- At San Diego State: Speedy, athletic receiver who is not afraid of contact ... Burst onto the scene with three catches for 58 yards in his first career game against Ohio in the 2018 DXL Frisco Bowl ... Also played on special teams.
- 2021 (Senior): Played in 10 of the team's 14 games, making four catches for 52 yards (13.0 avg.) with a long of 24 yards ... Logged nine snaps in the opener against New Mexico State on Sept. 4 without making the stat sheet ... Played 21 statless snaps at Arizona on Sept. 11 ... Did not play vs. Utah on Sept. 18 ... Made his first three catches for the season for 28 yards (9.3 avg.) with a long of 20 yards in 37 offensive snaps off the bench against Towson on Sept. 25 ... The three receptions tied a career high (third time he's had three catches in a game) ... Did not make the stat sheet in 12 snaps off the bench vs. New Mexico on Oct. 9 ... Came up with a 24-yard catch in 11 offensive snaps off the bench at San José State on Oct. 15 ... Played four snaps at Air Force on Oct. 23 and 10 vs. Fresno State on Oct. 30 ... Did not play at Hawai'i on Nov. 6, against Nevada on Nov. 13 or at UNLY on Nov. 19 ... Played two statless snaps off the bench against Boise State on Nov. 26 ... Was targeted twice in 23 snaps vs. Utah State in the Mountain West Championship game on Dec. 4 but did not make a catch ... Played 11 statless snaps against No. 24/25 UTSA in the Tropical Smoothie Frisco Bowl.
- 2020 (Junior): Played in the team's eight games off the bench ... Had four catches for 43 yards (10.8 avg.) with a long of 21 yards ... Played in the opener vs. UNLV on Oct. 24, registering a 21-yard catch ... Came up with two receptions for 10 yards (5.0 avg.) at Utah State in reserve role with a long of nine yards ... Did not make a catch in offensive snaps against San José State on Nov. 6, vs. Hawai'i on Nov. 14, at Nevada on Nov. 21, at Colorado on Nov. 28 or vs. Colorado State on Dec. 5 ... Had a 12-yard catch off the bench at No. 14/16 Brigham Young.
- 2019 (Sophomore): Played in all 13 games in a reserve role ... Had nine catches for 119 yards (13.2 avg.) with a 49-yard touchdown ... Played statless offensive snaps vs. Weber State, UCLA and New Mexico State ... Had a productive game in just 12 snaps vs. Utah State, making three catches for a career-high 65 yards (21.7 avg.) with a 49-yard touchdown ... The touchdown was the first of his career, while the three receptions tied a career best ... The 49-yard catch from Ryan Agnew was then SDSU's longest passing play this season ... The touchdown brought the Aztecs to within six points at 23-17 late in the fourth quarter ... Made a 5-yard grab in 11 snaps at Colorado State ... Did not make a catch in 16 snaps against Wyoming ... Caught an 8-yard pass at San José State in 16 snaps, which went for a first down ... Logged 19 statless snaps at UNLV ... Made a 11-yard grab in 14 snaps vs. Nevada ... Had two catches for 17 yards (8.5 avg.) in 31 snaps against Fresno State with a long of nine yards ... Had a 13-yard reception in six snaps off the bench at Hawai'i ... Logged four statless snaps against Brigham Young ... Played 16 snaps vs. Central Michigan in the New Mexico Bowl without finding the stat sheet.
- 2018 (Freshman): Made the most out of his one appearance, making three catches for 58 yards (19.3 avg.) with a long of 30 yards ... Did not play the first 12 games of the season, but was on the travel squad for games vs. Air Force, San José State, Fresno State and Hawai'i ... Made his first career appearance against Ohio in the DXL Frisco Bowl, making three catches for 58 yards (19.3 avg.) with a long of 30 yards in just nine snaps.

 Hills, Calif. ... Caught 23 passes for 259 yards and one touchdown during his junior season ...

 and a 71 by ESPN ... Ranked 27th among wide receiver prospects in the state of California and
 39th in the West by Scout ... Also competed in basketball and track and field as a prep.
