-0 record and a 1.91 ERA over 22 innings. Alex Newman (6-1, 3.97, 37.0 IP) is the other top pitcher for New Mexico State.

SDSU leads the all-time series, 5-2, including an 8-1 victory at home on March 14, 2009. Current senior Felicia Reifschneider (San Diego/Morse HS) scored as a pinch runner in that game.

Discussing Iowa State

Iowa State owns a 2-6 record heading into the Cathedral City Classic and is in the midst of a five-game losing streak (all last week at the Littlewood Classic in Tempe, Ariz.).

Lexi Slater leads the Cyclones with a .368 batting average. Tori Torrescano (.333, 3 HR, 6 RBI) and Jordan Smith (.316) have also contributed for ISU, which is hitting .255 as a team.

The pitching staff at Iowa State has struggled in the early going, combining for a 9.91 team ERA. Lauren Kennewell has the best ERA (8.22), while Torrescano (9.38 ERA) has thrown the most innings (15.2).

San Diego State leads the all-time series between the two programs, 7-3, after knocking off Iowa State, 4-3, in 10 innings on March 14, 2009 at SDSU Softball Stadium. Current seniors Ashley Rose (Antioch, Calif.) (0-for-2) and Felicia Reifschneider (San Diego/Morse HS) (1-for-1, R) each played in the game, while classmate Bailey Micetich (Woodland, Calif.) allowed three runs (one earned) on seven hits and two walks over eight innings.

Previewing No. 14/15 Stanford

Stanford is off to a 8-3 start with its losses coming to Texas A&M (10-9), UC Davis (2-1) and Nevada (11-3). Last weekend at the Nike Invitational, the Cardinal went 4-1.

Jenna Rich leads the .325-hitting Stanford team with a .438 average to go along with two doubles, two triples, a homer

and 12 RBIs. Hanna Winter (.395, 3 SB), Leah White (.379, 9 R) and Jenna Becerra (.357, 2 HR) are the team's next best hitters, while the 2011 USA Softball National Player of the Year Ashley Hansen (.333) leads the team with 12 runs. Teagan Gerhart leads the pitching staff with a 8-1 record and a 1.88 ERA over 52 innings.

SDSU leads the all-time series, 11-10, after beating the Cardinal in Palo Alto, 3-2, last March 27. Current senior Justeen Maevea (San Diego/Mira Mesa HS) had two hits, while sophomore Katie Mathis (Grass Valley, Calif.) scored twice and junior Kristin May (Corona, Calif.) homered.

Watching Cal State Northridge

Cal State Northridge is struggling out of the gate with a 0-10 record. The mark, however, is a bit deceiving as the eight of those games have been against teams that made the 2011 NCAA tournament and five have come against schools who are ranked in one of the two national polls.

Leann Lopez leads CSUN, which is hitting .171 as a team, with a .267 batting average. Jaci Carlsen (.240, 3 SB) and Mikayla Thielges (.227, 3 HR, 5 RBI) have also contributed to the offense. Mia Pagano has been the team's top pitcher on a staff that has a combined 11.09 ERA, boasting a 0-3 record with a 7.23 ERA over 31 innings.

Cal State Northridge leads the all-time series, 35-14-1, but the Aztecs swept a doubleheader last March in Northridge. Current sophomore Lorena Klopp (San Diego/Steele Canyon HS) had a combined two home runs and seven RBIs in the 4-1 and 13-0 victories.

Aztecs Receiving Votes in Both Polls

SDSU is still receiving votes in the latest ESPN.com/USA Softball poll and is back in the recognition area for the USA Today/NFCA poll after going 4-1 last weekend at the 22nd annual Campbell/Cartier Classic. All four of San Diego State's losses this season have been by one run and all have been against teams who have been nationally ranked (three) or receiving votes (one).

In the USA Today/NFCA poll, the Aztecs picked up two votes, which ties them with Maryland, Massachusetts, Purdue and Syracuse for 32nd in the nation. Auburn and Hawaii each have 76 votes and tie for 24th. North Carolina leads the receiving votes group with 60 points, followed by Florida State (42), Kentucky (15), LSU (10), New Mexico (6), South Florida (6), the five schools at two votes, and Mississippi State (1).

In the ESPN.com/USA Softball poll, SDSU gained eight votes and have 11, which is tied with former Mountain West member Brigham Young for 29th. Florida State is ranked No. 25 in the latest poll with 41 points. Hawaii's 28 points as it just out of the top 25, while Oklahoma State (26) and South Florida (20) are just ahead of San Diego State and the Cougars. Below the Aztecs are Maryland (10), Syracuse (6), McNeese State (5), Mississippi State (3), Kentucky (2), Massachusetts (2), Arkansas (1) and Virginia Tech (1).

SDSU Softball Picked to Win the MW Regular Season Title

The San Diego State softball team has been picked to win the 2012 Mountain West regular season title in a preseason poll released Feb. 7. The preseason poll was voted on by the league's five head coaches.

The Aztecs, who went 34-21 last year and 8-5 in the MW en route to earning a trip to the NCAA tournament for the fourth consecutive season and fifth time in six years, had 16 points in the poll and four first-place votes. UNLV was picked to finish second with 13 points and the other first-place vote, while Boise State (9 points), New Mexico (8) and Colorado State (4) rounded out the preseason poll.

SDSU returns five starters and three pitchers from last year's squad, including two-time all-MW pitcher Bailey Micetich (Woodland, Calif.), last year's MW Freshman of the Year Hayley Miles (Antelope, Calif.) and two-time Louisville Slugger/NFCA All-West Region pick Justeen Maeva (San Diego/Mira Mesa HS).
